One More Week: UPIKE is coming off its first-ever playoff win, defeating Baker in a 42-35 thriller.

Round 2 (Ding Ding): UPIKE will take on the No. 1 overall seed, the Keiser Seahawks, in round two of the 2024 NAIA Football Playoffs.

Playoff History: UPIKE is coming off its first NAIA playoff win. Their opponents, the Keiser Seahawks, are defending national champions and have won 20 consecutive games coming into Saturday.

No. 6 for 6: Lee Kirkland completed 24 of 35 passes for 310 yards and three touchdowns against Baker last week.

Hot Streak: Junior receiver Brandon Newton has four touchdown receptions in the Bears' last two games.

Ground Game: Amon Williams averaged 6.3 yards per carry after carrying the ball 24 times from 152 yards and two scores last week at Baker.

Series History: Saturday marks the second all-time meeting between UPIKE and Keiser. The Seahawks defeated the Bears 24-17 in the 2018 season opener.

Kirkland and the Record Book

UPIke quarterback Lee Kirkland's bloody assault on the record book is staggering. His name appears a remarkable 93 times in it. That list is entirely too long to recite here, but how about a list of the records he currently holds?

- Passing yards in a season, 3,676, this year
- Completions in a season, 339, this year
- Pass attempts in a season, 508, this year
- Touchdown passes in a season, 38, this year
- Passing yards in a game, 646, 11/16/24, national record
- Completions in a game, 41, 11/16/24
- Pass attempts in a game, 58, 9/30/23
- Touchdown passes in a game, 11, 11/16/24, national record
- Passing yards in a career, 9,555
- Completions in a career, 883
- Pass attempts in a career, 1,427
- Touchdown passes in a career, 101
- 300-yard games in a career, 15

Amon Among Men

Amon Williams is only a freshman but he has had a fantastic season. Here's a look inside the numbers through 11 games this season:

- He now holds the record for points in a season with 108
- With two touchdowns last Saturday, he has broken a tie and is alone atop the list of touchdowns in a season with 18
- He now has 15 touchdowns rushing, which is tied for the most in a season
- After scoring twice last week, he now has scored in seven straight games, which ties a school record and seven straight games with a rushing touchdown is the school record
- The 5-11, 185-pound freshman from Cumming, Ga., now has 1,219 rushing yards and 15 touchdowns while catching 54 passes for 450 yards and three additional scores

Saturday's situation

UPIke's 42-35 win over Baker (Kan.) was not only the first playoff win in school history but also the first postseason victory for the Appalachian Athletics Conference. Here's a look at some of the notable information from Baldwin City:

- AAC Offensive Player of the Year Lee Kirkland continued to show his worth, finishing 34-for-25 for 310 yards and three touchdowns. The scoring tosses covered 38, 6 and 10 yards. For good measure, the 6-6, 265-pound graduate student from Bluffton, S.C., ran for 42 yards and a score
- Williams, the freshman tailback, had 152 yards and two scores on the ground, averaging 6.3 yards per carry. Additionally, he caught seven passes for 66 yards
- UPIke's defense is often overlooked, but in the fourth quarter on Saturday, it turned Baker away four times. It began with an interception by senior Ja'Vione Shepherd, giving the Bears the ball at their own 21 and leading to the game-winning score. After that, the Wildcats drove to the UPIke 19 before tackling quarterback Sam Heggemann in the backfield on fourth-and-1. After that, Marshawn Boyden and Joe Alvarez had interceptions in UPIke territory to end the opportunities
- Five Bears caught at least three passes in the win
- Four players had double figure tackles in the game
- Freshman linebacker Caleb Anderson was credited for being in on 18 tackles, with a school record 14 of them being assisted tackles

Bear Facts (Cont.)

Playoffs: A look back

Today marks only the second trip to the playoffs for the Bears, so here's a look back at what happened in the first game, played Nov. 19, 2005.

It was 13-7. That's right. Heading into the fourth quarter, St. Francis (Ind.), a heavy favorite over the fifth-year program, led by six points.

But then ...

