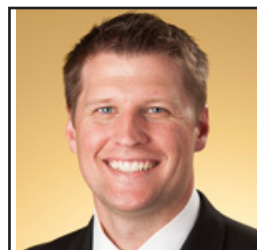

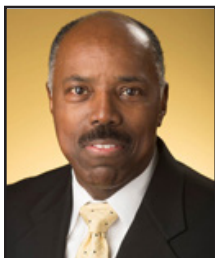

# HEAD COACH AL SKINNER



**Al Skinner**  
**Head Coach • 23rd Year**  
**UMass • 1974**

Al Skinner, a former Division I national coach of the year and two-time BIG EAST Conference Coach of the Year, has been named the new head coach of the Kennesaw State men's basketball program, Director of Athletics Vaughn Williams announced on Sunday (April 26).

Skinner, who becomes the sixth head coach in program history, brings 22 years of Division I head coaching experience to Kennesaw State.

Skinner most recently served as associate head coach at Division I Bryant University in Rhode Island.

"I am extremely honored and excited to announce that Al Skinner has accepted our offer to become the next head coach of Kennesaw State men's basketball," Williams said. "It is a great compliment to the University and Department of Athletics to attract someone of Al's stature and record of accomplishments.

"Coach Skinner embodies every value, characteristic and skill set that we look for when choosing head coaches to lead our student-athletes," Williams added. "He has distinguished himself at the highest level of college basketball as evident by his nine NCAA Tournament appearances. He also has a stellar history of graduating his players as every men's basketball player who stayed four years at Boston College graduated.

"We look forward to Al bringing those attributes to Kennesaw State and building a men's basketball program that regularly challenges for Atlantic Sun Conference titles and NCAA Tournament appearances, while at the same time instilling into our student-athletes those characteristics and values that are essential to being successful," Williams said.

# HEAD COACH AL SKINNER

A current member of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition, Skinner compiled a 385-291 (.570) career record while guiding his teams to nine NCAA Tournament appearances and four conference titles during tenures at the University of Rhode Island and Boston College. His teams posted ten 20-plus win seasons.

"My lifelong passion has been basketball. I am passionate about coaching young men to be successful team members on winning basketball teams," Skinner said. "With the assistance of the alumni, student body, faculty, President Dan Papp, Director of Athletics Vaughn Williams and Owl fans, we will work tirelessly to build a basketball program Kennesaw State will be proud of. I appreciate the opportunity I have been given to coach the KSU basketball team."

The winningest coach in BC history, Skinner spent 13 seasons at The Heights, compiling a 247-165 (.560) record from 1997-2010. He took Boston College to six NCAA Tournaments in a seven-year stretch, leading his 2005-06 team to the Sweet 16. Four of his teams finished the year ranked in the final Associated Press Top 25 Poll, including the 2001 and 2007 clubs that concluded those seasons at No. 7.

After guiding the Eagles to a 27-5 overall record and the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Skinner was named 2001 National Coach of the Year by Chevrolet/CBS, ESPN, Sports Illustrated, The Sporting News and the United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA). He also earned BIG EAST Conference Coach of the Year honors.

Skinner earned BIG EAST Conference Coach of the Year again in 2005 after leading Boston College to a 25-5 mark and the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

The Eagles accomplished something no Big East team had done before by starting the season 20-0. During the streak, the Eagles beat two ranked opponents and, were one of two teams (Illinois) in the country to begin the year 20-0. Following a win over No. 9 Syracuse in early February, the Eagles vaulted to No. 3 in both the AP and coaches' polls, marking the highest ranking for any Boston College basketball team.

Prior to his time at BC, Skinner spent nine seasons as head coach at Rhode Island, leading the Rams to a 138-126 (.523) mark.

Skinner took over as head coach at URI in 1988 after serving as an assistant on the Rams' bench from 1984-88.

During his tenure in Kingston, he led Rhode Island to a pair of NCAA Tournament berths (1993 and 1997) and two more National Invitational Tournament (NIT) appearances (1992 and 1996), as well as three 20+ win seasons. He was named the Atlantic-10 Coach of the Year in 1991-92 and was inducted into the University of Rhode Island Athletics Hall of Fame in 2000.

Skinner comes to Kennesaw State after serving two seasons as associate head coach under longtime friend Tim O'Shea at Bryant University where the Bulldogs compiled a 34-29 (.540) overall record, including a 22-12 (.647) mark in the Northeast Conference. The two have a long history of sharing a bench as O'Shea spent 14 years as an assistant under Skinner at Rhode Island and Boston College.

Skinner first broke into coaching as an assistant at Marist College in 1982 following successful stints in the ABA and NBA from 1974-80 (Nets, Pistons, 76ers). Drafted by the ABA's New York Nets in the eighth round of the 1974 draft, Skinner was named to the 1974-75 ABA All-Rookie Team and led the Nets to an ABA Championship a year later.

Prior to his professional playing career, Skinner spent three years on the court at the University of Massachusetts from 1971-74, becoming the only player in Minuteman history to be named a three-time All-Yankee Conference selection.

A team captain and All-America Honorable Mention in 1973-74, Skinner remains one of the most decorated players in UMass basketball history, concluding his career with 1,235 points, 749 rebounds and 320 assists in 79 games. Skinner was inducted into the UMass Athletics Hall of Fame in 1982, and his No. 30 jersey was retired by the Minutemen on Feb. 18, 2004.

Skinner and his wife, Donna, have two grown children, Vaniecia and Andre.

