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DUKES HOST BOBCATS FOR FAMILY WEEKEND

- James Madison returns home after a big road win last week, as it gets set to host Texas State in Sun Belt Conference action on Saturday during Family Weekend.
- Kickoff from Bridgeforth Stadium is set for 1:30 p.m. and will be streamed on ESPN+.
- Pregame radio coverage on the Morris Insurance & Financial JMU Radio Network will begin at 12:30 p.m.
- Saturday's game is sponsored by Sentara and the 2022 JMU football season is presented by CarMax.

NEW OPPONENT FOR THE DUKES

- Saturday marks the first meeting between JMU and Texas State.
- The Bobcats become the third Texas team to play the Dukes, as JMU is 2-1 in previous games against programs from the Lone Star State.
- The Dukes are 1-1 against Sam Houston, winning at home in 2016 and falling on the road in 2020. JMU also picked up an FBS win at SMU in 2015 in its first game ever in Texas.
- JMU has also played three other games in Frisco, Texas, going 1-2 in those national championship appearances.

JMU STORMS BACK, STUNS APP STATE

- Trailing 28-3 at App State, JMU mounted a historic comeback, scoring 29 unanswered to rally for a 32-28 win in Boone, N.C., on Sept. 24.
- App State scored on four consecutive drives in the second quarter to take a 25-point lead. JMU would respond with 29 in a row between the late second and early fourth.
- JMU's final 22 points were scored in a span of 5:43 between the late third and early fourth quarters.
- After allowing App's last score, JMU's defense proceeded to limit the Mountaineers to just 84 yards on their final nine drives. That stretch included a +2 turnover margin for the Dukes, four three-and-outs and a one-play drive that ended with a Jailin Walker interception to set up Kaelon Black's go-ahead touchdown.
- Todd Centeio threw for two touchdowns and ran for another while Black scored a touchdown both in the air and on the ground.
- JMU outgained App State 375-298, which included a 166-63 margin in the run game.
- It was the Dukes' first Sun Belt win and is the largest comeback in the FBS this season.
- JMU won in Boone for just the third time and for the first time since 1991.

DUKES RECEIVE VOTES IN BOTH MAJOR FBS POLLS

- JMU received votes in both major FBS polls after a 3-0 start and a statement win in Boone.
- The Dukes received four votes in the Associated Press Top 25 College Football Poll, while reeling in 11 votes in the USA Today Sports AFCA Coaches' Poll.
- It additionally received one vote in the Football Writers Association of America-National Football Foundation Super 16 Poll.
- This is the third time ever that JMU is receiving votes in the AP Top 25 and the first time for both the USA Today and FWAA-NFF Super 16 polls.
- Back in 2010, the Dukes received votes in the AP poll both on Sept. 12 (11) and Sept. 19 (8) following a win at Virginia Tech.

CENTEIO NAMED SBC POTW

- Todd Centeio became JMU's first Sun Belt Offensive Player of the Week in a vote by the league's media following JMU's win at App State.
- Centeio tallied 297 total yards, throwing for 209 yards and two touchdowns while leading the game with 88 rushing yards and a score.
- He guided JMU on three straight touchdown drives in a span of 5:43 to go from down 28-10 to leading 32-28.
- This season, he ranks top 15 in the FBS in three categories, including fifth in point responsibility per game (24.7), 10th in pass efficiency rating (180.0) and 12th in passing touchdowns (11).

KAEON HONORED BY HORNUNG AWARD

- Kaelon Black was recognized on the Paul Hornung Award Honor Roll on Sept. 27.
- Black rushed for 85 yards and a touchdown, averaging 4.7 yards per carry, in JMU's 32-28 come-from-behind win against the Mountaineers.
- He also added a 23-yard touchdown reception for the first multi-score game of his career.
- Black's fourth-quarter touchdown rush put JMU ahead for good to cap off the FBS' largest comeback of the 2022 season.
- The Paul Hornung Award, presented by Texas Roadhouse, is now in its 13th season and given annually to the most versatile player in major college football by the Louisville Sports Commission.

