- The Kent State University men's basketball team returns home to battle MAC West Division opponent Ball State on Tuesday, January 23rd at 7 p.m.
- The Golden Flashes have a 2-2 record against MAC West opponents.
- The Golden Flashes have a 2-2 record against MAC west opponents.
- Kent State has a 43-38 record all time against Ball State and have won the last 14 in the series.
   Head coach Rob Senderoff is 7-0 against the Cardinals since taking over the program in 2011-12.
- The Golden Flashes fell at Toledo, 72-65, in their last contest on Saturday night. KSU was down
- by 12 in the middle of the first, and had a two-point lead with 4:27 to play, but couldn't hold on.
- KSU shot 42% (8-for-19) from three-point distance against Toledo. The Flashes are shooting 48% (29-for-60) in their last three contests, which is up 14 percentage points on their season average (34%).
- The defense held the MAC's leading offense (80.2 ppg) eight points below their season average.
- Junior guard Jaylin Walker scored 19 points off the bench for Kent Stateand was a perfect
  4-for-4 free three point land in the first half with a buzzer beater to end the first half. It is the
  second consecutive game a Golden Flash was 100% from three, as Danny Pippen was 4-for-4 vs.
  Western Michigan.
- Senior guard Kevin Zabo scored 20 or more points in his third consecutive game. He leads the squad averaging 18.7 ppg in MAC play, which ranks fourth in the league.
- Junior center Adonis De La Rosa recorded 14 boards, his second straight game with 12 or more.
- Kent State ranks fifth in the MAC in scoring defense (72.4) and in conference-only games is averaging 72.7 ppg which is also sixth in the league. The Golden Flashes are also the sixth-best free throw shooting team in the conference at 71.3%.
- Kent State is holding opponents 33.4% from three-point distance which is second in the MAC.
   The Flashes are third in the conference in defensive rebounding (34.4 rpg).

### Kent State Game Notes

#### LAST TIME OUT

Kent State's hope of capturing its first Mid-American Conference road victory of the season slipped away during a cold spell in the closing minutes of a 72-65 loss at Toledo on Saturday. A layup by Desmond Ridenour with 4:27 to play gave the Golden Flashes a 61-59 lead with 4:27 to play in a back-and-forth second half. Unfortunately for the Flashes, a pair of split trips to the foul line accounted for their only points until Kevin Zabo broke the team's field goal drought on a drive with just 20 seconds remaining. After Zabo's bucket cut the Toledo lead to 67-65, the Rockets closed out the win from the foul line. Saturday's battle in Savage Arena was closer than that seven-point outcome. The frustrating finish spoiled big offensive performances by Zabo and Jaylin Walker. Zabo's 20-point effort marked his third consecutive game of 20 or more points. Walker finished with 19 points - 14 coming in the first half when he made 5-of-6 from the field and all four of his three-point attempts.

#### **KENT STATE 100, BALL STATE 90 - JAN. 3, 2017**

The Kent State University men's basketball team (9-5, 1-0 MAC) had a record setting night in picking up its Mid-American Conference opening game, defeating the Ball State Cardinals (9-5, 0-1 MAC), 100-90, Tuesday at home. The Golden Flashes were a perfect 31-for-31 from the free throw line, setting a new MAC record for most free throws made in a perfect night. The previous record for the conference was 25, and the previous program record was 13. The Flashes were three short of the NCAA record. Jimmy Hall scored 20 points against the Cardinals, and led the Golden Flashes with nine rebounds and five assists without a turnover. Jaylin Walker was the team's leading scorer at 21 points, finishing 3-for-6 from beyond the arc. Kevin Zabo had his best game for Kent State, finishing with 18 points on 7-for-8 shooting with four rebounds. Overall, Kent State shot 41.7 percent (30-for-72) from the floor and 9-for-19 from 3-point range, to go along with its perfect free throw shooting night. Ball State shot 47.6 percent (30-for-63) from the floor. Kent State won the rebounding battle, 38-30, with 17 offensive rebounds. Kent State had the lower turnover margin, 13-16.

