The Kent State women's basketball travels to Northern Illinois for a 12 p.m. ET contest on Wednesday for its first game since Jan. 17.

The Golden Flashes have played stellar defense to start MAC play, limiting opponents to only 61.4 ppg and 38.8% shooting. Kent State held Buffalo 12 points below its season average entering last Monday's contest but was unable to make a field goal in the final 4:11 of a 65-62 road setback, as the Bulls ended with a 12-3 run. **Bridget Dunn** led the way with 13 points, while **Nila Blackford**, **Casey Santoro** and **Lindsey Thall** added 11 points apiece.

Kent State has defeated a pair of Power 5 opponents this season. The Flashes rank 14th in the nation in three-point field goal percentage (.370) and 17th in three-pointers per game (8.9), Kent State is 18th in rebounding margin (+8.9) and has yet to be outrebounded.

Lindsey Thall having the best season of her career with averages of 12.8 ppg and 6.7 rpg. **Casey Santoro** has been one of the nation's most productive non-starters with averages of 12.8 ppg and 3.6 apg while ranking 30th nationally with a 2.28 assist-to-turnover ratio. **Katie Shumate** adds 12.2 ppg. **Bridget Dunn** (9.8 ppg) is averaging a team-high 13.6 ppg during MAC play. **Nila Blackford** (9.5 ppg, 9.3 rpg) and **Hannah Young** (7.6 ppg, 6.7 rpg) have helped the Flashes dominate opponents on the glass.

Northern Illinois will play its third game in five days, having defeated Eastern Michigan on Saturday and Akron on Monday. The Huskies score 70.1 ppg but allows 74.5 ppg, which ranks among the bottom 25 nationally.

Chelby Koker scores a team-high 18.1 ppg and adds 4.5 apg, which ranks fourth in the MAC. A'Jah Davis (15.6 ppg) leads the conference in rebounding (11.9 rpg) and field goal percentage (.516). Janae Poisson (12.5 ppg) ranks fifth nationally with 3.20 three-pointers per game.

THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, The Years of Youth, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the Todd Starkey era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year Larissa Lurken made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State is third in the nation in free throws per game (15.17), ninth in free throws made (2,379) and 16th in free throw attempts (3,279).

- Kent State is third in the MAC in rebounding (40.6 rpg) and ranks 21st nationally with a +8.9 rebounding margin.
- Junior **Nila Blackford** ranks third in the MAC at 9.3 rebounds per game and grabbed a season-high 17 boards against Akron on Jan. 5. Seniors **Hannah Young** and **Lindsey Thall** add career-high averages of 6.8 and 6.6 rebounds per game, respectively.
- The Flashes have outrebounded 14 of 15 opponents this season, including impressive +25 and +23 efforts against Clarion and Penn State, respectively. Kent State and Ohio both grabbed 43 rebounds during Wednesday night's game in Athens.
- Kent State is possessing 76.7% of defensive rebounding opportunities, which leads the MAC by a wide margin.
- Only three opponents have recorded double-digit offensive boards, and teams are scoring just 6.8 second-chance points per game. Duquesne (11) and Toledo (13) are the only foes to reach double-figures.
- Kent State also leads the conference in offensive rebounding percentage (.372) and averages 13.3 second-chance points per game.

- Kent State ranks 17th in the nation in three-point field goal percentage (.374) and three-point field goals per game (9.0).
- The Golden Flashes have made at least 10 triples in six games.

Todd Starkey enters his sixth season as the head women's basketball coach at Kent State in 2020-21 after being hired as the program's sixth head coach in April 2016. Already the third-winningest coach in school history, he has led the Golden Flashes to two Postseason WNIT appearances and two Mid-American Conference East Division titles.

Kent State was playing its best ball of the year and had won seven of its last nine games when a potential season-to-remember was unexpectedly cut short this past March with the cancellation of the MAC Tournament. The East Division champion Flashes knocked off defending champion Buffalo in a quarterfinal matchup and was the highest-remaining seed in the field.

Starkey has found much success in recruiting talented student-athletes, landing two of the highest-touted signing class in school history back-to-back in 2018 and 2019. Both classes had two student-athletes earn spots on the MAC All-Freshman Team, while only one other school had multiple honorees over the two seasons. While Nila Blackford led all conference freshmen in rebounding. Led by Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall, the 2018 class ranked second nationally with 964 points.

For the third time in four seasons under Starkey's guidance, Kent State finished the 2019-20 season in the top-100 of the RPI. The Flashes had five players average more than 11 points per game with guards Megan Carter and Katie Shumate earning All-MAC honorable mention selections. Lindsey Thall was named to the MAC All-Defensive Team after being the top shot blocker in the conference for the second year in a row.

The 2018-19 season saw Kent State post its first 20-win campaign in eight years while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of the biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 22-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country during the 2016-17 season with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. Korinek was then named to the first team in 2018. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.
