JMU AT THE CANCUN CHALLENGE

- James Madison treks to Riviera Maya, Mexico for the Cancun Challenge at the Hard Rock Hotel Riviera Maya on Nov. 23-24. The Dukes open up against Michigan State on Thursday (6:30 p.m. ET) before facing Montana State on Friday (9 p.m. ET). Both games will stream on FloHoops.

- This will be JMU's first-ever meeting against the Spartans and Bobcats.

CANCUN CHALLENGE

- Officials with Triple Crown Sports are gearing up for another great Cancun Challenge event. The 2024 Cancun Challenge will see 18 men's and women's programs make the trip to Cancun over Thanksgiving week to the all-inclusive Hard Rock Hotel Riviera Maya
- The 18th running of the women's event will be held Nov. 23-25. For 2023, the four-team Mayan Division will feature Green Bay, Maryland, UMass and Washington State. These squads will play a three-game round robin at the event. In the Riviera Division, six teams will be making the trip and playing two games while in Mexico Creighton, Georgia Tech, James Madison, Michigan State, Montana State and New Mexico.
- JMU will return to Cancun for the first time since the 2016-17 campaign when the program participated in the same event. That season, the Dukes cruised to an 83-53 win over Idaho State (Nov. 24) before falling to Iowa, 90-75, on Nov. 25.
- **Da'Lishia Griffin** tallied her first double-double of the season with 11 rebounds and a career-high 19 points, while Lexie Barrier scored a career-high 10 points to defeat the Bengals. Three Dukes scored in double digits in their loss to the Hawkeyes: **Precious Hall** (22), Griffin (14) and **Kamiah Smalls** (10). Hall was named to the Riviera All-Tournament Team.
- James Madison is 4-4 all-time in Mexico, competing in the Carribean Challenge in 2008 and 2010, and the Cancun Challenge in 2012 and 2016.

UP NEXT

- Following the conclusion of the Cancun Challenge, the Dukes return to the commonwealth for a matchup against the Liberty Flames on Friday, Dec. 1. Action in Lynchburg is scheduled for 12 p.m. inside Liberty Arena.

News & Notes

- James Madison women's basketball made 31-of-63 (.492) from the field to overpower VCU, 78-65, inside the Atlantic Union Bank Center on Nov. 19.

- JMU (4-1) pulled down 45 rebounds and held the Rams (3-1) to 3-of-19 (.158) from three.

- Redshirt sophomore **Peyton McDaniel** led all players with 19 points with a 7-for-15 (.467) shooting clip. Redshirt junior **Jamia Hazell** registered a season-high 15 points, 11 of which came in the second half. Classmate **Annalicia Goodman** added 12 points and a season-high eight boards, while **Steph Ouderkirk** dished out a career-high five assists to go along with five rebounds.

- The Dukes scored more paint points (40-30), bench points (28-21) and second chance points (11-9).

- James Madison made 31 field goals, tied for the most it recorded this season against a Division I opponent. The Dukes also knocked down 31 shots against Longwood on Nov. 15.

- Redshirt junior **Olivia Mullins** finished with a season-high nine points and tied her season-high in rebounds with three. Meanwhile, Barnes tied her Division I career-high in points (9) in 16 minutes of action.

- Graduate student **Carole Miller** tallied a season-best four assists and tied her season-high rebounds (4).

JMU VS. BIG TEN

GAME RECAP VS. VCU

James Madison holds a 9-30 record against Big 10 foes.

- The Dukes have played Maryland the most with 13 meetings, with the Terrapins owning a 12-1 lead in the all-time series. - JMU has a winning record against Indiana (1-0), Purdue (1-0), Penn State (3-1) and Minnesota (2-1).

- The last time James Madison played a Big Ten Opponent was in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament in 2023 when the No. 14 seed Dukes trekked to Columbus, Ohio to face the No. 3 seed Ohio State on March 18.

- JMU led OSU 26-14 after the opening quarter but saw the Buckeyes outscore the Dukes 66-40 the rest of the way as Ohio came away with an 80-66 victory inside Value City Arena at the Schottenstein Center.

- **Kiki Jefferson** led the way for James Madison with 17 points and eight rebounds. **Jamia Hazell** added 10 points and five boards in 24 minutes of action, while **Caroline Germond** finished with eight points and a pair of assists. **Peyton McDaniel** and **Annalicia Goodman** both contributed with nine points off the bench.

