### DUKES WELCOME IN BLACK BEARS

- JMU is back home for week two of its 50th season of football on Saturday, Sept. 11 when it hosts Maine.
- Kickoff from Bridgeforth Stadium is set for 4 p.m. and will be televised on NBC Sports Washington Plus while being streamed on FloFootball (\$).
- Pregame radio coverage on the Morris Insurance & Financial JMU Radio Network begins at 3 p.m.
- The JMU football season is sponsored by CarMax, and Saturday's game is presented by Pepsi.

### BREAKING DOWN THE SERIES

- Saturday's opener marks the 19th meeting between the teams, with JMU hold a 13-5 series lead.
- This is the first meeting between the teams since 2017.
- JMU has won three straight in the series, with road wins in 2012 and 2016 and a home triumph in 2017.
- It has also won eight of nine, with Maine's last win coming back on Oct. 8, 2011 in a 25-24 overtime victory at Bridgeforth Stadium.
- The Dukes are 6-2 against Maine at home, while going 7-3 in Orono.
- JMU has never scored more than 38 points against Maine, while the Black Bears have never scored above 28.
- All-time in the series, JMU averages 22.8 points per game, while Maine scores 15.3 per contest.

### MULTIPLE RECORDS SET IN BIG OPENING WIN

- JMU set a pair program records and matched two others in its 68-10 season-opening win last Saturday against Morehead State.
- The Dukes held MSU to an astounding -57 rushing yards, shattering the previous record of -35 against Bloomsburg in 1989. They also scored 51 second-half points, the most in a second half in team history.
- Cole Johnson threw for a career-high five touchdowns, tying the single-game passing touchdowns record, and adding in Billy Atkins' touchdown toss, JMU's six total passing scores also matched the school record.
- The Dukes out-gained the Eagles by nearly 500 yards, racking up 687 yards of total offense, which was the fifth-most yards in a single game. JMU rushed for 345 yards while throwing for 342.
- Kaelon Black ran for 100 yards on 12 carries, while Latrelle Palmer had 98 yards and a pair of scores. In the air, Kris Thornton and Solomon Vanhorne both reeled in a pair of touchdown catches.
- JMU had a +4 turnover margin, producing three interceptions and a fumble recovery.
- The Dukes also went 9-for-13 on third down while holding MSU to a 4-for-14 clip.

## CELEBRATING 50 SEASONS

- James Madison University began sponsoring football in 1972, as this fall marks the 50th season for the Dukes.
- JMU will celebrate the 50th all season long, honoring specific decades at each home game.
- This week, the Dukes honor the 1980's, which featured the program's first wins over FBS opponents and the first pro draft picks.
- In week one, the Dukes recognized the 1972 team and remembered Dr. Challace McMillin, the first coach in program history, who passed away in 2020.
- Other content, such as video features, alumni interviews, Throwback Thursdays and On This Date will highlight the history of JMU football.
- JMU has won two national championships, nine conference titles and has made 17 postseason appearance.
- All-time JMU is 339-218-4 for a .608 win percentage.

## JOHNSON HONORED BY CAA

- Following a career outing in the opener, Cole Johnson was named CAA Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 6.
- Johnson was 19-of-28 (67.9%) for 298 yards and five touchdowns, tying the program's single-game record.
- He averaged 15.7 yards per completion, which is top 10 nationally after the opening week.
- Johnson aided in JMU gaining 687 yards, the fifth-most in school history.

## JMU IN CAA OPENERS

- JMU is in its 29th season as a member of CAA Football in 2021.
- The Dukes are 20-8 in conference openers.
- JMU has won six straight CAA openers, with Villanova being the last team to spoil a CAA opener for the Dukes in 2014.
- The Dukes joined the CAA (formerly the Atlantic 10 and Yankee Conference) in 1993.

## JMU-MAINE CONNECTION

- Two JMU coaches and one student-athlete have previous ties to Maine.
- Defensive Coordinator Corey Hetherman was with the Black Bears from 2015-18, serving as the DC for his final three seasons.
- Cornerbacks coach Matt Birkett spent seven seasons at Maine, as he was with the program from 2012-18.
- Jordan Swann, a cornerback for the Dukes, was with the Black Bears from 2018-20, playing in 17 career games.

## RUNNING BACK ROOM IS LOADED

- JMU was without All-American Percy Agyei-Obese, but that didn't stop the deep running back room from gaining 345 yards on the ground.
- The Dukes averaged 7.7 yards per carry.
- Kaelon Black led the squad with 148 all-purpose yards, gaining 100 yards on 12 carries and making two catches for 48 yards.
- Latrele Palmer scored twice and gained 98 yards rushing, while Peyton Rutherford finished with 58 yards in the fourth quarter alone.
- Seven different players had a rush of at least 10 yards, including three over 20.

