#### THE GAME

Kent State will host Ball State at the M.A.C. Center on Sunday at noon for a Mid-American Conference women's basketball contest that will be broadcast nationally on CBS Sports Network.

The Golden Flashes had their four-game winning streak ended on Wednesday with a 59-53 setback at Toledo. Kent State led by as many as six points during the fourth quarter but missed its final five shots as the Rockets closed with an 11-2 run. **Riley Rismiller** led in the scoring column with 13 points and **Anna Campanelli** was right behind with 12.

**Mya Babbitt** is the fourth leading scorer in the MAC at 15.9 ppg and has two of the top six single-game scoring performances in the league. Babbitt is second in the conference with 44 three-point field goals. **Riley Rismiller** (8.8 ppg) and **Tatiana Thomas** (7.4 ppg) provide low post options. Rismiller has three double-doubles and ranks ninth in the MAC in rebounding with 6.0 per game, while Thomas is grabbing 6.5 boards per conference contest. **Dionna Gray** (5.5 ppg) is fourth in the MAC in assists with 5.2 per game.

Ball State bounced back from its first conference loss last Saturday with a 76-70 road victory over Central Michigan on Wednesday. The Cardinals lead the MAC in scoring (77.0 ppg), field goal percentage defense (.368), rebounding margin (+10.5) and assists per game (18.4).

Bree Salenbien (14.9 ppg, 8.2 rpg) and Tessa Towers (13.4 ppg, 8.1 rpg) have six double-doubles each and give Ball State one of the top interior duos in the conference. Grace Kingery (12.1 ppg) is the MAC leader with 52 three-point field goals and Karsyn Norman (9.5 ppg) has a 1.75 assist-to-turnover ratio to rank second in the league.

## THE GOLDEN FLASHES NICKNAME

The origin of the nickname "Golden Flashes" has been a topic of debate. According to documentation in Phillip Shiver's book, *The Years of Youth*, widely regarded as historically correct, the reason for Kent State's nickname is noted in a letter to Linda Baughman, dated Aug. 6, 1959. Merle Wagoner recalled that the change in the name of Kent State athletics teams from "Silver Foxes" to "Golden Flashes" occurred in 1926 after the dismissal of President John E. McGilvrey (Kent State's first nickname originated from McGilvrey, who had a silver fox farm east of campus).

With Acting President T. Howard Winters providing the impetus, a contest was held (with a \$25 first prize) to select the new name. No special significance was attached to the winning suggestion, which was used first in 1927 by the basketball team after it had been approved by the student body and the faculty athletic committee. Also laying claim to the origin was Oliver Wolcott, one-time Kent State grid great who played center on the 1921 and 1922 teams. As former sports editor of the Kent Courier Tribune, the local newspaper, the name "Silver Foxes" seemed pretty frail to him. So, during the 1927 football season, he began referring to the team as "Golden Flashes."

## STARKEY RECORDS 300TH CAREER VICTORY

- Head coach **Todd Starkey** earned his 300th career win on Jan. 27 as Kent State defeated Bowling Green, 82-74.
- Now in his 10th season guiding the Golden Flashes' program, Starkey surpassed **Laurel Wartluft** (1977-86) for second on the all-time wins list with 143.
- Varsity K Hall of Fame member **Bob Lindsay** owns the program standard and is the winningest coach in Mid-American Conference history.

## KENT STATE - BALL STATE NOTES

- Kent State leads the series, 43-27.
- The visiting teams won both regular season meetings last year and Ball State took the rubber match in the MAC Tournament semifinals.
- The Golden Flashes have held the Cardinals below 65 points in eight of the last 13 meetings.
- Kent State is 27-7 all-time in matchups inside of the M.A.C. Center but Ball State has been victorious in its past two visits.
- The Flashes are 6-9 vs. Ball State under head coach **Todd Starkey**.

