THE STORYLINES

■ JSU enters today's game having dropped its opening two Ohio Valley Conference games of the season on the road last weekend. Both contests were tight as JSU fell in a shootout at UT Martin, 83-94, and then in double-overtime at Eastern Illinois, 67-71.

■ Thursday's matchup will be the fourth against Murray State since Rick Pietri took over the Gamecock program in 2013-14. After winning just two of the first 18 meetings in the series prior to his arrival, Pietri is 3-0 against the Racers during his tenure.

■ JSU sports the fifth highest scoring offense in league games averaging 75 points per contest through the first weekend. MSU sits third after achieving 80 points in its first and only OVC game so far this season.

■ The Gamecocks will try and avoid their first 0-3 start in league play since the 2013-14 season. That year, JSU won seven of its next nine OVC games and finished 8-8 in Pietri's debut season.

BUCHANON SETS CAREER-HIGH SCORING

In her first season playing as a Gamecock, senior transfer Lacey Buchanon set a career high with 21 points at Eastern Illinois on Dec. 31. Her previous JSU high was 14 points against New Orleans on Nov. 22, while her collegiate high sat at 19 from a game against UL Monroe as a member of the Troy Trojans on Jan. 15, 2015.

MONSTER NIGHT FOR MORRISON IN MARTIN

Junior Gretchen Morrison came off the bench in the OVC-opener on Dec. 29 to go 9-for-12 from three-point range scoring a season-high 27, the most by a Gamecock in 2016-17. Her nine triples came one shy of matching her own school-record for individuals threes in a game. Her efforts helped JSU set a new school mark with 16 total threes.

JSU HITS 16 3-POINTERS

This season has seen an explosion of outside shooting by the Gamecocks. Five of the top 12 all-time three-point shooting games have come during 2016-17 before the calendar has even turned. On Dec. 29, Jax State set a new school record with 16 triples in the OVC-opener at UT Martin.

200 AND TOO GOOD:

Senior Briana Benson has had plenty of games where opponents probably thought she was just, "too good" from three-point range. The Jonesboro, Ga., native has made 194 career three-pointers during her time in the Red and White. Already JSU's all-time career three-point leader, she can become the first Gamecock ever to hit 200 career triples, and just the 11th all time in the Ohio Valley Conference.

NAUGHTON'S BIG NIGHT

Senior Kelly Naughton had a memorable night as JSU hosted ACC foe Clemson on Dec. 21, the Elk Grove, Ill., native set or matched six season-highs including: Points, Rebounds, Steals, FGs, 3pt FGs and Minutes. In the process, she matched her career high of 10 points and set a new personal best with seven rebounds. Her previous best marks were six rebounds against Auburn as a freshman and 10 points at Morehead State during her sophomore season.

PHELION CREATES DOUBLE TROUBLE

Tyler "Cocoa" Phelion had 16 points and 10 boards against Clemson on Dec. 21 for her second consecutive double-double following 13-and-10 against Nicholls State. It was the first back-to-back double-double for the Gamecocks since current senior Destany McLin did so during the 2013-14 season.

GAMECOCKS ROLL OVER BREWTON-PARKER

■ JSU recorded the most-lopsided win in program history with an 89-26 thumping of Brewton-Parker College on Nov. 29 at Pete Mathews Coliseum.

■ The 63-point margin breaks the old record for margin of victory, 62 points, set by the 1889-90 club against Miles College.

■ The Gamecocks also established a new mark for fewest points allowed by holding the NAIA program to 26 total points. JSU held Southeast Missouri to 34 points in January of 2015 in a 70-34 rout.

SLOWING DOWN THE SEMINOLES

JSU opened the season with an 11-point loss to nationally-ranked Florida State in Tallahassee. Since that time, FSU went 12-1 in non-conference play with its only loss coming to No. 1 UConn by two points. FSU's average win came by 30.8 points. When Rick Pietri, a coach with a reputation for turning programs around, came on-board as the new head women's basketball coach at Jacksonville State University in June of 2013, he began developing a new culture for the Gamecock women's basketball program.