21 TEAMS REMAIN UNBEATEN

- Following the 4th full week of college football, JMU remains one of just 21 unbeaten FBS teams.
- Only two Sun Belt teams hold an unblemished record - JMU and Coastal Carolina.
- The SBC duo are the only unbeaten teams from outside the SEC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12 and Pac 12.
- The SEC leads the country with five teams, followed by four each from the ACC and Big Ten. Three unbeaten teams are also from both the Big 12 and Pac 12.

JMU IN THE NATIONAL RANKS

- Entering week five of the college football season, JMU ranks top 10 in the FBS in 11 stat areas.
- That includes leading the country in four different areas, including rushing defense (26.3), tackles for loss per game (10.7), fourth-down defense (0%) and fewest interceptions (0).
- JMU boasts one of the top defenses thus far, ranking third in total defense (208.0), which is just over 20 yards per game off Minnesota's lead pace (187.8).
- The Dukes are also seventh in fewest turnovers (2), ninth in scoring offense (46.3) and punt-return defense (0.0) and 10th in third-down defense (26.3%), sacks per game (3.33) and pass efficiency rating (181.29).

DUKES TO PLAY ON NFL NETWORK

- Following this week's game, JMU hits the road for Jonesboro, Ark., to take on Arkansas State on Saturday, Oct. 8.
- Kickoff is set for 7 p.m. ET (6 p.m. CT) from Centennial Bank Stadium, and the game will be televised nationally on NFL Network.
- This is JMU's first national broadcast in its FBS era and will also be JMU's first matchup against the Red Wolves.

TRY RUNNING ON THE DUKES

- In recent years, JMU has prided itself on stopping the run. Even a move to the FBS and Sun Belt hasn't slowed the front seven down, as JMU leads the country in rushing defense.
- Through three games, JMU has only given up 88 total rushing yards - that's 26.3 per game.
- In last week's win at App State, the Mountaineers only mustered 63 yards on 34 carries (1.9 avg).
- JMU's defense did that to an offense that was averaging 208 rushing yards per game and 4.8 per carry entering last Saturday.
- The Dukes lead the country in tackles for loss, at 10.7 per game and is third in total defense, at 208.0 yard allowed per contest.

THIRD DOWN STREAK CONTINUES

- App State was 2-of-4 on third down at halftime while holding its 28-10 lead against JMU.
- It seemed JMU's stretch of not allowing a team at 50% or better was in jeopardy.
- Fast forward to the second half -- JMU's defense held App to just 2-of-8, finishing at 4-of-12.
- That performance was the 26th straight game that JMU held its foes to under 50% on third.
- North Dakota State was right at 50% during the 2019 FCS championship game.
- The last team to go over 50% on third was NC State in the 2018 season opener - that spans 52 consecutive games for the Dukes' defense.

COMING BACK FROM 28-3

- It's not the first time we've seen a team climb back from a 28-3 deficit.
- The New England Patriots rallied back from down 28-3 in Super Bowl LI on Feb. 5, 2017 against the Atlanta Falcons, winning 34-28 in overtime.
- Fast forward to Sept. 24, 2022, where JMU reeled off 29 unanswered to stun App State.
- In both instances, teams found themselves down 18 at the break - New England trailed 21-3 and JMU 28-10.
- While JMU held App State to just 84 yards on its final nine drives, JMU gained 282 over eight drives beginning with its first touchdown.
- Fun fact: JMU lost 40 yards on kneel downs on the final four plays, or else it would have rushed for more than 200 yards and gained over 400 yards of total offense.

KT'S ON THE JMU CHARTS

- Kris Thornton ranks top 10 at JMU in all three receiving categories, positioning himself as one of the best at the position in just 25 games.

CIGNETTI IN SEASON #4

- Curt Cignetti is in his fourth season at the helm in 2022 and his 12th overall as a head coach.
- Over his first three-plus seasons, he's guided JMU to a 36-5 record, three conference championships and three trips to the FCS semifinals, with a title-game berth in his first season.
- He opened JMU's FBS era with a 44-7 home win against Middle Tennessee from the C-USA.
- After a dominant win against Norfolk State, he guided the Dukes to an incredible 32-28 comeback win at App State, in which they rallied from a 28-3 deficit for their first Sun Belt win.
- JMU's final win at the FCS level on Dec. 10, 2021, a 28-6 triumph over Montana in FCS quarterfinals, was the 100th career victory for Cignetti.
- The two-time VaSID State Coach of the Year has coached three Consensus All-Americans at JMU and 25 total since the 2019 season.
- Prior to JMU, Cignetti spent the 2017 and 2018 seasons at Elon, going 14-9. He was first a head coach at Division II Indiana (Pa.), where he was 53-17 from 2011-16.

