THE GAME

Kent State will take on Ohio inside of the Convocation Center in Athens in a matchup between two of the top Mid-American Conference women's basketball teams on Wednesday, January 16 with tip scheduled for 7 p.m.

One of only two remaining unbeaten teams in conference play, the Golden Flashes (10-4) have won seven in a row and seek the first 4-0 start to league play since 2010-11.

Kent State used an outstanding defensive effort to pull out a 58-47 victory over Toledo on Saturday for the third win inside of Savage Arena in the past 12 months. The Flashes held the Rockets to a season-low 47 points on 18-for-58 (31.0 percent) from the field, as **Lindsey Thall** matched her career-high blocked four shots. A 13-0 run to start the fourth quarter allowed Kent State to pull away. **Megan Carter** led all scorers with 22 points, including 13 in the final quarter. **Asiah Dingle** added 13 points.

Megan Carter (15.0 ppg) has scored at least 12 points in all but three games this season and has a team-high 36 assists. **Asiah Dingle** (13.8 ppg) has provided a scoring threat at the point guard position. **Lindsey Thall** (10.1 ppg, 5.0 rpg) leads Kent State with 26 three-pointers to go with a MAC-best 24 blocks. **Merissa Barber-Smith** is the team's top rebounder at 6.7 per game and has registered 18 blocked shots. **Ali Poole** (9.6 ppg) and **Alexa Golden** (6.4 ppg) have both made better than 40-percent of shots from beyond the three-point line.

One of three remaining undefeated teams in the country prior to an 88-70 setback to Central Michigan last Wednesday, Ohio entered last week ranked No. 3 in both the espnW Mid-Major Poll. The Bobcats rank fifth in the country in scoring (83.6 ppg), 10th in three-pointers per game (10.1), 15th in three-point field goal percentage (.380), 15th in scoring margin (+18.6) and 20th in field goal percentage (.465).

CeCe Hooks (16.6 ppg) is one of three players in the country averaging at least 4.0 rpg, 4.0 apg and 4.0 spg. Gabby Burris (15.0 ppg) is the team's top rebounder at 5.6 rpg. Amani Burke (12.9 ppg) and Dominique Doseck (12.7 ppg) both average more than 2.0 three-pointers per game and are shooting better than 40-percent from long distance. Erica Johnson (12.8 ppg) is one of the top freshmen in the conference and averages a team-best 4.5 apg off the bench.

THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, The Years of Youth, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper. the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

STARKEY EARNS CAREER VICTORY #200

- Third-year head coach **Todd Starkey** earned career win #200 on Tuesday, Nov. 20 as Kent State took care of Youngstown State, 62-34.
- Named the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year in 2017, Starkey is already third on the program's career wins list with 42. He passed Richard Keast (1986-89) on Nov. 18.
- Starkey spent nine seasons (2005-14) as the head coach at Division II Lenoir-Rhyne, posting a 165-95 record.

CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the first two seasons of the **Todd Starkey** era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year **Larissa Lurken** made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State lead the nation in free throws per game (16.38), ranks sixth in free throws made (1,278), and ranks 12th in free throw attempts (1,711) and 30th in free throw percentage (.747).

DINGLE DAZZLES IN MAC DEBUT

- Freshman point guard **Asiah Dingle** had the best performance of her collegiate career in the Golden Flashes' Mid-American Conference opener vs. Eastern Michigan on January 5.
- Dingle set a new career-high in nearly every statistical with 29 points, 9 rebounds, 5 steals and 3 blocks.
- Her 29 points are the most by a Kent State freshman since Ellie Shields poured in 31 vs. Toledo on January 30, 2008.
- Dingle nearly matched EMU with 13 points in the final quarter to lead the Golden Flashes to victory.

FOURTH QUARTER FLASHES

- Kent State started the MAC season by winning back-to-back games when trailing at the start of the fourth quarter for the first time in program history.
- On Saturday, the Golden Flashes scored the first 13 points of the final period in a victory at Toledo.
- Through three conference games, Kent State has outscored its opponents by 29 points over the final 10 minutes of the game.
- The Flashes have scored at least 23 points in the final quarter of each game, and their 75 points are 18 more than in any other quarter.
- A different Kent State player has hit double-digits in the fourth quarter of each MAC contest. **Asiah Dingle** scored 13 vs. EMU, **Ali Poole** poured in 10 vs. NIU and **Megan Carter** had 13 at Toledo.

