FLASHES AT A GLANCE

- » Kent State is opening Mid-American Conference play at home this weekend against Western Michigan.
- » The game of Friday will mark the 82nd all-time between the two schools, with KSU holding a 49-32 edge.
- » Kent State defeated the Broncos, 9-3, in the second game of its MAC Tournament Championship run last season. KSU had a 4-3 lead after the sixth and blew the game open scoring five runs in the seventh.
- » Kent State is hitting .294 as a team which is fifth in the Mid-American Conference.
- » Holly Speers leads the country with a .579 batting average and is second in on-base percentage (.667).
- » The Flashes are 9-1 when scoring six or more runs.
- » Kent State's longest winning streak of the year was six games from Feb. 16-23. Kent State outscored its opponents 45-13 during that stretch.
- » The Golden Flashes scored 10 or more runs in three straight games for the first time since 2011.
- » KSU pitching has not allowed a run in the seventh inning, while outscoring its opposition 17-0.
- » The Flashes are 11-3 when scoring first and are 1-1 in extra inning games this season.
- » The Flashes have won two games in walk off fashion against Yale and Oakland.
- » The Golden Flashes played a three game series last week against Penn State and won one game.
- » Senior Holly Speers hit .750 (6-for-8) with five walks, two home runs and three RBIs against Penn State.
- » Junior **Bailey Brownfield** had a huge run producing weekend at the plate driving in seven runs. She connected on two runs scoring doubles and a triple, the first of her career.
- » Speers began the season on a 14-game hitting streak and has tallied a hit in 18 of 20 games played.
- » She is second in school history with 38 career home runs and is tied for seventh in MAC history. Speer hit her 38th home run last weekend against Penn State in a two-homer game.
- » Sophomore **Maria Cegledy** hit two triples in the Flashes win over Lehigh. It is the first time the feat was accomplished since Kim Kirkpatrick hit two triples against Toledo in 2014.
- » Sophomore pitcher **Madi Huck** has reocorded three complete game shutouts this season. She began the season having not allowing an earned run in over 40 innings dating back to last season.
- » The Flashes return All-MAC First Team member **Bailey Brownfield** and All-MAC Second Teamer **Emily Dobbin.** She was also named to the All-MAC Tournament team along with **Holly Speers.**
- » Kent State was picked to win the MAC East Division and MAC Tournament in the preseason coaches poll.
- » The Golden Flashes have won either the MAC regular season or tournament championship in each of the last three seasons.

Series History

Kent State leads the all-time series against Western Michigan, 49-32. The teams will face-off for the 82nd time on Saturday. The Golden Flashes won last year's lone game against Western Michigan in the MAC Tournament, 9-3. The last time the Flashes and Broncos met in a regular season series was 2015 under a different scheduling format, with KSU winning both games in Kent, 3-0 and 2-0. Current KSU pitching coach Emma Johnson threw a three-hit shutout against WMU in the 3-0 win. Kent State has won nine of the last 10 games.

KENT STATE'S CLUTCH HITTING

The Golden Flashes have won three games this season when trailing or tied entering the seventh inning. In the season's first weekend in South Carolina, senior **Hunter Brancifort** hit a grand slam home run in the bottom of the seventh inning when Kent State was down to it's last out to tie the game at seven and force extra innings. The Flashes scored the games winning run in the ninth on a **Bailey Brownfield** double. Against Lehigh on March 2nd with the game tied at six in the seventh, Allie Luther doubled to centerfield to score the go-ahead run. Later that day against Yale, Holly Speers depositied a walk off double to left center as KSU won both of it's games that day in the seventh. Brownfield hit her second walk off of the season against Oakland on March 1th as part of a 7-6 KSU victory.

HIT THE BALL HOLLY

Senior **Holly Speers** leads the Golden Flashes in every major offensive statistical category with a .579 avg, 33 hits, 7 home runs, 6 doubles, 27 RBIs and 17 walks and leads the country in batting average. She has blasted 38 career home runs which is second in Kent State history. She is also tied for seventh in Mid-American Conference history in home runs. This season she won three consecutive MAC East Player of the Week awards in KSU's first three weeks of action. She ranks second in the nation in on base percentage (.667) and 3rd in slugging percentage (1.053). Speers began the season on a 14-game hitting streak and has recorded a hit in 16 of the 17 games she's played. The Surrey, British Columbia native is a member of Team Canada and spent last summer traveling the globe players against some of the best competition in the world.

HUCK'S HOT START

Sophomore pitcher Madi Huck had one of the best starts to a season that Kent State has had in recent memory not allowing an earned run for 27.2 innings. Dating back to last season she did not allow an earned run for 42.2 innings of work. During her hot start to the season she shutout Coastal Carolina, UConn and Delaware and even picked up a save against Nicholls. Huck was instrumental in Kent State's MAC Tournament title run last year, throwing seven shutout frames in the first championship game against Ohio to force a second game and an eventual Golden Flashes championship.

EMILY DOBBIN MAKES THE CATCH!

All-MAC Second Team member Emily Dobbin made one of the most important catches in Kent State softball history in the MAC Championship last season. Against Ohio in the MAC Cham, pionship he robbed a home run leaping to make the catch over the left field fence. The play was ranked the #2 on ESPNw's Top 10 for the week. Dobbin who is one of the most versatile players on the team, is second on the team in batting average hitting .327 with five doubles and six RBIs. She had monster weekend at the Racer Classic hitting 8-for-12 with a double, four RBIs and four runs scored. The Vancouver, Washington native has helped the Kent State pitching staff in two of the last three seasons due to injuries on the staff. This year she has made three appearances and recorded her first win of the year against Lafayette, her first win since 2016. She struck out the side in her first start of the season against Robert Morris.

