FLASHES AT A GLANCE

» The Golden Flashes travel to Bowling Green for the second to last MAC series of the season.

» **Holly Speers** won both the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Week and Louisville Slugger / NFCA National Player of the Week awards. She batted .778 (7-for-9) with four home runs, 11 RBI, two doubles, two walks and a slugging percentage of 2.333. It is the second time Speers has won both award in her career.

» She was also named to the USA College Softball Player of the Year Top 25 list and is the first player in school history to be on the watch list.

» Speers leads the nation in batting average (.495), on-base percentage (.649), slugging percentage (1.038) and walks per game (1.15). She is also 11th in RBI per game (1.22) and 12th in HR per game (0.34).

» Kent State is hitting .315 as a team which leads the MAC and is 20th in the nation and is averaging 5.76 runs per game with is 29th. The Flashes are 19th in doubles per game at 1.55.

» Kent State swept a three-game series at home last weekend against Buffalo, outscoring the Bulls 33-3.

The Flashes bats hit .518 as a team against Buffalo as nine different players had multiple hits. **Bailey Brownfield** was 7-for-9 with two doubles and six RBI and **Allie Luther** hit two home runs and 4 RBI.

» Madi Huck tossed two complete games with a shutout and held Buffalo's lineup to a .125 batting average. She had an ERA of 1.27 in 11 innings while striking out 16 and walking just two.

» Kent State scored 10 or more runs in three consecutive games this season for the second time. The last time it happened before this season was 2011.

» The Flashes are 18-8 when scoring first and are 2-1 in extra inning games this season.

» KSU has won four games in walk off fashion against Yale, Oakland, Western Michigan, Toledo and Buffalo.

» Junior **Bailey Brownfield** has been on fire. In April, she is hitting .524 (22-for-42) with five doubles, a home run and 16 RBI with an on base percentage of .556.

» Senior **Emily Dobbin** is having the best season of her career and was on a 10-game hitting streak before being snapped in the first game against Toledo. Her nine doubles are the most of her career.

» Sophomore **Maria Cegledy** was clutch in the first MAC series of the year sending the game to extras with a two out RBI single in the seventh and plated the winning run in the sixth inning of the second game against the Broncos. Cegledy is second on the team in conference only batting average hitting .462 (12-for-26) and is third with 11 RBI.

» Freshman **Kennadie Goth** is 38th in the country in batting average (.420).

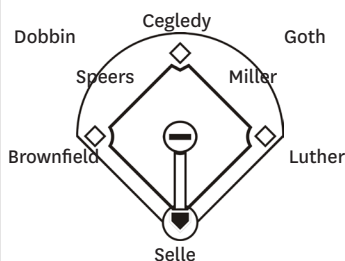
» Kent State was picked to win the MAC East Division and MAC Tournament in the preseason coaches poll.

Series History

Kent State leads the all-time series against Bowling Green, 68-44-1 and will meet for the 114th time on Friday afternoon. Kent State has won the last 13 straight games in the series and 16 of the last 17. Last season Kent State beat Bowling Green on the last weekend of the season to secure a spot in the MAC Tournament.

KENT STATE'S CLUTCH HITTING

The Golden Flashes have won three games this season when trailing or tied entering the seventh inning. In the season's first weekend in South Carolina, senior **Hunter Brancifort** hit a grand slam home run in the bottom of the seventh inning when Kent State was down to it's last out to tie the game at seven and force extra innings. The Flashes scored the games winning run in the ninth on a **Bailey Brownfield** double. Against Lehigh on March 2nd with the game tied at six in the seventh, **Allie Luther** doubled to centerfield to score the go-ahead run. Later that day against Yale, Holly Speers deposited a walk off double to left center as KSU won both of it's games that day in the seventh. Brownfield hit her second walk off of the season against Oakland on March 11th as part of a 7-6 KSU victory. **Maria Cegledy** hit a two out, two strike RBI single up the middle against Western Michigan to tie the game and brought the Flashes all the way back from being down five. In game two of the series she hit the game-winning double to rightfield in the sixth inning. Brownfield did it again vs. Toledo, cranking a walk-off single to left in the 7-6 victory.

