Kent State begins Mid-American Conference play on the road with a 2 p.m. tip scheduled for Saturday against Bowling Green.

The Golden Flashes made history on Monday with the largest margin of victory in the program's record book, defeating Davis & Elkins, 117-37. Kent State shot just under 60% from the field and eight players reached double-figures to contribute to the third highest single-game scoring performance in program history. **Mya Babbitt** led the way with 19 points and **Rylee Kalocay** posted career-highs in points (16), rebounds (6), assists (6) and steals (4).

Mya Babbitt is the MAC's third leading scorer at 15.7 ppg and has two of the top four single-game scoring performances in the league. Babbitt is tied for second in the conference with 25 three-point field goals and is the Flashes' second leading rebounder (4.9 rpg). **Janae Tyler** (10.5 ppg) and **Riley Rismiller** (8.6 ppg) provide low post options. Rismiller has three double-doubles and ranks seventh in the MAC in rebounding with 7.3 per game. **Dionna Gray** (4.4 ppg) is fifth in the MAC in assists with 5.2 per game.

Bowling Green has won six straight games by an average margin of 36.2 points and are the MAC's top scoring team at 75.8 ppg. Defensively, the Falcons rank in the top three in steals per game (11.0), turnovers forced per game (20.2) and blocks per game (4.6). Bowling Green is 7-0 when forcing 18 or more turnovers.

Paige Kohler recorded the first triple-double in program history during Sunday's win over Lourdes and enters league play with averages of 14.8 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 4.0 apg. Johnnea Donahue adds 12.9 ppg and ranks sixth in the country with 3.9 steals per game. Lauren Gerken (6.2 ppg), Taya Ellis (6.1 ppg) and Jaedyn Cook (5.5 ppg) each have at least 10 blocks.

THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, *The Years of Youth*, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

STARKEY RECORDS 300TH CAREER VICTORY

- Head coach **Todd Starkey** earned his 300th career win on Jan. 27 as Kent State defeated Bowling Green, 82-74.
- Now in his 10th season guiding the Golden Flashes' program, Starkey surpassed **Laurel Wartluft** (1977-86) for second on the all-time wins list with 143.
- Varsity K Hall of Fame member **Bob Lindsay** owns the program standard and is the winningest coach in Mid-American Conference history.

- Kent State's three-game winning streak came to an end inside of the Stroh Center.
- Lexi Fleming shot 6-of-7 from three-point range and scored a BG single-quarter record 21 points to help the host lead 30-18 after 10 minutes.
- After falling behind by 23 late in the second period, the Golden Flashes scored the next 11 and got the deficit back to single-digits with 2:08 remaining in the third quarter on a jumper by **Jenna Batsch**.
- Kent State shot just 5-of-17 the rest of the game.
- The Flashes played without a pair of post players and were outrebounded 40-28.
- Batsch led KSU with 25 points and **Tatiana Thomas** tied her career-high with 14.
- Fleming cooled down and finished with 25 points, while Paige Kohler added 18 and game-high 8 rebounds.

CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the Todd Starkey era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year **Larissa Lurken** made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State is 14th in the nation in free throws per game (14.13), 22nd in free throws made (4,013).

JUNIORS NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-MAC TEAMS

- Forward **Janae Tyler** and guard **Mya Babbitt** were selected to the 10-member Preseason All-MAC teams, as voted on by the conference's 13 head coaches.
- Despite being sidelined for 10 games last season, Tyler was an All-MAC honorable mention selection with averages of 11.6 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.
- Over her last 10 games played (missed final two games of regular season), Tyler's production rose to 14.3 points and 6.3 rebounds per contest.
- Babbitt had a breakout sophomore season, boosting her scoring output from 2.4 points per game as a freshman to 11.8.
- She made a program record 83 three-point field goals and led the MAC with 41.3% accuracy from behind the arc.

PASSING ON THE PORTAL

- For the second year in a row, Kent State did not have a player enter the transfer portal.
- The Golden Flashes are 1 of only 4 Division I programs who not lost a player to the portal each of the past two offseasons.
- Stability has also been a cornerstone under head coach **Todd Starkey**, as associate head coach **Fran Recchia** and assistant coach **Alexa Golden** have been part of the program for all 10 seasons of the Starkey era.
- Recchia was an assistant coach on Starkey's inaugural staff before being promoted in July 2018.
- Golden was a starter on Starkey's first three squads and has been a member of the staff in various roles since graduation.

HEAD COACH TODD STARKEY

Todd Starkey was hired as the sixth head coach of the Kent State Women's Basketball team in April 2016.

Already the second-winningest coach in school history with 164 victories, Starkey has led the Golden Flashes to one NCAA Tournament appearance, four Postseason WNITs and two Mid-American Conference East Division titles. His teams have recorded four 20-win seasons,

including 21 victories each of the past three years.

Starkey has found much success in recruiting talented student-athletes, landing two of the highest-touted signing classes in school history back-to-back in 2018 and 2019. Both classes had two student-athletes earn spots on the MAC All-Freshman Team, while only one other school had multiple honorees over the two seasons. Nila Blackford led all conference freshmen in rebounding during the 2019-20 season. Led by Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall, the 2018 class ranked second nationally with 964 points. Overall, these two classes have combined for four All-MAC honors and a pair of MAC All-Defensive Team nods.

The 2021-22 season ended with a berth in the WNIT for the Golden Flashes and a final record of 19-12. The season was highlighted by wins over two Power 5 programs at the Gulf Coast Showcase in Estero, Florida and a win in the WNIT. First, the Flashes took down #19 UCLA, 75-69 at the showcase. Two days later, Penn State was the victim as the Flashes won 81-74. Later in the year, Youngstown State couldn't handle the Golden Flashes in the WNIT, as Kent came out on top, 68-59. That win was the second postseason WNIT win in program history. The Flashes boasted the second best defense by points per game allowed in the MAC and were second in the MAC for three-point percentage. The 21-22 season also saw Starkey become the third coach to reach 100 wins at Kent State.

The Flashes advanced to the MAC Tournament quarterfinals for the fifth year in a row in the unique 2020-21 season. Kent State's three all-conference selections were tied for the most of any team in the league. In the MAC opener against Ohio, the Flashes set a new program record with 16 three-point field goals. Lindsey Thall was the conference's top shot blocker for the third straight season.

Kent State was playing its best ball of the year, having won seven of its last nine games, when a potential 2019-20 season-to-remember was unexpectedly cut short with the cancelation of the MAC Tournament. The East Division champions knocked off defending tournament champion Buffalo in a quarterfinal matchup and was the highest-remaining seed in the field. For the third time in the first four seasons under Starkey's guidance, Kent State finished in the top-100 of the RPI. Five players averaged more than 11 points per game with guards Megan Carter and Katie Shumate earning All-MAC honorable mention selections.

The 2018-19 season saw Kent State post its first 20-win campaign in eight years while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited

Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 26-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling and player development.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country during the 2016-17 season with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. Korinek was then named to the first team in 2018. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

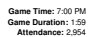