Upon his arrival, it didn't take very long for Pietri to reverse the fortunes of JSU women's basketball. After inheriting a team that had gone 1-27 the year before his arrival, Pietri posted 14 wins in his first season in charge of the program. The turnaround was one of the best in NCAA Women's Division I Basketball that year. After opening with four losses to start the 2013-14 OVC schedule, the Gamecocks put together a stretch that saw them win eight of their last 12 games to earn one of the eight spots in the 2014 OVC Women's Basketball Tournament. Once in the field for the championship, JSU put together an improbable run in Nashville, Tenn. – site of the tournament. Jax State, the No. 6 seed in the field, topped SIU Edwardsville in the opening round to set up the third meeting of the year with Tennessee Tech. Having trailed TTU for most of the game, Briana Benson made a put back at the buzzer that sent the Jax State contingent into a frenzy and a spot in the semifinals against Belmont. Benson's buzzer-beater made ESPN's Top-10 plays of the day on SportsCenter that night. JSU's run in the tournament fell short with a loss to Belmont in the semifinal round.

For his efforts in that first season at JSU, Pietri was named the 2013-14 OVC Coach of the Year by his colleagues.

In his second year in charge of the program, Pietri guided the Gamecocks to heights unseen in the program's NCAA Division I history. JSU turned in a 19-10 overall mark – the most wins in JSU's Division I era. The Gamecocks started strong by winning nine of twelve games in the first two months of the season, the best start since the 1990-91 campaign. The nine non-con-

ference wins by JSU marked the most since moving to Division I. One of those victories was the first ever JSU road win over a "Power 5" conference school, when the Gamecocks beat SEC foe Alabama in Tuscaloosa by a final of 64-62.

Jax State finished the 2014-15 Ohio Valley Conference slate with a 10-6 record and placed in a tie for fourth in the league. The Gamecocks were among the best in the nation at handling the basketball that year. The team ranked fourth in NCAA Division I women's basketball in fewest turnovers committed with a per game average of 11.2.

The success on the hardwood also translated into success in academics. Jax State ranked 14th in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association 2015 Academic Top 25 Honor Roll presented by AT&T. JSU posted a team grade point average of 3.511. The team GPA had soared from a 2.3 in 2012-13 before his arrival to a 3.5 in 2014-15.

A roster decimated by injuries in 2015-16 impacted JSU to a 10-18 overall mark and a 5-11 mark in conference play. Jax State's success at home under Pietri did continue with seven wins at the newly-renovated Pete Mathews Coliseum.

Before his tenure at JSU, Pietri spent the previous 13 seasons as the head coach at South Alabama. Prior to his arrival, South Alabama had posted 10-straight losing seasons. He turned the Lady Jags into a contender in the Sun Belt Conference, capturing back-to-back Sun Belt West Division titles in 2003 and 2004. South made consecutive WNIT Postseason appearances both in 2003 and 2004, and he is also the all-time winningest coach in Lady Jaguars history with a career record of 220-167.

Pietri's turnaround of the South Alabama program started with his first team, during the 2000-01 campaign as the Jags finished with a record of 13-16. The thirteen victories were the most wins in a season for the program in over 10 years.

