QUICK FLASHES

- Kent State enters the weekend 18th in the nation with an average of 17.64 digs per set.
- Sophomore **Erin Gardner**, who opened the season with back-to-back Mid-American Conference East Division Defensive Player of the Week nods, ranks 14th in the country in total digs (578) and 16th in digs per set (5.35).
- Gardner's career-high 37 digs against Idaho State on Sept. 7 ranks as the fifth-most in a four-setter in program history.
- The Avon, Ohio native became the 12th member of Kent State's 1,000-dig club during a 3-0 victory over Ball State on October 19 at the M.A.C. Center. Gardner needed only 189 sets to achieve the milestone, which is 20 fewer than any other player in program history.
- Kent State leads the conference in hitting percentage (.229) and ranks second kills per set (13.60).
- The Flashes are the only team with four players who have recorded 220 or more kills.
- Senior **Ashley Makruski** leads the way with 283 kills in a breakout final campaign. Freshmen **Savannah Matthews** (267) and **Morgan Copley** (260) and sophomore **Danie Tyson** (229) round out the quartet.

TRIO OF FLASHES EARN MAC VOLLEYBALL POSTSEASON HONORS

- Setter **Alex Haffner** was named All-MAC Honorable Mention, while opposite **Morgan Copley** and outside hitter **Savannah Matthews** were named to the six-member All-Freshman Team, as the Mid-American Conference office announced its volleyball postseason honors on Wednesday (Nov. 20).
- **Haffner** is the first Kent State setter to receive all-conference recognition since **Katarina Kojic** in 2015. During conference play, she was fifth in assists per set (10.07) but averaged 11.49 assists over final 12 matches after switching to a 5-1 offense.
- She helped the Golden Flashes lead the MAC in hitting percentage and rank third in kills per set.
- The redshirt sophomore was the best attacking setter in the conference with a .414 hitting percentage and 0.92 kills per set.
- The Golden Flashes had two All-Freshman Team selections for the second year in a row.
- **Copley** ranked second in points per set (2.91) and third in kills per set (2.67) among conference freshmen. Her .274 in hitting percentage ranked second overall among pins who averaged at least 2.50 kills per set.
- The Aurora, Ohio native posted double-digit kills in 10 matches against MAC opponents.
- **Matthews** led all first-year players with 3.05 digs per set and ranked fourth in points (2.79) and kills per set (2.44). She was fifth overall among pins in digs per set.
- Matthews posted a team-best five double-doubles during the conference season.

GARDNER DIGGING AT RECORD PACE

Sophomore **Erin Gardner** became the 12th member of Kent State's 1,000-dig club during a 3-0 victory over Ball State on October 19 at the M.A.C. Center. Gardner needed only 189 sets to achieve the milestone, which is 20 fewer than any other player in program history.

Although only halfway through her Golden Flashes career, Gardner is already eighth on the school's career list with 1,156 digs. Last season, she set freshman program records for both total digs (578) and digs per set (5.07).

Gardner has tallied at least 10 digs in 53 of 59 career matches and has hit the 20-dig mark 28 times.

HAFFNER CLIMBS RECORD BOOK

Redshirt sophomore **Alex Haffner** has recorded 1,796 assists during her first two seasons as a Golden Flash, putting her seventh on the school's career list. She needs just 29 assists to be the first Kent State player to tally 1,000 in a season since 2015.

Haffner has also made major contributions defensively. She has totaled 479 digs and posted 21 double-doubles.

GROMALA EARNS VICTORY NO. 100

Head coach **Don Gromala** earned his 100th career victory when Kent State took down Bowling Green, 3-1, on November. The milestone victory was also a big one for the program, as the Golden Flashes had never won inside of the Stroh Center, which opened its doors in 2011.

Gromala, who is in his eighth season guiding the Flashes, is just the second coach in school history to win 100 matches. His 2015 team captured the program's first Mid-American Conference East Division title with a 13-3 league record.

SCOUTING OHIO

The Bobcats (17-12, 9-7) won the final four matches of the regular season with just a single set loss during the winning streak. Ohio had lost four in a row prior to that. As a team, the Bobcats leads the MAC in blocking (2.24 bps) and are second in hitting percentage (.221).

Middle blocker Tia Jimerson and setter Vera Giacomazzi picked up MAC specialty awards, as announced by the conference office on Wednesday. Jimerson earned both Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year accolades. She leads the MAC with 4.17 points per set, 1.34 blocks per set and a .377 hitting percentage. The junior was nearly unstoppable in the most recent matchup against Kent State on November 7, posting 18 kills on 21 attempts for an .857 hitting percentage. Giacomazzi was named Setter of the Year for the second time in her career. The junior ranks second nationally in total assists (1,259) and 12th in assists per set (11.45 aps).

Opposite Maggie Nedoma was also an All-MAC First Team selection. The six-rotation player averages a team-best 3.31 kills per set and adds 2.40 digs per set in her first season as a Bobcat.

Dahlia Bouyer joins Jimerson to give Ohio the top middle duo in the conference. Bouyer adds 1.85 kills per set while ranking in the top-10 in both hitting percentage (.354) and blocking (0.95 bps).

Libero Macy Reihing is the team leader with 4.58 digs per set, which ranks fifth in the league.

ALL-TIME VS. OPPONENTS

Kent State is 26-58 all-time against Ohio and has lost five straight meetings. The Flashers' most recent victory was a 3-2 win at the M.A.C. Center on October 5, 2017. Head coach Don Gromala is 3-15 against the Bobcats.