- The last time the Dukes defeated a Big Ten school was in 2016 when James Madison outlasted Rutgers in double overtime, 82-76, on Dec. 5. Former Duke **Precious Hall** scored a school record 46 points in the win, shooting 15-of-29 (.517) from the field and 6-of-13 (.462) from three.

NCAA RANKING SUMMARY (AS OF NOV. 22)

- James Madison owns six top 25 marks in Division I: defensive rebounds per game (3rd - 36.6), rebound margin (5th - +22.0), rebounds per game (5th - 52.2), field goal percentage defense (8th - .301), bench points per game (11th - 35.2) and three-point percentage defense (T-23rd - .211).

1,000-P0INT CLUB

- Redshirt junior guard **Jamia Hazell** is inching closer to eclipsing 1,000 career points with 858 in 92 career games. With a career scoring average of 9.3 ppg, Hazell is on track to achieve the feat sixteen games down the road.

- The Raleigh, N.C. native scored a season-best 17 points in the season-opener against Eastern Mennonite on Nov. 6. The guard went 7-for-9 (.778) from the field and a perfect 3-for-3 from the line.

- Hazell's 92 career games are tied with classmate **Steph Ouderkirk** for the most on the team. The guard has started in 64 contests, averaging 25.9 minutes per outing.

NCAA ALL-TIME BY VICTORIES

- James Madison is fourth all-time in women's college basketball Division I history with 1,202 wins heading into the 2023-24 season.
- Tennessee was first with 1,451, followed by UConn (1,271) and Stanford (1,210). The Lady Volunteers started their program in 1902.

- This year is the 102nd season of JMU women's basketball. The Dukes reached the 1,000-win mark on Jan. 6, 2015, with a 74-57 win over UNCW. At the time, James Madison joined Tennessee and Louisiana Tech as the only programs to reach the milestone.

- Middle Tennesee recently became the 25th Division I program to eclipse 1,000 wins after defeating Florida A&M on Nov. 9, 93-48.

NCAA ALL-TIME BY PERCENTAGE

- Prior to the beginning of the season, James Madison ranked 22nd all-time in win percentage at .672, the second-highest among current Sun Belt Conference teams.

- Old Dominion was 12th (.699), while FGCU sat at the top (.847). The Eagles began DI competition in 2002-03, boasting a record of 582-105.

News & Notes

BASKETBALL SCHOOL

- JMU women's and men's basketball combined for 48 wins last year, with records of 26-8 and 22-11, respectively. Forty-eight wins tie the school's record with the 2014-15 and 2015-16 seasons. Those campaigns saw the women's program go 29-4 and 27-6 in that span.
- The efforts also marked the sixth time in JMU history that both teams had 20 or more wins in the same season.

DUKES AT THE ATLANTIC UNION BANK CENTER

- JMU is 30-15 (.667) inside the confines of the Atlantic Union Bank Center, the program's home since the 2020-21 season.
- The Dukes went 10-4 last season, the best home record for the team at the AUBC and most home wins since the 2019-20 season when they went 14-1.
- James Madison is 7-3 in its last 10 home contests, with the three losses coming at the hands of Georgia Southern (69-65, Jan. 19), Marshall (71-58, Feb. 24) and Toledo (60-49, Nov. 8).

