The Kent State women's basketball team seeks its first win of the 2022-23 season when it hosts Northern Kentucky for a 2 p.m. contest Sunday at the M.A.C. Center.

Ranked No. 20 in the preseason Mid-Major Top 25 poll, the Golden Flashes led Florida State by 11 late in the third quarter before struggling to make shots over the final 12 minutes in an 80-71 setback during the season opener Thursday night.

Forward **Lindsey Thall** led Kent State with 19 points and guard **Katie Shumate** was right behind with 18. Guard **Casey Santoro** joined them in double-figures and finished with 11 points. Kent State outscored the Seminoles in the paint, 40-36, but was lost the rebounding battle, 50-40. Guard **Hannah Young** had a team-high eight rebounds.

Guard **Corynne Hauser** and forward **Bridget Dunn** provided solid production off the bench. Hauser scored seven points and led the Flashes with five assists and two steals in her collegiate debut. Dunn grabbed six boards in 13 minutes of action.

Northern Kentucky was picked to finish fourth in the Horizon League preseason poll and opened the season with a 101-95 triple-overtime victory over Lipscomb on Thursday. After rallying from a seven-point deficit with under a minute remaining in the second overtime period, the Norse held the Bison scoreless in the final overtime.

All-Horizon League guard Lindsey Duvall scored 17 of her career-high 36 points from the free throw line and also led the Norse with 15 rebounds and six assists. Guard Khamari Mitchell-Steen matched her career-high with 23 points and pulled down nine boards. Guard Kailee Davis made all three of her shots from behind the three-point line and added 16 points. Forward Trinity Thompson provided an inside presence with 11 rebounds and three blocks to go with her seven points.

THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, *The Years of Youth*, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

STARKEY EARNS 100TH VICTORY AT KENT STATE

- Sixth-year head coach **Todd Starkey** earned his 100th win as Kent State head coach in the regular season finale against Ohio on Saturday, March 5 by a score of 59-50.
- Named the Mid-American Conference Coach of the Year in 2017, Starkey is the third Golden Flashes coach to guide the program to 100 wins.

KENT STATE - NORTHERN KENTUCKY NOTES

- Kent State is 4-0 all-time vs. Northern Kentucky.
- The Golden Flashes' largest margin of victory came in the first-ever meeting, 72-59, on Nov. 29, 1981, in Highland Heights.
- Head coach **Todd Starkey** is 3-0 against the Norse with an 80-73 victory on the road to start last season.
- Kent State has won those games by an average of 4.3 points per contest.

FLASH BACK: (NOV. 10, 2021)

KENT STATE 80, N. KENTUCKY 73

- **Casey Santoro** scored nine of her team-high 19 points (at the time) in the final three minutes as Kent State rallied late to beat Northern Kentucky in the season opener for both teams.
- Santoro put the Golden Flashes ahead by nine with 8:00 to play, but the host Norse drained three three-pointers over the next five minutes to fuel a run and go ahead 64-63 with 3:02 to play.
- An immediate answer was provided by Santoro, who scored on a driving layup and added a triple for a 70-66 lead with 1:07 remaining.
- A parade to the charity stripe followed, with Kent State going 8-for-8 in the final minute to push the lead to as many as 10.
- **Lindsey Thall** helped lead the Flashes to a 40-30 scoring advantage in the paint with 17 points, 8 rebounds and 3 blocked shots.
- **Hannah Young** (11) and **Nila Blackford** (10) also scored in double-figures.
- Lindsey Duvall led all players with 27 points.
- Grayson Rose added 16 points and four blocks.

- The Mid-American Conference Women's Basketball Preseason Poll was released on Oct. 27 with Kent State picked to finish fourth overall, as was voted upon by the conference's 12 head coaches.

CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the Todd Starkey era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year Larissa Lurken made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State is seventh in the nation in free throws per game (14.79), 11th in free throws made (2,632) and 20th in free throw attempts (3,563).

- Kent State is fourth in the MAC in rebounding (38.3 rpg) and ranks 42nd nationally with a +5.9 rebounding margin.

HEAD COACH TODD STARKEY

Todd Starkey was hired as the sixth head coach of the Kent State Women's Basketball team in April 2016.

Already the third-winningest coach in school history with 101 victories, Starkey has led the Golden Flashes to three Postseason WNIT appearances and two Mid-American Conference East Division titles.

Starkey has found much success in recruiting talented student-athletes, landing two of the highest-touted signing classes in school history back-to-back in 2018 and 2019. Both classes had two student-athletes earn spots on the MAC All-Freshman Team, while only one other school had multiple honorees over the two seasons. Nila Blackford led all conference freshmen in rebounding during the 2019-20 season. Led by Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall, the 2018 class ranked second nationally with 964 points. Overall, these two classes have combined for four All-MAC honors and a pair of MAC All-Defensive Team nods.

The 2021-22 season ended with a berth in the WNIT for the Golden Flashes and a final record of 19-12. The season was highlighted by wins over two Power 5 programs at the Gulf Coast Showcase in Estero, Florida and a win in the WNIT. First, the Flashes took down #19 UCLA, 75-69 at the showcase. Two days later, Penn State was the victim as the Flashes won 81-74. Later in the year, Youngstown State couldn't handle the Golden Flashes in the WNIT, as Kent came out on top, 68-59. That win was the second postseason WNIT win in program history. The Flashes boasted the second best defense by points per game allowed in the MAC and were second in the MAC for three-point percentage. The 21-22 season also saw Starkey become the third coach to reach 100 wins at Kent State.

The Flashes advanced to the MAC Tournament quarterfinals for the fifth year in a row in the unique 2020-21 season. Kent State's three all-conference selections were tied for the most of any team in the league. In the MAC opener against Ohio, the Flashes set a new program record with 16 three-point field goals. Lindsey Thall was the conference's top shot blocker for the third straight season and enters this season third in school history.

Kent State was playing its best ball of the year, having won seven of its last nine games, when a potential 2019-20 season-to-remember was unexpectedly cut short with the cancelation of the MAC Tournament. The East Division champions knocked off defending tournament champion Buffalo in a quarterfinal matchup and was the highest-remaining seed in the field. For the third time in the first four seasons under Starkey's guidance, Kent State finished in the top-100 of the RPI. Five players averaged more than 11 points per game with guards Megan Carter and Katie Shumate earning All-MAC honorable mention selections.

The 2018-19 season saw Kent State post its first 20-win campaign in eight years while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to

within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 24-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country during the 2016-17 season with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. Korinek was then named to the first team in 2018. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

Starkey got his coaching career started at his alma mater, Montreat College, in North Carolina. He was an assistant men's basketball coach for five seasons (1998-03), helping the team to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 2000.

Starkey grew up in nearby Canfield, Ohio, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in outdoor education from Montreat College. His playing career began in basketball and tennis at Mars Hill College.
