

#### **FLASHES AT A GLANCE**

- » Kent State takes on nationally ranked competition for the third consecutive week when it battles #25 Michigan on the road for a three-game set. Due to inclement weather a single game will be play Thursday with a doubleheader slated for Sunday.
- » KSU has lost it's previous eight games with five coming against nationally ranked squads. The Golden Flashes fell in an extra innings to #12 Arizona 7-6 two weeks ago and battled back from a two run deficit in the seventh inning to force extras.
- » The Golden Flashes have shown they can win games against ranked teams this season. The program won two games in the same day against a ranked team for the first time in school history when it defeated #21 Baylor twice on Feb. 23. KSU won its first game over a ranked team since downing then-#3 Michigan in 2017.
- » Freshman pitcher **Andrea Scali** has impressed in her first season of competition. She has was recognized as USA Softball's Co-National Player of the Week for the sweep over the Lady Bears. Scali currently ranks ninth in the nation with 10.4 strikeouts per seven innings.
- » Fourth-year Head Coach **Eric Oakley** became the fastest Kent State head coach to earn their 100th victory at KSU as Oakley accomplished the feat in 173 games with a 7-1 season-opening win over LIU Brooklyn. During his three complete seasons as the skipper, the Golden Flashes have finished each season with a .540 or better winning percentage and have won nine postseason games.
- » The Golden Flashes return six starters from a team that finished fourth in the Mid-American Conference last season. Senior **Bailey Brownfield** and sophomore **Kennadie Goth** highlight the returners amongst position players. Brownfield hit .351 last season, clubbed 13 doubles and drove in 41 runs; the latter two both rank ninth in a single season in program history. Goth compiled one of the most impressive freshman seasons in program history, registering a .403 batting average which ranks sixth in school history and was eigth nationally among freshman.
- » Six Flashes were named All-MAC last year which led the league. Senior **Bailey Brownfield**, juniors **Maria Cegledy** and **Madi Huck**, and freshmen **Kennadie Goth** and **Brenna Brownfield**.
- » Last season, **Holly Speers** became the school's first-ever NFCA First Team All-American and led the country in batting average (.483), slugging percentage (1.033), on-base percentage (.656), walks (60) and walks per game (1.20) and set MAC single-season records for batting average, slugging percentage, walks and on-base percentage. Speers is now a member of the Canadian National Team.

#### **KENT STATE, PLEASE...**

Kent State University respectfully requests that the institution and its intercollegiate athletics teams be referred to as "Kent State" or "KSU" in shortened reference, as opposed to "Kent." Kent State University requests that its team name is reffered to as the "Golden Flashes" on first reference with "Flashes" also being acceptable upon second reference. Thank you.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

Kent State is 1-14 all-time against Michigan, who has made 12 WCWS appearances and won 20 Big Ten Conference championships. The Golden Flashes played Michigan four times in the 2017 season with one game at a neutral site in Lexington, Ky. and with the other three played at Michigan. The closest KSU played Michigan that year was a 2-0 loss in which the Flashes committed three errors and did not allow an earned run to score. The Flashes lone win came in 2015 with a 3-0 victory over the then #3 Wolverines. Current KSU pitching coach Emma Johnson was the winning pitcher and dominated only allowing three hits. Future MAC Player of the Year Maddy Grimm did all of Kent State's offensive damage with her bat clobbering two home runs. This season Kent State has played games against Arizona's head coach Mike Candrea and Michigan head coach Carol Hutchins, the two winningest softball coaches in collegiate history.

#### **BAILEY BROWNFIELD BACK FOR SENIOR SEASON**

Senior Bailey Brownfield is back for her fourth tour of duty with the Golden Flashes and has been one of the most consistent hitters in the MAC over the last two seasons, earning First Team All-MAC recognition. In her junior season, she was also named to the NFCA All-Mideast Region Second Team and hit .351 last season with 13 doubles, two triples and a home run while driving in 41 runs. She continued her hot hitting during league play with the MAC's sixth best average in conference-only games (.413) and led the league in doubles (9) while driving in the third most runs (24). For the second straight season, she saw her average increase by at least .025 percentage points. As a freshman she hit .271, then .324 as a sophomore, before her career-best .351 mark last season. The Thornville, Ohio native was clutch in late-inning situations last year and collected three game-winning or go-ahead hits. She hit a go-ahead double in the ninth inning to beat Rider and recorded walk-off singles against Oakland and Toledo. Brownfield also made a successful transition from the outfield to third base last year and registered a .966 fielding percentage in her first collegiate season at third. She delivered a clutch RBI double in the sixth inning to tie the game at Baylor for an eventual extra inning win. Her 33 career doubles are currently tied for 10th in program history.