NEW FACES

- Six newcomers made their way to Harrisonburg during the offseason -- four transfers and two true freshmen. The Dukes will gain veteran experience from graduate student **Carole Miller** (Guard Virginia), senior **Hevynne Bristow** (Guard Ohio State), redshirt junior **Olivia Mullins** (Guard Saint Joseph's) and junior **Ashanti Barnes** (Forward Trinity Valley C.C.). Meanwhile, first-year players **Jada Mills** (Guard) and **Atiana Williams** (Guard) look to make their mark.
- Miller was ranked the No. 82 player in the country by ESPN and No. 21 at her position on signing day after an illustrious career at Edison High School. The Alexandria, Va. native spent the past four years at Virginia where she saw action in 84 games, starting in 67.
- Bristow played in 29 games, averaging 10.5 minutes per contest at Ohio State last season as the Buckeyes made their first Elite Eight appearance in 30 years. The guard registered 3.4 ppg and 2.8 rpg in her three years in Columbus. Prior to OSU, Bristow spent her freshman year at Providence where she averaged 2.7 points and 2.2 rebounds per contest.
- Mullins comes to JMU after making 76 appearances and 36 starts for SJU from 2020-23. Last year with the Hawks, the guard averaged 8.0 points, 3.6 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game, starting in all 31 games.
- After spending the 2021-22 season at Old Dominion, Barnes transferred to Trinity Valley Community College. As a Cardinal, the Norfolk, Va. native finished with 10.7 ppg and 8.0 rpg, starting in 12 out of 22 games. The forward registered a double-double performance with 13 points and 15 rebounds versus Northwest Florida State College in the NJCAA DI Women's Basketball Championship game on March 27.
- Mills was a three-year varsity starter at Putnam Science Academy in Putnam, Conn. where she avered 12.5 points and 4.0 rebounds per game. Last season, the guard led Putnam to a 25-6 record and a fourth-place finish at the Independent Schools National Championship.
- Williams joined the Dukes as a preferred walk-on after a successful career at Menchville High School. The Newport News, Va. native helped guide her team to their first-ever VHSL Class 5 State Championship title in 2022. Her father. Chris Williams, played basketball at JMU from 2000-04.

SUN BELT CONFERENCE PRESEASON POLL

- The reigning Sun Belt Conference champions were picked to finish first in the Sun Belt Women's Basketball Preseason Coaches Poll, the conference announced on Oct. 16. JMU tallied nine first-place votes for 186 points, followed closely behind by Troy with 177 points and three first-place votes.
- Southern Miss was third with 159 points and one first-place vote and is led by Preseason Player of the Year Dominique Davis.
- Additionally, redshirt sophomore **Peyton McDaniel** and redshirt junior **Kseniia Kozlova** were both named to the All-Sun Belt Second Team for the upcoming season.
- The 2023 Sun Belt Sixth Woman of the Year was a major factor from deep for the Dukes in 2022-23. McDaniel finished the season 75-of-195 (38.5%) from three to lead the team, hitting multiple three-pointers in 17 contests. In the Sun Belt Championship game, she shot a perfect 7-of-7 from three to tie her career-high of 30 points and defeat Texas State, 81-51, on March 6.
- Kozlova started in all 34 games for the Dukes last season, averaging 10.5 points and 5.6 rebounds per contest. The center finished first on the team in field goal percentage (min. of 100 attempts), going 144-of-252 (57.1%) from the field.

COACH O

- James Madison Director of Athletics **Jeff Bourne** announced a three-year contract extension for Head Coach **Sean O'Regan** that will keep him under contract through the 2027-28 season.
- In his seven years leading the program, O'Regan has compiled a record of 156-62 (.716), including five seasons with over 20 wins. This past season, **Kiki Jefferson** was named Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year, while **Peyton McDaniel** was tabbed as the league's Sixth Woman of the Year. The duo dazzled in the SBC Tournament, with Jefferson earning the conference's Most Outstanding Player award and McDaniel picking up All-Tournament Team honors.

News & Notes

- While most seem to hold an advantage at home, the Dukes thrived away from Harrisonburg with a 12-4 record during their 2022-23 campaign. James Madison started the season 8-0 in true road games and 1-0 in neutral-site contests before falling to Coastal Carolina, 79-64, on Jan. 26.
- The team's 12 wins on the road tied for the program record with the 2006-07 and 2014-15 seasons.
 JMU was also perfect at neutral locations at 4-0 during the regular season, with victories over Eastern
 Michigan at the Saint Joseph's Hawk Classic (Dec. 20), and 3-0 in the Sun Belt Tournament in Pensacola, Fla.
 (March 3-6).
- Only 10 schools in Division I had at least a dozen true road victories: BGSU (14-3), Columbia (14-3), South Carolina (13-0), Villanova (13-1), FGCU (13-2), UC Irvine (13-3), Holy Cross (13-5), Creighton (12-3), Gardner-Webb (12-4), and JMU (12-4).
- The trend continued as the Dukes rolled past Xavier, 81-54, on Nov. 11. Next, the Dukes head to Mexico for the Cancun Challenge to face Michigan State (Nov. 23) and Montana State (Nov. 24) before heading to Lynchburg, Va. to square off against Liberty (Dec. 1).

