Flash Facts

- The Kent State University men's basketball team looks to eclipse the .500 mark in Mid-American Conference action when it hosts West Division foe Western Michigan in the M.A.C. Center on Tuesday, January 16th at 7 p.m.
- The Golden Flashes won a thriller last Friday at home against the Ohio Bobcats, 70-69. The game went down to the final seconds and with three seconds remaining with Kent State up by one, Kevin Zabo intentionally missed a free throw to ensure Ohio would not get a good look.
- Senior guard Kevin Zabo registered a career-high 24 points against the Bobcats, shooting 8-for-15 from the field and 4-for-7 from three point land and yanked down a career-best six rebounds. He has scored in double-figures in 10 of the past 11 games after doing so only once in the first six contests.
- Kent State received balanced scoring as all nine players that saw action scored. This is the first time all season that every player in the game recorded a point.
- Junior point guard Jalen Avery leads the nation in assist to turnover ratio at 7.33. Avery has not committed a turnover in 2018 and only has three turnovers in the last eight games.
- Sophomore forward Danny Phippen swatted two shots against Miami last Tuesday and ranks seventh in the MAC with 1.3 blocks per game. Phippen has registered a blocked shot in all but three games this season.
- Head coach Rob Senderoff is 4-3 against Western Michigan since taking over the program in 2011-12. The Golden Flashes won the last meeting in Kent in 2016, 85-78.
- Kent State ranks sixth in the MAC in scoring defense (72.5) and in conference-only games is averaging 71.2 ppg which is also fifth in the league. The Golden Flashes are also the sixth-best free throw shooting team in the conference at 71.8%.

LAST TIME OUT

Senior guard Kevin Zabo scored a career-high 24 points and missed a key free throw in the closing seconds to help Kent State clinch a 70-69 win over Ohio University on Saturday night at the M.A.C. Center. Yes. You read that right. Zabo intentionally missed the second of two free throws with 3.1 seconds to play and Kent State clinging to a 70-69 lead. Jalen Avery then rebounded the miss off of the front of the rim as the final seconds ticked away. Senderoff assumed Ohio was likely to get the rebound, but with no timeouts remaining the Bobcats would have a difficult time getting a good look at a game-winner with three seconds remaining and their basket the better part of 94 feet away. After the miss, Jaylin Walker blocked out the Bobcat next to him and Avery grabbed the ball as Kent State (8-9, 2-2) secured its second Mid-American Conference win.

WESTERN MICHIGAN 92, KENT STATE 88 - JAN. 14, 2017

The Kent State University men's basketball team (9-8, 1-3 MAC) lost a hard fought road game Saturday, falling to the Western Michigan Broncos (6-10, 2-2 MAC), 92-88. Five players scored in double figures Saturday, led by a double-double effort from Jimmy Hall. He led the Golden Flashes with 24 points on 8-for-11 shooting and 10 rebounds. Deon Edwin and Desmond Ridenour each had a team-high five assists, along with 16 and 10 points, respectively. Edwin was a perfect 5-for-5 from the floor. After a missed layup with 11:24 left, the Flashes would not miss a shot until the final 15 seconds. The run began with back-to-back buckets in the paint from Mitch Peterson, and continued with a persistent attack at the basket. The Flashes cut the deficit to five points with six minutes left, but the home team made timely buckets to maintain the lead. Western Michigan scored on six of their next seven trips down the floor, helping them maintain the lead at 86-78 with 1:27 left. Kent State went to Hall down the stretch, who scored six straight points to bring the score to 86-84 with 27 seconds left. The home team held on down the stretch, scoring six points at the foul line in the final 23 seconds.

