

FLASHES AT A GLANCE

- » Kent State is playing in its first ever NISC and playing in its first postseason since the 2017 NCAA Tournanent where the Golden Flashes eliminated Oregon State, 2-1.
- » Kent State's Andrea Scali took home the MAC Pitcher and Freshman of the Year awards and Brenna Brownfield the MAC Player of the Year award. Its the first time in league that a single school has won the player, pitcher and freshman awards in the same season.
- » In addition to Scali and Brenna Brownfield being named to the All-MAC First Team, third baseman Bailey Brownfield and outfielder Maria Cegledy were selected to the All-MAC Second Team. Scali, along with first baseman Megan Turner, were tabbed to the MAC All-Freshman Team.
- » Andrea Scali has thrown three no-hitters this year including a perfect game this season. She threw a perfect game against Bowling Green on May 4th, and was just the fourth perfect game in school history. It is the first in school history since 2017 and the first seven-inning perfect game since 1983. Against Youngstown State, she became the first Flash freshman to throw a no-hitter since 2009. Her three no-no's this year is the most in a single-seaosn in KSU history and she was one out away from a fourth at the MAC Tournament when she lost a no-hitter with two outs in the seventh inning to Central Michigan.
- » Scali has taken home a MAC-best six pitcher of the week honors and has won two national weekly awards this year from USA Softball and the NFCA.
- » Senior Bailey Brownfield is third in school history with 204 career hits, second in doubles (45) and seventh in RBIs (115). She is one of only three players in school history to tally over 200 career hits.
- » Sophomore Kennadie Goth was named to the All-MAC Tournament Team and went 6-for-12 at the plate with a double and a run scored. She is currently on a season-best seven game hitting streak.
- » Prior to the start of conference play, the Golden Flashes played the sixth toughest schedule in the NCAA.
- » Fourth-year Head Coach Eric Oakley became the fastest Kent State head coach to earn their 100th victory at KSU as Oakley accomplished the feat in 173 games with a 7-1 season-opening win over LIU Brooklyn. During his three complete seasons as the skipper, the Golden Flashes have finished each season with a .540 or better winning percentage and have won nine postseason games.
- » The Golden Flashes have shown they can win games against ranked teams this season. The program won two games in the same day against a ranked team for the first time in school history when it defeated #21 Baylor twice on Feb. 23. KSU won its first game over a ranked team since downing then-#3 Michigan in 2015. » This year Kent State qualified for a league-record 16th straight MAC Tournament.

KENT STATE, PLEASE...

Kent State University respectfully requests that the institution and its intercollegiate athletics teams be referred to as "Kent State" or "KSU" in shortened reference, as opposed to "Kent." Kent State University requests that its team name is reffered to as the "Golden Flashes" on first reference with "Flashes" also being acceptable upon second reference. Thank you.

BAILEY BROWNFIELD BACK FOR SENIOR SEASON

Senior Bailey Brownfield was named to the All-MAC Second Team this year and it marks the third time she has been named All-MAC after garning first-team recognition the past two seasons. Brownfield has been one of the most consistent hitters in Kent State history and is third in school history with 204 career hits, second in doubles (45) and seventh in RBIs (115). She is one of only three players in school history to tally over 200 career hits. She has played in 216 games which is the second most in school history and will tie Jessica Toocheck's (2005-08) 217 games in the first game of the NISC. Her 18 doubles this year are tied for the second most in a single-season in school history with Beth Cinadr (2011). Brownfield is 17th in the NCAA in doubles and 18th in doubles per game (0.36). As of this week she is tied for first in the NCAA with four multi-double games this season. She is a career .325 hitter which would rank seventh in Kent State history and is currently hitting .351, her same average as last season. Brownfield began her career as a walk-on and will go down in program history as one of its best hitters.

