THIS WEEK: Kennesaw State closes out its inaugural regular-season home schedule this week when it hosts No. 13/15 Charleston Southern Saturday (Nov. 7) at Fifth Third Bank Stadium. Kickoff is slated for 1 p.m.

**WATCH LIVE:** The Owls-Buccaneers game can be seen on the Big South Conference Network with Brian Katrek handling the play-by-play and Jimmy Robinson providing analysis.

**LISTEN LIVE:** A live audio broadcast with Brian Giffin, Tutan Reyes and Art Eckman describing the action will also be available at KSUOwls.com.

**SENIOR DAY:** Saturday's contest will mark Senior Day as Kennesaw State with recognize its four seniors - offensive lineman Brett Gillespie, running back Ryan Godhigh, defensive end Mason Harris and wide receiver Prentice Stone.

NATIONAL POLLS: For the third consecutive week. Kennesaw State appears in the STATS FCS Poll. The Owls received a program-high five votes after collecting two in each of the previous two weeks.

Charleston Southern enters the weekend ranked No. 13 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 15 in the STATS FCS rankings. The Buccaneers represent the first ranked opponent on the Owls

WHAT'S AT STAKE: A lot will be on the line when Charleston Southern and Kennesaw State meet on Saturday. The Owls (6-2, 2-1) are unbeaten at home (5-0) and remain in contention for the Big South Conference championship. Meanwhile, the Buccaneers are coming off a 33-25 win over then No. 1/3Coastal Carolina and can clinch a share of the league title and automatic berth to the FCS playoffs with a win.

**PROTECTING THE NEST: Kennesaw** State has posted its 5-0 record at Fifth Third Bank Stadium. The Owls have recorded wins over Edward Waters, Shorter, Point and Big South Conference opponents Gardner-Webb and Monmouth.

**INSIDE THE NUMBERS:** Something will have to give on Saturday as Kennesaw State enters the game ranked third in the FCS in total offense (455.2 ypg.) while Charleston Southern boasts the country's top-ranked defense, allowing 244.1 yards a game. On the flip side, the Owls are No. 11 in total defense (295.1) and the Buccaneers' rushing offense is No. 11, averaging 245.3 yards a game.

Coastal Carolina (2003), VMI (2003) and Monmouth (2014) won six games during their respective inaugural seasons in the Big South. When adding 2002 to the equation, Gardner-Webb had nine wins during the league's first year of football.

**SETTING A STANDARD:** KSU became the first newcomer to the league to win its first-ever conference game when the Owls defeated Gardner-Webb, 12-7, on Oct. 17. When including 2002, KSU is just the second team on the list, as GWU won its debut Big South game.

**A LOOK AHEAD:** The Owls will open a two-game road trip to close out its inaugural season schedule when it travels to Conway, S.C. to visit Coastal Carolina on Nov. 14. Kickoff is set for 2 p.m.

#### SCOUTING CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

- Charleston Southern represents the first nationally-ranked opponent Kennesaw State will play. The Buccaneers are No. 13 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 15 in the STATS FCS rankings.
- Charleston Southern is 7-1 overall and 4-0 in Big South Conference action after defeating top-ranked Coastal Carolina, 33-25, on Saturday.
- Charleston Southern is first nationally in total defense, allowing 244.1 yards per game. No Big South team has ever led the country in total defense.
- The Bucs became the first team in Big South history to hold three consecutive opponents to less than 200 yards of offense -- 112 to Monmouth, 142 to Presbyterian and 110 to Gardner-Webb.
- Charleston Southern is surrendering an average of 15.5 points, 105.8 rushing a yards and 138.4 passing yards a game to lead the Big South.
- The Buccaneers defense is led by senior linebacker Aaron Brown (51 tackles, 5 tackles for loss) and redshirt freshman linebacker Solomon Brown (42 tackles, 9.5 tackles for loss, 5 sacks).
- Charleston ranks fourth in the Big South Conference in total offense (398.1) and passing offense (152.9) and 11th in the FCS rushing offense (245.3).
- The Bucs' offense is led by junior RB Darius Hammond who is ranks No. 23 in the nation in total yards per game (135.88).
- Head coach Jamey Chadwell is in his third season at Charleston Southern and has guided the Bucs to a 25-8 record.