HOME COOKIN'

- New subdivision, same result.
- Since 2016, JMU has been incredible at the friendly confines of Bridgeforth Stadium.
- Over the past six-plus seasons, the Dukes have gone 45-2 on their home turf.
- That includes four unbeaten seasons, going 9-0 in 2017 and 2019, 8-0 in 2016 and 5-0 in 2020.
- During the span, JMU has scored 50+ points in 22 games, had 10 over 60 points, four over 70 and two with at least 80.
- JMU's first home loss from 2016-21 came on Oct. 6, 2018 when current head coach Curt Cignetti led Elon to a 27-24 win.
- The Dukes saw a 19-game home win streak end last season on Oct. 9, 2021, falling 28-27 to Villanova.

THE SUN HAS RISEN

- James Madison ushered in a new era, as it officially joined the Sun Belt Conference on July 1.
- The Dukes are one of 14 full-time members of the Sun Belt, and with the additions of JMU, Old Dominion, Marshall and Southern Miss, the league unveiled its east and west divisions.
- The east consists of App State, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, JMU, Marshall and ODU.
- The west is comprised of Arkansas State, Louisiana, South Alabama, Southern Miss, Texas State, Troy and ULM.
- James Madison is first institution to host five FBS opponents in the first year of its FBS transition since the NCAA implemented the two-year transition process for reclassifying institutions in 1997.
- New SBC members went 3-1 in their debuts in the league with USM's 40T loss being the lone setback.
- The league has produced major victories already at Notre Dame, Texas A&M and Nebraska, and App State hosted College GameDay on Sept. 17.

CENTEIO ON O'BRIEN WATCH LIST

- Quarterback Todd Centeio received quite the national attention following JMU's season-opening victory, which included being added to a prestigious watch list.
- Centeio became the first JMU quarterback to throw for six touchdowns while also rushing for more than 100 yards in a single game.
- He's also the first FBS quarterback to achieve those numbers since Louisville's Lamar Jackson in 2016.
- Centeio was added to the Davey O'Brien Award midseason watch list after being selected to the Davey O'Brien Great 8 List for week one.
- He, along with wide receiver Kris Thornton were named to the Pro Football Network's Week 1 College Football Team of the Week, and the signal caller was also recognized amongst the Allstate Sugar Bowl's Manning Award Stars of the Week.
- Centeio also received a helmet sticker from ESPN anchor Matt Barrie on College Football Final.

KT EARNS REGIONAL HONOR

- For the second time in his career and the first at the FBS level, Kris Thornton was named DC Touchdown Club Washington Metro College Football Player of the Week after week one.
- His week-one totals were just one catch and 10 yards shy of career highs.
- It was his fifth 2+ touchdown game and his fourth over 100 receiving yards since the start of the 2021 season.
- He turned in his sixth multi-TD game and fifth 100-yard outing the next week.

JMU AGAINST THE COMMONWEALTH

- The Dukes have faced 15 teams from the Commonwealth since beginning football in 1972.
- This year, JMU faces Norfolk State (Sept. 10) at home and Old Dominion (Nov. 12) in Norfolk.
- In 156 games, JMU has racked up an 95-61 record against teams from around the state.
- With its week-two win versus Norfolk State, it has claimed 16 straight over state schools.
- The Tribe was the last state team to beat JMU in a 44-41 triumph on Oct. 31, 2015 in Williamsburg.
- The Dukes have played William & Mary (27-17) more than any other state team, at 44 games, and have faced Richmond (21-18) 39 times and Liberty (12-6) on 18 occasions.

JMU's SHUTOUT HISTORY

- The Dukes turned in a shutout for the 28th time in program history against Morehead State.
- It was the seventh time JMU tallied more than 50 points while holding the opposition scoreless.
- JMU has shut out a team in four straight seasons and in five of the last six.
- The Dukes have now opened the season six times with shutout wins, joining the 1987, 1994, 1996, 2000 and 2005 openers.

