DUKES CLASH WITH SPIDERS TO WRAP REGULAR SEASON

- JMU finally returns to Bridgeforth Stadium on Saturday, April 17, as it closes the regular season with a huge CAA matchup against #11 Richmond.
- Kickoff is set for 2 p.m. at Bridgeforth Stadium and will be televised on NBC Sports Washington Plus. It will also be streamed on FloFootball (\$).
- Pregame radio coverage on the JMU Glo Fiber Radio Network begins an hour prior to kick at 1 p.m.
- JMU's 2020-21 season is sponsored by CarMax and Saturday's game is presented by Scott Insurance.

SOUTH DIVISION TITLE ON THE LINE

- This weekend's game in Harrisonburg has a lot at stake, as the victor will win the CAA South Division title.
- The league's automatic qualifier for the FCS playoffs still hangs in the balance with JMU, Richmond and Delaware still in contention.
- The CAA athletics directors will determine the league's AQ Saturday following the games.

BREAKING DOWN JMU VS. RICHMOND

- Saturday marks 38th meeting between the teams, with JMU leading 19-18.
- The series began in 1981 and JMU has led the all-time record just twice, in 1991 (5-4) and in 2020-21 (19-18).
- The Dukes and Spiders have played once a season since 1983.
- JMU has won four in a row, with Richmond's last win coming on Oct. 24, 2015 (59-49 at JMU).
- Last season's meeting was JMU's largest win (48-6) against UR at Bridgeforth Stadium and its previous trip to Robins Stadium in 2018 was the most points and largest margin of victory (63-10) in the history of the series.
- During the four-game series win streak, JMU has outscored UR on average by a margin of 44.5 to 18.
- JMU is 9-9 in games played at home, 10-8 in away matchups and 0-1 in neutral-site games.

DUKES FIRST IN EVERY FCS POLL

- JMU has maintained its #1 ranking for seven straight weeks in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25.
- It received 25 of 40 first-place votes in Monday's poll, as it was followed by #2 North Dakota State, #3 Weber State, #4 South Dakota State and #5 Sam Houston State.
- The Dukes also took the top spot once again in the AFCA Coaches' Poll and was honored as the #1 team in the NCAA Division I Selection Committee's top-10 ranking that was released on April 1.
- Five CAA teams are ranked once again this week, as Delaware is 7th, Villanova is 10th, Richmond is 11th and Rhode Island is 19th.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

- Back on Nov. 16, 2019, five JMU players scored touchdowns and the Dukes forced four turnovers en route to a 48-6 win against Richmond.
- The victory clinched JMU's 2019 outright CAA championship.
- Ben DiNucci threw for 179 yards and three touchdowns while adding 39 and a score on the ground.
- Jawon Hamilton rushed for 80 yards on 10 carries and Percy Agyei-Obese had a rushing touchdown.
- Brandon Polk caught four passes for 104 yards and a TD, and Riley Stapleton had six catches for 72 yards and a pair of scores.
- JMU out-gained UR 423-265, including 235-61 in the run game.
- The Dukes conceded just six points on Richmond's three red-zone trips.

DUKES VS. THE COMMONWEALTH

- Since the start of the program in 1972, JMU has faced 15 teams from the state of Virginia.
- In 151 games, JMU has racked up a 90-61 record against teams from the Commonwealth.
- It has won 10 straight games against teams from around the state since 2016.
- The Dukes have played William & Mary more than any other team, going 26-17 in 43 all-time games.
- This week's opponent, Richmond, is next with 37 all-time matchups, with JMU going 19-18 in those games.
- JMU has also faced former FCS program and FBS independent Liberty 18 times, going 12-6.

DEFENSE CONTINUES DOMINANCE

- JMU's defense is proving to be on the best in the FCS this spring, and its second-half numbers are simply incredible.
- Last time out at William & Mary did a team manage points in the second half, however it was against JMU reserves.
- In second halves through four games, JMU has allowed just 11 first downs, -33 rushing yards, 175 passing yards, 142 total yards and 4-for-23 on third down.
- In fourth quarters alone, the defense has conceded five first downs, -28 rushing yards, 63 passing yards, 35 total yards and just one third-down conversion.
- Nationally, JMU leads the country in total defense (169.5) and is second in rushing defense (38.0), fourth in scoring defense (10.8) and seventh on both third-down (28.6%) and in passing defense (131.5)