HIT THE BALL HOLLY

Senior **Holly Speers** leads the country with a .495 avg, .621 on-base percentage, 1.038 slugging percentage and 1.15 walks per game. She has blasted 45 career home runs which is second in Kent State history and sixth in MAC history. This season she won three consecutive MAC East Player of the Week awards in KSU's first three weeks of action and has four total. She was named a USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 25 Finalist and is the first player in program history to be named to the list. The Surrey, British Columbia native is a member of Team Canada and spent last summer traveling the globe playing against some of the best competition in the world.

HUCK'S HOT START

Sophomore pitcher Madi Huck had one of the best starts to a season that Kent State has had in recent memory not allowing an earned run for 27.2 innings. Dating back to last season she did not allow an earned run for 42.2 innings of work. During her hot start to the season she shutout Coastal Carolina, UConn and Delaware and even picked up a save against Nicholls. She pitched 11 frames against Buffalo and only allowed two earned runs while striking out 16 and walking just two. Huck was instrumental in Kent State's MAC Tournament title run last year, throwing seven shutout frames in the first championship game against Ohio to force a second game and an eventual Golden Flashes championship.

EMILY DOBBIN MAKES THE CATCH!

All-MAC Second Team member Emily Dobbin made one of the most important catches in Kent State softball history in the MAC Championship last season. Against Ohio in the MAC Championship she robbed a home run leaping to make the catch over the left field fence. The play was ranked the #2 on ESPNw's Top 10 for the week. Dobbin is hitting .352 with nine doubles and 16 RBIs. She hit her first home run of the season against Ball State. She had monster weekend at the Racer Classic hitting 8-for-12 with a double, four RBIs and four runs scored. The Vancouver, Washington native has helped the Kent State pitching staff in two of the last three seasons due to injuries on the staff. This year she has made three appearances and recorded her first win of the year against Lafayette, her first win since 2016. She struck out the side in her first start of the season against Robert Morris.

UNDER OAKLEY'S WATCH

Third year head coach Eric Oakley has enjoyed one of the most successful stretches in Kent State softball history leading the Flashes to a MAC regular season and tournament championship. In his first season in 2016, Oakley was named the MAC Coach of the Year guiding the Flashes to a MAC Regular Season with a 37-22 record, the fourth most wins in program history. In his second season, Kent State won the MAC Tournament Championship for the third time in program history and eliminated Oregon State in the NCAA Tournament. Oakley has been with the program since 2015 when he was named pitching coach and coached one of the most dominant staff's in the nation that finished with the third lowest ERA in the nation (1.55). In his head coaching tenure he has beaten five Power 5 opponents and eight during his three total years at Kent State. make the NCAA Tournament last season.

MARIA MAKES HER MARK

Sophomore outfielder Maria Cegledy has had a coming out party at the plate this season. Last season she served primarily as a defensive only player in centerfield and proved herself as one of the best fielding outfielders in the conference. After not recording a hit in only 16 at bats last year, Cegledy has a .324 average in 71 at bats this year. The Pataskala, Ohio native hit two triples in the same game against Lehigh on March 2. Its the first time a KSU player had two triples in one game since Kim Kirkpatrick against Toledo in 2014. She had her biggest weekend in a Kent State jersey, going 5-for-10 vs. Western Michigan. She hit her first career home run against Toledo at home. Cegledy is second on the team in league batting average at .444 and is third with 11 RBIs.