## RATKE NEARING FCS HISTORY

- Ethan Ratke already owns the JMU and CAA career records for both field goals and scoring.
- After week one, Ratke has converted 73 field goals and has scored 404 points, and he's nearing two national records.
- He's one of just six players ever in the FCS with 70 or more field goals and he needs just three to become the all-time leader.
- Dan Carpenter, who played 2004-07 at Montana, has 75 career field goals.
- Ratke also ranks second in the FCS in career scoring by a kicker, as he needs just 10 points to surpass Carpenter's record of 413.
- Amongst all players (kickers or non-kickers), Ratke ranks 15th in FCS history in scoring, as only 15 players at any position have reached 400 career points.

## WHAT'S ON DECK

- JMU hits the road to face #10 Weber State in Ogden, Utah on Saturday, Sept. 18.
- Kickoff is set for 8 p.m. ET (6 p.m. MT) and will be streamed on ESPN+.
- This is the third all-time meeting, with JMU owning playoff wins in 2017 and 2019.
- It will be the furthest west JMU has ever traveled and its first trip to the Mountain time zone.
- JMU previously traveled to Dallas four times and Fargo, N.D., twice.

- The Dukes have faced 15 teams from the Commonwealth since beginning football in 1972.
- In 150 games, JMU has racked up an 89-61 record against teams from around the state.
- The Dukes have played William & Mary (25-17) more than any other state team, at 42 games, and have faced Richmond (19-18) 37 times and Liberty (12-6) on 18 occasions.

## DUKES IN SEASON OPENERS

- The Dukes are 27-22-1 in season openers dating back to the inaugural 1972 season.
- JMU rolled to a 68-10 win on Sept. 4 vs. Morehead State and hasn't lost to a FCS opponent to open the season since 2002.
- It was the fifth time JMU and MSU met on the opening weekend, with JMU claiming wins in 2010, 2015, 2016, 2020 and 2021 - all at JMU.
- In home openers, JMU is 39-11, which includes 19 straight home-opening victories.
- During its current 19-game win streak to open the Bridgeforth slate, JMU has outscored its opponents by an average of 49.3 to 8.8. JMU has put up more than 40 points in 15 of those wins, including 80 in the '16 opener.
- The last team to win JMU's first home game was Hampton - a 31-28 Pirate triumph on Aug. 31, 2002.

## JMU'S SUPER BOWL CHAMPS

### Dukes Set Multiple Records in Season-Opening Win Against MSU

**HARRISONBURG, Va.** – James Madison kicked off the 50th season of football in style, setting two team records while matching another in a 68-10 victory against Morehead State on Friday night at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The second-ranked Dukes limited the Eagles to an astounding -57 rushing yards, shattering the previous record of -35 against Bloomsburg in 1989. JMU also scored 51 second-half points, the most in a second half in school history and the second most in any half.

Quarterback Cole Johnson threw for a career-high five touchdowns and the Dukes had six total passing touchdowns, tying both JMU records for passing touchdowns by an individual and a team.

The Dukes out-gained MSU by nearly 500 yards, as they racked up 687 yards of total offense, the fifth most in school history. JMU rushed for 345 yards and threw for 342.

Running back Kaelon Black rushed 12 times for 100 yards, the second 100-yard game in just his third career outing. Fellow running back Latrelle Palmer also ran for 98 yards and a pair of touchdowns for his third career two-touchdown game. Peyton Rutherford finished the game strong, adding 58 yards in the fourth quarter, which included a game-long 56-yard rush.

Johnson was 19-of-28 for 298 yards with his five scores, while rookie quarterback Billy Atkins finished the game 4-of-7 for 44 yards and his first career touchdown.

The quarterback duo found four different Dukes for touchdowns in the passing game, led by Kris Thornton, who had four catches for 82 yards and a pair of scores. Antwane Wells made four grabs for 60 yards and a touchdown, Kevin Curry had three receptions for a career-best 50 yards and a touchdown while Solomon Vanhorse reeled in three passes for 39 yards and two touchdowns.

Defensively, safety Chris Chukwuneke turned in a career-high six tackles with one for loss. Safety Que Reid made five stops with an interception and a breakup, as he was one of four Dukes to produce a takeaway. Cornerbacks Greg Ross and Taurus Carroll each had an interception, while defensive lineman Abi Nwabuku-Ononji registered his first career fumble recovery.

JMU led 17-3 at the half, before turning on the jets, scoring four touchdowns in the third to extend the lead to 45-10. Palmer sparked the offense with a 47-yard touchdown on the fourth play of the second half, and the Dukes followed that with Johnson touchdown passes to Thornton and Vanhorse. In the fourth, the Dukes found the endzone four times, with three touchdowns and a safety. That included first career touchdowns for both Atkins and quarterback Patrick Bentley, who capped off the scoring with a four-yard touchdown run in the final minute.

MSU's Mark Pappas threw for 243 yards and three interceptions, finding his All-PFL receiver BJ Byrd nine times for 127 yards.