COACH HARROW PROMOTION

ROAD DOGS

- Neil Harrow has been elevated to associate head coach, as announced by Head Coach Sean O'Regan on Sept. 22. The 2023-24 season will mark Harrow's second as a member of the Dukes' coaching staff.
 In his new role, Harrow will oversee transfer, international and junior college recruiting. Shortly after arriving in Harrisonburg, he brought on Caroline Germond (TCU) and Kobe King-Hawea (Texas), who combined for 44 starts in 2022-23. The new title also gives Harrow scouting coordinator duties where he will oversee the planning and development of scouting activities.
- Lastly, Harrow takes over offensive coordinator responsibilities, as the Dukes head into their second season in the Sun Belt Conference. As a member of Troy's coaching staff, he helped guide the Trojans to their best offensive season since the 1992-93 season when they averaged 86.0 ppg, the third-best average in the NCAA in 2020-21.

2023 SUN BELT TOURNAMENT

- James Madison entered the Sun Belt Tournament as the No. 1 seed, having shared the regular season crown with Texas State and Southern Miss. Head Coach Sean O'Regan's squad opened against No. 8 Marshall, smothering the Thundering Herd in the quarterfinals, 62-43.
- The Dukes then took on No. 5 Old Dominion, the season's third matchup between JMU and the Monarchs. Jefferson and junior Kseniia Kozlova produced 22 and 20 points, respectively, to pull away for the 70-64 victory on March 5. The win punched the Dukes' ticket to the championship game against Texas State.
- After a 14-14 score at the end of the first quarter, James Madison ran away with the game. Junior Peyton McDaniel connected on 7-of-7 shots from three-point range to tie her career-high of 30 points, while Jefferson went 4-for-5 (80.0%) from deep for 22 points. The Dukes overpowered the Bobcats in an 81-51 romp on March 6. The 30-point victory was the largest margin in Sun Belt title game history.

2023 NCAA TOURNAMENT

- No. 14 James Madison led No. 3 Ohio State 26-14 after the opening quarter but saw the Buckeyes outscore the Dukes 66-40 the rest of the way as OSU came away with an 80-66 victory on March 18, inside Value City Arena at the Schottenstein Center.
- **Kiki Jefferson** led the way for James Madison with 17 points and eight rebounds. **Jamia Hazell** added 10 points and five boards in 24 minutes of action, while **Caroline Germond** finished with eight points and a pair of assists. **Peyton McDaniel** and **Annalicia Goodman** both contributed with nine points off the bench.

HEAD COACH SEAN O'REGAN

JMU '03 | Eighth Season | 160-63

Sean O'Regan enters his eighth season at the helm of the James Madison women's basketball program at the start of the 2023-24 season.

O'Regan is coming off a 26-8 (13-5 Sun Belt) season in 2022-23 that saw the Dukes capture the Sun Belt Championship Tournament title and an NCAA Tournament berth. His squad led the league in scoring margin (+8.8), opponent field goal percentage (.361), opponent three-point percentage (.286), and rebounding margin (+8.1). Kiki Jefferson was named Sun Belt Player of the Year, while Peyton McDaniel was tabbed as the league's Sixth Woman of the Year. The two dazzled in the SBC Tournament, with Jefferson earning the conference's Most Outstanding Player award and

McDaniel picking up All-Tournament Team honors.

In 2021-22 O'Regan coached VaSID First Team All-State and Second Team All-CAA honoree Kiki Jefferson, who became the 32nd player in program history to surpass the 1,000-point milestone. Jefferson led the Dukes and finished third in the conference with 18.8 points per game. The guard netted 174 foul shots over the course of the season to rank fourth in the country in free throws made.

The Dukes were ineligible for postseason play due to conference realignment.

In an odd 2020-21 season due to COVID-19, O'Regan led his team to a 14-10 record and earned the No. 2 seed in the CAA Tournament. The Dukes dominated Northeastern 81-65 in the guarterfinals but fell just short to No. 3 Drexel, eventual champion, in the semifinals, 79-76 in overtime.

For the second consecutive season, O'Regan has coached the CAA Rookie of the Year as Peyton McDaniel earned the honor to become the 10th Duke in program history to do so. Former Rookie of the Year Kiki Jefferson landed on the 2020-21 All-CAA First Team while Rayne Tucker earned a spot on the All-CAA Third Team. Freshmen Peyton McDaniel and Jamia Hazell secured spots on the All-CAA Rookie Team after taking home CAA Rookie of the Week honors a combined six times in 14 opportunities.

