The Opening Kick

- Kent State seeks to regain the Wagon Wheel rivalry trophy as year two of the #KentGRIT era under the direction of head coach **Kenni Burns** continues with a mid-week #MAAction game Tuesday night against Akron.
- OL **Tony Georges** switched sides in the rivalry during the offseason and has started at the center position each of the past seven games for the Golden Flashes. The redshirt senior played in 33 games and made 19 starts for the Zips from 2021-23.
- Kent State has been among the most disciplined teams in the country, ranking 2nd among FBS teams in fewest penalty yards per game (30.20) and 6th in fewest penalties per games (4.20).
- WR **Chrishon McCray** caught his 8th TD of the season on the opening possession of last week's game at first-place Miami. McCray is tied for 7th on Kent State's all-time receiving TDs list with 12 in only 20 career games.
- In his first Wagon Wheel Game last November, McCray helped the Flashes build a 27-10 lead with 6 catches for 161 yards and 2 scores before suffering a season-ending injury on the second possession of the third quarter. The offense totaled just 22 yards the rest of the night as Akron scored 21 unanswered in the fourth quarter for the come-from-behind victory.

Series History

- Kent State is 28-36-2 all-time against Akron.
- The Golden Flashes had a 4-game winning streak in the rivalry ended last season in a 31-27 defeat.
- At home, Kent State has gone 17-10.
- Of the 32 meetings since the Zips joined the Mid-American Conference in 1992, 14 have been decided by 8 or fewer points.
- Kent State is 4-10 in those games.

YEAR TWO | #ALLIN

The theme for year two of the #KentGRIT era is #AllIn, as getting everyone in the program on the same page and in alignment with the culture was a main goal and objective of the off-season. In addition to continuing to bring the returning players closer together, this philosophy was a factor in deciding to add each of the 23 transfers who are members of this year's roster.

RUNNING TO THE TOP

Head coach **Kenni Burns** was a running back at Indiana and is the all-time leading rusher at Sacred Heart Griffin High School in Springfield, Illinois. Burns is one of five reported FBS head coaches to have been a collegiate running back, joining Thomas Hammock (NIU RB and HC), Dino Babers (Syracuse HC, Hawaii RB), Stan Drayton (Allegheny RB, Temple HC) and Kalani Sitake (BYU RB and HC). Georgia's Kirby Smart and South Carolina's Shane Beamer were running back coaches before getting head coaching positions.

FAMILIAR FRIEND

After sitting out the 2023 campaign as a two-time transfer, **Ky Thomas** has bolstered the Flashes' backfield. The running back re-joins a familiar friend in head coach **Kenni Burns**, who coached Thomas at Minnesota during the 2021 season. Thomas ran for 824 yards and six scores as a Golden Gopher, highlighted by a career-high 144 yards and Offensive MVP honors during a Guaranteed Rate Bowl victory. The 2019 Kansas Gatorade Player of Year then returned home to play for the Jayhawks in 2022.

POMP AND CIRCUMSTANCE

Head coach **Kenni Burns** has continued to raise the academic standard for his student-athletes, resulting in the highest term GPA (3.120) and cumulative GPA (3.124) in program history this past spring. Twenty Golden Flashes have earned their undergraduate degree, with five earning the honor from Kent State.

TEAM IMPACT

In 2022, the Golden Flashes signed **Kingston Woods**, the toughest, most resilient kid in Northeast Ohio, through the university's partnership with Team IMPACT, a non-profit organization that tackles the emotional trauma and social isolation experienced by children facing serious and chronic illnesses by matching them with a college athletics team. Kingston signed his letter of intent at the annual spring showcase, then closed out the afternoon with the ringing of the victory bell.

Graduate offensive lineman **Cameron Golden** represents Kent State as a Team IMPACT fellow, working with the organization and serving as a liaison between teams, families and the organization. Golden participated in a leadership and Team IMPACT seminar in Boston over the summer, working with other student-athletes and fellows on how to best serve Team IMPACT.