#### **MONMOUTH REVIEW**

- QB Trey White (102) and RB Chaston Bennett (124) rushed for 100 yards
- Owls won the time of possession for the 6th time in 8 games this season, holding the ball for 35:31.
- S Taylor Henkle had game-sealing interception with 1:03 remaining and totaled 9 solo tackles
- LB Anthony Gore had team-high 10 tackles
- Owls held the ball for 13:11 in the second quarter that included a 17-play 80-yard scoring drive that consumed 8:58 of the clock
- KSU was 12 of 15 on 3rd down conversion attempts

**TAYLOR HENKLE EARNS MULTIPLE HONORS:** Redshirt freshman Taylor Henkle became the Owls' first multiple award winner when he was named the STATS FCS National Freshman of the Week and Big South Conference Freshman of the Week. Henkle was recognized for his performance versus Monmouth on Saturday (Oct. 31) after recording nine solo tackles, two pass breakups and a late-game interception that sealed a 23-13 Big South Conference win

**DERRICK FARROW NAMED TO CFPA FCS WATCH LIST:** Kennesaw State junior Derrick Farrow was one of 32 defensive backs named to the 2015 FCS Defensive Awards Watch List, the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) announced on Wednesday (Nov. 4). The list includes 32 defensive backs, 32 linebackers, and 34 defensive linemen from the Football Championship Subdivision. All FCS players are eligible for awards at their respective positions, and are not preemptively eliminated from consideration. The award winners will be announced January 13, 2016.

**DEBUT PROGRAMS IN 2015:** Kennesaw State is one of four institutions who have debuted football in 2015. Along with the Owls, East Tennessee State (FCS), Finlandia University (Division III), located in Hancock, Mich.

and Lyon College (NAIA) in Batesville, Ark. started football programs this fall. The Owls are 6-2, while East Tennessee State is 1-7, while Finlandia is 3-6 and Lyon College is 0-9.

**WINNING MENTALITY:** Kennesaw State immediately fostered a winning mentality and clinching a winning season. The Owls' 6-2 record ties for the second-best eight-game start in an inaugural season since 2008. Mercer, which played in the non-scholarship Pioneer Football League, started 7-1 in 2013 en route to a 10-2 overall record. Old Dominion began its first year 6-2 before finishing 9-2 while playing as an FCS Independent in 2009.

**ONE FOR THE BOOKS:** Kennesaw State set the Big South single-game record for total offense with 699 yards versus Point (Oct. 10), bettering the old mark of 695 set by Charleston Southern vs. West Virginia Wesleyan in 2015. KSU amassed 391 rushing yards and 308 passing yards, becoming just the second team in Big South history with 300 rushing and 300 passing yards in the same game. The first was Coastal Carolina in 2006 against Gardner-Webb (332 rush, 306 pass).

#### **GROUND FORCE**

- Kennesaw State leads the Big South with 322.5 rushing yards per game, currently the second-highest per game average in league history. The record is 357.5 rushing yards per contest set by VMI in 2008.
- The Owls are on pace for 3,548 rushing yards this season, which would be the fourth-highest single-season total in Big South history.
- The Owls have rushed for more than 300 yards in a game five times this season; the conference record for most 300-yard rushing games is eight (VMI 2008).

#### WHITE WHIMS

- With 806 yards rushing and 936 yards passing, White is on the verge of becoming the Big South Conference's first 1,000-yard rusher and 1,000-yard passer.
- QB Trey White set a Big South single-game record for most quarter-back rushing attempts (34) versus Gardner-Webb on Oct. 17. His 170 rushing yards against the Runnin' Bulldogs were third-most in a game by a signal-caller.
- White is just the second quarterback in Big South history to record a 3-TD rush game and 3-TD pass game in the same season, joining Coastal Carolina's Tyler Thigpen, who achieved the feat in 2005.
- White is the Big South's top rushing quarterback this season with 806 yards (third overall). He is averaging 100.8 yards a game.

**JUST FOR KICKS:** Freshman PK Justin Thompson tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals versus Gardner-Webb on Oct. 17. It was the second time this season Thompson made four field goals in a game, previously accomplishing the feat versus Shorter (Sept. 19), becoming just the third kicker in league history with multiple 4-field goal efforts. Liberty's Matt Bevins did it a record four times in his career, while VMI's Matt Sharpe achieved it twice in 2003.

**BIG PLAY J:** Redshirt-freshman Justin Sumpter has shown a knack for coming up with big catches early in his first season. The Owls' WR has caught 20 pass for 453 yards and three touchdowns. He is currently averaging 22.6 yards a reception to rank sixth in the country in yards per reception. Sumpter has three catches of 46 or more yards, including a 69-yard TD reception in the inaugural game at East Tennessee State.

