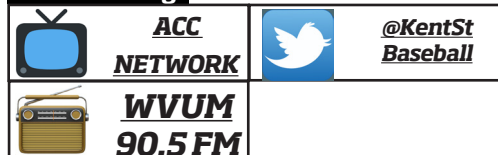

FLASH FACTS

- Kent State was ranked #29 in the most dominant programs of the decade (2010-19) by 247 sports
- The Golden Flashes debuted at #61 in D1 Baseball's pre-season ranking
- Kent State was picked second in the MAC pre-season poll, but earned 6/11 coaches' votes to win the MAC tournament
- The Flashes made it 21-straight seasons with 30 or more wins with last season's 30-24 mark
- Coach Duncan's squad returns six players from last season's starting lineup including All-Americans Kirby and Carew
- This is the second time in the last 10 seasons that Kent State has taken on the #1 team in the country and the first time in the regular season, in 2012, Kent State defeated then #1 Florida in the College World Series
- This will be the first regular-season meeting between the Hurricanes and Golden Flashes, the two teams have met twice before in the NCAA Regionals. Miami has won both meetings, once in 1994 in Coral Gables and again in 2007 at the University of Missouri
- Kent State went 2-1 in the opening weekend at the Snowbird Classic. The Flashes dropped a 3-1 pitcher's duel on Friday to Iowa but rebounded to defeat Indiana State 4-3 (10) and St. Joe's 11-3. Patrick Ferguson paced the offense with five RBI in the first three games. Ben Carew kept his hot bat going from last season, going 5-10 with two steals
- Zach Schultz likely gets the ball for Kent State on Wednesday night. The senior threw three innings of shutout, one hit relief in the 4-3 10 inning victory over Indiana State on Saturday. He posted a team best 2.68 ERA in 53 innings last year in 19 appearances, including seven starts

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Getting to Know Kent State

- Kent State is located in Kent, Ohio, about 50 miles southwest of Cleveland.
- The school and community are both named after Marvin Kent, who was influential in making the area a hub for the Atlantic and Great Western Railroad.
- The university, which had a fall 2017 enrollment of 39,367, is the third-largest in the state of Ohio behind Ohio State and Cincinnati.
- KSU boasts notable alumni in the fields of sports and entertainment, including Nick Saban, Julian Edelman, Lou Holtz, James Harrison, Antonio Gates, Drew Carey, Arsenio Hall and Michael Keaton.

Pride in the Program

Kent State's baseball tradition dates back more than 100 years. Originally called the "Normal Nine," it first tasted post-season success in 1964. In 1993, the Golden Flashes came within one win of winning the regional title, knocking off eventual national champion LSU in the process.

Kent State re-emerged onto the national stage in 2011 with a stunning 7-5 win at Texas in the NCAA Regional tournaments, then compiled a 21-game winning streak in 2012 en route to the school's first ever regional title and appearance in the Super Regionals. There, in a decisive third game in Oregon, all-time hits leader Jimmy Rider floated a single into left field in the bottom of the ninth to send KSU to the College World Series.

The Golden Flashes have spun 11 no-hitters -- including Eric Lauer's 2016 gem which also clinched the regular season conference crown.

Decade of Dominance

Kent State has been one of the preeminent college baseball teams, none more so than in the 2010s. From 2010-2019, Kent State totaled 386 wins and a .655 winning percentage. Over the last 10 seasons, the Flashes won six Mid-American Conference titles and five MAC tournament championships. The five trips to the NCAA Regionals was highlighted in the program's appearance in the 2012 College World Series. 247 Sports tagged the Golden Flashes as #29 in their "teams of the decade" rankings, one of just five "non-power 5" schools to rank inside the top-30.

Developing Pros

Kent State has seen 112 players selected in the MLB Draft and 25 reach the Major League level. Of the 45 players drafted under head coach Jeff Duncan's watch, 15 have come in the top 10 rounds. Four former Flashes are currently playing in the MLB: Andrew Chafin (P, Diamondbacks), Eric Lauer (P, Brewers), Travis Shaw (3B, Blue Jays), Taylor Williams (P, Brewers). LHP Eric Lauer was selected in the first round of the 2016 Draft following a standout year with the Flashes (named Collegiate Baseball's National Player of the Year) and made his Big League debut in April 2018. The Padres announced Lauer to be the 2019 Opening Day starter on Sunday, March 24. Lauer was traded in the offseason from San Diego to Milwaukee as part of a four-player deal.

Carew-sin'

2019 was quite the season for redshirt junior Ben Carew. He led the MAC in overall batting average and hits and was also second in on-base percentage, third in both runs scored and stolen bases and eighth in slugging percentage. In conference games only, he led the MAC in batting average (.435), hits (47) and runs scored (34) while also ranking second in stolen bases (12), third in on-base percentage (.504), fourth in at bats (108) and seventh in slugging percentage (.611). Carew ended the regular season ranked 7th nationally with a .414 batting average and also ranked 8th in Division I in hits per game (1.67), 9th in hits, 39th in runs scored, 40th in runs per game (1.12), 41st in on-base percentage, 44th in stolen bases and 50th in stolen bases per game. As a result, Carew earned Third-Team All-America honors after being named by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association and American Baseball Coaches Association.