#### **KENT STATE 76, BALL STATE 68 - JAN. 19, 2016**

Kent State moved into first place in the Mid-American Conference East Division as Xavier Pollard, Kellon Thomas and Khaliq Spicer led the Golden Flashes to a 76-68 road win over West leading Ball State on Tuesday. Pollard scored 22 points and Thomas added 20 while Spicer controlled the paint defensively in blocking five shots. The trio were the key to Kent State holding on to a second-half lead as foul trouble forced Jimmy Hall to the bench. Hall added 14 points and four rebounds in just six minutes as the Flashes improved to 13-5 overall and 4-1 in MAC play. Thomas scored 11 of his 20 from the foul line, going 11-for-12. He also dished out three assists while playing 30 turnover-free minutes. Pollard had four assists against just three turnovers.

#### **ALL-TIME SERIES**

The Golden Flashes lead the all-time series over the Cardinals 43-38. Kent State is 29-9 at home, its second best winning perctange (76.3%) against a MAC opponent at home. Kent State is also in the midst of the longest winning-streak of the series, winning the past 14 contests. The Flashes last loss with a 76-67 setback in 2005 in Muncie. Head coach Rob Senderoff is 7-0 against the Cardinals since taking over the program in 2011-12.

#### 13 3-POINTERS

The Flashes recorded a season-high 13 3-pointers made in the team's win over Western Michigan, connecting on 57 percent of its 23 3-point shot attempts. The Golden Flashes hit the double digit mark in 3-pointers made for the fouth time this season, and are 4-0 when eclipsing the 10 three pointer mark . Last season, Kent State had seven games of 10 or more 3-pointers, tying the program high during the Rob Senderoff era. The Flashes have had at least four games with 10 or more

3-pointers in every season since the 2012-13 campaign.

#### THE MAN IN THE MIDDLE

Junior center Adonis De La Rosa has taken on a much bigger role this season averaging 11.5 ppg, which is third on the team, after averging just 3.7 last year. He scored a career-high 24 points in the Flashes' 85-69 win over Central Michigan shooting 9-for-13 from the floor on January, 6th. He is second in the MAC with a 59% field goal percentage.

De La Rosa is also the team's leading rebouder, ripping down 7.8 rpg. After tireless hours in the gym this summer he has increased his free throw pertenage from 56% (43-77) last year to 79% (69-87) this season. His 79% mark is the highest free throw percentage in the country for any player seven feet or

#### AVERY LEADS THE NATION

Junior point guard Jalen Avery leads the nation with a 6.5 assist to turover ratio. The Covington, Ky. native has committed the fewest turnovers (12) of all players in the country that qualify (min. 3 assists per game). He leads the second ranked player, Muhammad-Ali Abdur-Rahkman from Michigan, by 0.43 assists.

#### **BLOCK PARTY**

Kent State forward Danny Pippen has made an impact defensively for Kent State, serving as one of the league's best shot blockers. Pippen has 21 blocks so far, averaging 1.2 per game. The single season blocks record is 81, held by John Edwards. The most blocks in a season during the Rob Senderoff era is 56, da State 25, Nevada 23, Saint Mary's 19, New Mexico State 4, a mark that ranks third overall and is held by former MAC Defensive Player of the Khalig Spicer.

#### ZABO EMERGING AS DYNAMIC SCORER

Senior Kevin Zabo has scored at least 20 or more points in three consecutive games for the first time in his career. His 24 points in the win over Ohio (Jan. 12) are the most in his career, and he also grabbed down a career-best six boards. Over those last three games he is shooting 54% (25-of-46) and 63% (10-of-16). Zabo is fourth in the MAC in scoring in conference-only games.

#### WALKER OFF THE BENCH

Head coach Rob Senderoff has elected to use junior guard Jaylin Walker off the bench in the last three games. Walker scored 19 points against Toledo (Jan. 20) as the six-man and made his first four three-point field goals. It was the most points off the bench since Jimmy Hall scored 21 against Miami on February 14, 2017.

#### WALKER 1,000 POINT WATCH

Jaylin Walker has been a prolific scorer since stepping on the court for Kent State. He has scored 951 points over three seasons and barring a set back, will surpass 1,000 points scored this season. Averaging 16.8 points per game, Walker is on pace to cross 1,000 points at home against Buffalo on Jan. 30.

