### Flash Facts

- The Kent State University men's basketball team takes on MAC West foe Toledo in a divisional crossover battle at John F. Savage Arena on Saturday, Jan. 20th at 7 p.m. Kent State has won three of its last four for the second time this year since opening on a three game winning streak.
- The Golden Flashes have a 2-1 record against MAC West opponents.
- Kent State has a 15-49 record at Toledo, the last KSU win was a 76-75 overtime thriller in 2015.
- Head coach Rob Senderoff is 4-4 vs. Toledo since taking over the program in 2011-12.
- The Golden Flashes defeated Western Michigan, 73-71, in their last contest on Tuesday night. Mitch Peterson scored the game-winning basket on an offensive rebound with 0.3 seconds left.
- KSU shot its best percentage of the season from beyond the three point arc (13-23, 57%), and made its first eight attempts. It is the fourth time this year the Flashes have made at least ten threes and are 4-0 in those games.
- The defense held the MAC's fourth leading scorer (Thomas Wilder, 17.6 ppg) to just 10 points.
- Kent State scored 45 points in the first half against Western Michigan, its second highest half point total of the season, after scoring 46 points in the first half against Central Michigan.
- Sophomore forward Danny Pippen dropped a career-high 16 points against the Broncos, shooting 6-for-9 and 4-for-5 from three point land. He was a perfect 6-for-6 and 4-for-4 in the first half.
- Senior guard Kevin Zabo scored 20+ points in back-to-back games for the first time in his career.
- Junior center Adonis de la Rosa notched his fifth double-double this year (11 points, 12 rebounds).
- Kent State ranks fifth in the MAC in scoring defense (72.4) and in conference-only games is averaging 71.6 ppg which is also sixth in the league. The Golden Flashes are also the sixth-best free throw shooting team in the conference at 72.0%.
- Kent State is holding opponents 33.4% from three-point distance which is fourth in the MAC.

## LAST TIME OUT

Mitch Peterson capped a flurry of offensive rebounds by Kent State as the M.A.C. Center clock ticked away, floating in a short fadeaway with 0.3 seconds remaining to lift the Golden Flashes to a 73-71 victory over Western Michigan on Tuesday night. The buzzer beater finally put away the Broncos, who battled back to tie the game after trailing by as many as 18 points in the first half. A three by Peterson with 10:13 remaining gave the Flashes a 63-49 lead, but it was followed by a five-minute scoring drought that saw Western outscore KSU 18-5. The Broncos finally deadlocked the game with seven seconds to play when a goaltending call credited Reggie Jones with a layup. Kevin Zabo led the Flashes with 23 points. Danny Pippen added 16 points, all in a first half that saw him make 6-of-6 from the field and 4-of-4 from three-point range as KSU took a 45-33 lead into the break. Adonis De La Rosa finished with his fifth double-double of the season, scoring 11 points to go with 12 rebounds. Jaylin Walker finished with 10 points and Jalen Avery contributed nine assists.

## TOLEDO 78, KENT STATE 58 - FEB. 11, 2017

The Kent State University men's basketball team (13-12, 5-7 MAC) took its first road loss in almost a month, falling to the Toledo Rockets (13-12, 6-6 MAC) Saturday, 78-58. Jaylin Walker led the Flashes in scoring with 13 points off the bench. Jimmy Hall registered 10 points and had a team-best five rebounds. Deon Edwin finished one short of his career-high in assists with five, and contributed six points. When the two teams played in the M.A.C. Center, Kent State gave Toledo its best performance. On Saturday, Toledo did the same, shooting a season-best 65.2 percent (30-for-46) with eight 3-pointers. Kent State shot 40.7 percent (24-for-59) from the floor and 23.8 percent (5-for-21) from distance. The high shooting mark for Toledo kept the Flashes' rebounding total low, but Kent State registered 13 of 25 boards on offense. Kent State won the turnover margin, 12-15.

