Kent State will spend Thanksgiving in Estero, Florida before playing three games as part of the Gulf Coast Showcase, beginning Friday at 1:30 p.m. against 19th-ranked UCLA. The Golden Flashes are 3-0 for the first time since 2010-11 when they opened with six straight victories and captured an early-season tournament title at the Great Alaska Shootout.

Career victory No. 250 was memorable for head coach **Todd Starkey**, as Kent State hit the century mark for the first time in 21 years during last Thursday's 101-40 victory over John Carroll. All 12 Flashes in uniform made a field goal and rebounded a missed shot. Nine players contributed to a 15-of-31 shooting performance from behind the three-point arc.

The Flashes' offensive efficiency has been elite, ranking in the top 25 nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (.426), 3-pointers per game (9.7), turnover margin (+9.33) and scoring average (84.0). Kent State also leads the Mid-American Conference in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.31) and field goal percentage (.475). **Casey Santoro** has been one of the nation's most productive non-starting players and is the Flashes' top scorer at 15.0 ppg. Santoro ranks third in the MAC in assist-to-turnover ratio (4.67) and fourth in apg (4.7). **Lindsey Thall** is averaging 13.3 ppg and team-best 6.7 rpg.

Only eight Bruins have seen the court so far season, and standout Charisma Osborne (21.5 ppg) was unavailable during the team's 69-57 victory over Virginia on Sunday. Osborne was named to a trio of national player of the year preseason watch lists. Transfers Ilmar'l Thomas (Cincinnati) and Jaelynn Penn (Indiana) have made immediate impacts for the Bruins. Thomas, who enters the weekend with 1,986 career points, is averaging 20.3 ppg while shooting 61.9% from the floor. Penn adds 12.7 ppg while leading the team with 6.0 rpg and 5.0 apg. Natalie Chou (11.0 ppg), an All-Pac-12 honorable mention performer a season ago, scored a game-high 20 points against Virginia. Two additional transfers, Gina Conti (Wake Forest) and Angela Dugalic (Oregon), have not made their UCLA debuts.

## THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, The Years of Youth, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

## STARKEY EARNS CAREER VICTORY

- Named the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year in 2017, Starkey is already third on the program's career wins list with 85 during his time on the sidelines for the Golden Flashes.

- Kent State and UCLA will meet on the hardwood for the first time.
- The Golden Flashes are 2-6 all-time against schools currently in the Pac-12 with a 2-1 record against Washington while going 0-1 against Arizona, Arizona State, Oregon, Stanford and USC.
- Head coach **Todd Starkey** is 0-1 against the Pac-12, falling 79-54 to No. 14 Stanford in the opening round of the 2017 Play4Kay Showcase in Las Vegas.
- Starkey is 0-5 against ranked opponents and 0-12 against schools from Power 5 conferences.
- Kent State's most recent win against a Power 5 opponent was a 59-58 victory over Washington in the opening round of the Great Alaska Shootout on Nov. 23, 2010.
- The Flashes are 1-6 all-time against the Gulf Coast Showcase field with a 1-3 record against UMass, 0-2 record against Penn State and 0-1 record against Iowa State.

## KENT STATE PROJECTED TO FINISH FOURTH IN MAC PRESEASON POLL

- The Mid-American Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Poll was released on Nov. 4 with Kent State picked to finish fourth overall, as was voted upon by the conference's 12 head coaches.
- The Golden Flashes received 102 points in the poll.

## CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the Todd Starkey era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year Larissa Lurken made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State is third in the nation in free throws per game (15.35), eighth in free throws made (2,302) and 13th in free throw attempts (3,161).