KENT STATE 85, WESTERN MICHIGAN 78 - FEB. 16, 2016

Galal Cancer scored a career-high 24 points and Kent State's defense shut down Western Michigan in overtime to secure an 85-78 victory on Tuesday night at the M.A.C. Center. The Golden Flashes needed overtime to beat the Broncos in the Mid-American Conference opener in Kalamazoo on Jan. 5. Western's Thomas Wilder forced another extra session on a driving layup with 1.1 seconds remaining in regulation. From there, KSU held Western to just 1-for-6 shooting from the field. Cancer's 6-of-10 from three-point range led the way as the Flashes shot 50-percent from beyond the arc (13-for-26). Thomas (15 points, 5 assists), Deon Edwin (13 points, 6 rebounds) and Chris Ortiz (13 points, 5 rebounds, 4 assists) gave KSU five players scoring in double-figures in a balanced scoring attack that looked to the perimeter for the bulk of its scoring. The Flashes finished with just 18 points in the paint after a 50-point effort inside during the first meeting in Kalamazoo.

NONCON WRAPUP

The Golden Flashes finished the non-conference portion of the season at 6-7, taking crucial steps towards a run through the Mid-American Conference. The defending league champions took some lumps against top competition, falling on the road to the likes of Xavier, Albany and Loyola Chicago. However, several highlights were had, including the program's fourth Power 5 victory under head coach Rob Senderoff, taking down Oregon State at home, 79-78. Kent State also maintained its claim as the best basketball program in Northeast Ohio, taking down Youngstown State, 111-78, and Cleveland State, 72-62. Individually, multiple student-athletes have broken out into bigger roles. Adonis De La Rosa has emerged as a top low post threat, with nine double digit scoring efforts. Jalen Avery has also established himself as one of the nation's most efficient point guards, leading the country with a 6.22 assist to turnover ratio. Jaylin Walker has led the scoring efforts as expected, averaging a team-best 17.6 points per game.

Kent State Game Notes

ALL-TIME SERIES

Kent State leads the all-time series 61-56, with Kent State winning nine of the past 12 meetings. In games played in Kent, the Flashes are 38-16. Kent State has the series' longest winning streak at seven games from 2007 through 2012. Head coach Rob Senderoff is 4-3 against Western Michigan since taking over the program in 2011-12.

10 3-POINTERS

The Flashes recorded 10 3-pointers made in the team's win over Oregon State, connecting on 40 percent of its 25 3-point shot attempts. The Flashes hit the double digit mark in 3-pointers made for the second time this season, previously hitting 10 against Ohio Christian on Nov. 16. Last season, Kent State had seven games of 10 or more 3-pointers, tying the program high during the Rob Senderoff era. The Flashes have had at least four games with 10 or more 3-pointers in every season since the 2012-13 campaign.

EFFICIENT ADONIS

Junior center Adonis de la Rosa scored a career-high 24 points in the Flashes' 85-69 win over Central Michigan on 9-13 shooting from the floor last Saturday. Over his past six games he is 31-52 for 60% and is second in the MAC in field goal percentage. De la Rosa has increased his free throw percentage from 56% (43-77) last year to 80% (65-81) this season.

AVERY LEADS THE NATION

Junior point guard Jalen Avery leads the nation with a 7.33 assist to turnover ratio. The Covington, Ky. native has committed the fewest turnovers (9) of all players in the country that qualify (min. 3 assists per game). He leads the second ranked player, Muhammad-Ali Abdur-Rahkman from Michigan, by 1.13 assists. Avery has not had a turnover in 2018 and only has three in his last seven games.

BLOCK PARTY

Kent State forward Danny Pippen has made an impact defensively for Kent State, serving as one of the league's best shot blocker through the early portion of the season. Pippen has 21 blocks so far, averaging 1.3 per game. At his current pace, he will finish the year at 48 shots blocked, matching Jimmy Hall for the program's sixth best single season mark. The single season blocks record is 81, held by John Edwards. The most blocks in a season during the Rob Senderoff era is 56, a mark that ranks third overall and is held by former MAC Defensive Player of the Khaliq Spicer.

WALKER 1,000 POINT WATCH

Jaylin Walker has been a dynamic scorer since stepping on the court for Kent State. He has scored 922 points over three seasons and barring a set back, will surpass 1,000 points scored this season. Averaging 17.1 points per game, Walker is on pace to cross 1,000 points at home against Buffalo on Jan. 30.

