THE GAME

The Kent State women's basketball will host its annual Play4Kay game Wednesday against Buffalo. The game helps to raise awareness and funding for women's cancer research and honor female cancer survivors.

The Golden Flashes return to Kent following four road games in eight days, which ended with impressive wins at Northern Illinois on Saturday and Sunday. The Huskies, who entered the weekend winners of five in a row and in second in the Mid-American Conference standing, were averaging 71.6 points per game. Kent State played lockdown defense for 80 minutes and held NIU to two of its four lowest-scoring contests of the season, including a season-low on Sunday. The 73-58 wire-to-wire victory started with the Flashes shooting 9-of-10 from behind the three-point arc and scoring a program record 33 points in the opening quarter.

Four players are averaging at least 10.0 points per game for the season. **Nila Blackford** is one of three MAC players averaging a double-double with team-best marks of 15.7 ppg and 10.6 rpg. **Katie Shumate** (11.8 ppg) has a team-high 41.5 three-point field goal percentage. **Lindsey Thall** adds 11.5 ppg and is the top shot blocker (1.7 bpg) in the MAC for the third year in a row while averaging a career-best 5.7 rpg. **Clare Kelly** (10.0 ppg) has scored at least 11 games in six of the past seven games, including a career-high 27 points against Toledo on February 8. **Mariah Modkins** (7.2 ppg) leads the Flashes with 3.1 apg. **Casey Santoro** adds 6.8 ppg off the bench.

The Bulls enter at No. 17 in the most recent Women's Mid-Major Top 25 Poll but have lost two of their last three contests. Buffalo is third in the conference in both scoring offense (75.0 ppg) and scoring defense (69.0 ppg). The Bulls are an elite rebounding team, ranking seventh in the country in offensive rebounds per game (16.6) and 12th in total rebounds per game (44.2).

Dyaisha Fair is one of 10 finalists for the 2021 Nancy Lieberman Award, which recognizes the nation's top point guard. Fair pours in 24.8 ppg, which ranks sixth in the nation, and also ranks in the top-25 in three-point field goals (53), assists per game (5.4) and steals per game (2.9). Keowa Walters (5.5 ppg, 5.9 rpg), Loren Christie (4.0 ppg, 5.7 rpg), Zena Elias (2.1 ppg, 5.3 rpg), Adebola Adeyeye (4.6 ppg, 4.5 rpg) and Elea Gaba (8.4 ppg, 4.4 rpg) provide the Bulls with depth in the frontcourt.

THEGOLDENFLASHESNICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, *The Years of Youth*, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

- Kent State is 29-20 all-time vs. Buffalo.
- The Golden Flashes won each of the first 19 games in the series, beginning with an 86-77 victory on Jan. 13, 1999.
- However, the Bulls are 17-3 over the past 20 meetings.
- Kent State has reached the 70-point mark just 3 times during this stretch, averaging 57.1 ppg.
- The Flashes are 16-7 in games played at the M.A.C. Center.
- Kent State is 3-8 under fifth-year head coach **Todd Starkey**.

FLASH BACK: (MARCH 11, 2020)

KENT STATE 72, BUFFALO 66

- Kent State held off a furious run in the closing minutes to defeat defending champion Buffalo in a MAC Tournament quarterfinal contest.
- The Golden Flashes took their largest lead of the night, 68-53, on a pair of free throws by **Asiah Dingle** with 3:35 to play.
- The Bulls turned up the pressure on defense and were able to get as close as 68-64 with possession of the ball at the 1:06 mark.
- Kent State was able to get three stops in a row and knock down free throws to avoid being eliminated by Buffalo for the third consecutive year.
- Dingle paced KSU with 18 points, seven assists and four steals.
- Nila Blackford** recorded a double-double with 14 points and 13 rebounds.
- Dyaisha Fair led all players with a career-high 36 points and grabbed a team-high 11 rebounds.

KENT STATE PROJECTED TO FINISH SIXTH IN MAC PRESEASON POLL

- The Mid-American Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Poll was released on Nov. 19 with Kent State picked to finish sixth overall, as was voted upon by the conference's 12 head coaches.
- The Golden Flashes, which shared the East Division title with Ohio last season, received 88 points in the poll.
- Central Michigan (142 points) received 10 first-place votes and was selected as the favorite to win the MAC regular season title for the fifth season in a row.
- The Chippewas also led the way with six votes to win the 2021 MAC Tournament.
- Ohio received three votes, while one coach selected with Ball State, Buffalo and Eastern Michigan.

CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the **Todd Starkey** era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year **Larissa Lurken** made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State leads the nation in free throws per game (15.64), eighth in free throws made (2,158) and 15th in free throw attempts (2,942).

Todd Starkey enters his fifth season as the head women's basketball coach at Kent State in 2020-21 after being hired as the program's sixth head coach in April 2016. Already the third-winningest coach in school history, he has led the Golden Flashes to two Postseason WNIT appearances and two Mid-American Conference East Division titles.

Kent State was playing its best ball of the year and had won seven of its last nine games when a potential season-to-remember was unexpectedly cut short this past March with the cancellation of the MAC Tournament. The East Division champion Flashes knocked off defending champion Buffalo in a quarterfinal matchup and was the highest-remaining seed in the field.

Starkey has found much success in recruiting talented student-athletes, landing two of the highest-touted signing class in school history back-to-back in 2018 and 2019. Both classes had two student-athletes earn spots on the MAC All-Freshman Team, while only one other school had multiple honorees over the two seasons. While Nila Blackford led all conference freshmen in rebounding. Led by Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall, the 2018 class ranked second nationally with 964 points.

For the third time in four seasons under Starkey's guidance, Kent State finished the 2019-20 season in the top-100 of the RPI. The Flashes had five players average more than 11 points per game with guards Megan Carter and Katie Shumate earning All-MAC honorable mention selections. Lindsey Thall was named to the MAC All-Defensive Team after being the top shot blocker in the conference for the second year in a row.

The 2018-19 season saw Kent State post its first 20-win campaign in eight years while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 22-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country during the 2016-17 season with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. Korinek was then named to the first team in 2018. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

Starkey got his coaching career started at his alma mater, Montreat College, in North Carolina. He was an assistant men's basketball coach for five seasons (1998-03), helping the team to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 2000.

Starkey grew up in nearby Canfield, Ohio, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in outdoor education from Montreat College. His playing career began in basketball and tennis at Mars Hill College.
