Kent State will play of the first of two road games this week when it takes on Ball State on Wednesday, Jan. 23 at 7 p.m. inside of Worthen Arena. The Golden Flashes have lost two in a row after a 3-0 start to Mid-American Conference play and will look to avoid their first three-game skid of the season.

The Golden Flashes fell in a defensive battle, 48-44, at Ball State on Wednesday. Kent State forced 23 turnovers and held the Cardinals to 16-of-49 shooting. **Alexa Golden** had six steals and **Asiah Dingle** had five, as both players matched their career-high. Golden added two blocks and a team-high four assists. The Flashes had 19 offensive rebounds and held a 46-44 advantage on the boards overall. **Lindsey Thall** and **Merissa Barber-Smith** led the rebounding effort with eight and seven boards, respectively. **Megan Carter** led the offense with 12 points and Dingle scored 11.

**Megan Carter** (15.6 ppg) has scored at least 13 points in all but three games this season and is second on the team in assists (41). **Asiah Dingle** (13.6 ppg) has provided a scoring threat at the point guard position. **Lindsey Thall** (9.3 ppg, 5.3 rpg) leads Kent State with 28 three-pointers to go with a MAC-best 25 blocks. **Merissa Barber-Smith** is the team's top rebounder at 6.9 per game and has registered 19 blocked shots. **Alexa Golden** (7.2 ppg) leads the team in assists (2.7 apg), steals (2.5 spg) and three-point field goal percentage (.394).

Miami bounced back from a 1-2 league start with back-to-back three-point wins last week. The RedHawks are one of the best defensive teams in the conference and have the nation's top three-point field goal defense (.213). Miami allows the fewest points in the MAC (58.9 ppg).

Offensively, Miami average 66.6 ppg, which ranks eighth in the conference. Lauren Dickerson leads the way with 14.4 ppg and is the MAC leader at 5.9 apg. Dickerson adds 5.4 rpg and 2.3 spg. Savannah Kluesner (13.8 ppg) leads Miami at 7.6 rpg and is averaging 18.8 ppg and 10.4 rpg during league play. Kendall McCoy adds 12.7 ppg and 5.5 rpg while making better than 45-percent of her attempts from beyond the arc.

## THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, The Years of Youth, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

## STARKEY EARNS CAREER VICTORY #200

- Third-year head coach **Todd Starkey** earned career win #200 on Tuesday, Nov. 20 as Kent State took care of Youngstown State, 62-34.
- Named the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year in 2017, Starkey is already third on the program's career wins list with 42. He passed Richard Keast (1986-89) on Nov. 18.
- Starkey spent nine seasons (2005-14) as the head coach at Division II Lenoir-Rhyne, posting a 165-95 record.

## CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the first two seasons of the **Todd Starkey** era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year **Larissa Lurken** made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State lead the nation in free throws per game (16.33), ranks seventh in free throws made (1,323), and ranks 11th in free throw attempts (1,771) and 30th in free throw percentage (.747).

## DINGLE DAZZLES IN MAC DEBUT

- Freshman point guard **Asiah Dingle** had the best performance of her collegiate career in the Golden Flashes' Mid-American Conference opener vs. Eastern Michigan on January 5.
- Dingle set a new career-high in nearly every statistical with 29 points, 9 rebounds, 5 steals and 3 blocks.
- Her 29 points are the most by a Kent State freshman since **Elie Shields** poured in 31 vs. Toledo on January 30, 2008.
- Dingle nearly matched EMU with 13 points in the final quarter to lead the Golden Flashes to victory.

## DEFENSE TRAVELS

- Kent State's defense has been sensational in the team's last six road games.
- The Golden Flashes are allowing only 54.7 points per game and holding opponents to 35.3-percent from the floor.

Todd Starkey enters his third season as the head women's basketball coach at Kent State after being hired as the program's sixth head coach in April 2016.

Starkey was named 2017 Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 20-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since

1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Last season, Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

Starkey got his coaching career started at his alma mater, Montreat College in North Carolina. He was an assistant men's basketball coach for five seasons (1998-03), helping the team to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 2000.

Starkey grew up in nearby Canfield, Ohio, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in outdoor education from Montreat College. His playing career began in basketball and tennis at Mars Hill College.

Fran Recchia was promoted to associate head coach in July 2018. Entering her third season on the women's basketball staff, she mentors the team's wings.

In her first season on staff, Recchia helped guide Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball, which concluded with the first Mid-American Conference East Division title since 2004-05 and a WNIT postseason berth. The Golden Flashes, who compiled a 19-13 overall record, had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and fifth most-improved record in the country. MAC Player of the Year Larissa Lurken enjoyed a breakout senior season under Recchia's tutelage, setting program records for points (752) and scoring average (23.5 ppg) while making an NCAA Division I record 280 free throws. She was the only Division I player in the nation that averaged 20 points, six rebounds, two assists, two blocked shots, two three-pointers and one steal per game.

Before arriving in Kent, Recchia had spent five of the previous six seasons as an assistant coach at Radford. Upon returning in 2013, she served as the program's recruiting coordinator and was responsible for wing player development, scouting, academics and compliance. Overall, she helped guide the Highlanders to one WNIT appearance and two Big South runner-up finishes while mentoring five All-Big South selections.

Recchia served as an assistant coach at Tusculum College in Greeneville, Tennessee during the 2012-13 season and was head coach at William Byrd High School in Vinton, Virginia from 2007-10.

Prior to that, she spent five years at Virginia Tech, playing guard from 2001-05 and then serving as a graduate assistant during the 2005-06 season. She helped the Hokies to four 20-win seasons and five postseason appearances, including four consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament.

A 2004 graduate with a bachelor's degree in physical education from Virginia Tech, Recchia earned a master's degree in education in 2006.

Already a 1,000-point scorer through three seasons, Korinek finished second in the Mid-American Conference at 19.8 points per game and her 634 points are the third-most scored by a Flash in program history.

Additionally, he ranked eighth at Kent State with 128 games played and ninth with 92 wins to his credit.