## FLASH BACK: (MARCH 14, 2025)

### BALL STATE 70, KENT STATE 53

- Ball State avenged a MAC Tournament semifinals loss the previous season with a wire-to-wire victory.
- After a three-pointer by **Jenna Batsch** on its opening possession, Kent State went nearly six minutes without scoring. Batsch ended the drought with another triple.
- The Golden Flashes made just one more basket in the quarter and trailed 20-8.
- A pair of baskets by **Tatiana Thomas** brought Kent State back within single-digits and trailing 34-26 at halftime.
- Ball State closed the third period with an 8-0 run to lead by 18 entering the fourth.
- Advantages in three-pointers (10-4) and points off turnovers (22-6) were key for the Cardinals.
- Batsch led the Flashes with 14 points and **Bridget Dunn** grabbed 13 rebounds to break KSU's single-season record (332).
- Lachelle Austin had a game-high 21 points to lead Ball State to the championship game for the second time in the last four years.

## CHARITABLE FLASHES

Getting to the free throw line has been a focus of Kent State's offensive game plan during the Todd Starkey era. The Golden Flashes led the country in free throws made (594) and ranked seventh in free throws attempted (794) during the 2016-17 season. That same season, MAC Player of the Year **Larissa Lurken** made a NCAA Division I record 280 free throws, which included a MAC record 22 against WKU on Nov. 26, 2016.

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Kent State is 13th in the nation in free throws per game (14.14) and tied for 22nd in free throws made (4,170).

- Recchia was an assistant coach on Starkey's inaugural staff before being promoted in July 2018.
- Golden was a starter on Starkey's first three squads and has been a member of the staff in various roles since graduation.
- Assistant coach **Paige Salisbury** was a teammate of Golden on Starkey's first team and returned in the Director of Basketball Operations role for the 2022-23 season and was promoted to assistant coach prior to the following season.

## 90 PERCENT CLUB

- Over the first 1,449 games in the history of Kent State women's basketball, only one player every posted a game with at least 10 made shots and a field goal percentage of 90.0 or higher - **Amy Slowikowski** accomplished the feat by shooting 10-of-11 (.909) against Ball State on February 3, 1988.
- In the next two games, the Golden Flashes had a player join Slowikowski in this exclusive club while breaking her single-game field goal percentage record by shooting 11-of-12 from the floor for 91.7 percent.
- Forward **Emory Klatt** scored a career-high 29 points in her record-setting performance against Akron on January 17. Klatt made her first nine shots of the contest, extending her consecutive makes streak to 16 following a 7-for-7 performance in the previous game against Ohio.
- Center **Riley Rismiller** matched her teammate last Saturday and scored a career-high 25 points in a victory at Buffalo.
- There have only been seven performances this season of a player shooting at least 90 percent with a minimum of 11 made shots.
- Klatt and Rismiller are the only pair of teammates to accomplish the feat and are also the only players to do so against a conference opponent.

## INSIDE THE RECENT FOUR-GAME WINNING STREAK

- Following an 0-4 start the MAC play, Kent State found success going inside during a four-game winning streak.
- The Golden Flashes averaged 37.5 points in the paint per game and scored at least 40 in three of the four contests.
- Forward **Emory Klatt** and center **Riley Rismiller** combined to average 25.5 points with an 80.0 field goal percentage during the streak.
- Klatt** averaged 14.8 points per game on 23-of-26 shooting for an incredible 88.5 percent. The sophomore made 16 consecutive field goals at one point and was named MAC Player of the Week on January 20. Her career-high 29 points are the most by any post player in the conference this season.
- Rismiller** averaged 10.8 points per game on 17-of-24 shooting for 70.8 percent. The junior scored a career-high 25 points during the Golden Flashes' victory at Buffalo last Saturday.
- Forward **Bianca Juzzo** started the final three games of the winning streak after scoring a season-high 11 points in the first game of the streak at Eastern Michigan on January 10.
- Juzzo, who totaled just 28 points and 91 minutes played during KSU's first 15 games, averaged 7.0 points and 3.3 rebounds in the four victories.
- Led by Klatt, the Flashes' bench contributed 34.5 points per game during the streak.
- Freshmen **Anna Campanelli** (9.3 ppg) and **Caitlyn Holmes** (5.3 ppg) increased their production and recorded career-best scoring performances.
- Campanelli scored 19 points last Saturday at Buffalo, while Holmes had 10 in the first game of the streak at Eastern Michigan on January 10.