St. Francis quarterback Chris Bramell hit Cory Jacquay from 24 yards out to make it 20-7. The kickoff, into a fierce wind that day in Fort Wayne, died at the Bear 36, and the Cougars recovered. They quickly scored again.

It ended St. Francis 41, Pikeville 7.

Bramell finished only 11-of-21 for 170 yards with a touchdown and three interceptions.

Pikeville quarterback Chip English was 11-of-22 for 95 yards with one touchdown and an interception. The only score of the day came when he hit Justin Lamb on a 34-yard touchdown pass.

Lamb hauled in four passes for 52 yards. Mid-South Conference Offensive Player of the Year Calvin Joplin was limited to 30 yards on 11 carries.

Defensively, it's no surprise that Antwan Marsh was the standout, intercepting two passes on the day. E.J. Underwood, a transfer from Ohio State, had one as well.

Lamb and Marsh have since been inducted into the athletics Hall of Fame at the school, and the 2005 team was enshrined in 2019.

Did you know ...

- While it's not the first trip to the playoffs for the Bears, it is the first time UPike has been there. The school underwent a name change on July 1, 2011, six years after its only other trip to the postseason.
- UPike boasts of three professional schools: The Kentucky School of Osteopathic Medicine, founded in 1997; the Kentucky College of Optometry, established in 2016; and the Tanner College of Dental Medicine, which will welcome its inaugural class in 2026.
- This is the first time in school history the Bears will play a 12th game in a single season. Last week's game marked the ninth time they've played 11 times
- Today's game is the latest point on the calendar the Bears have played a football game. The earliest? In the COVID-shortened spring 2021 season, they opened on Feb. 12

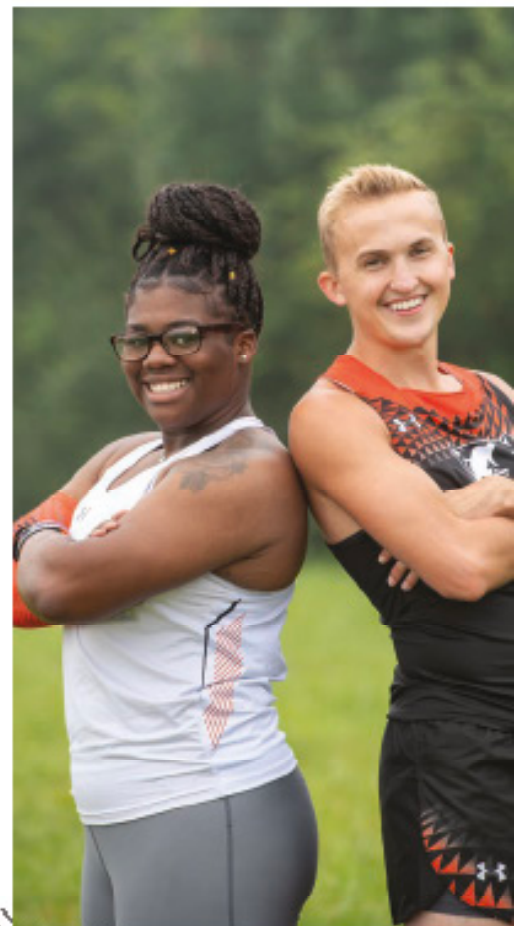

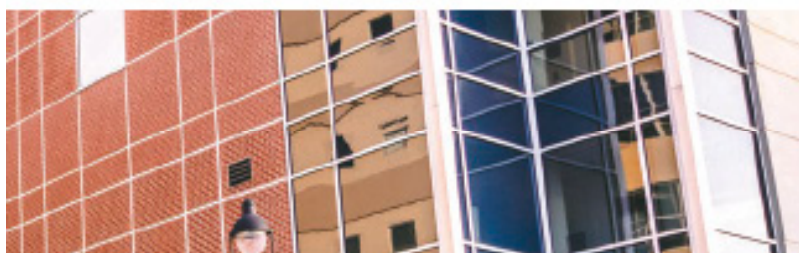
