THE GAME

Kent State will try to extend its season-best four-game winning streak on Saturday, Jan. 5 as Mid-American Conference play begins against Eastern Michigan. Tip-off is scheduled for 5 p.m.

The Golden Flashes have won four straight games to conclude the best non-conference season since going 9-3 in 2010-11. Kent State put an exclamation mark on 2018 with a dominant wire-to-wire 92-38 victory over Clarion on New Year's Eve. The Golden Flashes scored the game's first 19 points en route to season-best performances for points (92), field goals (33), field goal percentage (.524), 3-point field goals (11), 3-point field goal percentage (.458), assists (19) and steals (17). Eight different Flashes scored at least eight points. **Megan Carter** led all scorers with 15. **Hannah Young** (13) and **Merissa Barber-Smith** (11) both had career-high scoring performances.

Megan Carter (15.6 ppg) has scored at least 14 points in all but two games this season and is second on the team in rebounding (4.8 rpg) and assists (2.6 apg). **Asiah Dingle** (12.0 ppg) has provided a scoring threat at the point guard position. **Lindsey Thall** (9.6 ppg, 4.6 rpg) leads Kent State with 18 three-pointers to go with 14 blocks. **Merissa Barber-Smith** is the team's top rebounder at 7.2 per game and has registered a team-high 17 blocked shots. **Alexa Golden** (6.3 ppg) has a team-high 22 steals.

Eastern Michigan is coming off of a 53-39 victory over Division II Northwood on Dec. 30. The Eagles had lost their two previous games, to UNC Greensboro and Butler, at the West Palm Beach Invitational.

A stingy defense has allowed EMU to post its best non-conference record under third-year head coach Fred Castro. The Eagles are third in the MAC in scoring defense (57.3 ppg) and rank in the top-50 nationally in both field goal percentage defense (.354) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (.267). Offensively, the Eagles have struggled, ranking in the bottom two of the league in scoring (57.3 ppg), field goal percentage (.360), 3-point field goal percentage defense (.252) and free throw percentage (.596).

The guard trio of Corrione Cardwell (14.0 ppg), Danielle Minott (13.5 ppg) and Courtnie Lewis (11.6 ppg) are the team's top scorers. Point guard Jenna Annecchiarico (5.2 ppg, 4.2 apg) ranks third in the nation with a 3.83 assist-to-turnover ratio. Annecchiarico has committed just 12 turnovers in 391 minutes of action this season. Forward Lorraine Enabulele (5.8 ppg) grabs a team-best 6.3 rebounds per game.

THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, The Years of Youth, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

STARKEY EARNS CAREER VICTORY #200

- Third-year head coach **Todd Starkey** earned career win #200 on Tuesday, Nov. 20 as Kent State took care of Youngstown State, 62-34.
- Named the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year in 2017, Starkey is already third on the program's career wins list with 39. He passed Richard Keast (1986-89) on Nov. 18.
- Starkey spent nine seasons (2005-14) as the head coach at Division II Lenoir-Rhyne, posting a 165-95 record.

KENT STATE - EASTERN MICHIGAN NOTES

- Kent State is 38-27 all-time vs. Eastern Michigan.
- The Golden Flashes are 4-0 under third-year head coach Todd Starkey after losing 11 consecutive contests to the Eagles.
- The Flashes are 22-7 all-time record vs. the Eagles in Kent, EMU last won at the M.A.C. Center on Feb. 4, 2015 (70-53).
- Kent State's 19-game winning streak from 1992-03 is the longest for either team.
- The Flashes have won both games that have required overtime. Most recently, KSU came out on top in double-overtime, 96-94, in the 2000 MAC Tournament quarterfinals.
- Last season, Kent State pulled away with a seven-point victory after the game was tied through three periods in both matchups.

FLASH BACK: (JAN. 10, 2018) **KENT STATE 76, EASTERN MICHIGAN 69**

- Kent State put together its highest-scoring half of the season to erase a 34-27 halftime deficit and beat Eastern Michigan for the second time in 12 days.
- The Golden Flashes shot 54.2-percent from the field (13-for-24) and 95.2-percent at the free throw line (21-for-22) to outscore the Eagles 49-35 over the final 20 minutes.
- Naddiyah Cross and Jordan Korinek combined for 20 of KSU's' 27 points in the final period, which started with a 49-49 tie. The senior duo went 13-for-14 at the foul line over the final 6:28 to close it out.
- Cross shot an efficient 8-for-13 from the floor and tallied a career-high 24 points.
- Korinek scored 23 points to go with a seasonhigh 13 rebounds and career-high five assists.
- McKenna Stephens added 17 points.
- Courtnie Lewis led EMU with 19 points.

CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the first two seasons of the **Todd Starkey** era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year **Larissa Lurken** made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State lead the nation in free throws per game (16.45), rank sixth in free throws made (1,234), 14th in free throw attempts (1,651) and 31st in free throw percentage (.747).

THIRD SEASON MONTREAT COLLEGE. '93

Montreat College, Bachelor's Degree in Outdoor Education Todd Starkey enters his third season as the head women's basketball coach at Kent State after being hired as the program's sixth head coach in April 2016.

Starkey was named 2017 Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 20-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since

1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Last season, Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

Starkey got his coaching career started at his alma mater, Montreat College in North Carolina. He was an assistant men's basketball coach for five seasons (1998-03), helping the team to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 2000.

Starkey grew up in nearby Canfield, Ohio, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in outdoor education from Montreat College. His playing career began in basketball and tennis at Mars Hill College.

She was the only Division I player in the nation that averaged 20 points, six rebounds, two assists, two blocked shots, two three-pointers and one steal per game.

Before arriving in Kent, Recchia had spent five of the previous six seasons as an assistant coach at Radford. Upon returning in 2013, she served as the program's recruiting coordinator and was responsible for wing player development, scouting, academics and compliance. Overall, she helped guide the Highlanders to one WNIT appearance and two Big South runner-up finishes while mentoring five All-Big South selections.

Recchia served as an assistant coach at Tusculum College in Greeneville, Tennessee during the 2012-13 season and was head coach at William Byrd High School in Vinton, Virginia from 2007-10.

Prior to that, she spent five years at Virginia Tech, playing guard from 2001-05 and then serving as a graduate assistant during the 2005-06 season. She helped the Hokies to four 20-win seasons and five postseason appearances, including four consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament.

A 2004 graduate with a bachelor's degree in physical education from Virginia Tech, Recchia earned a master's degree in education in 2006.

THIRD SEASON FLORIDA STATE, 13

Morgan Toles enters her third season as an assistant coach on the women's basketball staff and first as recruiting coordinator. In addition to mentoring the team's point guards in addition to spearheading community service and marketing efforts.

Toles helped guide Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during the 2016-17 season, which concluded with the first Mid-American Conference East Division title since 2004-05 and a WNIT postseason berth. The Golden Flashes, who compiled a 19-13 overall record, had the nation's largest RPI improvement jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and fifth most-improved record in the country.

For her efforts, Toles was named to the 2017 Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Thirty Under 30 list, which recognizes 30 up-and-coming coaches age 30 and under at all levels of women's basketball.

Prior to Kent State, Toles spent two seasons as a graduate assistant at Florida State. The Seminoles posted a 57-13 record (.814) with an Elite Eight and a Sweet 16 appearance during those years.

Toles played the final two years of her collegiate career at Florida State, serving as a co-captain while leading the team to the 2013 NCAA Tournament during her senior season. Before transferring to Florida State, she was a two-year starting point guard at Auburn, where she earned SEC All-Freshman Team honors in 2010. Toles ranked in the top-15 nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio during her freshman and senior seasons.

A 2013 graduate with a bachelor's degree in social science from Florida State, Toles earned a master's degree in sport management in 2016.

A fixture of Kent State basketball since the 2005-06 season, former Golden Flash Mike McKee ('10) enters his second season as an assistant coach with the women's basketball program in 2018-19. He heads the Golden Flashes' player development efforts and primarily works with post players.

After serving as the Director of Basketball Operations for the men's program for six years, McKee was hired by head coach Todd Starkey in April 2017. During his first year on the women's side, he was instrumental in the continued development of All-MAC First Team forward Jordan Korinek. Already a 1,000-point scorer through three seasons, Korinek finished second in the Mid-American Conference at 19.8 points per game and her 634 points are the thirdmost scored by a Flash in program history

A four-year letterwinner and member of three MAC championship teams (2006, 2008, 2010) as a student-athlete, He spent the 2010-11 season as a graduate assistant before moving into the operations role. During that time, the Golden Flashes boasted six conference championship teams and participated in the postseason nine times.

A celebrated three-point marksman, McKee wrapped up his time on the court in style by leading the Golden Flashes to their second MAC Championship in three seasons in 2010. Kent State compiled a 24-10 overall record and advanced to the second round of the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). Also a member of the 2008 Kent State team that went 28-7 and earned a No. 9 seed in the NCAA Tournament, McKee drained 143 career three-pointers during his time with the Blue and Gold, ending his career tied for ninth all-time in school history. Additionally, he ranked eighth at Kent State with 128 games played and ninth with 92 wins to his credit.

The Plum, Pa. product was a member of the Chi Alpha Sigma National College Athlete Honor Society and earned Academic All-MAC honorable mention accolades in 2009. McKee is a two-time graduate of Kent State University, earning his undergraduate degree in education in December of 2009 and his master's in sports and recreation management in May of 2011.