SCALI'S STRONG SHOWING

Redshirt freshman pitcher Andrea Scali was named the MAC Pitcher and Freshman of the Year and became the first player in the conference to take home both honors since Kent State's Kylie Reynolds in 2007. She begn her collegiate career striking out the side in the first inning en route to a complete game one-hitter with 12 strikeouts against Northeast Conference regular season champion LIU Brooklyn in a 7-1 win in February. Her 12 strikeouts were the most by a KSU pitcher in their first career start since current pitching coach Emma Johnson also punched out 12 against Weber State on Feb. 10, 2012. The record for most strikeouts in a debut is held by three-time MAC Pitcher of the Year Kylie Reynolds when she struck out 16 Campbell Camels on Feb 16, 2007. She lost a no-hitter in the seventh inning against Conference-USA regular season champion North Texas and tossed a one-hitter against the Mean Green with 12 strikeouts. She followed that performance up with a two-hitter against #21 Baylor (2/23) and won a pitchers dual 1-0 with 11 strikeouts. For her performance she was named the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Week. She won a second national awards when the NFCA named her Pitcher of the Week on April 23rd as she threw 22.2 innings withing allowing an earned run and no-hit Robert Morris. During conference-only games she led the MAC in ERA (1.00), wins (9), shutouts (4), opponent batting average (.182) and WHIP (0.94), while ranking second in total strikeouts (98) and strikeouts per seven innings (8.52). Her 21 wins this year are the eigth most in a single season in Kent State history and is the first freshman 20 game winner since Carla Brookbank's 23 in 1992. Her 258 strikeouts are the sixth most in a single season in school history and the most ever by a freshman, surpassing Reynolds' 254 in 2007. She is seventh in the country with 11 shutouts and 11th with 258 strikeouts and 9.7 strikeouts per seven innings.

BRENNA BROWNFIELD NAMED PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Sophomore Brenna Brownfield was selected as the MAC Player of the Year by the conference's head coaches and became the first underclassmen to claim the award since Ball State's Jennifer Gilbert in 2012. Kent State also became the first school in MAC history to have three different players claim the MAC Player of the Year honors in consective seasons (Holly Speers 2018, Maddy Grimm 2017). During conference play the Thornville, Ohio native led the MAC in batting average (.488) and ranked third in on-base percentage (.542), OPS (1.333), RBIs per at bat (.325) and fourth in slugging percentage (.791). The sophomore tallied eight multi-hit games and five multi-RBI games. She began league play with an extra-base hit in five of her first six games. She was instrumental in Kent State earning series victories on the road at Toledo and Western Michigan, going 9-for-17 with seven RBIs and five extra-base hits.

TURNER EMERGES AT FIRST

Freshman first baseman Megan Turner earned a starting role during conference play and ran away with the opportunity, clobbering MAC pitching to the tune of a .351 average. She finished the year second in MAC-only games among rookies in batting average and third in slugging percentage (.541). In the month of April, the Warren, Ohio product hit a homer in four games during a six-game stretch including a grand slam at rival Akron. She had great success at the dish in a three-game series with eventual MAC regular season champion Miami, going 8-for-12, including a four-hit game. Megan's brother Michael is a standout catcher on the Kent State baseball team and both have hit grand slams this season.

UNDER OAKLEY'S WATCH

Fourth year head coach Eric Oakley has enjoyed one of the most successful stretches in Kent State softball history leading the Flashes to a MAC regular season and tournament championship. Oakley became the fastest head coach in program history to win 100 games for the Blue and Gold and accomplished the feat in 173 games. In his first season in 2016, Oakley was named the MAC Coach of the Year, while guiding the Flashes to a MAC Regular Season Championship with a 37-22 record, the fourth-most wins in program history. During the 2017 NCAA Tournament, the Flashes eliminated Oregon State with a 2-1 victory. Last season, he coached Holly Speers to become the school's first ever NFCA First Team All-American. Over the last four seasons, Oakley has led all MAC coaches with 56 league victories. Oakley has been with the program since 2015 when he was named pitching coach and guided one of the most dominant staffs in the nation that finished with the third-lowest ERA in the country (1.55). In his head coaching tenure, he has beaten eight Power 5 opponents.

KENT STATE VS. LYNCHBURG REGIONAL

Appalachian State - never met George Washington - 3-0 Liberty - never met Marshall - 17-23 Rutgers - 2-0

Kent State has played in Lynchburg once before in 2015 for a five-game weekend, but has never played the host Flames. The Golden Flashes outscored their opponents (North Carolina Central, Princeton, Quinnipiac, Rider and Saint Francis (Pa.)) 37-5 that weekend.