SINCE THE ARRIVAL OF COACH PIETRI

- Jacksonville State has won 43 games in three seasons under Rick Pietri after posting just 15 wins in the previous three seasons.
- Averaged 14.3 wins over a three-year span.
- Inherited a 1-27 team in 2013-14 and won 14 games in his first season at JSU. The Program's turnaround was one of the best in the NCAA.
- Was named the 2014 Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year.
- JSU turned in a 19-10 overall mark in 2014-15 – the most wins in JSU's Division I era. The Gamecocks started strong by winning nine of twelve games in the first two months of the season and the best start since the 1990-91 campaign. The nine non-conference wins by JSU marked the most since moving to Division I.
- Jax State has made back-to-back appearances in the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament for the first time since the 2008 and 2009 seasons.
- JSU advanced to the semifinals of the 2013 OVC Tournament after wins over SIU Edwardsville and Tennessee Tech.
- A pair of Gamecocks have been named All-OVC performers under Pietri's tutelage - Former JSU standout Candace Morton and Destany McLin.
- Jax State was listed 14th in the Women's Basketball Coaches Association 2015 Academic Team Honor Roll presented by AT&T.
- JSU posted a team grade point average of 3.511. The Gamecocks were one of two Ohio Valley Conference teams listed in the top-25. The team GPA has soared from a 2.3 in 2012-13 to a 3.5.
- Enters the 2016-17 season ranked sixth on the Jacksonville State coaching record chart with 43 wins entering his fourth season leading the program. He needs one win to move in to the top-five on the chart and five wins to surpass Ron Akers (1976-80), who collected 47 career wins.

During Pietri's tenure, the Jags posted a 130-54 (.707) record at home, including setting an arena record with 14 home wins during the 2008-09 season. The Jags finished with a winning record in five of his last six years, including three straight years with a 17-13 record from 2010-11 through the 2012-13 season.

One of USA's best defensive clubs was the 2003-04 squad, which finished the campaign ranked eighth in the nation in scoring defense (55.0 ppg) and led the Sun Belt in that category for the third straight year. In 2011-12, South Alabama once again led the league and ranked 11th nationally while allowing a school-record low 52.8 ppg.

Pietri brought in an established pattern of winning and success to the South Alabama program in the spring of 2000. In only his second season at St. Paul's High School in Mobile, his 1999-2000 boys' team finished with the school's best record, 26-5, and first playoff win in the history of the program. After that season, he was voted Mobile County Private School Coach of the Year by local coaches, his fifth county Coach of the Year award in six years.

The boys' teams Pietri coached at Mobile's B.C. Rain High School from 1995-98 each garnered a winning percentage at or above 75 percent. He led his B.C. Rain teams to four consecutive appearances in Alabama's "Final Four". His 1997 squad finished 28-7 and won the 5A State Championship, while his teams finished as runners-up in 1996 and 1998. Pietri was named 1998 5A State Coach of the Year by the Alabama Sports Writers Association and was also named Mobile Press Register Coach of the Year for Southwest Alabama each season he coached at B.C. Rain.

Pietri began his collegiate coaching career as a men's assistant at Spring Hill College for four seasons (1989-93), before joining Duane Reboul's staff at Birmingham Southern in 1993-94.

Before he gained his degree from South Alabama, Pietri was a 1983 graduate of De La Salle High School in New Orleans, La. Pietri is married to the former Suzanne Odom, a Mobile native. They have two sons, Wesley (22) and Jordan (20).

■ JSU DEBUT

- Jax State has four new faces on the 14-player roster and three of the four made their debut in the season opener at Florida State.
- Senior Lacey Buchanan, who transferred to JSU from Troy, earned the starting point guard role this season. In the opener, she dished out three assists in 22 minutes of action.
- Junior transfer Kiandria 'Ki-Ki' Patterson made the biggest splash of the new faces with 10 points off the bench at Florida State. The East Mississippi Community College transfer was 4-of-8 from the field, including a pair of three pointers vs. the Seminoles.
- Freshmen Morgan Towells played two minutes off the bench, while junior transfer Tasha Magruder saw action in the post. She came to JSU from Walters State Community College.