When he crosses the milestone, he will become the 32nd player in Kent State history to do so and the fifth player to cross 1,000 under head coach Rob Sen- $\frac{1}{24}$ . deroff. If Walker can stay on the floor consistently when he returns, he is on pace to approach 1,300 career points, putting him just outside the Kent State Others receiving votes: Drake 72, Northern Kentucky 60, Utah Valley all-time top-10. He will likely pass Kris Brewer, another top scorer under Rob Senderoff. The all-time points record at Kent State is 1,820 by Trevor Huffman.

#### NONCON WRAPUP

The Golden Flashes finished the non-conference portion of the season at 6-7, taking crucial steps towards a run through the Mid-American Conference. The defending league champions took some lumps against top competition, falling on the road to the likes of Xavier, Albany and Loyola Chicago. However, several highlights were had, including the program's fourth Power 5 victory under head coach Rob Senderoff, taking down Oregon State at home, 79-78. Kent State also maintained its claim as the best basketball program in Northeast Ohio, taking down Youngstown State, 111-78, and Cleveland State, 72-62. Individually, multiple student-athletes have broken out into bigger roles. Adonis De La Rosa has emerged as a top low post threat, with nine double digit scoring efforts. Jalen Avery has also established himself as one of the nation's most efficient point guards, leading the country with a 6.22 assist to turnover ratio. Jaylin Walker has led the scoring efforts as expected, averaging a team-best 17.6 points per game.

#### MISTAKE FREE AVERY

Jalen Avery has had an incredible start to his junior season and is making a name for himself as one of the most efficient point guards in the Mid-American Conference. Through 18 games, Avery has committed just 12 turnovers, while racking up 75 assists. His best game distributing came against Mississippi Valley State, in which he recorded a career-high 10 assists to no turnovers. It was the first double digit assist game for Kent State since Derek Jackson recorded 11 on December 6, 2014 against Kennesaw State (W, 58-46). Avery has also only had 11 fouls called against him. Last season, Avery ranked second in the nation among qualified players in fouls called against per 40 minutes at 1.11. This rate was only topped by Saint Mary's starting point guard Emmett Naar at 0.93. The top four players ranked in this statistic made the NCAA Tournament.

#### **COACH SENDEROFF**

Rob Senderoff made his first trip to the NCAA Tournament as a head coach in his sixth season with the program. With this record-breaking season in the books, Senderoff now ranks third all-time at Kent State in total wins at 131. He ranks 11 wins behind Jim Christian and 21 behind Jim McDonald. His winning percentage of .593 is the third best among coaches with at least five years at Kent State, ranking behind Christian (.704) and Gary Waters (.605).

#### GOLDEN FLASHES PICKED SECOND IN MAC EAST

Kent State was tabbed to finish second in the MAC East Division as selected by the league's 12 head coaches and an 18-member MAC News Media Panel. Junior guard Jaylin Walker was voted to the MAC East Preseason All-MAC Team

Rob Senderoff enters his seventh year as the head men's basketball coach at Kent State.

The 44-year-old took over the program in April 2011 after spending seven

previous years on the Golden Flashes' coaching staff. He ended the 2016-17 season with a 122-81 record as head coach, including a trip to the 2017 NCAA Tournament.

In his six seasons as head coach, the 22-year coaching veteran has continued the success of the storied program that he helped build by leading the Golden Flashes to four 20-win campaigns and postseason appearances.

The six year run culminated in a fantastic 2016-17 season in which the Flashes returned to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2008. Kent State claimed the program's first Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship under Rob Senderoff, defeating the top three seeds in the tournament in succession. The Flashes scored the most points in program history at 2,722, beating the previous record by 40 points. Senderoff led his squad to the postseason despite almost a dozen newcomers to the program.

In the 2015-16 season, Senderoff led the Golden Flashes to 19 wins in a campaign that was highlighted by All-District honors for junior Jimmy Hall and MAC Defensive Player of the Year honors for Khaliq Spicer. 2014-15 was Senderoff's most successful as head coach, as he led Kent State to a share of the Mid-American Conference regular season title. The championship season was followed by a postseason run to the CollegeInsider. com Postseason Tournament (CIT) quarterfinals during which Senderoff tied the school record for postseason wins. The Flashes were earned road wins at Middle Tennessee and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi before falling to Northern Arizona.