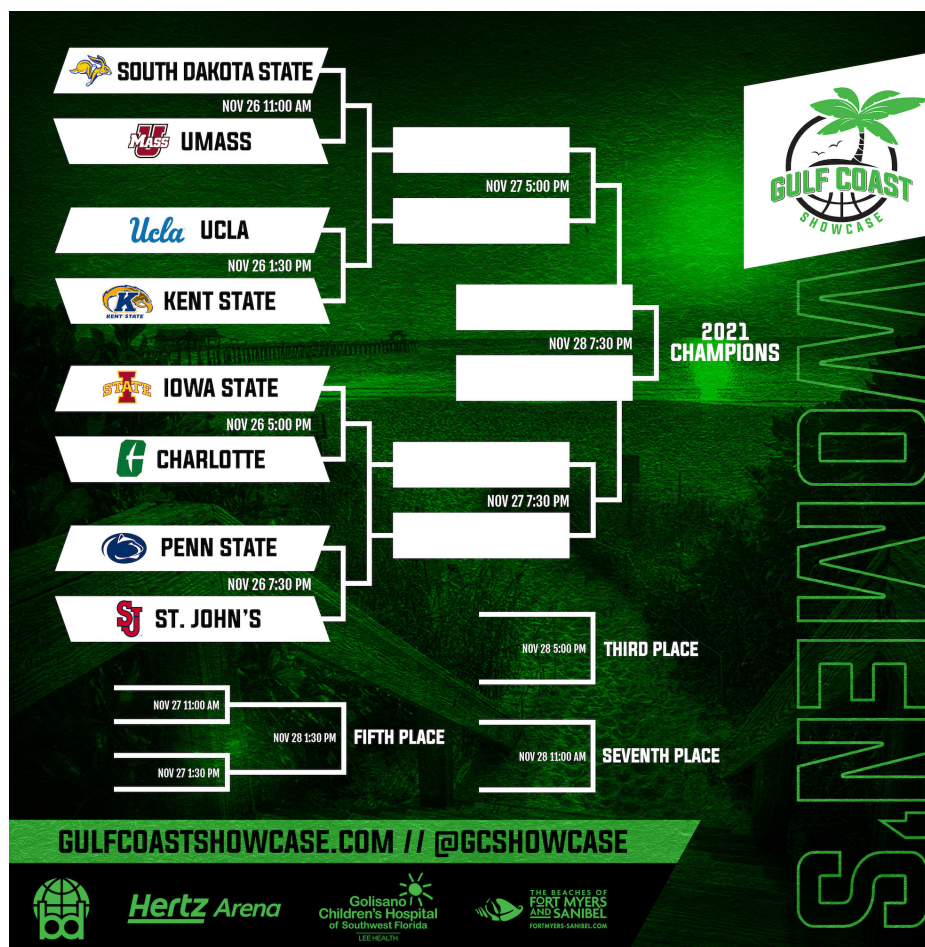

Todd Starkey enters his sixth season as the head women's basketball coach at Kent State in 2020-21 after being hired as the program's sixth head coach in April 2016. Already the third-winningest coach in school history, he has led the Golden Flashes to two Postseason WNIT appearances and two Mid-American Conference East Division titles.

Kent State was playing its best ball of the year and had won seven of its last nine games when a potential season-to-remember was unexpectedly cut short this past March with the cancellation of the MAC Tournament. The East Division champion Flashes knocked off defending champion Buffalo in a quarterfinal matchup and was the highest-remaining seed in the field.

Starkey has found much success in recruiting talented student-athletes, landing two of the highest-touted signing class in school history back-to-back in 2018 and 2019. Both classes had two student-athletes earn spots on the MAC All-Freshman Team, while only one other school had multiple honorees over the two seasons. While Nila Blackford led all conference freshmen in rebounding. Led by Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall, the 2018 class ranked second nationally with 964 points.

For the third time in four seasons under Starkey's guidance, Kent State finished the 2019-20 season in the top-100 of the RPI. The Flashes had five players average more than 11 points per game with guards Megan Carter and Katie Shumate earning All-MAC honorable mention selections. Lindsey Thall was named to the MAC All-Defensive Team after being the top shot blocker in the conference for the second year in a row.

The 2018-19 season saw Kent State post its first 20-win campaign in eight years while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.