HONORING #54 JASON BITSKO

On Aug. 20, 2014, during a preseason practice, Kent State's football team received tragic news of the unexpected overnight death of **Jason Bitsko**. The fourth-year junior had become a team leader, mentor and friend to many both on and off the field. In Bitsko's honor, the number 54 is now worn by a select offensive lineman every season. This season, tackle **Cameron Golden** has earned the honor, which also serves as the single digit equivalency and captaincy of the offensive line.

SELECT COMPANY

Kent State is one of 11 schools who have 10 or fewer players in their final year of eligibility who have played their entire career at the same school. Leading the Flashes is linebacker **Matt Harmon**, who began his college football career in 2018.

The Flashes are also second in the nation in fewest returning players from the 2023 season, bringing back 57 players. They are one of five teams with under 60 returners. Of those returners, 18 players were consistent starters last season. The Flashes return their top passer, receiver and rusher from a season ago.

STAYING DISCIPLINED

Kent State has been among the most disciplined teams in the nation, ranking second in penalty yards against per game (30.20) and fourth in penalties against per game (4.20). The Flashes have been flagged for four or fewer penalties in seven of 10 games this season.

STARTING EARLY

Seven true freshmen have combined to make 21 starts this season for the Flashes. WR **Dashawn Martin** started each of the first nine games and is third on the team in receiving yards (108). OL **Elijah Williams** was the starting center for each of the first three games prior to injury, while LB **Jayden Studio** (4), RB **Ayden Harris** (2), WR **Jay Jay Etheridge** (1), CB **Jaire Rawlison** (1) and QB **Ruel Tomlinson** (1) have also made starts.

BIG PLAY McCRAY

All-MAC First Team WR **Chrishon McCray**, who is referred to as "Big Play McCray" within the program, returned to form in the MAC opener against Eastern Michigan by catching five balls for 188 yards and scores from 65 and 68 yards out. McCray followed his first big performance since suffering a season-ending injury last November with a career-high 213 yards and three touchdowns this past Saturday against Ball State. This was his third consecutive game against a MAC opponent with 161 or more receiving yards.

One of only 15 FBS players with at least three offensive plays of 60 or more yards this season, McCray totaled 90-plus yards after catch in each of the first two MAC contests. He is tied for 15th nationally in receiving TDs (8) and third in the MAC in yards per catch (16.54).

DYNAMIC DUO

All-MAC WRs **Chrishon McCray** (612 yds, 8 TDs) and **Luke Floriea** (547 yds, 5 TDs) are among the most productive wideout duo in the conference this season, combining for 74 receptions, 1,159 yards and 12 TDs. Both wideouts have multiple 100-yard performances and rank in the top-11 in the MAC for receiving yards. The pair have accounted for 63.2% of the team's receptions and 75.6% of receiving yards.

MILESTONE MEN

RB **Ky Thomas** eclipsed 1,000 career rushing yards during the second quarter of Kent State's opener at Pitt on Aug. 31. Thomas is the Flashes' leading rusher and has already surpassed his nine-game total with Kansas in 2022 with 389 yards, giving him 1,483 as a collegian.

WRs **Chrishon McCray** and **Luke Floriea** both went over 1,000 receiving yards against Ball State on Oct. 12. McCray (1,222 yards) reached the milestone in just 16 games, while Floriea (1,169 yards) did so during his 42nd game in a Kent State uniform.

HULA BOWL BOUND

WR **Luke Floriea** has accepted an invitation to play in the 79th Hula Bowl College Football All-Star Game in Orlando on Jan. 11th, 2025. The Hula Bowl is the nation's premier college football all-star game, where top scouts from the NFL, UFL, and CFL come to evaluate standout talent during Hula Bowl week. Floriea joins **Eugene Baker** (1999) and **Jason Gavadza** (2000) as Golden Flashes who have participated in the game.

GOLD(EN) STANDARD

Graduate student **Cameron Golden** has built quite an impressive resume beyond the gridiron by taking on several leadership roles at the department and conference levels. In addition to being a Team IMPCT fellow, Golden was voted by his peers as President of Kent State's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC). He also serves on the Executive Committee for the MAC Council of Student-Athletes (COSA).