When he crosses the milestone, he will become the 32nd player in Kent State history to do so and the fifth player to cross 1,000 under head coach Rob Senderoff. If Walker can stay on the floor consistently when he returns, he is on pace to approach 1,300 career points, putting him just outside the Kent State all-time top-10. He will likely pass Kris Brewer, another top scorer under Rob Senderoff. The all-time points record at Kent State is 1,820 by Trevor Huffman, a record that is not out of reach for Walker.

MISTAKE FREE AVERY

Jalen Avery has had an incredible start to his junior season and is making a name for himself as one of the most efficient point guards in the Mid-American Conference. Through 11 games, Avery has committed just eight turnovers, while racking up 48 assists. His six assist to turnover ratio currently ranks first in the nation. His best game distributing came against Mississippi Valley State, in which he recorded a career-high 10 assists to no turnovers. It was the first double digit assist game for Kent State since Derek Jackson recorded 11 on December 6, 2014 against Kennesaw State (W, 58-46).

Avery has also only had five fouls called against him, once in the opener against Youngstown State as well as against Southeastern Louisiana, Cleveland State, Loyola Chicago and Xavier. Avery currently holds a fouls called against per 40 minutes average at 0.75. Last season, Avery ranked second in the nation among qualified players in fouls called against per 40 minutes at 1.11. This rate was only topped by Saint Mary's starting point guard Emmett Naar at 0.93. The top four players ranked in this statistic made the NCAA Tournament.

COACH SENDEROFF

Rob Senderoff made his first trip to the NCAA Tournament as a head coach in his sixth season with the program. With this record-breaking season in the books, Senderoff now ranks third all-time at Kent State in total wins at 130. He ranks 11 wins behind Jim Christian and 21 behind Jim McDonald. His winning percentage of .593 is the third best among coaches with at least five years at Kent State, ranking behind Christian (.704) and Gary Waters (.605).

GOLDEN FLASHES PICKED SECOND IN MAC EAST

Kent State was tabbed to finish second in the MAC East Division as selected by the league's 12 head coaches and an 18-member MAC News Media Panel. Junior guard Jaylin Walker was voted to the MAC East Preseason All-MAC Team

Rob Senderoff enters his seventh year as the head men's basketball coach at Kent State. The 44-year-old took over the program in April 2011 after spending seven previous years on the Golden Flashes' coaching staff. He ended the 2016-17 season with a 122-81 record as head coach, including a trip to the 2017 NCAA Tournament.

In his six seasons as head coach, the 22-year coaching veteran has continued the success of the storied program that he helped build by leading the Golden Flashes to four 20-win campaigns and postseason appearances.

The six year run culminated in a fantastic 2016-17 season in which the Flashes returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2008. Kent State claimed the program's first Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship under Rob Senderoff, defeating the top three seeds in the tournament in succession. The Flashes scored the most points in program history at 2,722, beating the previous record by 40 points. Senderoff led his squad to the postseason despite almost a dozen newcomers to the program.

In the 2015-16 season, Senderoff led the Golden Flashes to 19 wins in a campaign that was highlighted by All-District honors for junior Jimmy Hall and MAC Defensive Player of the Year honors for Khaliq Spicer. 2014-15 was Senderoff's most successful as head coach, as he led Kent State to a share of the Mid-American Conference regular season title. The championship season was followed by a postseason run to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) quarterfinals during which Senderoff tied the school record for postseason wins. The Flashes were earned road wins at Middle Tennessee and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi before falling to Northern Arizona.

The inaugural year for Senderoff began with one of the most memorable debuts in the coaching profession. Kent State recorded a monumental 70-60 win over West Virginia and Hall of Fame Head Coach Bob Huggins, snapping the Mountaineers' 36-game non-conference home winning streak. The victory, which was part of ESPN's 24-hour College Basketball Tip-Off Marathon, also marked the first true road win over a BCS school for Kent State in 41 years.