.500 OR BETTER IN 19 STRAIGHT YEARS

- JMU's success from year to year has come to be expected, as the Dukes have secured at least a .500 record or better in 19 straight seasons.
- The Dukes have secured a winning record in 32 of 50 seasons since beginning football in 1972.
- JMU has tallied 9+ wins in a record 5 straight seasons from 2015-19 and again in 2021.

JMU'S SEASON & HOME OPENERS

- After the Middle Tennessee win, the Dukes are now 28-22-1 all-time in season openers, dating back to their 1972 inaugural campaign.
- JMU has won its past three season openers, adding in a pair of Morehead State wins in 2020 and 2021.
- In the last three openers, JMU has averaged wins by a margin of 54.7 to 5.7.
- In home openers, JMU improved to 40-11, which includes 20 straight home-opening victories.
- During its current 20-game win streak to begin the Bridgeforth slate, JMU has outscored its opponents by an average of 49.1 to 8.7.
- JMU has scored more than 40 points in 16 of those wins, including 80 in the 2016 opener.
- The last opposing team to win JMU's home opener was Hampton back on Aug. 31, 2002 (31-28).

- NFL aside, Bryce Carter has played four games with the CFL's Ottawa REDBLACKS and has a pair of sacks.
- Liam Fornadel was just signed last week by the Winnipeg Blue Bombers on the practice squad.

DUKES PICKED 6TH IN EAST

- JMU was picked to finish sixth in the Sun Belt Conference East Division in a vote by the league's 14 head coaches.
- The Dukes tallied 31 points in the East Division poll, finishing just four points behind Georgia Southern for fifth and six points ahead of seventh-place Old Dominion.
- App State, which reached the SBC title game last year, was selected as the preseason favorite in the East after receiving 10 first-place votes.
- In the West, defending champion Louisiana received 12 first-place votes to lead the pack.
- Last year, JMU finished 12-2 with a 7-1 mark in the CAA for its last season in the FCS.
- The Dukes return a pair of FCS All-Americans in Kris Thornton and long snapper Kyle Davis, as nine starters are back from the 2021 team.

THORNTON PRESEASON ALL-SUN BELT

- Wide receiver Kris Thornton was selected to the Preseason All-Sun Belt First Team offense.
- Thornton had a breakout season in 2021, making 83 receptions for 1,097 yards and 13 touchdowns.
- His 83 catches tied the JMU single-season record, while his receiving touchdowns and yards ranked third and fourth, respectively, on JMU's single-season lists.
- Thornton was a Phil Steele FCS Fourth Team All-American and First Team All-CAA pick last year after ranking fourth nationally in receiving TD, 15th in total touchdowns (14) and 18th in catches per game (5.9).

DAVIS NAMED TO FBS WATCH LIST

- Kyle Davis was named to the 2022 watch list for The Patrick Mannelly Award, which recognizes the best long snapper in the Football Bowl Subdivision.
- Davis was one of 25 FBS seniors named to the preseason watch list and one of three from the Sun Belt Conference.
- He's been JMU's primary long snapper for the past four seasons, totaling 51 games since 2018.
- Davis was a First Team FCS All-American in both 2020 and 2021.
- He's had zero bad snaps both on punt and PAT/field goal units during his career, aiding in 95 made field goals to help Ethan Ratke become the NCAA's all-time leader (101).

WRAPPING UP FCS RUN

- The end of the 2021 season marked the final run for the Dukes in the Football Championship Subdivision.
- Since joining the Division I ranks in 1980, JMU reached the FCS Playoffs (formerly I-AA) 18 times with a pair of national championships.
- The Dukes won their first title in 2004 and a second in 2016.
- JMU closed its FCS tenure with a program-record eight consecutive postseason berths (2014-21), reaching the national title game three times and at least the semifinals five times.
- It also won 13 straight home playoff games to end its run as an FCS program.
- The Dukes won nine of its 10 all-time conference championships as a member of the Colonial Athletic Association (formerly Atlantic 10 and Yankee Conference).
- Still to date, JMU's 2004 squad is the only team in FCS playoffs history to win a national championship without ever playing a home

Dukes Trounce Blue Raiders in FBS Debut, 44-7

HARRISONBURG, Va. – James Madison kicked off a new era of college football in style, as Todd Centeio amassed nearly 400 yards and tied the program's single-game passing touchdown record to lead the Dukes to a dominant 44-7 victory against Middle Tennessee on Saturday night at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The Dukes (1-0) outgained the Blue Raiders (0-1) by a wide margin, racking up 548 yards of total offense while allowing just 119.