#### **National Team Rankings**

- Kennesaw State ranks first in the FCS in third down conversion percentage (58.0 percent), yards per pass completion (19.67), sacks allowed (0.25), third in rushing offense (322.5) and 11th in time of possession (33:40).
- Defensively, the Owls are fourth in the FCS in passing yards allowed (146.6) and 11th in total defense (295.1).

#### **Team Notes**

- Kennesaw State is the only FCS program since 2008 to score 50-plus points in each of its first two games (56 at East Tennessee State, 58 versus Edward Waters)

#### **Quick Strike Offense**

- The Owls have scored on the first drive in six of their eight games, scoring five touchdowns and making a field goal. KSU was held with a score on its first possession versus Gardner-Webb (Oct. 17) and Monmouth (Oct. 31).
- KSU has twice scored on its first offensive play of a game. QB Trey White and WR Justin Sumpter hooked up on 55-yard scoring play versus Edward Waters on Sept. 12, and RB Chsaton Bennett ran 80 yards for a TD on KSU's opening play from scrimmage at Dayton (Sept. 26).

#### **Ball Hawks**

- The Owls' defense has forced at least one turnover in six of eight games this season.
- Kennesaw State has scored a defensive (3) or special teams (1) touchdown in three times this season (at ETSU, vs. Edward Waters, vs. Shorter).

#### **Scoring Fraternity**

• Thirteen different players have scored a touchdown for the Owls this season. Junior QB Trey White leads KSU nine touchdowns.

#### First and Third

- The Kennesaw State defense has been dominant in the first and third quarters of games this season. The Owls have allowed a total of 24 points (3.0) in the first quarter and 14 points (1.75) in third quarter through eight games.
- KSU has held its opponents scoreless in the first quarter in four of seven games. Even better, the Owls have blanked their opponent in six of eight games in the third quarter.
- The Oct. 17 game versus Gardner-Webb marked the first time this season that KSU has held an opponent scoreless in the first half.
- The only scores in the third quarter against Kennesaw State were touchdowns by Dayton (Sept. 26) and Liberty (Oct. 24).

#### **Opening Act**

- The Owls are averaging 21.25 points in the first half through their first eight games, while their defense is surrendering just 10.6 points in the first half and 7.6 points in the second half.
- KSU is outscoring its opponents 170-85 in the first half and 115-62 in the second half. Overall, the Owls have outscored their opponents, 285-146.

#### **Stopping the Run**

• Kennesaw State has held seven of its eight opponents to under 200 rushing yards, and two teams have failed to gain 100 yards rushing.

#### Air Defense

- Seven different players have intercepted a pass for Kennesaw State, including defensive lineman Nick Perrotta and safety Taylor Henkle, who have two each.
- KSU's defense has three times recorded two interceptions in a game (at ETSU, at Dayton and versus Monmouth)
- The defense has also twice recorded four sacks in a game (Shorter, at Dayton) and has at least one sack in all five games.

**WINNING RETURNS:** Through eight games, KSU has four TD returns by its defense and special teams. When redshirt freshman LB Dez Billingslea returned a fumble 65 yards for a touchdown on the final play of the game against Shorter (Sept. 19), it was the third of the season for the Owls and tied a Big South Conference single-season record.

A NIGHT OF FIRSTS: The Owl's 56-16 win over East Tennessee State on Sept. 3 marked a night of firsts in the history of the Kennesaw State football program. Here is a list of a few of the firsts:

- First Offensive Play: Trey White 4-yard rush
- First Touchdown: Trey White 6-yard run (1st quarter)
- First Passing Touchdown: White 69 yards to Justin Sumpter (3rd quarter)

#### **INAUGURAL GAME OFFENSIVE NOTES:**

- Kennesaw State had five touchdown drives of 50 or more yards, including four of 65 yards or more
- The 56 points are the most scored by a debuting FCS program dating back to 2008, and the 40-point win is the second largest during that same time period. KSU is one of just two teams to open against another FCS program among 10 institutions that have started a program. Charlotte, which debuted as an FCS program and has since moved to the FBS level, defeated Campbell, 52-7, in 2013.
- The 56 points by the Owls tied for the fifth most scored in FCS play during the opening weekend and led Big South Conference teams
- The 512 total yards gained led Big South Conference teams and KSU's 416 yards rushing were the third-highest total nationally