■ GAMECOCK ROSTER BOLSTERED FOR 2016-17

- After the 2015-16 JSU women's basketball roster was decimated down to seven players in 18 of the 28 games last season, head coach Rick Pietri hit the recruiting trail to raise the roster standards. Entering the season, JSU has 14 players on the active roster, which is the most since the program had 14 players listed on the 2009-10 roster.
- The Gamecocks return an abundance of experience after just losing two seniors from last season's squad. Pietri, entering his fourth year in charge of the program, returns six players from a season ago, including top point producer senior Briana Benson.
- Senior Kelly Naughton will add veteran leadership to Jax State's guard position. JSU returns the outside presence of junior Gretchen Morrison and the post position with junior Tyler Phelion and sophomores Chloe Long and Rayven Pearson. Long and Pearson bolstered the post for JSU as the tandem from Hazel Green, Alabama combined for 27 starts in their freshman season at JSU.
- JSU welcomes the return of All-Ohio Valley Conference performer from 2014-15 Destany McLin and the addition of Lacey Buchanan, who returns to her hometown after one season at Troy.
- McLin, who redshirted last season after nagging injuries following the 2014-15 season, led the Gamecocks in scoring as a junior with a 12.4 scoring average. In her last two seasons on the court, the Athens, Alabama native has poured in 776 total points and averaged 13.4 points per game as a sophomore and junior combined. Her last competitive game was March 3, 2015.
- Buchanan, who led Jacksonville High School to the AHSAA Class 4A state championship in 2012, returns to her hometown to help lead JSU. After two seasons at Gadsden State Community College, she inked with Troy for the 2014-15 season. Buchanan had to sit out last season due to NCAA transfer rules. She played in 31 games with the Trojans and averaged 5.6 points per game. She scored in double figures in seven games - all against Sun Belt Conference competition.
- Jax State also returns redshirt sophomore Leah Strain, who missed last season due to an injury. Strain saw action in 25 games as a freshman. Red shirt freshman Jada Coggins will make her JSU debut this season after suffering an injury prior to last season.
- Pietri dipped in to the junior college ranks with the addition of guard Kiandra 'Ki-Ki' Patterson and forward Tasha Magruder. Patterson joins the Gamecocks after two seasons at East Mississippi Community College. She averaged 17 points per game in her two seasons at EMCC. She originally signed with Mississippi State out of Columbus (Miss.) High School. Magruder adds depth to the post position after two seasons at Walters State CC. She helped WSCC to back-to-back appearances in the NJCAA National Tournament.

■ JSU ENTERS OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE SEASON

- Jax State's OVC home opener is set for Jan. 5 against Murray State, followed by Austin Peay on Jan. 7. The Gamecocks welcome OVC Champion Belmont to campus on Jan. 18 before a two-game road trip to Nashville, Tennessee against Tennessee State and to Richmond, Kentucky versus Eastern Kentucky.
- After playing five of the first eight conference games away from Pete Mathews Coliseum, the back end of the conference schedule favorable. JSU plays five home games in the final half of the season, including a three-game home stand in February. JSU will open the month of February with its annual Education Day contest on Feb. 1 against Southeast Missouri. The Gamecocks and Redhawks will tip off at 11:30 a.m. in front of local elementary kids from Jacksonville and Calhoun County.
- The OVC Women's Basketball Tournament returns to Nashville for the seventh consecutive postseason and will get underway on March 1 at Municipal Auditorium. The schedule for the 2017 Women's Basketball Championship will see the No. 1 vs. No. 8 and No. 2 vs. No. 7 seeds playing on Wednesday, with the teams winning those games having an off day on Thursday when the first round games continue with No. 3 vs. No. 6 and No. 4 vs. No. 5 matchups. The semifinals will remain on Friday with the Championship Game still being played on Saturday.

- Instrumental in USA's success in capturing back-to-back Sun Belt West Division titles in 2003 and 2004.
- Coached in his homestate of Louisiana at McNeese State from 2003-05 and Louisiana-Monroe from 2000-01.
- The 2000-01 ULM squad finished 20-9 overall and 17-3 in Southland Conference play.

- Helped guide the Barons to their first winning season in recent history with a 15-14 overall mark and claimed the program's first Southern States Athletic Association Tournament win.
- Pittman's connection to the Ohio Valley Conference dates back to his time at Eastern Kentucky. While in Richmond working towards his master's degree, he was a manager for the EKU men's team under head coach Jeff Neubauer.

