

## MEDIA AND CREDENTIALS

## PRE-GAME

- Credentials with field/All Access will be approved each game by the home institution, please email Dan Griffin, Director of Athletics Communication at dgriff34@kent.edu to request a credential
- Requests MUST BE MADE at least 72 hours prior.
- Approved credentials will have their name on a check-in list in front of the stadium and will undergo a temperature screening prior to entry to the stadium
- Those individuals will also be sent a pre-game questionnaire that must be answered to gain entrance
- Screening and entrance will begin an hour before kick off
- ALL media members will be given a wrist band that will dictate working-area access
- EVERY working individual must practice the <u>FlashesSaveSeven</u>

## IN-GAME

- Those with field access will be limited to the areas behind the end zone (photo/video) and the first two rows of the stands (Photo/video/sideline reporter)
- NO access to the bench areas will be given
- Those with press box access will be limited to the press box area only and will be asked to remain seated and in their designated area
- Pre-game meal will consist of boxed or individual meals
- Stats will be distributed virtually, media is encouraged to follow the game on the live stats link provided

## **POST-GAME**

- There will be a post-game press conference held virtually via Zoom Webinar
- If needed, a press conference with the visiting team will be held PRIOR to the home press conference