## KENT STATE 85, TOLEDO 61 - JAN. 21, 2017

The Kent State University men's basketball team (10-9, 2-4 MAC) put on a show for a sold out crowd in the M.A.C. Center Saturday, defeating the Toledo Rockets (10-9, 3-3 MAC), 85-61. Kent State scored 85 points on 57.6 percent (34-for-59) shooting. Kent State picked up 50 points in the paint, the season-best against a Division I opponent. Toledo was held to 36.7 percent (18-for-49) shooting and 22.7 percent (5-for-22) from distance. Kent State is the first team to hold Toledo to under 40 percent shooting this season. Seniors Jimmy Hall and Deon Edwin scored 50 of Kent State's 85 points on a combined 21-for-32 shooting. Hall had a game-best 27 points, pushing him into Kent State's top-10 scorers of all time at 1,343 points. He also tallied five rebounds and three assists. Edwin scored a career-high 23 points on 9-for-12 shooting. He dished out a team-high five assists. Adonis De La Rosa led with six boards and set a new career high with blocks.

## ALL-TIME SERIES

Toledo leads the all-time series 82-48, with the Rockets holding a commanding 15-49 record in Toledo. Kent State has won three of the last five meetings since 2015. The Rockets have the longest winning streak of the series, winning 15 in a row from 1938-1961. This is the 131st all-time meeting. Kent State won the first meeting, 25-24, in 1938.

## 13 3-POINTERS

The Flashes recorded a season-high 13 3-pointers made in the team's win over Western Michigan, connecting on 57 percent of its 23 3-point shot attempts. The Golden Flashes hit the double digit mark in 3-pointers made for the fourth time this season, and are 4-0 when eclipsing the 10 three pointer mark . Last season, Kent State had seven games of 10 or more 3-pointers, tying the program high during the Rob Senderoff era. The Flashes have had at least four games with 10 or more 3-pointers in every season since the 2012-13 campaign.

# Kent State Game Notes

## EFFICIENT ADONIS

Junior center Adonis de la Rosa scored a career-high 24 points in the Flashes' 85-69 win over Central Michigan on 9-13 shooting from the floor on January, 6th. He is second in the MAC with a 59% field goal percentage. De la Rosa has increased his free throw pertenage from 56% (43-77) last year to 80% (66-82) this season.

## AVERY LEADS THE NATION

Junior point guard Jalen Avery leads the nation with a 6.25 assist to turover ratio. The Covington, Ky. native has committed the fewest turnovers (12) of all players in the country that qualify (min. 3 assists per game). He leads the second ranked player, Muhammad-Ali Abdur-Rahkman from Michigan, by 0.43 assists. Avery has not had a turnover in 2018 and only has three in his last seven games.

## BLOCK PARTY

Kent State forward Danny Pippen has made an impact defensively for Kent State, serving as one of the league's best shot blocker through the early portion of the season. Pippen has 21 blocks so far, averaging 1.2 per game. The single season blocks record is 81, held by John Edwards. The most blocks in a season during the Rob Senderoff era is 56, a mark that ranks third overall and is held by former MAC Defensive Player of the Khaliq Spicer.

## 20 POINTS FOR ZABO

Senior Kevin Zabo has scored at least 20 points in back-to-back games for the first time in his career. His 24 points in the win over Ohio (Jan. 12) are the most in his career and he also grabbed down a career-best six boards. Zabo is coming off a 23 point night against WMU when he went 5-for-7 from three.

## WALKER 1,000 POINT WATCH

Jaylin Walker has been a dynamic scorer since stepping on the court for Kent State. He has scored 932 points over three seasons and barring a set back, will surpass 1,000 points scored this season. Averaging 16.7 points per game, Walker is on pace to cross 1,000 points at home against Buffalo on Jan. 30.

When he crosses the milestone, he will become the 32nd player in Kent State history to do so and the fifth player to cross 1,000 under head coach Rob Senderoff. If Walker can stay on the floor consistently when he returns, he is on pace to approach 1,300 career points, putting him just outside the Kent State all-time top-10. He will likely pass Kris Brewer, another top scorer under Rob Senderoff. The all-time points record at Kent State is 1,820 by Trevor Huffman.

