The Kent State women's basketball team will hold the annual Play4Kay game as Mid-American Conference play resumes against Miami on Saturday.

The Golden Flashes handed Troy its first home loss of the season last Saturday, recording a wire-to-wire 84-73 victory in a MAC-Sun Belt Conference Challenge contest. Kent State opened with an 11-0 lead and never allowed the Trojans to get closer than four points. **Janae Tyler** scored a career-high 26 points and **Jenna Batsch** added 20 points and seven assists. **Dionna Gray** matched her career-high with nine assists.

Preseason All-MAC First Team selection **Jenna Batsch** (16.6 ppg, 4.1 apg) is the only player in the conference averaging at least 16 points and four assists per game. **Bridget Dunn** (8.6 ppg) ranks fifth in the nation in defensive rebounding (8.5 drpg) and 26th overall in rebounds per game (9.9). **Mya Babbitt** (12.1 ppg) leads the MAC with 61 three-pointers and has made 40.9% of attempts from beyond the arc. **Janae Tyler** (10.9 ppg) has scored more consistently in recent games, averaging 13.5 ppg over the last eight contests. **Dionna Gray** averages 8.3 ppg and 4.9 apg while leading Kent State to an 14-5 record in games played this season.

Defense has been key to Miami already matching last season's conference win total. The RedHawks rank in the top-30 in the country in scoring defense (56.0 ppg), steals per game (11.9), turnovers forced per game (21.7) and defensive rating (80.9).

Enjulina Gonzalez is the only three-time MAC Player of the Week recipient this season. Gonzalez ranks third in the conference in scoring at 17.0 ppg and shoots 41.9% on three-point attempts. Amber Tretter adds 10.5 ppg and grabs a team-high 8.0 rpg, which puts her fifth in the MAC. Guard Tamar Singer (6.4 ppg) leads the RedHawks with averages of 3.9 apg and 2.1 spg.

THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, The Years of Youth, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

STARKEY RECORDS 300TH CAREER VICTORY

- Head coach **Todd Starkey** earned his 300th career win on Jan. 27 as Kent State defeated Bowling Green, 82-74.
- Now in his ninth season guiding the Golden Flashes' program, Starkey surpassed **Laurel Wartluft** (1977-86) for second on the all-time wins list with 143.
- Varsity K Hall of Fame member **Bob Lindsay** owns the program standard and is the winningest coach in Mid-American Conference history.

CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the Todd Starkey era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year **Larissa Lurken** made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State is 15th in the nation in free throws per game (14.11), 23rd in free throws made (3,740).

CHARITY STRIPE SUCCESS

- Kent State has been among the best free throw shooting teams in the country this season. The Golden Flashes rank second the nation in free throw percentage (.806) and rank 31st in free throws made per game (14.38).
- Senior **Jenna Batsch** made her first 22 free throws of the season and is 92-of-99 overall after 24 games. Batsch's 92.9% ranks seventh among all Division I players from the charity stripe.
- A career 86.4% shooter from the charity stripe, Batsch needs 16 more attempts to qualify for Kent State's career leaderboard. **Dawn Zerman** (1996-00) and **Amy Slowikowski** (1987-90) both shot 84.5% and sit atop the all-time list.
- Sophomore **Riley Rismiller** shoots 89.8% at the foul line, which is the best accuracy in the country among players list at 6-4 or taller.
- Rismiller is one of only eight players in the nation to have shot at least 93% in a game with a minimum of 15 attempts with her 14-of-15 performance in the season opener against James Madison.
- Junior **Dionna Gray** shot 11-of-11 at the foul line during her season debut against Duquesne last Wednesday, becoming the first Golden Flash to be perfect in a game with at least 10 attempts since **Megan Carter** went 12-of-12 against St. Bonaventure on Dec. 3, 2019.

ONE (SHOT) AND DUNN

- Senior **Bridget Dunn** has played a major role in limiting opponents to 7.8 second-chance points per contest and ranks fifth in Division I with an average of 8.5 defensive rebounds per game.
- Dunn has grabbed 10 or more defensive boards nine times this season and has recorded 13 double-digit total rebounding performances.
- The Carmel, Indiana native ranks 26th in the country in overall rebounding (9.9 rpg) and seeks to become the first Kent State player to lead the MAC since **Tracey Lynn** during the 1990-91 season (10.7 rpg).
- Dunn grabbed a career-high 18 boards during the Golden Flashes overtime loss at Coppin State on Dec. 19, which is tied for the ninth-highest single-game rebounding effort in program history.
- As a team, Kent State is eighth nationally in defensive rebounds per game (30.0) and 18th in rebounding margin (+8.3).
- The Flashes have totaled at least 53 rebounds in four games this season, a feat that occurred just once over the previous two seasons.
- The team's current average of 40.8 rebounds per contest puts it on pace to join 1980-81 (1,393) and 1986-87 (1,310) as the only squads to reach 1,300 rebounds.