The inaugural year for Senderoff began with one of the most memorable debuts in the coaching profession. Kent State recorded a monumental 70-60 win over West Virginia and Hall of Fame Head Coach Bob Huggins, snapping the Mountaineers' 36-game nonconference home winning streak. The victory, which was part of ESPN's 24-hour College Basketball Tip-Off Marathon, also marked the first true road win over a BCS school for Kent State in 41 years.

The historic first win was just the beginning, as the Flashes won 21 games, advanced to the semifinals of the MAC Tournament and earned an invitation to play in the CIT in each of his first two seasons. Senderoff earned the first postseason victory of his head coaching career in 2013, as the Golden Flashes defeated Fairfield in a CIT first round matchup.

During his 13 seasons as part of the Kent State program, Senderoff has helped guide the Golden Flashes to 11 postseason appearances (2002-06; 2008-13; 2015; 2017), racking up 250 victories for an average of nearly 22 wins per year in the process. He has been on the sideline for four of the six Mid-American Conference regular season titles in school history. In 2011, Kent State became the first MAC team in 21 years, and just the second in 48 years, to claim second consecutive outright regular season championships. The Golden Flashes capped off the year by advancing to the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) quarterfinals.

Senderoff assumed the de facto role of offensive coordinator during his three seasons as Associate Head Coach (2008-11), taking Kent State's scoring to new heights under his watch. In 2010-11 the Golden Flashes poured in 2,626 points, which trailed only the 2001-02 Elite Eight team for the highest single-season total in school history. In his first year back with the program in 2008-09, Senderoff helped orchestrate an offense that led the MAC in both scoring and field goal percentage. It was the first time since joining the league in 1951-52 that the program has led the conference in scoring.

Long known for his ability to develop post players, Senderoff transformed the play of 2011 MAC Player of the Year Justin Greene. Under his tutelage, Greene went from a 2.2 points per game scorer as a freshman to the nation's most improved player in 2009-10, followed by an Honorable Mention All-American selection in 2010-11. Greene capped off his career in 2012 and will go down as one of the top players to ever put on a Kent State uniform, ranking fourth in career scoring, second in rebounding and second in blocked shots.

A proven national recruiter, his track record as a talented young assistant did not go unnoticed. Current ESPN.com Insider Jeff Goodman analyst recognized him as the top assistant coach in the MAC in 2010, the same year that The Hoop Scoop rated him as one of the top 50 Mid-Major Assistants in the country. Coming in at No. 4 on the list, he was the only MAC assistant coach ranked in the top 25.

During Senderoff's first stint on staff from 2002-06, the Golden Flashes went 89-40 (.690) and won three MAC East Division titles. After three straight NIT appearances, he helped KSU advance to the NCAA Tournament in 2005-06 as the team won both the MAC regular season and tournament titles with a 25-9 overall record. Senderoff spent the 2006-07 season at Indiana where he worked with All-Big Ten and preseason All-American D.J. White. While a member of the Hoosier's staff, IU went 21-11 and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He was also part of a staff that recruited The Hoop Scoop's No. 1 recruiting class in the country in 2007.

With the Golden Flashes he had a critical role in the progression of 2004 First Team and MAC Defensive Player of the Year, John Edwards, who played in the NBA with the Atlanta Hawks and Indiana Pacers. Additionally at Kent State, Senderoff also coached All-MAC performer Antonio Gates who went on to become an All-Pro tight end for the San Diego Chargers.

A native of Spring Valley, N.Y., Senderoff began his coaching career as a student assistant at the University at Albany under legendary coach Richard "Doc" Sauers before moving on to the MAC as a graduate assistant at Miami from 1995-97 where he was part of a staff that helped develop NBA players Wally Szczerbiak and Ira Newble. Returning to the East Coast, he spent time at Fordham (1997-99), Yale (1999-2001) and Towson (2001-02) prior to joining the Golden Flashes staff.