#### **INAUGURAL DEFENSIVE GAME NOTES:**

- Redshirt junior defensive lineman Nick Perrotta had a game-changing 19-yard interception return for a TD late in the second quarter that gave the Owls a 21-13 lead. He finished with four tackles, including two for loss.
- Kennesaw State limited ETSU to 98 rushing yards (2.6 yards per carry)
- Redshirt senior defensive lineman Mason Harris tied for the team lead with seven tackles, including three for loss and a sack for 10 yards. He also had two quarterback hurries and a forced fumble.
- Redshirt freshman Taylor Henkle tied for the team lead with seven tackles, including one for loss, and had a pass breakup. He also recorded the first defensive tackle in program history.
- Redshirt defensive back Dante' Blackmon had four tackles and returned an interception 23 yards.

**SMASHING DEBUT:** Kennesaw State is the sixth different program to win its first game as members of the Big South Conference, joining Gardner-Webb and Elon in 2002, Coastal Carolina in 2003, Stony Brook in 2008 and Monmouth in 2014. Meanwhile, the Owls' 56 points at East Tennessee State was the most scored by a Big South member in a season opener against an FCS opponent, and the fourth-most points scored overall in an opening game of a season since the league's formation in 2002.

OWLS FLY INTO BIG SOUTH RECORD BOOK: One game into its history, Kennesaw State immediately wrote itself into the Big South Conference record book. The Owls' 416 yards and six touchdowns rushing in their debut game against East Tennessee marked just the 10th time in league history that a football member gained at least 415 yards on the ground with six rushing TDs. The last to do it was Presbyterian on Sept. 6, 2014 against Bluefield (523/7). KSU's performance was just the fifth such effort against an FCS opponent.

**THE SENIORS:** The four seniors on the Kennesaw State roster include Brett Gillespie (OL, Kennesaw, Ga. / North Greenville), Ryan Godhigh (RB, Acworth, Ga. / Harrison HS), Mason Harris (DL, Fort Oglethorpe, Ga. / South Carolina) and Prentice Stone (Marietta, Ga. / Eastern Kentucky).

Bohannon was formally introduced as head coach at a press conference inside the locker room at Fifth Third Bank Stadium before a standing-room only audience that included media, family, friends, KSU Athletics administration and coaches, members of the University community and invited guests on March 26, 2013.

"Let me just first say how humbled and honored I am to be here today," Bohannon said in his opening remarks. "This is something you look forward to in our profession and I'm honored to be a part of an institution that is as special as this one is. I'm truly excited and it's surreal for me to hear 'first head football coach at Kennesaw State."

"I also want to give special thanks to University President Dr. Dan Papp, Vaughn Williams, the search committee and the people I met with during my interview," Bohannon added.

"My family is important to me and that's the culture I want to bring to KSU. People are excited to be here and to be in this department and that's what I want to continue," Bohannon said. "It was a surreal moment for me last night looking back on what's gotten me to this podium today. I started out on the field at age eight with my mom dropping me off. I've watched my dad coach and that's what I've learned from. It's had a huge affect on me and my path here today.

"My family, the coaches I've worked with, they've all been influential and I can't thank them enough and I'll never be able to," Bohannon added. "This is the plan laid out for me and I've followed it and that's why I'm here today."

Since his arrival at Kennesaw State, Bohannon hit the ground running as he worked to assemble a staff, made numerous speaking engagements, and traveled the state of Georgia recruiting. He signed his first recruiting class of 29 players on Feb. 5, 2014, and added 16 future Owls to the nest on Feb. 4, 2015.

A native of Griffin, Ga., Bohannon has 17 seasons of coaching experience at the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) and Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) levels, all of which have come while working with Georgia Tech head coach Paul

### **HEAD COACH BRIAN BOHANNON**

Prian Bohannon made history on March 24, 2013 when he was named the first football coach in the history of Kennesaw State University.

Bohannon joined the Owls' family after spending the previous five seasons as quarterbacks/B-backs coach at Georgia Tech where he engineered one of the country's most prolific spread option offenses.

Bohannon was formally introduced as head coach at a press conference inside the locker room at Fifth Third Bank Stadium before a standing-room only audience that included media, family, friends, KSU Athletics administration and coaches, members of the University community and invited guests on March 26, 2013.

"Let me just first say how humbled and honored I am to be here today," Bohannon said in his opening remarks. "This is something you look forward to in our profession and I'm honored to be a part of an institution that is as special as this one is. I'm truly excited and it's surreal for me to hear 'first head football coach at Kennesaw State."