Making his JMU debut, Centeio was excellent through the air, going 21-of-33 for 287 yards and six touchdowns, matching Cole Johnson's JMU single-game mark. He also led the game in rushing, with 14 carries for 110 yards, averaging 7.9 per rush.

Kris Thornton was just shy of a pair of career highs, making 11 receptions for 145 yards on his way to scoring three touchdowns. Reggie Brown also had a career night, as he made five catches for 78 yards and a pair of scores, both in the second quarter to open the game's scoring.

Defensively, JMU was paced by Jailin Walker's nine tackles, while Taurus Jones had seven stops, 2.5 tackles for loss, a forced fumble and a recovery. Josh Sarratt also finished with seven tackles, Isaac Ukwu had a two tackles for loss with a sack, and both Jamree Kromah and Jalen Green had 1.5 TFL.

The Dukes scored the game's first 37 points in of 19:19 between the second and third quarter, holding MTSU's air-raid offense without a point until its lone touchdown late in the third quarter.

HOW IT HAPPENED

- After a scoreless first, which featured multiple fourth-down stops between the two teams, Todd Centeio opened the second quarter with a 20-yard strike over the middle to Reggie Brown for the game's opening touchdown. JMU 7, MTSU 0 (14:55 2nd).
- Centeio once again found Brown on a 29-yard dart in the corner of the end zone to double the lead. JMU 14, MTSU 0 (6:49 2nd).
- On the ensuing drive, Centeio went to the air again, connecting with Kris Thornton on a 7-yard touchdown toss. JMU 21, MTSU 0 (3:05 2nd).
- Centeio opened the second half with his fourth TD on a 35-yard pass over the middle to Thornton. JMU 28, MTSU 0 (13:16 3rd).
- Centeio with his fifth TD, this time on a 19-yard stripe to Thornton, the third consecutive touchdown catch for JMU's leading receiver. JMU 35, MTSU 0 (10:47 3rd).
- Xavier Cokley made a great read on a pass in the end zone and brought down the receiver for a safety. JMU 37, MTSU 0 (10:36 3rd).
- The Blue Raiders got on the board with a 26-yard pass from Chase Cunningham to Yusuf Ali in the left corner of the end zone. JMU 37, MTSU 7 (3:31 3rd).
- JMU closed the scoring with a 9-yard touchdown catch by Ravenel from Centeio. JMU 44, MTSU 7 (6:49 4th).

GAME NOTES

- JMU rushed for 261 yards, gaining 5.0 yards per carry, while holding MTSU to just 12 yards on the ground. In addition to Centeio, Percy Agyei-Obese ran for 82 yards on 5.5 per carry.
- The Dukes finished 9-of-17 on third down, while limiting the Blue Raiders to 4-of-16. That is the 50th straight game JMU has held a team to 50% or less on third.
- The Dukes dominated time of possession by a 36:55 to 23:05 margin.
- JMU also got a boost in field position from Sarratt, who averaged 13.0 yards per punt return. The Dukes had an average starting field position of its own 36, as opposed to MTSU's own 21.
- Centeio became the first JMU quarterback to rush for 100 yards since Nov. 17, 2018 when Ben DiNucci had 104 at Towson.
- His 397 yards of total offense was also just 30 yards shy of a Bridgeforth Stadium record.
- JMU out-gained MTSU by a 137-16 margin in the first quarter, controlling 11:36 of the clock. At half, JMU had tallied total yards to MTSU's 24, which included -14 rushing.
- JMU had an attendance of 23,074 for its season opener, which included 8,680 in the student section alone.
- The Blue Raiders were led by Chase Cunningham, who was 18-of-32 for 116 yards and a touchdown. Yusuf Ali provided eight catches for 60 yards and the only score.