The historic first win was just the beginning, as the Flashes won 21 games, advanced to the semifinals of the MAC Tournament and earned an invitation to play in the CIT in each of his first two seasons. Senderoff earned the first postseason victory of his head coaching career in 2013, as the Golden Flashes defeated Fairfield in a CIT first round matchup.

During his 13 seasons as part of the Kent State program, Senderoff has helped guide the Golden Flashes to 11 postseason appearances (2002-06; 2008-13; 2015; 2017), racking up 250 victories for an average of nearly 22 wins per year in the process. He has been on the sideline for four of the six Mid-American Conference regular season titles in school history. In 2011, Kent State became the first MAC team in 21 years, and just the second in 48 years, to claim second consecutive outright regular season championships. The Golden Flashes capped off the year by advancing to the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) quarterfinals.

Senderoff assumed the de facto role of offensive coordinator during his three seasons as Associate Head Coach (2008-11), taking Kent State's scoring to new heights under his watch. In 2010-11 the Golden Flashes poured in 2,626 points, which trailed only the 2001-02 Elite Eight team for the highest single-season total in school history. In his first year back with the program in 2008-09, Senderoff helped orchestrate an offense that led the MAC in both scoring and field goal percentage. It was the first time since joining the league in 1951-52 that the program has led the conference in scoring.

Long known for his ability to develop post players, Senderoff transformed the play of 2011 MAC Player of the Year Justin Greene. Under his tutelage, Greene went from a 2.2 points per game scorer as a freshman to the nation's most improved player in 2009-10, followed by an Honorable Mention All-American selection in 2010-11. Greene capped off his career in 2012 and will go down as one of the top players to ever put on a Kent State uniform, ranking fourth in career scoring, second in rebounding and second in blocked shots.

A proven national recruiter, his track record as a talented young assistant did not go unnoticed. Current ESPN.com Insider Jeff Goodman analyst recognized him as the top assistant coach in the MAC in 2010, the same year that The Hoop Scoop rated him as one of the top 50 Mid-Major Assistants in the country. Coming in at No. 4 on the list, he was the only MAC assistant coach ranked in the top 25.

During Senderoff's first stint on staff from 2002-06, the Golden Flashes went 89-40 (.690) and won three MAC East Division titles. After three straight NIT appearances, he helped KSU advance to the NCAA Tournament in 2005-06 as the team won both the MAC regular season and tournament titles with a 25-9 overall record. Senderoff spent the 2006-07 season at Indiana where he worked with All-Big Ten and preseason All-American D.J. White. While a member of the Hoosier's staff, IU went 21-11 and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He was also part of a staff that recruited The Hoop Scoop's No. 1 recruiting class in the country in 2007.

With the Golden Flashes he had a critical role in the progression of 2004 First Team and MAC Defensive Player of the Year, John Edwards, who played in the NBA with the Atlanta Hawks and Indiana Pacers. Additionally at Kent State, Senderoff also coached All-MAC performer Antonio Gates who went on to become an All-Pro tight end for the San Diego Chargers.

A native of Spring Valley, N.Y., Senderoff began his coaching career as a student assistant at the University at Albany under legendary coach Richard "Doc" Sauers before moving on to the MAC as a graduate assistant at Miami from 1995-97 where he was part of a staff that helped develop NBA players Wally Szczerbiak and Ira Newble. Returning to the East Coast, he spent time at Fordham (1997-99), Yale (1999-2001) and Towson (2001-02) prior to joining the Golden Flashes staff.

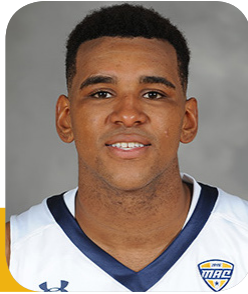

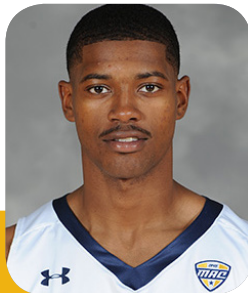