UNDER OAKLEY'S WATCH

Third year head coach Eric Oakley has enjoyed one of the most successful stretches in Kent State softball history leading the Flashes to a MAC regular season and tournament championship. In his first season in 2016, Oakley was named the MAC Coach of the Year guiding the Flashes to a MAC Regular Season with a 37-22 record, the fourth most wins in program history. In his second season, Kent State won the MAC Tournament Championship for the third time in program history and elimined Oregon State in the NCAA Tournament. Oakley has been with the program since 2015 when he was named pitching coach and coached one of the most dominant staff's in the nation that finished with the third lowest ERA in the nation (1.55). In his head coaching tenure he has beaten five Power 5 opponents and eight during his three total years at Kent State. make the NCAA Tournament last season.

MARIA MAKES HER MARK

Sophomore outfielder Maria Cegledy has had a coming out party at the plate this season. Last season she served primarily as a defensive only player in centerfield and proved herself as one of the best fielding outfielders in the conference. After not recording a hit in only 16 at bats last year, Cegledy has a .268 average in 41 at bats this year. The Pataskala, Ohio native recorded two triples in the same game against Lehigh on March 2. Its the first time a KSU player had two triples in one game since Kim Kirkpatrick against Toledo in 2014.

ALLIE LUTHER EMERGES AT FIRST BASE

Senior first baseman Allie Luther has clubbed three home runs this season, more than all her prior seasons combined. She had the best game of the season against UConn on February 17th in a 10-0 Kent State win. Luther was 3-for-4 iwth a home run, four RBIs and two runs scored. The Pickerington, Ohio native smashed the first home run of her career last year against Evansville in a mid-week sweep of the Purple Aces. Luther is batting .367 this season and is second on the team in home runs (3) and RBIs (9).

FRESHMEN MAKING AN IMPACT

This season's seven member freshman class has made an immediate impact on the squad. **Kennadie Goth** is hitting .489 in 45 at bats with two doubles, two triples and 10 runs scored. She began her career on a five game hitting streak and in the first game of her career, went 3-for-3 with a double against Nicholls. The freshman slapper provides the Golden Flashes with a speed threat at the top of the lineup. **Kaitlyn Miller** is hitting .273 and has played the majority of games at second base. She is one of the Flashes' best bat handlers and can bunt for a base hit when called upon. Catcher **Carlee Selle** has started 16 games and smashed a homer.

A CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON

The Golden Flashes are coming off a 2017 Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship, which is the third in program history. The Flashes won in dramatic fashion, coming out of the loser's bracket by winning three games on Championship Saturday for just the third time in the tournament's 26 year history. Kent State defeated Northern Illinois 9-3 and Ohio twice in the championship round 1-0 in eight innings and 3-0. Ronnie Ladines was named Tournament MVP putting up a monster tournament both at the plate and in the circle. She won four games with a 1.06 ERA and 34 strikeouts and batted .529 (9-for-17) with two doubles, four home runs, seven RBIs and a 1.353 slugging percentage. Kent State had success at the NCAA Tournament in Waco, Texas eliminating Oregon State, 2-1, and just barely falling to eventual Super Regional squad Baylor, 1-0. In each of the Flashes four NCAA Tournament appearances they have at least won one game.

KENT STATE PICKED TO WIN MAC EAST AND TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP

The Golden Flashes were picked to win the MAC East Division and tournament championship in the MAC's preseason coaches poll. Kent State received six first-place votes and three votes to win the MAC Tournament and earn the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The Flashes have been picked to win the MAC East Division in back-to-back seasons. Kent State has won a MAC championship in three straight years with two regular season crowns in 2015 and 2016 and a tournament title a season ago.

FLASHES GREAT EMMA JOHNSON JOINS STAFF

Kent State welcomes back a familiar face to the dugout this season, as Emma Johnson joins Eric Oakley's staff as an assistant coach. Johnson, who had one of the most decorated careers in Kent State history, will work with the Golden Flashes' pitching staff. Johnson ranks in the top 20 in MAC history in wins, strikeouts, innings pitched, complete games, games started and appearances. Johnson have one of the top five ERAs in the country her senior season and went on to play two season for the Pennsylvania Rebellion of the NPF.

DIAMOND SPORTS EXCELLENCE AT KENT STATE

Kent State softball and baseball both have a rich tradition of winning. KSU is the only MAC school since the NCAA began sponsoring a softball championship in 1982, that have sent both diamond sports to both the Women's College World Series and College World Series. Golden Flashes softball made its run to the WCWS in 1990. The Golden Flashes knocked off powers Oregon and Ohio State en-route to the WCWS in Oklahoma City. Kent State baseball went to Omaha in 2012. KSU eliminted #12 Kentucky in a marathon 21-inning win and defeated #10 Oregon in a three game series in Eugene. The Flashes also sent #5 Floirda home at the CWS.

GETTING TO KNOW KENT STATE

Kent State is located in Kent, Ohio, about 50 miles southwest of Cleveland. The school and community are both named after Marvin Kent, who was influential in making the area a hub for the Atlantic and Great Western Railroad. Kent State boasts several notable alumni in the fields of sports and entertainment, including Nick Saban, Julian Edelman, Lou Holtz, James Harrison, Antonio Gates, Drew Carey, Arsenio Hall and Michael Keaton.
