Kent State will travel to Toledo on Saturday as it begins February with three of its first four games on the road. Tip inside of Savage Arena is scheduled for 2 p.m.

The Golden Flashes defeated Ball State, 69-68, Wednesday night to avenge a loss to the Cardinals in the Mid-American Conference opener. The fourth quarter featured five lead changes, with Kent State going ahead for good on a free throw by **Hannah Young** with 2:21 remaining. Ball State split a pair of free throws to make it a one-point with 40.0 to play. **Megan Carter** weaved through the defense to beat the shot clock and go ahead by three and the Cardinals were held to a layup as just 0.1 remained. Carter made half of her 14 field goal attempts and finished with a game-high 20 points. **Katie Shumate** stuffed the stat sheet with 15 points, nine rebounds, career-best five assists, one steal and one block. **Nila Blackford** added 14 points and eight boards.

Five Golden Flashes are scoring in double-figures for the season. **Nila Blackford** is posting team-leading averages of 14.1 points and 7.3 rebounds per game. **Megan Carter** (12.8 ppg) has scored in double-digits in nine of her past 10 contests against Division I opponents. **Asiah Dingle** (12.6 ppg) leads the Flashes in assists (3.5 apg) and steals (1.9 spg). **Katie Shumate** (11.7 ppg) has displayed a versatile skill set and ranks in the top-two on the team in rebounding (6.4 rpg), steals (24) and blocked shots (16). **Lindsey Thall** (10.9 ppg) is second in the MAC in blocked shots (1.8 bpg) and third in three-point field goal percentage (.389).

Toledo lost at home against Eastern Michigan, 77-62, on Wednesday and is now 4-3 in home contests this season. The Rockets had won four in a row prior to setbacks in each of their past two contests. Although Toledo ranks third in the MAC in field goal percentage (.414), it is the second-lowest scoring team at 66.5 points per game.

Preseason All-MAC West guard Nakiah Black leads the Rockets at 12.1 points per contest and 33 three-pointers. Freshman guard Quinesha Lockett (8.9 ppg) has come into her own during league play and is averaging a team-best 12.1 points per game against MAC opponents. Mariella Santucci (8.8 ppg) ranks second in the conference in assists per game (4.6) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.57) while leading all conference point guards with 5.9 rebounds per game. Forward Tanaya Beacham adds 9.4 points and 4.9 rebounds per game.

THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, The Years of Youth, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

STARKEY EARNS CAREER VICTORY #200

- Fourth-year head coach **Todd Starkey** earned career win #200 on Tuesday, Nov. 20, 2018 as Kent State took care of Youngstown State, 62-34.
- Named the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year in 2017, Starkey is already third on the program's career wins list with 63. He passed Richard Keast (1986-89) on Nov. 18.
- Starkey spent nine seasons (2005-14) as the head coach at Division II Lenoir-Rhyne, posting a 165-95 record.

KENT STATE - TOLEDO NOTES

- Kent State is 32-41 all-time vs. Toledo.
- The Golden Flashes are 3-0 inside of Savage Arena over the past two seasons, but the Rockets are 23-13 overall as the home team.
- This is the first time Kent State has beaten Toledo in three consecutive meetings since a five-game streak from 2004-08.
- The Golden Flashes are 4-1 vs. Toledo under fourth-year head coach **Todd Starkey**.
- The Rockets had won nine straight matchups prior to Starkey's arrival.

FLASH BACK: (JAN. 12, 2019)

KENT STATE 58, TOLEDO 47

- Kent State put the game away with a 24-point fourth quarter to improve 3-0 in Mid-American Conference play for the first time since the 2010-11 season.
- The Golden Flashes held Toledo scoreless for more than five minutes during the second period and took a 26-18 lead into the break.
- Kent State shot just 3-for-15 in the third quarter held a slim 34-32 lead heading into the final 10 minutes of the contest.
- The Flashes opened the fourth quarter with a 13-0 run to take its largest lead of the game with 4:24 remaining.
- Toledo got within six with 1:41 to play, but **Ali Poole** answered with a jumper late in the shot clock and KSU's defense forced three turnovers and 0-of-3 shooting in the final minute.
- Megan Carter** all scorers with 22 points, including 13 in the final quarter.
- Asiah Dingle** added 13 points and six rebounds.
- Sara Rokkanen led Toledo with 12 points and eight boards.

KENT STATE PROJECTED TO FINISH THIRD IN MAC EAST DIVISION

- The Mid-American Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 30 with Kent State picked to fourth second in the East Division, as was voted upon by the conference's 12 head coaches.
- The Golden Flashes, which finished fourth in the division last season, received 50 points in the poll.
- Redshirt senior guard **Megan Carter**, an All-MAC Third Team selection last season, was named to the Preseason All-MAC East Team.
- Ohio was unanimously selected to win the overall regular season and East Division titles.
- Central Michigan (60 points) edged Northern Illinois (59 points) as the favorite to win the West Division. Five of the six teams in the division received a first-place vote.

CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the **Todd Starkey** era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year **Larissa Lurken** made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State leads the nation in free throws per game (15.78) and ranks sixth in free throws made (1,799), 13th in free throw attempts (2,416) and 25th in free throw percentage (.745).

THALL'S NIGHT TO REMEMBER

- Sophomore **Lindsey Thall** will always remember the 2019-20 home opener in which she scored 32 points and made a Kent State single-game record eight three-point field goals against Ohio State.
- The Strongsville, Ohio native made a statement against the school she grew up hoping to play for by going 8-for-13 from long range.
- Thall led the Golden Flashes' dominant fourth quarter by outscoring the Buckeyes 19-12 over the final 10 minutes of the contest. All nine OSU players in uniform saw at least 17 minutes of action, so the late run did not come with end-of-the-bench players on the court.
- The 6-foot-2 forward is on pace to be one of the most prolific three-point shooters in Kent State history.
- Thall drained a team-high 66 three-pointers, which puts her third on the Golden Flashes' single-season list. She has added 42 this season to give her 108 and just 2 away from program's the top-10 list.
- Her 39.6-percent from beyond the arc is the second-highest in KSU history.

CARTER IS CLUTCH

- Redshirt senior guard **Megan Carter** has already provided two game-winning shots in the final seconds during the first month of the season.
- Carter's heroics began on opening night with a driving floater from just outside of the paint with 0.2 remaining on the clock to give Kent State a 77-75 win over Duquesne inside of PPG Paints Arena.
- The Preseason All-MAC East Division selection received a return pass after inbounding the ball with 4.3 seconds remaining and was able to create enough separation to get the shot over the defender.
- Carter had dealt with a thumb injury that kept her on the sideline for much of preseason practice and actually came off the bench and had a slow start to the night before scoring eight of her 12 points in the final period.
- Her layup with 2.2 second to play capped the Golden Flashes' 13-point rally over the final 4:54 to defeat Robert Morris, 82-81, on November 24.
- Following a three-pointer by **Lindsey Thall** to get within 81-80 with 6.2 to play, Kent State knocked the ensuing entry pass out of bounds.
- With RMU out of timeouts and inbounding from a spot, the Flashes put two defenders on the ball. The strategy paid off, as **Katie Shumate** got her hand of the pass, which landed in Carter's arms with an open path to the basket to lay it in.
- Carter scored 11 of her 16 points over the final 3:33 of the contest.
- During her redshirt freshman season, Carter's elbow pullup with 2.2 seconds to play lifted Kent State to an 80-78 victory over Bowling Green inside of the M.A.C. Center of January 28, 2017.

FREEBIES WELCOMED

- Kent State leads the Mid-American Conference with 15.4 free throws made per contest while ranking 41st in the country in free throw percentage (.748) and 53rd in free throws made (261).
- So far this season, 22.8-percent of the Golden Flashes' points have come from the charity stripe, which is the 13th-highest mark in the country.
- Earning frequent trips to the foul line has often aided Kent State in coming away victorious, as the Flashes are averaging 17.4 makes and shooting 76.3-percent in 10 wins compared to 12.4 makes and 71.9-percent in seven losses this season.
- In six games played at the M.A.C. Center, Kent State is shooting 77.1-percent from the free throw line and converted 18.7 attempts per game.
- Kent State shot a perfect 13-for-13 in the fourth period of January 8th's contest against Eastern Michigan.
- On December 3, the Flashes made their final 23 free throw attempts against St. Bonaventure and shot 30-of-31 overall in the game.
- **Megan Carter** led the effort with a 12-for-12 performance. Carter is the top free throw shooter in the MAC at 86.4-percent, which ranks 31st nationally.

DEFENDING THE THREE IS KEY

- Opponents have shot 36.8-percent from behind the three-point arc this season against Kent State, which ranks 341st in the nation.
- The Golden Flashes' first two MAC opponents, Ball State and Eastern Michigan, connected on 16 of 29 three-point attempts for a 55.2-percent success rate.
- Kent State is 3-4 when the opposition makes at least eight triples and 7-3 when allowing seven or fewer long-range shots.
- In the team's 10 victories, the Flashes are holding teams 6.0 makes and a .324 three-point field goal percentage, while opposing are averaging 7.1 three-pointers and shooting 43.9-percent in seven losses.

Todd Starkey enters his fourth season as the head women's basketball coach at Kent State in 2019-20 after being hired as the program's sixth head coach in April 2016. Already the third-winningest coach in school history, he has led the Golden Flashes to two Postseason WNIT appearances and one Mid-American Conference East Division title.

Last season, Starkey led Kent State to a 20-win campaign for the first time since 2010-11 while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 22-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and

was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country during the 2016-17 season with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. Korinek was then named to the first team in 2018. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

Starkey got his coaching career started at his alma mater, Montreat College, in North Carolina. He was an assistant men's basketball coach for five seasons (1998-03), helping the team to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 2000.

Starkey grew up in nearby Canfield, Ohio, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in outdoor education from Montreat College. His playing career began in basketball and tennis at Mars Hill College.