DUKES CRUISE AGAINST TRIBE

- JMU scored touchdowns on its first four drives and rolled to a 38-10 win in JMU's last game at William & Mary on March 27.
- The Dukes out-gained W&M by nearly 300 yards (460-187) and held the Tribe to just 2.2 per carry.
- Cole Johnson threw for 220 yards and a touchdown, while Kaelon Black rushed for 141 yards and a score.
- Jawon Hamilton also scored two touchdowns, and Antwane Wells Jr. had career highs of six catches for 86 yards.
- JMU also scored once on special teams, as Alex Miller converted a seven-yard touchdown run on a fake field goal.

RATKE TIES CAA RECORD

- Ethan Ratke has closed in on rewriting the CAA record books, as he tied the league's career record for most field goals.
- He converted a 42-yard field goal at William & Mary for his 64th career field goal.
- He tied Towson's Aidan O'Neill (2016-19) for the all-time record.
- Ratke also ranks tied for ninth in FCS history in career field goals.
- The FCS record sits at 75 field goals, set by Montana's Dan Carpenter (2004-07).
- He's also the CAA all-time leader in career scoring by a kicker, at 355. That mark is also 16th in FCS history.

JMU ACTIVE STREAKS

JMU Shuts Out Morehead State, 52-0, in 2020-21 Opener

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Fourth-ranked James Madison football ran all over Zane Showker Field, accumulating more than 350 rushing yards and six scores on the ground, en route to a 52-0 season-opening victory against Morehead State on Saturday afternoon at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The Dukes moved to 1-0, playing in the program's first-ever, regular-season spring game, while the Eagles fell to 0-1. JMU moved to 8-2 all-time against MSU, having now won five straight in the series.

JMU dominated the ground game, rushing for 369 yards. Four different backs ran for more than 60 yards and scored touchdowns. Percy Agyei-Obese tallied a game-high 116 yards and a touchdown, Solomon Vanhorse had 82 yards and a score on just five carries, while both Latrelle Palmer (90) and Jawon Hamilton (68) found the endzone twice.

Cole Johnson was 10-of-14 for 147 yards and a touchdown, connecting on a 52-yard pass to Kris Thornton for his first passing score of the year. Thornton finished the game with three catches for a game-high 90 yards and the score. JMU's quarterbacks found 10 different pass catchers in the game.

Defensively, Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey led the way with a team- and career-high eight tackles with a tackle for loss. Mike Greene tallied five tackles with a pair for loss and a sack. Wayne Davis and Que Reid each nabbed interceptions, leading to a +1 turnover ratio. Three other Dukes recorded sacks in Mateo Jackson, Mikail Kamara and Sean Johns.

JMU opened each half with the hot hand on offense, scoring touchdowns on its first three drives while opening the second half with three touchdowns and a field goal. Morehead State was forced into six three-and-outs by JMU's defense.

GAME FACTS

- Today marked the JMU's 28th shutout in program history, as it has blanked an opponent in four straight seasons.
- JMU out-gained Morehead State, 556-98 on the afternoon.
- The rushing differential was massive, as JMU ran for 386 yards, as opposed to MSU's negative six. It also had 6.4 yards per carry, holding MSU to -0.2 per run.
- The Dukes went 9-for-13 on third down while holding the Eagles to a 5-of-16 clip.
- JMU made 12 tackles for loss, while MSU tallied three.
- The Dukes scored on all six red-zone trips while MSU never made it inside the JMU 20.
- JMU also thwarted MSU's only real scoring chance on a Tony Thurston blocked field goal.
- Morehead State was led by DeAndre Clayton, who came in to throw 7-of-9 for 71 passing yards and an interception.

RATKE TOP 20 IN FCS HISTORY

- Ethan Ratke's fourth-quarter field goal was the 59th of his career, which ties him for second all-time in CAA history.
- He's tied with William & Mary's Greg Kuehn (2002-05).
- Ratke also moved into the FCS top 20, as he's tied for 16th in career field goals.

#2 Dukes Pull Away in Second Half for Win Over Robert Morris

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Second-ranked James Madison reeled off 27 unanswered points and clamped down defensively, holding Robert Morris scoreless in the second half, en route to a 36-16 non-conference football victory on Saturday afternoon at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The Dukes improved to 2-0 while the Colonials fell to 0-1. JMU also moved to 2-0 in the all-time series.