Dukes Breeze Past Norfolk State, Move to 2-0

HARRISONBURG, Va. – James Madison used a balanced offensive attack and stout rushing defense to cruise past Norfolk State, 63-7, in non-conference football action on a rainy Saturday evening at Bridgeforth Stadium.

The Dukes improved to 2-0, while the Spartans fell to 0-2. JMU also moved to 3-0 all-time against NSU, having now outscored the opposition 155-21 in the series.

JMU more than doubled up Norfolk State in total yards, at 462-212, which included a 235-9 margin in the run game.

The Dukes rotated in all three quarterbacks, as the trio combined to throw 19-of-25 for 227 yards and four touchdowns. Todd Centeio, playing just the first half, was 12-of-17 for 165 passing yards and three touchdowns. Billy Atkins had a strong third quarter, going 6-of-7 for 48 passing yards and a touchdown.

Kris Thornton continued his strong start, reeling in seven catches for 102 yards and a pair of touchdowns, as he turned in two-plus touchdowns in consecutive games for the first time in his career. Devin Ravenel had his first career game with two receiving scores, as he made three grabs for 40 yards.

JMU's run game once again shined, as the group averaged 5.3 per rush on 44 carries, totaling five touchdowns from four different running backs. Percy Agyei-Obese led all rushers with 88 yards and a pair of touchdowns, averaging 7.3 per carry. Kaelon Black ran for 54 yards and a score, while three other Dukes had at least 25 yards.

Defensively, James Carpenter had a career outing, making a game-high eight tackles with 2.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. JMU conceded just 0.3 yards per rush, as the defensive unit has allowed just 21 rushing yards through the first two games. The defense also had a pair of takeaways, while not turning over the ball once.

JMU scored the game's first 35 points, and after NSU's lone score on a 90-yard pass, the hosts scored the final 28.

HOW IT HAPPENED

- Todd Centeio opened the game with a pair of touchdown passes, connecting with Kris Thornton on a 43-yard pass just five plays into the game. On the ensuing drive, he found Devin Ravenel on a 22-yard strike.
- After a Jordan Swann interception, Latrelle Palmer found the end zone five plays later to make it 21-0 at the end of the first.
- Percy Agyei-Obese scored his first rushing touchdown early in the second and Ravenel caught his second TD from Centeio to extend the lead to 35-0 at the break.
- After Norfolk State opened the third with a 90-yard touchdown pass, JMU answered back with three more touchdowns, as Thornton, Agyei-Obese and Kaelon Black all crossed the goal line for a 56-7 lead entering the final 15.
- The fourth quarter was only 10 minutes long and JMU kept to the ground heavily, as Sammy Malignaggi scored his first career touchdown to close the scoring.

GAME NOTES

- JMU was +2 in the turnover margin, with Swann's interception and a fumble recovery by Devyn Coles.
- The Dukes did not commit a turnover for the second straight game, marking two consecutive years JMU's offense has not committed a turnover in its first pair of games.
- JMU was over 50% for the second straight week on third down, going 6-for-10, while NSU was just 2-for-10. The Dukes also went 2-for-2 on fourth down.
- JMU was a perfect 7-for-7 in the red zone, while the Spartans were 0-for-1. NSU's lone red-zone chance at the end of the first half was thwarted by a pass breakup by Chauncey Logan on the final play.
- JMU put together three straight scoring drives in the opening 15 minutes, outgaining NSU 178-14.
- Otto Kuhns was 9-of-20 for 203 yards and a touchdown to lead the NSU offense. No NSU rusher gained more than seven yards rushing, as it combined for 26 carries and nine yards.
- Da'Quan Felton had three catches for 141 yards with the 90-yard touchdown reception for NSU.

JMU Storms Back to Win Thriller in Sun Belt Debut at App State

BOONE, N.C. – James Madison found itself down 28-3 before mounting a historic comeback, scoring 29 unanswered points to rally past App State, 32-28, in its Sun Belt Conference football opener on Saturday afternoon in front of 33,248 spectators at Kidd Brewer Stadium.

The Dukes improved to 3-0 and 1-0 in Sun Belt play, while the Mountaineers fell to 2-2 and 1-1. It was JMU's first win in Boone since Sept. 21, 1991, as the Dukes won for the third time in 10 tries at App.

App State put together four consecutive touchdown drives in the second quarter to capture a 25-point lead. After making it a 28-10 score at the half and 28-17 after three, the Dukes owned the fourth.