KENT STATE TAKES DOWN #21 BAYLOR TWICE

The Golden Flashes took down #21 Baylor two times in the same day on Saturday, Feb. 23. Kent State won the first game 1-0 before taking the nightcap 6-5 in eight innings. Kent State pitcher Andrea Scali shut out the Lady Bears for the first time this season in the 11-strikeout two-hitter. Baylor had not been two-hit since March 29th of last year when #2 Oklahoma All-American Paige Parker did so. It's also the most times the Lady Bears struck out since last season when All-American Kelly Barnhill of #2 Florida struck out 18 on March 3, 2018. Alexis Taube delivered a walkoff single in the eighth inning to beat the Lady Bears in game two. KSU won two games against a ranked team in the same day for the first time in program history. The last time Kent State defeated a ranked team was in 2015 at #3 Michigan, 3-0.

TAKING ON A CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

This season's schedule is shaping up to be one of the toughest non-conference slates for any mid-major team in the coutry, as the Flashes will play 13 games against teams that received a vote in the Preseason USA Today/NFCA Top 25 Coaches' Poll with 11 of the games against top-25 opponents. In total, Kent State will play 17 games against teams that qualified for the NCAA Tournament last season.

VODAN SHOWS OFF ATHLETICISM AS A DUAL SPORT ATHLETE

Junior catcher Vanessa Vodan is also member of the Kent State Track and Field Team as well as playing for the softball team. Vodan was the only player to reach base in all three games of Kent State's 2017 NCAA Tournament Regional in Waco. The Berea, Ohio native won the MAC Championship in the javelin and made an appearance at the NCAA East Preliminary in Tampa, Fla last year. Vodan is one of Kent State's quickest slap hitter and last year hit .311 and excelled in a pinch hitting role.

KENT STATE PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN THE MAC

The Golden Flashes were picked to finish second in the MAC preseason coaches' poll and received two first place votes and also received a nod to win the MAC Tournament Championship. Kent State has won three league championships in the last four seasons and has appeared in 15 straight MAC Tournaments, the longest streak in conference history since a regular tournament was held beginning in 1996. With Eastern Michigan discontinuing the sport after last season, the MAC has abolished divisions for the first time since 1997.

FLASHES WELCOME SEVEN NEWCOMERS THIS SEASON

Kent State welcomed seven freshmen this season including Brooklyn Whitt (Mt. Gilead, Ohio), Sabrina Kerschner (Waterville, Ohio), Anilese Kelly (Buffalo, N.Y.), Grace Saupe (Farwell, Mich.), Megan Turner (Warren, Ohio), Chloe Cruz (Canfield, Ohio) and Katie Synnestvedt (Garrettsville, Ohio). Freshmen have long been impact players in their first collegiate seasons in the program and last year the Flashes had two players (Kennadie Goth & Kaitlyn Miller) named to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

DIAMOND SPORTS EXCELLENCE AT KENT STATE

Kent State softball and baseball both have a rich tradition of winning. KSU is the only MAC school since the NCAA began sponsoring a softball championship in 1982 that have sent both diamond sports to both the Women's College World Series and College World Series. Golden Flashes softball made its run to the WCWS in 1990. The Golden Flashes knocked off powers Oregon and Ohio State en-route to the WCWS in Oklahoma City. Kent State baseball went to Omaha in 2012. KSU eliminted #12 Kentucky in a marathon 21-inning win and defeated #10 Oregon in a three game series in Eugene. The Flashes also sent #1 Florida home at the CWS.

GETTING TO KNOW KENT STATE

Kent State is located in Kent, Ohio, about 50 miles southwest of Cleveland. The school and community are both named after Marvin Kent, who was influential in making the area a hub for the Atlantic and Great Western Railroad. Kent State boasts several notable alumni in the fields of sports and entertainment, including Nick Saban, Julian Edelman, Lou Holtz, James Harrison, Antonio Gates, Drew Carey and Michael Keaton.