After allowing 163 yards and 4.4 per play in the first half, JMU's defense took over, allowing just 24 second-half yards, as RMU mustered just a single yard per snap over the final 30 minutes.

The Dukes tied the game just before halftime and tacked on another score to take the lead, at 23-16 with 10:41 to play in the third. JMU would go on to score on four of six drives to open the second half to pull away.

Percy Agyei-Obese ran for 55 yards and two touchdowns, while Jawon Hamilton led all players with 74 rushing yards, averaging 8.2 per carry. Kris Thornton found the endzone once again this week, reeling in five catches for 65 yards and a score. Antwane Wells Jr. also caught his first career touchdown, which tied the game just before the half. Cole Johnson was 17-of-24 for 198 yards, two touchdowns and three interceptions.

Defensively, Kelvin Azanama and Wayne Davis led the Dukes with eight tackles apiece. It was a career high for Azanama, while Davis matched his career best. MJ Hampton was active all over the field, accruing seven tackles with a career-high 1.5 for loss, while also forcing and recovering a key fumble in the second half. JMU transfers Abi Nwabuoku-Onkonji and Mason Cholewa each turned in their first sacks at JMU as part of the stout effort in the second half.

GAME FACTS

- JMU out-gained Robert Morris 394 to 187, which included a dominant 209 to 24 margin in the second half.
- The Dukes limited RMU to just 22 rushing yards and 0.7 per carry. Through two games, JMU has conceded 16 total rushing yards after Morehead State had -6 in week one.
- JMU allowed just one third-down conversion, as RMU went 1-for-13. The Dukes were 4-of-11 on third-down tries.
- Harry O'Kelly shined on special teams, averaging 48.5 yards on his four punts, which included pinning the Colonials inside the 2-yard line twice. All four of his punts were inside the 20. His first punt, downed at the one, led to an eventual safety.
- The teams were perfect in the red zone, as JMU was 4-for-4 (2 TD) and RMU was 2-for-2 (1 TD).
- For RMU, George Martin threw for 165 yards and a touchdown, with D'Andre Hicks making eight catches for 67 yards. Aniello Buzzacco led all players with 15 tackles.

Dukes Storm Back to Upend Elon 20-17 in CAA Opener

ELON, N.C. – James Madison overcame a 14-point halftime deficit, scoring the final 17 points of the game, to rally past Elon, 20-17, in the Colonial Athletic Association football opener for both teams on Saturday afternoon at Rhodes Stadium.

The #1 Dukes improved to 3-0 (1-0 CAA) while the Phoenix dropped to 1-2 (0-1 CAA). JMU also moved to 8-1 in the all-time series with Elon.

After falling behind 17-3 at halftime, the Dukes never allowed Elon to score again, limiting the hosts to just 36 second-half yards with a pair of first downs. Trailing 17-6 into the fourth quarter, the Dukes put together back-to-back touchdown drives with a huge special-teams play in between.

Inserting Gage Moloney at quarterback, he capped off a 13-play, 79-yard drive with an 18-yard touchdown to Antwane Wells Jr. to trim the deficit to 17-13 with 12:22 to go. On the ensuing possession, MJ Hampton blocked Hunter Stephenson's punt, setting up the Dukes at the Elon 33.

Seven plays later, Percy Agyei-Obese rushed to the endzone untouched from eight yards out to give JMU its first lead with 7:27 to go. After another three-and-out, JMU ran out the final 5:59 with an 11-play drive.

Agyei-Obese rushed for a career-high 132 yards and a score, averaging 6.9 per carry. Jawon Hamilton also ran for 63 yards, as the Dukes held a 231-77 advantage on the ground.

Cole Johnson was 9-of-16 for 107 yards and an interception, while Moloney finished the game 3-of-6 for 46 yards and a score. Kris Thornton had three catches for 53 yards, Scott Bracey had a game-high four grabs for 41 yards and Wells had two catches with his score.

Defensively, Kelvin Azanama had a game-high eight tackles with three hurries, and Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey made seven stops. Mike Greene was a force up front, with 3.5 tackles for loss, a career-high, and a sack. In his first career start James Carpenter had five tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss and a half sack. Wesley McCormick also registered his first career interception in the second half.