Todd Centeio put together a five-play, 92-yard drive that was capped off by a 36-yard strike to Terrance Greene Jr. for the touchdown. A Centeio to Kris Thornton two-point conversion made it 28-25 with 11:28 to play.

On the ensuing play Chase Brice was picked off by Jailin Walker, who returned his first career pick down to the nine yard line. Two plays later, Kaelon Black punched it in from two yards out to put JMU back in front, 32-28, with 10:36 to go. JMU forced App into a three-and-out and proceeded to run 13 plays and 7:07 off the clock, giving the Mountaineers just 2:06 to work with for their final possession.

App's last-ditch effort was thwarted by a fourth-down stop after Que Reid made a huge hit on Christian Horn for the incompleteness. JMU ran out the final 49 seconds to earn its first Sun Belt win in program history.

Centeio finished 16-of-28 for 204 yards and two touchdowns while rushing for 61 yards and a score. Black led the ground game with 85 rushing yards and a touchdown and added a 23-yard touchdown catch for his first multi-score game.

Eight Dukes had at least one catch, led by Reggie Brown, who caught four passes for a career-high 81 yards. Greene Jr. also had 46 receiving yards and the fourth-quarter score.

App State was led by Chase Brice, who was 17-of-28 for 235 yards and two touchdowns with an interception. Kaedin Robinson made five catches for 57 yards, while Dashaun Davis had three grabs also for 57 yards. Dalton Stroman and Miller Gibbs each caught touchdowns. Ahmani Marshal finished the game with 40 rushing yards, as App was limited to just 63 as a team and 1.9 per carry.

HOW IT HAPPENED

- JMU opened the game with nearly a seven-minute drive, as Camden Wise booted home a 27-yard field goal for his first career make to give the Dukes the 3-0 lead in the first.
- App State punched it in the end zone on four straight drives during the second quarter, with two coming off JMU turnovers deep in its own territory.
- Touchdowns by Cameron Peoples, Gibbs, Stroman and Nate Noel put the Mountaineers up 28-3 with 6:10 to play before the break.
- After converting a fourth down, Black took a swing pass from Centeio 23 yards to the house for JMU's first touchdown in a Sun Belt game to make it 28-10 at the break.
- JMU held App State off the board in the third and cut into the lead, as Centeio converted a fourth-down conversion and punched it in from two yards on the ensuing play to make it 28-17 heading to the fourth.
- Centeio needed just five plays to go 92 yards, as he connected with Greene Jr. on a 36-yard touchdown and Thornton's two-pointer trimmed the deficit to 28-25.
- Walker picked off Brice on App's next play and Black flew into the end zone two plays later, giving JMU the 32-28 lead with 10:36 to go.
- App State got a stop on defense late but was stalled on fourth down with 49 seconds left.

GAME NOTES

- JMU outgained App State, 376-298, which included an impressive 172-63 lead in the run game. The Mountaineers held a 186-183 yards advantage at halftime.
- The Dukes held App State to just 4-of-12 on third down, as the hosts went 2-of-8 in the second half. JMU struggled as well at 2-for-14.
- JMU was also 3-for-6 on fourth down, as opposed to App's 0-for-2.
- Each team turned the ball over twice, as JMU had a pair of fumbles and App had a fumble and interception.
- JMU held a time of possession lead, at 33:28 to 26:32. That included having possession for 10:29 in the fourth alone.
- Defensively, Jamare Edwards had a career-high eight tackles with 2.5 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. Three Dukes also put in seven tackles in Sam Kidd, Taurus Jones and James Carpenter, who finished with 1.5 TFL and a sack.
- Walker added four stops with his interception, and Mikail Kamara had a strip sack, allowing for Isaac Ukwu's fumble recovery.
- JMU's 28-3 deficit matched the largest since Nov. 3, 2018, when New Hampshire opened the game up 28-3 in Durham, N.H.
- JMU's first-quarter field goal marked the first made kick not by NCAA all-time scoring and field goals leader Ethan Ratke since Nov. 17, 2018, spanning 41 games.
- The 33,248 attendance was sixth-largest in Kidd Brewer Stadium history and highest attended JMU-App State game.