BAILEY BROWNFIELD

Junior third baseman **Bailey Brownfield** has been a force batting in the fourth spot of Kent State's lineup. She is hitting .466 in conference games this season with 20 RBIs. In the month of April the Thornville, Ohio native is hitting .524 (22-for-42) with five doubles and 16 RBIs. She has transitioned effectively to third base after playing left field last season, where she was named to the All-MAC First Team. The Junior had a season-high four RBIs last Saturday against Buffalo and has record a hit in 17 of her last 18 games.

FRESHMEN MAKING AN IMPACT

This season's seven-member freshman class has made an immediate impact on the squad. **Kennadie Goth** is hitting .420 which is 40th in the country. She has provided the Flashes with a great speed threat and also leads the club in steals (9). **Kaitlyn Miller** is hitting .321 and has played the majority of games at second base. She is one of the Flashes' best bat handlers and can bunt for a base hit when called upon. Catcher **Carlee Selle** has established herself as the starting backstop and has belted two homers.

VODAN SHOWS OFF ATHLETICISM AS A DUAL SPORT ATHLETE

Sophomore catcher Vanessa Vodan is a member of the Kent State Track and Field Team as well as playing for the softball team. Vodan was the only player last season to reach base in all three games of Kent State's NCAA Tournament Regional in Waco. In addition to being one of Kent State's quickest slap hitters, Vodan took first place at the Northeast Ohio Quad with a javelin throw of 45.0 meters. Last season she finished 14th at the MAC Championships in javelin, the same week that the KSU softball team won the MAC Tournament title.

A CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON

The Golden Flashes are coming off a 2017 Mid-American Conference Tournament Championship, which is the third in program history. The Flashes won in dramatic fashion, coming out of the loser's bracket by winning three games on Championship Saturday for just the third time in the tournament's 26-year history. Kent State defeated Northern Illinois 9-3 and Ohio twice in the championship round 1-0 in eight innings and 3-0. Ronnie Ladines was named Tournament MVP putting up a monster tournament both at the plate and in the circle. She won four games with a 1.06 ERA and 34 strikeouts and batted .529 (9-for-17) with two doubles, four home runs, seven RBIs and a 1.353 slugging percentage. Kent State had success at the NCAA Tournament in Waco, Texas eliminating Oregon State, 2-1, and just barely falling to eventual Super Regional squad Baylor, 1-0. In each of the Flashes four NCAA Tournament appearances they have at least won one game.

KENT STATE PICKED TO WIN MAC EAST AND TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP

The Golden Flashes were picked to win the MAC East Division and tournament championship in the MAC's preseason coaches' poll. Kent State received six first-place votes and three votes to win the MAC Tournament and earn the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The Flashes have been picked to win the MAC East Division in back-to-back seasons. Kent State has won a MAC championship in three straight years with two regular season crowns in 2015 and 2016 and a tournament title a season ago.

FLASHES GREAT EMMA JOHNSON JOINS STAFF

Kent State welcomes back a familiar face to the dugout this season, as Emma Johnson joins Eric Oakley's staff as an assistant coach. Johnson, who had one of the most decorated careers in Kent State history, will work with the Golden Flashes' pitching staff. Johnson ranks in the top 20 in MAC history in wins, strikeouts, innings pitched, complete games, games started and appearances. Johnson have one of the top five ERAs in the country her senior season and went on to play two season for the Pennsylvania Rebellion of the NPF.

DIAMOND SPORTS EXCELLENCE AT KENT STATE

Kent State softball and baseball both have a rich tradition of winning. KSU is the only MAC school since the NCAA began sponsoring a softball championship in 1982, that have sent both diamond sports to both the Women's College World Series and College World Series. Golden Flashes softball made its run to the WCWS in 1990. The Golden Flashes knocked off powers Oregon and Ohio State en-route to the WCWS in Oklahoma City. Kent State baseball went to Omaha in 2012. KSU eliminted #12 Kentucky in a marathon 21-inning win and defeated #10 Oregon in a three game series in Eugene. The Flashes also sent #5 Floirda home at the CWS.