## CHARITY STRIPE SUCCESS

- Kent State is among the most accurate free throw shooting teams in the country once again this season and ranks 17th in the nation with a 77.9% success rate at the charity stripe.
- In addition to being efficient, the Golden Flashes are making 15.5 free throws per contest, which ranks 21st nationally.
- Junior **Mya Babbitt** has shot 55-of-61 from the foul line this season for 90.2% to rank 14th in the country.
- Senior **Dionna Gray** is 42-of-48 for 87.5% and does not qualify for the national rankings.

# HEAD COACH TODD STARKEY

**T**odd Starkey was hired as the sixth head coach of the Kent State Women's Basketball team in April 2016.

Already the second-winningest coach in school history with 164 victories, Starkey has led the Golden Flashes to one NCAA Tournament appearance, four Postseason WNITs and two Mid-American Conference East Division titles. His teams have recorded four 20-win seasons, including 21 victories each of the past three years.

Starkey has found much success in recruiting talented student-athletes, landing two of the highest-touted signing classes in school history back-to-back in 2018 and 2019. Both classes had two student-athletes earn spots on the MAC All-Freshman Team, while only one other school had multiple honorees over the two seasons. Nila Blackford led all conference freshmen in rebounding during the 2019-20 season. Led by Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall, the 2018 class ranked second nationally with 964 points. Overall, these two classes have combined for four All-MAC honors and a pair of MAC All-Defensive Team nods.

The 2021-22 season ended with a berth in the WNIT for the Golden Flashes and a final record of 19-12. The season was highlighted by wins over two Power 5 programs at the Gulf Coast Showcase in Estero, Florida and a win in the WNIT. First, the Flashes took down #19 UCLA, 75-69 at the showcase. Two days later, Penn State was the victim as the Flashes won 81-74. Later in the year, Youngstown State couldn't handle the Golden Flashes in the WNIT, as Kent came out on top, 68-59. That win was the second postseason WNIT win in program history. The Flashes boasted the second best defense by points per game allowed in the MAC and were second in the MAC for three-point percentage. The 21-22 season also saw Starkey become the third coach to reach 100 wins at Kent State.

The Flashes advanced to the MAC Tournament quarterfinals for the fifth year in a row in the unique 2020-21 season. Kent State's three all-conference selections were tied for the most of any team in the league. In the MAC opener against Ohio, the Flashes set a new program record with 16 three-point field goals. Lindsey Thall was the conference's top shot blocker for the third straight season.

Kent State was playing its best ball of the year, having won seven of its last nine games, when a potential 2019-20 season-to-remember was unexpectedly cut short with the cancellation of the MAC Tournament. The East Division champions knocked off defending tournament champion Buffalo in a quarterfinal matchup and was the highest-remaining seed in the field. For the third time in the first four seasons under Starkey's guidance, Kent State finished in the top-100 of the RPI. Five players averaged more than 11 points per game with guards Megan Carter and Katie Shumate earning All-MAC honorable mention selections.

The 2018-19 season saw Kent State post its first 20-win campaign in eight years while breaking a 25-year-old school record with 241 three-point field goals made. The Flashes finished with the highest RPI ranking (81) in program history and boasted four wins against RPI Top 100 teams, including a victory at Green Bay in the first round of the Postseason WNIT. Guards Megan Carter and Alexa Golden thrived in their third season under Starkey's tutelage, earning All-MAC Third Team and Defensive Team honors, respectively. All-Freshman Team selections Asiah Dingle and Lindsey Thall highlighted the second highest-scoring freshman class (964 points) in the country.