#### **SCALI'S STRONG SHOWING**

Redshirt freshman pitcher Andrea Scali was named the first MAC Pitcher of the Week this season for her impressive debut at the FGCU Kickoff Classic, tossing 16 innings while not allowing an earned run and striking out 27 batters. The Parma, Ohio native went a perfect 3-0 inside the circle and compiled an impressive WHIP of 0.38. In her first collegiate start, Scali struck out the side in the first inning en route to a complete game one-hitter with 12 strikeouts against LIU Brooklyn in a 7-1 win. Her 12 strikeouts were the most by a KSU pitcher in their first career start since current pitching coach Emma Johnson also punched out 12 against Weber State on Feb. 10, 2012. The record for most strikeouts in a debut is held by three-time MAC Pitcher of the Year Kylie Reynolds when she struck out 16 Campbell Camels on Feb 16, 2007. She lost a no-hitter in the seventh inning against North Texas (2/22) and tossed a one-hitter against the Mean Green with 12 strikeouts. She followed that performance up with a two-hitter against #21 Baylor (2/23) and won a pitchers dual 1-0 with 11 strikeouts. Scali is fourth in the NCAA in shutouts (4), sixth in hits allowed per seven innings (2.26), 11th in strikeouts per seven innings (10.9) and 15th in ERA (0.41). She was named MAC Pitcher of the Week and and USA Softball Co-Player of the Week. Kent State has won a national weekly award in every year since 2015.

#### **HUCK SHOWS OUT IN BREAKOUT YEAR**

Junior pitcher Madi Huck compiled the best season of her brief career last season when she was named to the All-MAC Second Team. As the staff ace last year, she posted an 18-9 overall record with a 2.68 ERA and was a two-time MAC East Division Pitcher of the Week recipient. Huck led the MAC in conference-only games with 96.1 innings of work and her four shutouts was the second most in the conference. She also was third in victories (9) and fourth in strikeouts (70). The Delaware, Ohio native was sensational in the back stretch of the conference slate and went 5-0 with three shutouts, a 1.09 ERA and 34 strikeouts to just seven walks. She also possesses big game experience.

#### **GOTH IMPRESSES IN DEBUT CAMPAIGN**

Kennadie Goth compiled one of the most impressive freshman campaigns in recent memory. Last season, she hit .403 which is the sixth-highest in a single-season in school history and ranked eighth nationally among freshmen last season. Her average was the second-highest in a season by a Kent State freshman, trailing Pauline Maurice's .429 mark in 1988. The slapper totaled 16 multi-hit games a season ago which led the squad and stole a team-leading 11 bags which was sixth in the MAC. Goth was selected to the NFCA All-Mideast Region Third Team, All-MAC Second Team and MAC All-Freshman Team last season. The Shelby, Ohio native was an impressive multi-sport athlete in high school and became the first athlete in Shelby High School history to possess 16 letters (volleyball, basketball, softball and track) for the Whippets.

#### **UNDER OAKLEY'S WATCH**

Fourth year head coach Eric Oakley has enjoyed one of the most successful stretches in Kent State softball history leading the Flashes to a MAC regular season and tournament championship. Oakley became the fastest head coach in program history to win 100 games for the Blue and Gold and accomplished the feat in 173 games. In his first season in 2016, Oakley was named the MAC Coach of the Year, while guiding the Flashes to a MAC Regular Season Championship with a 37-22 record, the fourth-most wins in program history. second season, Kent State won the MAC Tournament Championship for the third time in program history and the school's first ever NFCA First Team All-America season and guided the team to its 15th straight MAC Tournament. In 2015 while he was named pitching coach and guided one of the most dominant staffs in the nation that finished with the third-lowest ERA in the country (1.55). In his head coaching tenure, he has beaten eight Power 5 opponents.