This season, Carew picked up where he left off, going 5-10 in the first three games with two runs scored and a pair of stolen bases. Carew showed off his versatility seeing time at second base, center field and left field already this season.

Kirby's Dream Land

Sophomore Justin Kirby has been an offensive juggernaut since he stepped on Kent State's campus. In 2019, Kirby took home the MAC Freshman of the Year Award. He led the conference and ranked 53rd in the nation with a .640 overall slugging percentage, belting nine home runs, 14 doubles and two triples. In conference play, the Alpharetta, Ga. native led the MAC in slugging (.809), doubles (13) and home runs (8) and ranked in the top-10 in batting average (.371) and runs scored (26).

Overall, Kirby ranked in the top-100 in three offensive categories and led the MAC in slugging percentage (.640) and tied for fourth in home runs (9). In MAC play, he led the conference in slugging percentage (.809), home runs (8) and doubles (13), and ranked seventh in runs scored (26) and eighth in batting average (.371).

Turner Turning Heads

Michael Turner had a strong finish to the 2019 season. He exploded offensively in the conference play, earning back-to-back MAC Player of the Week honors May 6 and 13. He belted two grand slams, both lifting the Flashes out of a deficit to go on to win the game.

His first came in the seventh inning at Ohio University and his second was in the first game at Bowling Green. Turner finished the season with a .369 average, tallying 52 hits, 12 doubles, four long balls and 42 RBI. In conference play, the Warren, Ohio native led the conference in sacrifice flies (5) and ranked second in RBIs (32) and third in batting average (.391). Turner went on to be named First Team All-MAC as a result of the strong finish.

Kent State Baseball Runs on Duncan

Since taking the reigns of the KSU Baseball program in the summer of 2013, Jeff Duncan has continued the winning ways of each of his predecessors. Duncan, who was at Purdue in 2012 when the Golden Flashes swept the field at the NCAA Gary Regional hosted by Purdue, has guided KSU to two MAC Tournament titles (2014, 2018) and back-to-back-to-back regular season conference crowns in 2016, 2017 and 2018. Under the Chicagoland native's leadership, Kent State boasts the following numbers:

- 220-120 overall record
- 108-46 MAC record
- 41-11 record in MAC series
- Have swept 15 MAC series
- Have only been swept once in a MAC series

The skippers' recent accomplishments also include back-to-back-to-back MAC Coach of the Year honors and being named the 2018 Chuck Tanner Collegiate Coach of the Year in addition to having coached 27 All-MAC performers, 47 Academic All-MAC players, two Academic All-American selections, four All-Americans, and eight All-Region players. Of the 42 players drafted under Duncan's watch, thirteen have come in the top 10 rounds.

Mike Birkbeck, the Legend

Considered by many as the best pitching coach in the country, Mike Birkbeck, a former major league pitcher, has been the associate head coach at Kent State since July 2004 and is currently in his 23rd season with the Flashes in 2019. Since his first year in 1997, "Birky" has been responsible for transforming Kent State into one of the finest pitching factories in all of Division I college baseball. Under Birkbeck, Kent State has won ten MAC regular season titles, ten MAC tournament crowns, and have appeared in ten NCAA Regional Tournaments. In his tenure, the Flashes have won 812 games, an average of 37 wins per year. The top five team strikeout totals for a single season ever at KSU have all come under Birkbeck's watch. Birky has worked with 53 student-athletes who have been drafted or signed into professional baseball, including 2011 First Round Draftee Andrew Chafin and 2016 fellow first rounder and National Player of the Year Eric Lauer.

Guess Who's Back? Barrett's Back

After serving as the team's volunteer assistant from 2015-17, Barrett Serrato returns to Kent State as the team's recruiting coordinator and assistant coach. Serrato returns and takes over for Derek Simmons, who left after last season to join the staff of the Indiana Hoosiers. From 2015-17 Serrato spent his time working with infielders and serving as the team's hitting coach. During those three seasons, Kent State won two Mid-American Conference titles and three East Division crowns.

He spent the 2018 and 2019 seasons as an assistant coach with the Lee University Flames, a Division-II school in Tennessee. This past fall, he served as a volunteer assistant at Central Florida.

A 2012 graduate of Purdue University, Serrato played and starred for Coach Duncan and the Boilermakers. In his senior season, he was an All-Big Ten, Big-Ten All-Tournament Team and NCAA Regional All-Tournament Team selection. He was drafted by the Texas Rangers and reached the Double-A level in his professional career.