KSU'S MAC TOURNAMENT HISTORY

Kent State owns an 9-18 all-time record in MAC Volleyball Championship play since its inception in 1987. The Flashes advanced to the championship match in their first appearance back in 1996, losing to Miami 3-0. They have made six semifinal appearances with the most recent coming in 2015. Kent State earned a first round bye and then swept Ball State in the quarterfinals before losing in four sets to host Ohio. Last season, the Flashes fell in three sets to eventual tournament champion Eastern Michigan.

This will be the sixth all-time conference tournament matchup with Ohio. The Bobcats have won all five matches to-date with two being played in Athens and three at neutral sites.

Head coach Don Gromala has led Kent State to six tournament appearances during his eight years guiding the program, including four consecutive from 2013-16. The Flashes are 2-5 in the tournament during Gromala's tenure.



Don Gromala enters his eighth year at Kent State after being hired as the eighth head coach in the volleyball program's 42-year history on April 17, 2012. Gromala has led the Golden Flashes to a 75-101 mark over his first six seasons, which included the school's first Mid-American Conference East Division title in 2015.

The 2016 season saw juniors Kelsey Bittinger and Challen Geraghty become the first Golden Flashes to earn multiple All-MAC First Team honors. Bittinger posted her 1,000th career dig in the team's MAC Tournament loss to become just the fourth Kent State player with 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs and the first to accomplish the feat in three seasons. Geraghty continued to record digs at a record-setting pace and will enter her senior season second on the school's all-time digs list.

In 2015, Kent State set new program records for conference wins (13), All-MAC selections (5) and MAC East Player of the Week selections (10) en route to tying Ohio for first in the MAC East and finishing just one match from the school's first conference regular season championship.

During his five seasons on the Kent State sidelines, Gromala has continued to take the Flashes to new heights. After leading Kent State to its first ever win over a nationally-ranked team and a return to the MAC Tournament in 2013, Gromala and his staff brought in an infusion of talent with back-to-back recruiting classes that were ranked among the top 100 in the country by PrepVolleyball.com.

The 2014 season saw Kent State earn 17 overall victories and 8 conference wins. Additionally, the Flashes defeated Eastern Michigan in the first round of the MAC Tournament for their first postseason win since 2007 and came away victorious in both of their matches against teams that played in the NCAA Tournament (Western Michigan and New Hampshire). Three Golden Flashes received all-conference honors, which is the most since 2009. Tinuke Aderemi-Ibitola and Liz Reikow were All-MAC Second Team selections, while Challen Geraghty was voted to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

Great strides were made during the 2013 season, as Kent State doubled its win total from the previous season to finish with a 12-18 record. Despite being picked to finish last by conference coaches prior to the season, Kent State tied for third in the MAC East Division and claimed the No. 8 seed in the MAC Tournament after missing the tournament the previous two seasons. A historic victory over No. 18 Ohio on October 10, 2013 was perhaps the highlight of the season, as Kent State knocked off a nationally-ranked opponent for the first time in program history. The four-set victory came in front of a raucous crowd at the M.A.C. Center and solidified the Flashes as a program on the rise.

Gromala inherited a youthful roster that featured just one senior and two juniors in his first season. On September 21, 2012, Gromala led the Golden Flashes to a dramatic 3-2 come-from-behind win at Miami to become the third coach in program history to come away victorious in his MAC debut. Other highlights of the season included a thrilling five-set victory over BIG EAST foe South Florida (17-15) and a 3-1 win at the M.A.C. Center over MAC Tournament runner-up Northern Illinois.

Gromala brought nine years of coaching experience rooted in the tradition of Midwest volleyball with him when he took over Kent State's program. Most recently, he spent four seasons as an assistant coach at perennial top-25 power Ohio State, where he was tutored by head coach Geoff Carlston. The Buckeyes advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament in Gromala's final two seasons on staff.

While in Columbus, Gromala assisted with all aspects of the Ohio State program, including training outside hitters and setters, scouting opponents and directing

camps and clinics. In all, Gromala oversaw the development of three AVCA All-Americans, six AVCA All-Region honorees, six All-Big Ten Conference picks and 26 Academic All-Big Ten recipients.

Gromala is no stranger to the MAC, having spent four years on the sidelines at Ohio, where he was part of a stretch in which the Bobcats compiled a 116-17 (.872) overall record and a 63-1 (.984) mark in conference play. He worked two years as an assistant coach following two seasons as a graduate assistant. The Bobcats captured the MAC Tournament crown to earn NCAA Tournaments appearances - including a Sweet 16 appearance in 2005 - in each of his four years on staff.

Gromala got his NCAA Division I coaching start at Iowa State, working as a volunteer assistant coach for his alma mater during the 2003 season as the Cyclones put together their best finish in nearly 10 years.

Before his stint at Iowa State, Gromala spent 2000-03 as an assistant at Des Moines Area Community College, coaching an NJCAA All-America pick and helping lead the squad to a sixth-place finish in the NJCAA Nationals.

A 2004 graduate of Iowa State with a bachelor's degree in liberal studies, Gromala both played for and coached the school's men's club volleyball team. The team posted four NIRSA Top 25 finishes during Gromala's tenure as head coach from 1999-2004. Gromala was a two-time all-conference selection and served as team captain during his playing days from 1998-2001.