THREE-POINT RECORD WATCH

- The Kent State single-season three-point field goals made records by an individual and team could both be broken before the season ends.
- Sophomore **Mya Babbitt** leads the Mid-American Conference with 61 three-pointers and is on pace to beat the current record of 71 set by **Melissa DeGrate** 20 years ago.
- Babbitt is knocking down attempts from long range at a 40.9% clip and has made multiple three-pointers in 17 of 24 games this season.
- The Golden Flashes have drained 197 three-point field goals as a team and are just behind pace of the record 266 made during the 2022-23 campaign.
- Seniors **Bridget Dunn** and **Jenna Batsch** have made at least 40 triples each and have been reliable shooters for Kent State throughout the past four seasons.
- Dunn moved ahead of **Kathy Carroll** for fourth on the career three-pointers list at Troy on Feb. 8 and now has 162 as a Flash. She needs 16 more to tie **Katie Shumate** for third.
- Batsch is a career 37.7% shooter from three-point range and needs seven to reach 100 for her career.

HEAD COACH TODD STARKEY

Todd Starkey was hired as the sixth head coach of the Kent State Women's Basketball team in April 2016.

Already the third-winningest coach in school history with 101 victories, Starkey has led the Golden Flashes to three Postseason WNIT appearances and two Mid-American Conference East Division titles.

Starkey has found much success in recruiting talented student-athletes, landing two of the highest-touted signing classes in school history back-to-back in 2018 and 2019. Both classes had two student-athletes earn spots on the MAC All-Freshman Team, while only one other school had multiple honorees over the two seasons. Nila Blackford led all conference freshmen in rebounding during the 2019-20 season. Led by Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall, the 2018 class ranked second nationally with 964 points. Overall, these two classes have combined for four All-MAC honors and a pair of MAC All-Defensive Team nods.

The 2021-22 season ended with a berth in the WNIT for the Golden Flashes and a final record of 19-12. The season was highlighted by wins over two Power 5 programs at the Gulf Coast Showcase in Estero, Florida and a win in the WNIT. First, the Flashes took down #19 UCLA, 75-69 at the showcase. Two days later, Penn State was the victim as the Flashes won 81-74. Later in the year, Youngstown State couldn't handle the Golden Flashes in the WNIT, as Kent came out on top, 68-59. That win was the second postseason WNIT win in program history. The Flashes boasted the second best defense by points per game allowed in the MAC and were second in the MAC for three-point percentage. The 21-22 season also saw Starkey become the third coach to reach 100 wins at Kent State.

The Flashes advanced to the MAC Tournament quarterfinals for the fifth year in a row in the unique 2020-21 season. Kent State's three all-conference selections were tied for the most of any team in the league. In the MAC opener against Ohio, the Flashes set a new program record with 16 three-point field goals. Lindsey Thall was the conference's top shot blocker for the third straight season and enters this season third in school history.

Kent State was playing its best ball of the year, having won seven of its last nine games, when a potential 2019-20 season-to-remember was unexpectedly cut short with the cancelation of the MAC Tournament. The East Division champions knocked off defending tournament champion Buffalo in a quarterfinal matchup and was the highest-remaining seed in the field. For the third time in the first four seasons under Starkey's guidance, Kent State finished in the top-100 of the RPI. Five players averaged more than 11 points per game with guards Megan Carter and Katie Shumate earning All-MAC honorable mention selections.

The 2018-19 season saw Kent State post its first 20-win campaign in eight years while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to

within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 24-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling, player development and technology applications.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country during the 2016-17 season with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. Korinek was then named to the first team in 2018. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

Starkey got his coaching career started at his alma mater, Montreat College, in North Carolina. He was an assistant men's basketball coach for five seasons (1998-03), helping the team to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 2000.

Starkey grew up in nearby Canfield, Ohio, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in outdoor education from Montreat College. His playing career began in basketball and tennis at Mars Hill College.