## NONCON WRAPUP

The Golden Flashes finished the non-conference portion of the season at 6-7, taking crucial steps towards a run through the Mid-American Conference. The defending league champions took some lumps against top competition, falling on the road to the likes of Xavier, Albany and Loyola Chicago. However, several highlights were had, including the program's fourth Power 5 victory under head coach Rob Senderoff, taking down Oregon State at home, 79-78. Kent State also maintained its claim as the best basketball program in North-east Ohio, taking down Youngstown State, 111-78, and Cleveland State, 72-62. Individually, multiple student-athletes have broken out into bigger roles. Adonis De La Rosa has emerged as a top low post threat, with nine double digit scoring efforts. Jalen Avery has also established himself as one of the nation's most efficient point guards, leading the country with a 6.22 assist to turnover ratio. Jaylin Walker has led the scoring efforts as expected, averaging a team-best 17.6 points per game.

## MISTAKE FREE AVERY

Jalen Avery has had an incredible start to his junior season and is making a name for himself as one of the most efficient point guards in the Mid-American Conference. Through 18 games, Avery has committed just 12 turnovers, while racking up 75 assists. His assist to turnover ratio currently ranks first in the nation. His best game distributing came against Mississippi Valley State, in which he recorded a career-high 10 assists to no turnovers. It was the first double digit assist game for Kent State since Derek Jackson recorded 11 on December 6, 2014 against Kennesaw State (W, 58-46).

Avery has also only had 11 fouls called against him. Avery currently holds a fouls called against per 40 minutes average at 0.75. Last season, Avery ranked second in the nation among qualified players in fouls called against per 40 minutes at 1.11. This rate was only topped by Saint Mary's starting point guard Emmett Naar at 0.93. The top four players ranked in this statistic made the NCAA Tournament.

## COACH SENDEROFF

Rob Senderoff made his first trip to the NCAA Tournament as a head coach in his sixth season with the program. With this record-breaking season in the books, Senderoff now ranks third all-time at Kent State in total wins at 131. He ranks 11 wins behind Jim Christian and 21 behind Jim McDonald. His winning percentage of .593 is the third best among coaches with at least five years at Kent State, ranking behind Christian (.704) and Gary Waters (.605).

## GOLDEN FLASHES PICKED SECOND IN MAC EAST

Kent State was tabbed to finish second in the MAC East Division as selected by the league's 12 head coaches and an 18-member MAC News Media Panel. Junior guard Jaylin Walker was voted to the MAC East Preseason All-MAC Team

## ROB SENDEROFF

>> HEAD COACH

**R**ob Senderoff enters his seventh year as the head men's basketball coach at Kent State. The 44-year-old took over the program in April 2011 after spending seven previous years on the Golden Flashes' coaching staff. He ended the 2016-17 season with a 122-81 record as head coach, including a trip to the 2017 NCAA Tournament.

In his six seasons as head coach, the 22-year coaching veteran has continued the success of the storied program that he helped build by leading the Golden Flashes to four 20-win campaigns and postseason appearances.

The six year run culminated in a fantastic 2016-17 season in which the Flashes returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2008. Kent State claimed the program's first Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship under Rob Senderoff, defeating the top three seeds in the tournament in succession. The Flashes scored the most points in program history at 2,722, beating the previous record by 40 points. Senderoff led his squad to the postseason despite almost a dozen newcomers to the program.

In the 2015-16 season, Senderoff led the Golden Flashes to 19 wins in a campaign that was highlighted by All-District honors for junior Jimmy Hall and MAC Defensive Player of the Year honors for Khaliq Spicer. 2014-15 was Senderoff's most successful as head coach, as he led Kent State to a share of the Mid-American Conference regular season title. The championship season was followed by a postseason run to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) quarterfinals during which Senderoff tied the school record for postseason wins. The Flashes were earned road wins at Middle Tennessee and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi before falling to Northern Arizona.

The inaugural year for Senderoff began with one of the most memorable debuts in the coaching profession. Kent State recorded a monumental 70-60 win over West Virginia and Hall of Fame Head Coach Bob Huggins, snapping the Mountaineers' 36-game non-conference home winning streak. The victory, which was part of ESPN's 24-hour College Basketball Tip-Off Marathon, also marked the first true road win over a BCS school for Kent State in 41 years.