DEFENSE TRAVELS

- Kent State's defense has smothered its opponents during the team's four-game road winning streak.
- The Golden Flashes are allowing only 49.2 points per game and holding opponents to 33.2-percent from the floor.
- Three teams have failed to score 50 points, with NJIT and Toledo posting their lowest-scoring game of the season.
- The defense has forced 22.3 turnovers per game during this four-game stretch.

THIRD SEASON MONTREAT COLLEGE, '93

Montreat College, Bachelor's Degree in Outdoor Education Todd Starkey enters his third season as the head women's basketball coach at Kent State after being hired as the program's sixth head coach in April 2016.

Starkey was named 2017 Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 20-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since

1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Last season, Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

Starkey got his coaching career started at his alma mater, Montreat College in North Carolina. He was an assistant men's basketball coach for five seasons (1998-03), helping the team to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 2000.

Starkey grew up in nearby Canfield, Ohio, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in outdoor education from Montreat College. His playing career began in basketball and tennis at Mars Hill College.

In her first season on staff, Recchia helped guide Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball, which concluded with the first Mid-American Conference East Division title since 2004-05 and a WNIT postseason berth. The Golden Flashes, who compiled a 19-13 overall record, had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and fifth most-improved record in the country. MAC Player of the Year Larissa Lurken enjoyed a breakout senior season under Recchia's tutelage, setting program records for points (752) and scoring average (23.5 ppg) while making an NCAA Division I record 280 free throws. She was the only Division I player in the nation that averaged 20 points, six rebounds, two assists, two blocked shots, two three-pointers and one

Before arriving in Kent, Recchia had spent five of the previous six seasons as an assistant coach at Radford. Upon returning in 2013, she served as the program's recruiting coordinator and was responsible for wing player development,

Toles helped guide Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during the 2016-17 season, which concluded with the first Mid-American Conference East Division title since 2004-05 and a WNIT postseason berth. The Golden Flashes, who compiled a 19-13 overall record, had the nation's largest RPI improvement jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and fifth most-improved record in the country.

For her efforts, Toles was named to the 2017 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Thirty Under 30 list, which recognizes 30 up-and-coming coaches age 30 and under at all levels of women's basketball.

Prior to Kent State, Toles spent two seasons as a graduate assistant at Florida State. The Seminoles posted a 57-13 record (.814) with an Elite Eight and a Sweet 16 appearance during those years.

Toles played the final two years of her collegiate career at Florida State, serving as a co-captain while leading the team to the 2013 NCAA Tournament during her senior season. Before transferring to Florida State, she was a two-year starting point guard at Auburn, where she earned SEC All-Freshman Team honors in 2010. Toles ranked in the top-15 nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio during her freshman and senior seasons.

A fixture of Kent State basketball since the 2005-06 season, former Golden Flash Mike McKee ('10) enters his second season as an assistant coach with the women's basketball program in 2018-19. He heads the Golden Flashes' player development efforts and primarily works with post players.

After serving as the Director of Basketball Operations for the men's program for six years, McKee was hired by head coach Todd Starkey in April 2017. During his first year on the women's side, he was instrumental in the continued development of All-MAC First Team forward Jordan Korinek. Already a 1,000-point scorer through three seasons, Korinek finished second in the Mid-American Conference at 19.8 points per game and her 634 points are the thirdmost scored by a Flash in program history

A four-year letterwinner and member of three MAC championship teams (2006, 2008, 2010) as a student-athlete, He spent the 2010-11 season as a graduate assistant before moving into the operations role. During that time, the Golden Flashes boasted six conference championship teams and participated in the postseason nine times.

A celebrated three-point marksman, McKee wrapped up his time on the court in style by leading the Golden Flashes to their second MAC Championship in three seasons in 2010. Kent State compiled a 24-10 overall record and advanced to the second round of the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). Also a member of the 2008 Kent State team that went 28-7 and earned a No. 9 seed in the NCAA Tournament, McKee drained 143 career three-pointers during his time with the Blue and Gold, ending his career tied for ninth all-time in school history. Additionally, he ranked eighth at Kent State with 128 games played and ninth with 92 wins to his credit.

The Plum, Pa. product was a member of the Chi Alpha Sigma National College Athlete Honor Society and earned Academic All-MAC honorable mention accolades in 2009. McKee is a two-time graduate of Kent State University, earning his undergraduate degree in education in December of 2009 and his master's in sports and recreation management in May of 2011.