JALA HARRIS TENNESSEE TECH, 2012

- Started her collegiate career at UAB before finishing the final three years at Tennessee Tech.
- Named the Conference USA Freshman of the Year.
- Set the UAB freshman record for assists with 103.
- An All-Ohio Valley Conference performer at TTU.

GAMECOCKS LED OVC IN SCORING DEFENSE FOR THE PAST TWO SEASONS

- For the past two seasons, Jacksonville State has finished the season atop the Ohio Valley Conference in scoring defense and since Rick Pietri took over the program, JSU has been among the top three teams in the OVC in scoring defense. In Pietri's first year, his club ranked third in scoring defense in the league.
- Over the past two seasons, the Gamecocks have held their opponents to 58.6 points per game.
- Against Pietri's JSU teams, opponents are scoring slightly above 60 points per game (61.9).
- In 2015-16, the Gamecocks limited the opposition to a league-best 57.8 points per game, holding a 5.4 edge over the second-best team in the category, UT Martin at 63.2 points per game.
- JSU also led the OVC in field goal percentage defense, limiting teams to .379 shooting. Jax State was the league's best at defending the three-point arc in 2015-16 as opponents netted just 28 percent of their shots from behind the arc against JSU in 2015-16.
- JSU's 2014-15 squad ranked second in the OVC in three-point field goal shooting defense at 29 percent from long range.
- In OVC games-only, JSU's 2015-16 team led the league in scoring defense at 58.7 points per game. In Pietri's first three seasons in OVC action, his Gamecocks have allowed 63.1 points per game to league foes.
- Dating back to the last four games of the 2015-16 season and the first two games this season, JSU opponents are 13-of-63 (.206) from behind the arc. The last six opponents have not recorded more than five treys against Jax State.

JSU'S THREE POINTERS-MADE STREAK

- While Jacksonville State is making it tough on the opponents on the offensive end of the floor with tough defense, it currently has a string of 86 consecutive games with at least one three-point basket.
- The streak dates back to JSU's Jan. 6, 2014 contest against Belmont as the Gamecocks went 0-for-4 in the contest.
- The Gamecocks hit at least one trey in the final 15 games of the 2013-14 season and drilled a three pointer in all 29 games of the 2014-15 campaign and in every game last season (28).
- Since the start of the Rick Pietri Era in 2013-14, JSU has made 519 three pointers and have connected on 33 percent from long range.
- Jax State is averaging 5.5 three pointers per game since the beginning of the 2013-14 season - a span of 94 games.

BENSON AND MCLIN JOIN JSU'S 1,000 CAREER POINTS CLUB

- Jacksonville State senior Briana Benson became the 11th Gamecock to reach 1,000 career points on December 18 in JSU's 74-52 win over Nicholls State. Benson, from Jonesboro, Georgia, was 19 points shy of reaching the 1,000 career point mark and surpassed 1,000 points with a game-high and season-best 22 points on the afternoon. Benson hit 1,000 career points at the 1:22 mark of the third quarter with one of her six three pointers. The senior had a career day with a career-high eight field goals as she was nearly spotless from the field, shooting 8-of-10 overall and 6-of-7 from behind the three-point arc.
- McLin reached the mark three games later at Eastern Illinois on Dec. 31, 2016 when she tallied a season-best 14 points in the double overtime loss. In the process, she became only the eighth member of the 1,000 career points club who has also pulled down 500 or more rebounds in a career. The Athens, Alabama native has already eclipsed the 500 rebound threshold as she pulled down her 500th rebound against Savannah State.
- With both players reaching the figure, they become the second and third Gamecocks to be added to the list since Rick Pietri took over the program prior to the 2013-14 season. They join former Gamecock Candace Morton as the most recent additions to the list as Morton surpassed the 1,000 career point mark during the 2014-15 season.
