#### THE GAME

The 45th season of Kent State women's basketball will start Tuesday night against Duquesne. The Golden Flashes and Dukes will play the second game of a scheduled doubleheader at PPG Paints Arena in downtown Pittsburgh with tip at approximately 8:30 p.m.

Fourth-year head coach **Todd Starkey**'s squad has been projected to finish third in the ultra-competitive Mid-American Conference East Division. Kent State was fourth a year ago but earned the No. 5 seed in the conference tournament. Each of the top four teams in the division posted 20-win campaigns while combining for five postseason victories.

The Flashes return four starters and 83.6-percent of its scoring from last year's 20-win team. Preseason All-MAC East selection **Megan Carter** headlines the returners after posting averages of 15.9 points, 4.1 rebounds and 2.2 assists per game during her redshirt junior season. Carter was the Flashes' most consistent scoring threat, reaching double-figures in 27 of 33 games on the season. Point guard **Asiah Dingle** (12.9 ppg) and forward **Lindsey Thall** (10.3 ppg, 4.7 rpg) were perhaps the two top true freshmen in the conference a season ago. Guard **Ali Poole** (8.8 ppg) is the team's most experienced player with 92 games in a Flashes uniform.

Freshmen **Nila Blackford**, **Clare Kelly** and **Katie Shumate** all made major contributions during the team's foreign tour to Vancouver in August, as the Flashes went 3-0 with an average margin of victory of 37.7 points.

Although Duquesne has averaged better than 22 wins in six seasons under the leaderships of head coach Dan Burt, the Dukes were voted to finish ninth among 14 teams in the Atlantic 10 preseason poll. The top three scorers, who combined for more than half of the team's scoring.

Duquesne's next four top scorers do return, led by guard Libby Bazelak. The junior averaged 7.4 points per game and led the Dukes in assists (2.9 per game) and steals (1.9 per game). Bazelak is also their top long-range threat with 27 makes and a 33.7 three-point point field goal percentage. Guard/forward Paige Cannon (5.3 ppg, 4.1 rpg) is the most experienced player on the roster with 98 career games played. Guard Nina Aho, who has played in just five games since a promising freshman campaign in 2016-17, is expected to be a key player for the Dukes.

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, The Years of Youth, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper. the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

- The Golden Flashes have lost four straight in the series with the most recent victory coming by a score of 75-70 on Dec. 5, 2001 at the M.A.C. Center.
- The Dukes won in Kent last season, 77-72.
- Kent State is 0-3 in trips to Pittsburgh with Duquesne owning an average margin of victory of 14 points in those contests.
- The Dukes won its most recent home game in the series, 86-60, on Dec. 3, 2014.

### FLASH BACK: (NOV. 28, 2018) DUQUESNE 77, KENT STATE 72

- Duquesne scored 48 points in the second half to rally from a five-point halftime deficit and leave the M.A.C. Center with a 77-72 victory.
- Kent State led by two through three quarters but shot 1-for-6 with three turnovers over its first nine possessions in the final period and fell behind, 64-57.
- Alexa Golden buried a three-pointer with 1:50 to play and the Golden Flashes had an opportunity to tie the game following a pair of missed free throws by the Dukes.
- Libby Bazelak came away with a big steal on the ensuing possession and Duquesne was able to put the game away at the charity stripe.
- Megan Carter led four Flashes in doublefigures with 17 points
- **Asiah Dingle** finished with 13 points and a career-high six assists.
- Chassidy Omogrosso scored half of her gamehigh 24 points at the foul line, as Duquesne shot 22-for-32 as a team.
- Julijana Vojinovic added 22 points.

#### **CHARITABLE FLASHES**

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the **Todd Starkey** era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year **Larissa Lurken** made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State ranks second the nation in free throws per game (15.86), sixth in free throws made (1,538), ninth in free throw attempts (2,067) and 32nd in free throw percentage (.744).

## FOURTH SEASON Montreat College. '93

Hometown: Canfield, Ohio

Alma Mater: Montreat College, Bachelor's Degree in Outdoor Education Todd Starkey enters his fourth season as the head women's basketball coach at Kent State in 2019-20 after being hired as the program's sixth head coach in April 2016. Already the third-winningest coach in school history, he has led the Golden Flashes to two Postseason WNIT appearances and one Mid-American Conference East Division title.

Last season, Starkey led Kent State to a 20-win campaign for the first time since 2010-11 while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 22-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and

was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country during the 2016-17 season with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. Korinek was then named to the first team in 2018. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.


