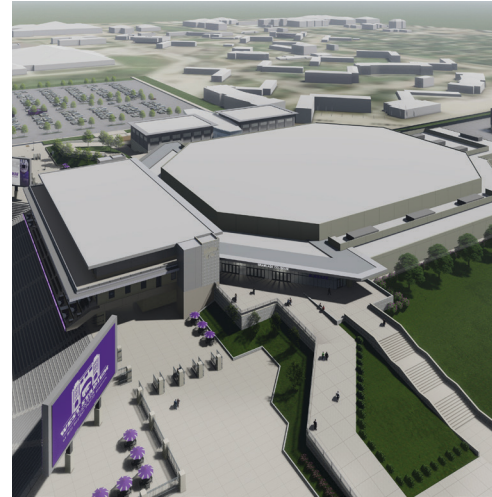




- ### SOUTH END ZONE UPGRADES

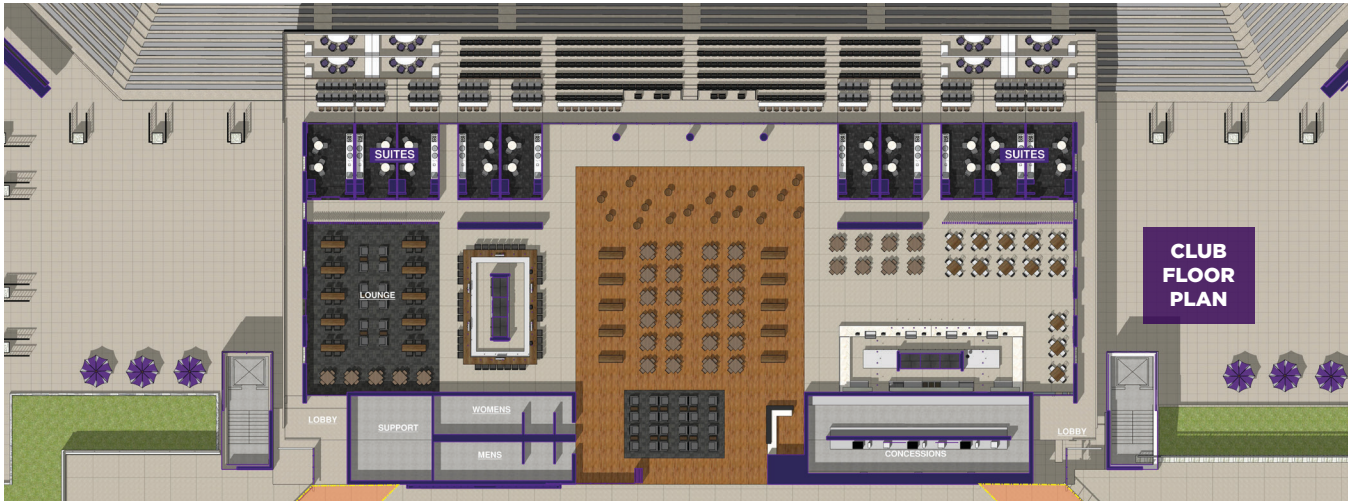

- New full service kitchen and bar with 12 points of sale for football and basketball

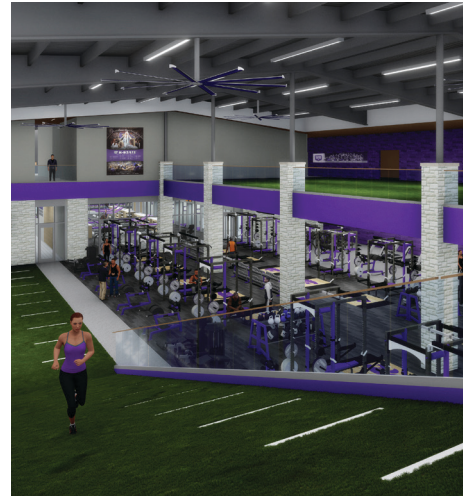

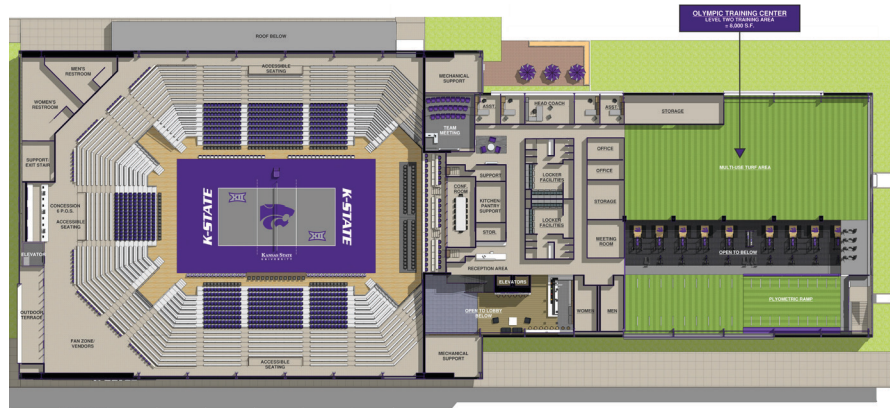