GAME FACTS

- JMU out-gained Elon 384-206, which included a 250-36 advantage in the second half.
- Elon scored the game's first 10 points and 17 of the first 20, before the Dukes closed the game with 17 unanswered over the final 20:06.
- JMU's defense tallied 9.0 tackles for loss and held the Phoenix to only 77 yards rushing (2.3 per carry).
- Elon was 5-of-9 on third down in the first half, before the Dukes gave up a 2-of-8 mark over the final 30 minutes to have them finish 7-of-17.
- Hampton's blocked punt marked the second straight year he's blocked a punt at Elon.
- Ethan Ratke made a pair of field goals to move up to 13th all-time in FCS history with 63 career field goals and 18th with 347 career points.
- The Phoenix was led by JR Martin, who threw for 129 yards and a touchdown. Jaylan Thomas also ran for 49 yards and eight different EU players caught a pass.

WHAT A COMEBACK

- For the second straight week, JMU overcame a slow start to rally for the win.
- JMU trailed 16-9 in the second quarter to Robert Morris last week, and was down 17-3 at half and 17-6 after three at Elon.
- The last time JMU overcame a double-digit deficit was Nov. 8, 2014, when it rallied from being down 24-10 to upend Stony Brook 27-24 on the road.

Fast Start Sets Tone in #1 JMU's 38-10 Win at William & Mary

WILLIAMSBURG, Va. – #1 James Madison scored touchdowns on its first four drives and used a stout defensive effort en route to a 38-10 Colonial Athletic Association football victory at William & Mary on Saturday afternoon at Zable Stadium.

The Dukes improved to 4-0 on the year and 2-0 in CAA play while the Tribe fell to 1-2 overall and in the league standings.

JMU out-gained William & Mary by nearly 300 yards on the day, which included a strong day from quarterback Cole Johnson, who threw for 220 yards and a touchdown on 16-of-22 passing in less than three quarters of work.

Rookie running back Kaelon Black had a career outing, as he rushed for 141 yards and his first collegiate touchdown, averaging 7.4 yards on his 19 carries. Jawon Hamilton also rushed for 40 yards and two scores for his second multi-touchdown game of the season. JMU also got help on the ground in special teams, as holder Alex Miller took a fake punt seven yards for his first career touchdown, which put JMU up 21-0 after one.

In the passing game, Antwane Wells Jr. led all players with career highs of six receptions for 86 yards, including 42 yards after the catch. Kris Thornton made three grabs for 49 yards and Clayton Cheatham recorded two catches for 38 yards, scoring the game's first touchdown.

Defensively, Kelvin Azanama tallied a career-high 11 tackles (10 solo) with a sack and pass breakup. Que Reid made six stops with an interception, and Diamonte Tucker-Dorsey contributed five tackles and a TFL. Wayne Davis, Mikail Kamara and Abi Nwabuku-Ononji each added sacks in the win.

JMU offense was clicking on all cylinders from the opening kickoff, as they scored three touchdowns in the first 15 minutes. Johnson found Cheatham on a six-yard pass to cap off a 13-play, 75-yard drive, giving JMU a 7-0 lead.

After another touchdown, in which Hamilton found the end zone for the first time, the Dukes forced an interception on the Tribe's first play of the ensuing drive, setting up Miller's fake field goal for a touchdown to lead 21-0 at the end of the first quarter.

Hamilton scored again to cap off an 81-yard drive, making it 28-0 late in the first half. The Dukes, leading 28-3 at the break, forced William & Mary into four consecutive three-and-outs to open the second half, and Black's 11-yard run late in the third made it 38-3. The Tribe added a late score for the final margin.

- JMU out-gained William & Mary 460-187, which included a 240-59 advantage in the run game.
- JMU limited the Tribe to just 2.2 yards per carry while gaining 5.2 per rush.
- The Dukes had 24 first downs, as opposed to W&M's 10.
- JMU controlled the time of possession by a margin of 35:23 to 24:37.
- The Dukes were 9-of-14 on third down, while holding the Tribe to a 3-of-10 clip.
- JMU cashed in on all five red-zone trips, all of which were touchdowns.

- Ethan Ratke tied the CAA all-time record for career field goals, as he converted a 42-yard kick in the third quarter for his 64th made field goal. He tied Towson's Aidan O'Neill (2016-19).