"I also want to give special thanks to University President Dr. Dan Papp, Vaughn Williams, the search committee and the people I met with during my interview," Bohannon added.

Since his arrival at Kennesaw State, Bohannon hit the ground running as he worked to assemble a staff, made numerous speaking engagements, and traveled the state of Georgia recruiting. He signed his first recruiting class of 29 players on Feb. 5, 2014, and added 16 future Owls to the nest on Feb. 4, 2015.

A native of Griffin, Ga., Bohannon has 17 seasons of coaching experience at the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) and Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) levels, all of which have come while working with Georgia Tech head coach Paul Johnson.

During Bohannon's time at Georgia Tech in 2008, the Yellow Jackets finished in the top four nationally in rushing offense every season, including in 2010 when they led the nation in rushing for the first time in school history.

No team in college football rushed for more yards than Georgia Tech as the Yellow Jackets accumulated more than 20,000 yards on the ground during his last five seasons on The Flats.

In 2012, Georgia Tech broke school records for total offense and rushing yards. The Yellow Jackets also averaged a school-record 40.0 points per game in conference play.

Two B-backs – David Sims and Zach Laskey – combined to rush for more than



1,300 yards. Two quarterbacks - Tevin Washington and Vad Lee - combined to run for more than 1,200 yards. Washington broke the school record for rushing touchdowns in a season (20).

Under Bohannon's direction, former Georgia Tech quarterbacks Washington and Joshua Nesbitt emerged as two of the most prolific signal callers in Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) history. Nesbitt and Washington combined to rush for more than 5,000 yards and rank first and third, respectively, in ACC history for career rushing yards by a quarterback.

Under Bohannon, four players rushed for more than 1,000 yards in a season -- B-back Jonathan Dwyer in 2008, Dwyer and Nesbitt in 2009, and B-back Anthony Allen in 2010.

Dwyer was a first-team All-ACC selection (2008, 2009). Nesbitt was the first team All-ACC quarterback in 2009, and Allen was first-team all-conference in 2010. Dwyer and Allen advanced to the NFL.

Before arriving at Georgia Tech, Bohannon spent six years as wide receivers coach at

Navy. He was part of a staff that returned the Midshipmen to the national spotlight. Navy won 35 games over four years, earning a school-record four consecutive bowl berths and a school-best four straight Commander-In-Chief's Trophies.

Navy's offense put up remarkable numbers in 2007. The Midshipmen ranked first nationally in rushing (348.8 ypg), 10th in scoring (39.3 ppg.), and 22nd in total offense (444.1 ypg.) and ninth in sacks allowed (1.08 pg). Navy's rushing attack averaged a nation's best 318.7 yards per contest in 2005 as the Midshipmen went to a bowl game for a third straight year, won a second consecutive bowl game and captured the Commander-In-Chief's Trophy for a third-straight year.

The Midshipmen led the nation in rushing (323.2 yards per contest) and set school records for rushing yards per game, total rushing yards (4,202), rushing yards per attempt (5.5), rushing touchdowns (44), total offense (5,506), total offense per game (423.5) and yards per play (6.0) in 2003.

Bohannon coached the wide receivers (1997-99) and defensive backs (2000-01) at Georgia Southern.

During Bohannon's five seasons in Statesboro, Georgia Southern advanced to the NCAA Division I-AA playoffs, finishing as national runner-up in 1998 and claiming back-to-back national championships (1999 and 2000).

A four-year letter winner and standout as a wide receiver at Georgia, Bohannon started his coaching career at West Georgia before earning his first full-time position at Gardner-Webb (N.C.) as wide receivers coach in 1996.

Bohannon earned his bachelor's degree in general business from Georgia in 1993 and a master's in business education from West Georgia in 1996. He is married to the former Melanie Cobb and the couple has has three children, sons Blake Patrick and Braden Thomas, and daughter Brooke Anna. The family resides in Woodstock, Ga.

Home and/or cell phone numbers will not be provided at any time. Media are encouraged to conduct interviews after practice due to better player availability. Practices are open to the media during the pre-practice session and through the first three periods Monday through Wednesdays. The remainder of the practice is closed to all media. Post-practice interviews will be conducted outside the Kennesaw State locker room at Fifth Third Bank Stadium.

#### **CREDENTIALS**

Credentials for Kennesaw State home games are issued for working media only. Because of severe space limitations, seating will be based on a priority system. Individual game credentials must be requested two (2) weeks prior to the date of the game.