The historic first win was just the beginning, as the Flashes won 21 games, advanced to the semifinals of the MAC Tournament and earned an invitation to play in the CIT in each of his first two seasons. Senderoff earned the first postseason victory of his head coaching career in 2013, as the Golden Flashes defeated Fairfield in a CIT first round matchup.

During his 13 seasons as part of the Kent State program, Senderoff has helped guide the Golden Flashes to 11 postseason appearances (2002-06; 2008-13; 2015; 2017), racking up 250 victories for an average of nearly 22 wins per year in the process. He has been on the sideline for four of the six Mid-American Conference regular season titles in school history. In 2011, Kent State became the first MAC team in 21 years, and just the second in 48 years, to claim second consecutive outright regular season championships. The Golden Flashes capped off the year by advancing to the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) quarterfinals.

Senderoff assumed the de facto role of offensive coordinator during his three seasons as Associate Head Coach (2008-11), taking Kent State's scoring to new heights under his watch. In 2010-11 the Golden Flashes poured in 2,626 points, which trailed only the 2001-02 Elite Eight team for the highest single-season total in school history. In his first year back with the program in 2008-09, Senderoff helped orchestrate an offense that led the MAC in both scoring and field goal percentage. It was the first time since joining the league in 1951-52 that the program has led the conference in scoring.

Long known for his ability to develop post players, Senderoff transformed the play of 2011 MAC Player of the Year Justin Greene. Under his tutelage, Greene went from a 2.2 points per game scorer as a freshman to the nation's most improved player in 2009-10, followed by an Honorable Mention All-American selection in 2010-11. Greene capped off his career in 2012 and will go down as one of the top players to ever put on a Kent State uniform, ranking fourth in career scoring, second in rebounding and second in blocked shots.

### SENDEROFF'S COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

- In his first game as a head coach, led Kent State to a 70-60 win over West Virginia and Head Coach Bob Huggins in Morgantown.
- Has graduated every student-athlete that has made it through senior day during his time as a head coach.

A proven national recruiter, his track record as a talented young assistant did not go unnoticed. Current ESPN.com Insider Jeff Goodman analyst recognized him as the top assistant coach in the MAC in 2010, the same year that The Hoop Scoop rated him as one of the top 50 Mid-Major Assistants in the country. Coming in at No. 4 on the list, he was the only MAC assistant coach ranked in the top 25.

During Senderoff's first stint on staff from 2002-06, the Golden Flashes went 89-40 (.690) and won three MAC East Division titles. After three straight NIT appearances, he helped KSU advance to the NCAA Tournament in 2005-06 as the team won both the MAC regular season and tournament titles with a 25-9 overall record. Senderoff spent the 2006-07 season at Indiana where he worked with All-Big Ten and preseason All-American D.J. White. While a member of the Hoosier's staff, IU went 21-11 and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He was also part of a staff that recruited The Hoop Scoop's No. 1 recruiting class in the country in 2007.

With the Golden Flashes he had a critical role in the progression of 2004 First Team and MAC Defensive Player of the Year, John Edwards, who played in the NBA with the Atlanta Hawks and Indiana Pacers. Additionally at Kent State, Senderoff also coached All-MAC performer Antonio Gates who went on to become an All-Pro tight end for the San Diego Chargers.

A native of Spring Valley, N.Y., Senderoff began his coaching career as a student assistant at the University at Albany under legendary coach Richard "Doc" Sauers before moving on to the MAC as a graduate assistant at Miami from 1995-97 where he was part of a staff that helped develop NBA players Wally Szczerbiak and Ira Newble. Returning to the East Coast, he spent time at Fordham (1997-99), Yale (1999-2001) and Towson (2001-02) prior to joining the Golden Flashes staff.

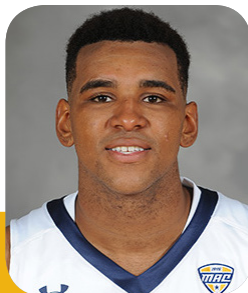

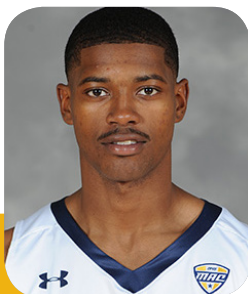