TACKLING MACHINE

In his first season as a starter, S **Josh Baka** leads the defense with 73 total tackles and is tied for 12th nationally with 51 solo tackles. Baka's career-high 18 tackles, against Ohio on Nov. 6 are the most by a KSU defender since **Kevin Bourne** had 21 in the 2016 finale. He is one of only 8 FBS players who have made 12 or more solo stops in a game this season.

#MACTION MATES

The defense has been bolstered by a pair of transfers from within the MAC in LB **Canaan Williams** (Bowling Green) and DE **Kameron Olds** (Buffalo). Williams, who has started 7 games at the Will and Mike positions, has totaled 38 tackles and is coming off a career-high performance with 7 stops last week at Miami. A pass-rush specialist, Olds is tied for third in the conference with 6.0 sacks while totaling 39 tackles and 1 interception.

SPECIAL TEAMS, SPECIAL PLAYERS

Josh Smith has helped the Flashes flip the field with his combination of power and precision kicking. Smith is the MAC leader in punts inside of the 20 (20) and has boomed 11 punts of 50+ yards, which ranks second. The four-year starter is averaging a career-best 42.3 yards per punt in 2024.

Prior to being elevated to the starting kicker role to start conference play, **Will Hryszko** was 1/1 on PATs and booted 10 kickoffs during his Flashes career. Hryszko drilled all three of his PATs and recorded a touchback on three of four kickoff attempts against Eastern Michigan. He accounted for all of Kent State's points at Bowling Green on Oct. 19 with field goals from 37 and 30 yards.

The first non-offensive TD of the #KentGRIT era was scored during the second quarter of the season opener at Pitt, as CB **Naim Muhammad** scooped up a bouncing ball while on punt coverage and raced 34 yards for the score. LB **Nylan Brown** stripped the Pitt returner of the ball to ignite the Flashes' first fumble recovery for a TD since the 2018 campaign.



BATTLE FOR THE WAGON WHEEL

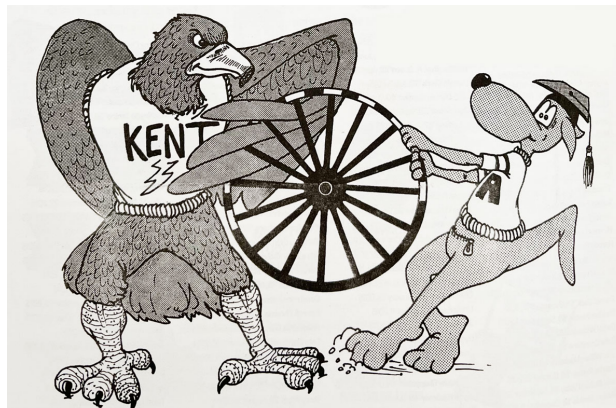
Dating back to 1946, Kent State and Akron have play for one of the more unique trophies in college football, the Wagon Wheel. The trophy is displayed in a neutral location during the (now) annual rivalry game, with the winner painting the wheel in its school colors. The Golden Flashes lead the series 27-25-1 since the trophy was introduced.

The schools first met on the gridiron in 1923 and played nearly every season through 1954. After not playing in the 1960s and meeting just three times in the 1970s, the rivalry game took place nine times from 1981-90. The teams have played every season Akron joined the Mid-American Conference in 1992, with the Zips holding a 19-13 advantage during this era.

The Wagon Wheel history dates back to the spring of 1870 when Akron industrialist John R. Buchtel set out for the town of Kent in search of a site to establish a college. It was muddy in the Ohio fields and his wagon became stuck in the area where Kent State University is now located.

When horses pulled the wagon, a wheel came off and became buried, not to be discovered until 1902, during the construction of a pipeline along the Western Reserve Trail.

Dr. Raymond Manchester, Kent State dean of men, acquired the wagon wheel and, in 1945, suggested the local historic artifact be given as the trophy to the winner of the annual Kent State - Akron football game.