Starkey was named 2017 MAC Coach of the Year for his efforts in guiding Kent State to one of biggest turnarounds in NCAA Division I women's basketball during his first season on the sidelines. The Golden Flashes finished the season with a 19-13 overall record and had the nation's largest RPI improvement, jumping 222 spots from the previous season, and the fifth most-improved record in the country. Despite being picked to finish last in the preseason, Kent State put together a 13-5 conference mark to win the program's first MAC East Division title since 2004-05. The regular season ended with a seven-game winning streak, which surpassed the number of conference games the team had won over the previous two seasons combined.

Behind the strength of five wins against RPI Top 100 teams, the Flashes received an at-large bid to the 2017 Postseason WNIT for the first time since the 2010-11 season. An angry Michigan squad that felt it deserved to play in the NCAA Tournament awaited

Kent State in the opening round. Down by 21 points at halftime, the Flashes fought back to within five with just over two minutes to play before falling, 67-60. The Wolverines went on to claim the WNIT championship.

The 26-year coaching veteran came to Kent State after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, where he was responsible for assisting with the program's recruiting, practice and game preparation, scouting reports, scheduling and player development.

During his second season in Bloomington in 2015-16, he helped lead the Hoosiers to a historic year as the team made its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance and grabbed its first win in the NCAA Tournament since 1983. Indiana finished the season with a 21-12 record, tying the school wins record, and was a perfect 14-0 at home. The Hoosiers finished fourth in the Big Ten, the school's highest conference finish in 18 years, and defeated three ranked opponents.

Starkey's time at IU began with a record-setting offensive performance, as the Hoosiers set single-game records for scoring (115) and 3-pointers made (16) in the season-opening win over Gardner-Webb on Nov. 15, 2014. The team would go on to post the program's best scoring average (71.9 ppg) since 1995-96 and make the second-most three-pointers (236) in a season.

His first head coaching job came at NCAA Division II Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory, North Carolina. Starkey concluded his nine-year tenure as the winningest coach in program history with a 165-95 record. Over his final six years, he led the Bears to four NCAA Tournament appearances and three Southern Atlantic Conference (SAC) regular season championships while averaging more than 20 wins per season. He received SAC Coach of the Year honors on four occasions, including a conference record three straight from 2009-11.

Starkey was named the 2009 Russell Athletic/WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year after leading Lenoir-Rhyne to one of the greatest seasons in program history. The Bears posted a 27-5 record and won both the conference regular season and tournament titles for the first time ever to earn the No. 1 seed in the NCAA Division II Southeast Regional Tournament. Lenoir-Rhyne won the first NCAA Tournament game in program history, 69-58, over Anderson before falling in the second round.

Academics are important to the Youngstown-area native. Kent State was the only Division I women's basketball program in the country during the 2016-17 season with two CoSIDA Academic All-America® selections, as Jordan Korinek and Larissa Lurken both earned second team honors. Korinek was then named to the first team in 2018. In his time at Lenoir-Rhyne, Starkey had 100-percent of the players who remained past their sophomore year graduate, while the team maintained a grade point average of 3.0 or higher every year.

Prior to his head coaching stint, Starkey served as an assistant coach for Lenoir-Rhyne's men's team for two seasons (2003-05). The team won the 2004 SAC regular season championship and made an NCAA postseason appearance.

Starkey got his coaching career started at his alma mater, Montreat College, in North Carolina. He was an assistant men's basketball coach for five seasons (1998-03), helping the team to an NAIA National Tournament appearance in 2000.

Starkey grew up in nearby Canfield, Ohio, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in outdoor education from Montreat College. His playing career began in basketball and tennis at Mars Hill College.