#### **KENT STATE TAKES DOWN #21 BAYLOR TWICE**

The Golden Flashes took down #21 Baylor two times in the same day on Saturday, Feb. 23. Kent State won the first game 1-0 before taking the nightcap 6-5 in eight innings. Kent State pitcher Andrea Scali shut out the Lady Bears for the first time this season in the 11-strikeout two-hitter. Baylor had not been two-hit since March 29th of last year when #2 Oklahoma All-American Paige Parker did so. It's also the most times the Lady Bears struck out since last season when All-American Kelly Barnhill of #2 Florida struck out 18 on March 3, 2018. Alexis Taube delivered a walkoff single in the eighth inning to beat the Lady Bears in game two. KSU won two games against a ranked team in the same day for the first time in program history. The last time Kent State defeated a ranked team was in 2015 at #3 Michigan, 3-0.

#### TAKING ON A CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

This season's schedule is shaping up to be one of the toughest non-conference slates for any mid-major team in the coutry, as the Flashes will play 13 games against teams that received a vote in the Preseason USA Today/NFCA Top 25 Coaches' Poll with 11 of the games against top-25 opponents. In total, Kent State will play 17 games against teams that qualified for the NCAA Tournament last season.

#### **VODAN SHOWS OFF ATHLETICISM AS A DUAL SPORT ATHLETE**

Junior catcher Vanessa Vodan is also member of the Kent State Track and Field Team as well as playing for the softball team. Vodan was the only player to reach base in all three games of Kent State's 2017 NCAA Tournament Regional in Waco. The Berea, Ohio native won the MAC Championship in the javelin and made an appearance at the NCAA East Preliminary in Tampa, Fla last year. Vodan is one of Kent State's quickest slap hitter and last year hit .311 and excelled in a pinch hitting role.

#### KENT STATE PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN THE MAC

The Golden Flashes were picked to finish second in the MAC preseason coaches' poll and received two first place votes and also received a nod to win the MAC Tournament Championship. Kent State has won three league championships in the last four seasons and has appeared in 15 straight MAC Tournaments, the longest streak in conference history since a regular tournament was held beginning in 1996. With Eastern Michigan discontinuing the sport after last season, the MAC has abolished divisions for the first time since 1997.

#### A SUCCESSFUL SEASON AT THE DISH

Last season saw the Flashes post the third-highest batting average (.308) in program history and the highest slugging percentage (.466) in school history. Six starters last season registered batting averages of over .300 (Holly Speers, Kennadie Goth, Bailey Brownfield, Maria Cegledy, Emily Dobbin, & Kaitlyn Miller). This season KSU will have to fill the void of NFCA First Team All-American Holly Speers who led the nation in batting average (.483), slugging percentage (1.033), on-base percentage (.656) and walks per game (1.2). Kent State also hit 43 home runs a season ago, with players returning this year accounting for 12 of those 43.

#### FLASHES WELCOME SEVEN NEWCOMERS THIS SEASON

Kent State welcomed seven freshmen this season including Brooklyn Whitt (Mt. Gilead, Ohio), Sabrina Kerschner (Waterville, Ohio), Anilese Kelly (Buffalo, N.Y.), Grace Saupe (Farwell, Mich.), Megan Turner (Warren, Ohio), Chloe Cruz (Canfield, Ohio) and Katie Synnestvedt (Garrettsville, Ohio). Freshmen have long been impact players in their first collegiate seasons in the program and last year the Flashes had two players (Kennadie Goth & Kaitlyn Miller) named to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

#### **DIAMOND SPORTS EXCELLENCE AT KENT STATE**

Kent State softball and baseball both have a rich tradition of winning. KSU is the only MAC school since the NCAA began sponsoring a softball championship in 1982 that have sent both diamond sports to both the Women's College World Series and College World Series. Golden Flashes softball made its run to the WCWS in 1990. The Golden Flashes knocked off powers Oregon and Ohio State en-route to the WCWS in Oklahoma City. Kent State baseball went to Omaha in 2012. KSU eliminted #12 Kentucky in a marathon 21-inning win and defeated #10 Oregon in a three game series in Eugene. The Flashes also sent #1 Florida home at the CWS.

#### **GETTING TO KNOW KENT STATE**

Kent State is located in Kent, Ohio, about 50 miles southwest of Cleveland. The school and community are both named after Marvin Kent, who was influential in making the area a hub for the Atlantic and Great Western Railroad. Kent State boasts several notable alumni in the fields of sports and entertainment, including Nick Saban, Julian Edelman, Lou Holtz, James Harrison, Antonio Gates, Drew Carey and Michael Keaton.