Despite the crazy season of scheduling the Dukes still handled business on the court as JMU led the CAA in free throw percentage (76.8%) while being third in conference in scoring (70.0), field goal percentage (41.3) and three-point percentage (32.5).

Prior to the season getting shutdown early due to COVID-19 concerns, O'Regan led the team to its third consecutive CAA regular-season title after finishing the year with a 25-4 (16-2 CAA) record in 2019-20.

On Feb. 28, 2020, JMU dominated Drexel for a convincing 69-39 win in the Convocation Center to give O'Regan his 100th career victory. With the win, O'Regan became the fastest coach in program history to win 100 games (130 total games).

Following the season senior Kamiah Smalls was named the CAA Player of the Year, senior Kayla Cooper-Williams earned her second consecutive CAA Defensive Player of the Year nod and freshman Kiki Jefferson was tabbed CAA Rookie of the Year. The Dukes led the CAA with five all-conference selections: Kamiah Smalls (POY, First Team), Kayla Cooper-Williams (DPOY, All-Defensive Team, Third Team), Kiki Jefferson (ROY, All-Rookie Team), Jackie Benitez (Second Team) and Rayne Tucker (All-Rookie Team).

In his third year, O'Regan guided JMU to one of its most successful seasons in program history. He helped the Dukes advance to the WNIT Semifinals for the first time since 2012. The 29 team wins produced tied the program record for wins in a season, while capping off 18 wins in the Convocation Center for a program record and piecing together 31-straight wins at Convo for the second longest streak in JMU history.

O'Regan led the Dukes to two more team records in 236 three-pointers made and 218 blocks. The Dukes defense held 16 opponents under 50 points for their most in the Division I era and tied for the most in program history. JMU also held seven opponents under 40 points for the most in the Division I era and tied for most in program

history.

O'Regan boasted CAA Defensive Player of the Year, All-Defensive Team, All-CAA Third Team, ECAC Honorable Mention Kayla Cooper-Williams during the season. Cooper-Williams broke the school record for blocks and ended the year at 240. She set three other records during the 2018-19 season. O'Regan also guided transfer Jackie Benitez to CAA Sixth Player of the Year accolades along with earning CAA Third Team and WNIT All-Tournament Team honors. Benitez accounted for 95 of the three-pointers made on the season, sixth most by a player in a season. In another strong year for Kamiah Smalls, O'Regan helped the junior earn All-CAA First Team, Richmond-Times Dispatch Player of the Year, Richmond-Times Dispatch First Team and VaSID First Team All-State honors. Junior Lexie Barrier earned All-CAA Second

His second season saw a continuation of the success he helped build, as O'Regan guided the Dukes to a 23-11 record and a second straight appearance in the WNIT Third Round. Sophomores Kamiah Smalls (First Team), Lexie Barrier (Second Team) and Kelly Koshuta (Third Team) were all named to All-CAA teams following the season.

In his first season as head coach, O'Regan led the Dukes to a 26-9 season, a fourth consecutive appearance in the CAA title game and a third-round appearance in the

WNIT after taking down Radford and Virginia at the Convo.

O'Regan has coached on the JMU women's basketball sidelines for 15 seasons, returning to his alma mater for the 2007-08 season as an assistant coach. He continued to ascend the Dukes' coaching ranks, being elevated to associate head coach in 2012 under JMU hall of fame coach Kenny Brooks.

As a team in 2016, the Dukes finished the regular season and league tournament on a 20-game win streak as they won their third consecutive CAA regular-season and tournament titles. JMU began receiving votes in the final regular-season polls and entered the NCAA tournament with the top 3-point field-goal defense in the country.

A JMU alum, O'Regan got his start in coaching as a student manager for the Dukes' men's basketball program and was a three-year head manager before graduating in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in kinesiology and concentration in sports management.

After graduation, he went to Evansville to be the men's basketball director of operations before moving into an assistant coaching position from 2005-07.

A native of Montpelier, Vt., O'Regan is married to the former Cara Campo, who is the Vice President of Marketing at a Boston-based firm. The two are parents to a son, Liam, born in October 2009, and a daughter, Addison Susan, born in May 2013.


