THE GAME

The Kent State women's basketball team will play the first of two home games over a five-day stretch at 2 p.m. on Sunday when Saint Francis (Pa.) visits the M.A.C. Center for the home opener.

The Golden Flashes finished on a 17-9 run over the final 2:47 to win on the road, 80-73, at Northern Kentucky on Wednesday night. **Casey Santoro** put Kent State ahead for good with a driving layup and scored nine of her career-high 19 points during the stretch to help close out the victory. All seven Flashes who entered the scoring column finished with at least seven points. **Lindsey Thall** stuffed the stat sheet with 17 points, eight rebounds, three steals, three blocks and two assists. **Hannah Young** had 11 points and six rebounds, while **Nila Blackford** also reached double-figures with 10 points.

Kent State made at least half of its shots in a season opener for the first time in more than a deciding, going 27-for-53 from the floor against the Norse. The Flashes' 80 points are the most in an opener since a 95-58 win over Youngstown State on Nov. 15, 2008. After recording double-digit steals just once in 20 games and ranking last in the MAC in steals per game last season, Kent State had 10 steals on Wednesday. **Abby Ogle** helped raise the defensive pressure in her Flashes debut and had three steals in just 18 minutes of action. Kent State's 27 points off turnover were the most since having 33 at Norther Illinois on Jan. 15, 2020.

Following a 14-9 campaign in 2020-21, the Red Flash were selected to finish third in the Northeast Conference Preseason Poll. This season's roster does not feature a student-athlete listed as taller than 6-1.

Saint Francis opened the season Tuesday on the road and lost to Temple, 73-53. Guard Kaitlyn Maxwell shot 3-of-4 from beyond the arc and finished with a career-high 21 points. Guard Jordan McLemore scored nine points in her first game as a Red Flash after transferring from Hartford. Guards Lili Benzel and Jenna Mastellone added eight points each. Saint Francis was outscored 40-18 in the paint and their 28 turnovers led to 26 points for the Owls.

THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, The Years of Youth, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the Todd Starkey era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year Larissa Lurken made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State is third in the nation in free throws per game (15.48), eighth in free throws made (2,296) and 13th in free throw attempts (3,149).

TODD STARKEY

SIXTH SEASON MONTREAT COLLEGE, '93

> Hometown: Canfield, Ohio

Alma Mater: Montreat College, Bachelor's Degree in Outdoor Education Todd Starkey enters his sixth season as the head women's basketball coach at Kent State in 2020-21 after being hired as the program's sixth head coach in April 2016. Already the third-winningest coach in school history, he has led the Golden Flashes to two Postseason WNIT appearances and two Mid-American Conference East Division titles.

Kent State was playing its best ball of the year and had won seven of its last nine games when a potential season-to-remember was unexpectedly cut short this past March with the cancelation of the MAC Tournament. The East Division champion Flashes knocked off defending champion Buffalo in a quarterfinal matchup and was the highest-remaining seed in the field.

Starkey has found much success in recruiting talented student-athletes, landing two of the highest-touted signing class in school history back-to-back in 2018 and 2019. Both classes had two student-athletes earn spots on the MAC All-Freshman Team, while only one other school had multiple honorees over the two seasons. while Nila Blackford led all conference freshmen in rebounding. Led by Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall, the 2018 class ranked second nationally with 964 points.

For the third time in four seasons under Starkey's guidance, Kent State finished the 2019-20 season in the top-100 of the RPI.The Flashes had five players average more than 11 points per game with guards Megan Carter and Katie Shumate earning All-MAC honorable mention selections. Lindsey Thall was named to the MAC All-Defensive Team after being the top shot blocker in the conference for the second year in a row.

The 2018-19 season saw Kent State post its first 20-win campaign in eight years while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPIT op 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 22-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, ying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country during the 2016-17 season with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. Korinek was then named to the first team in 2018. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

Starkey got his coaching career started at his alma mater, Montreat College, in North Carolina. He was an assistant men's basketball coach for five seasons (1998-03), helping the team to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 2000.

Starkey grew up in nearby Canfield, Ohio, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in outdoor education from Montreat College. His playing career began in basketball and tennis at Mars Hill College.