### SCOUTING NJIT

NJIT is in the middle of its first season in the Atlantic Sun. The Highlanders are off to a 2-4 start with wins at home against Jacksonville and on the road at Seton.

Overall, NJIT is 11-11 and faced a difficult non-conference schedule against Kentucky, Providence, St. John's and Stony Brook. The Highlanders topped two power five schools in St. Johns and South Florida.

Damon Lynn leads NJIT averaging 17.5 ppg and averages 18.3 points per game in his career. he has scored 20+ points in 35 of the 84 games in his career.

NJIT is led by Jim Engles, who is in his eighth season as head coach.

### OWLS HOLD OFF LATE CHARGE FROM SPARTANS

Looking for a big win on the road, the Kennesaw State Owls got just that against USC Upstate winning 78-75 in the Hodge Center on Wednesday, January 27.

Up by three with time winding down, the Owls' defense forced the Spartans into an off balanced three that they couldn't get to fall to clinch the win.

Kendrick Ray notched his fifth straight 20-point game with 23 and he dished out six assists on the night. Yonel Brown and Nick Masterson also scored in double-figures. Four other players had at least seven points to provide balanced scoring on the night for the Owls.

### **Racking up the Minutes**

Yonel Brown not only leads the Owls in minutes, but he leads the nation averaging 39.0 minutes per game. He has played all 40 minutes in 14 of the 22 games this season, and he played 42 minutes in the overtime game against Elon.

### **Taking Care of the Ball**

Against Reinhardt, Kennesaw State had a 2-1 assist to turnover ratio as the team finished with 20 assists and 10 turnovers. The 20 assists are a season high and the 10 turnovers were a season low until the team had eight against Florida Gulf Coast.

Taking care of the ball is something that KSU has been improving on as the season has gone on. Going back, the Owls have had less than 15 turnovers in the previous 15 of 18 games.

### **Batman and Robin**

Kendrick Ray and Brown are the highest scoring tandem in the A-Sun and they didn't disappoint against Stetson and FGCU. The two combined for 56 points against the Hatters and 51 points against the Eagles.

It was the third and fourth time this season the duo combined to score 50-plus points and three other times they have both topped 40 points. The two lead the A-Sun averaging 36.8 points per game. Ray is second in the A-Sun averaging 18.6 points per game and Brown is third averaging 18.2.

One of the two players has led the team in scoring in every game except for three so far this season.

### **30-Point Performances**

There have been seven A-Sun players with 30-point games this season and Kennesaw State has two of them through the team's 21 games.

Brown and Ray have combined for five 30-point performances this season. Brown has had three as he scored 34 against Alabama, 31 against Elon and 34 against Stetson. Ray has had two 30-point games scoring 30 against Mercer and 31 against FGCU.

### **Sharing the Ball**

The team has had more assists than turnovers in seven of nine games. In two of those games, the Owls accumulated 20 assists.

Against FGCU, the team totaled it's least amount of turnovers during the season with only eight and had 15 assists.

### **Free Throws**

Brown is making 80.7 percent of his free throws this season. For his career, he has the 10th best free throw shooting average ever in the A-Sun with a career percentage of 83.9 percent.

### **Offense Flowing**

Since A-Sun play, Kennesaw State is averaging 13 more points per game than they did through non-conference play. Currently, the Owls are averaging 80.2 point per game. After the 16 non-conference games, the team was averaging 67.1 ppg.

### **Home Sweet Home**

The Owls are 5-5 at home this season and a big reason for that has been a third scoring option stepping up. Nick Masterson has scored in double figures five times this season and four of those have come in the KSU Convocation Center. Aubrey Williams has also chipped in with double-figure scoring in three games at home.

Kennesaw State named Al Skinner the sixth men's basketball coach in school history on April 26, 2015. Skinner has a career record of 390-305 in his 23rd season and has taken his team's to either the NCAA tournament (9 times) or NIT (3 times) a total of 12 times.

Yonel Brown scored his 1,000th point in one of his favorite places to play in Assembly Hall at Indiana on December 22. Needing 15 points, he made a layup while getting fouled and then hit the free throw with 16:42 remaining in the game to reach the 1,000 points mark. He is the first Owl since Delbert Love in 1913 to reach the 1,000-point mark.

The Owls have been awarded for some great performances throughout the season by the Atlantic Sun as the team has won a weekly award four times.

Ray won his first Newcomer of the Week award after having two double-doubles in a row against Elon and Florida A&M. Brown was named Co-Player of the Week after the first game of the season, when he led all scorers with 34 points against Alabama.

Kennesaw State has landed on ESPN's Top 10 plays twice this season. The first occasion was when Kendrick Ray dunked on 6'10" Chinanu Onuaku of Louisville on a fast break.

In the next game against Chattanooga, Yonel Brown put up a shot from halfcourt to beat the shot clock, that bounced off the top of the backboard and swished through the net.

Heading into A-Sun play, Kennesaw State's non-conference schedule ranked 23rd in the country based on the NCAA rankings.

The Owls faced eight teams in the top 100 with four of those being in the top 50 RPI. No other team in the A-Sun played more than five teams in the top 100.

Kennesaw State scored over 100 points two games in a row for the first time since the team was at the NAIA level in 1991-92 against Reinhardt and Lipscomb. When the Owls scored over 100 points against Reinhardt, it was the first time going over the century mark since joining the D-I ranks. The last time the team reached the century mark was in the 2004-05 season in a 103-61 victory over UNC Pembroke on Feb. 19, 2005.

The Atlantic Sun Conference announced today that the 2016 Men's Basketball Championship Final on Sunday, March 6, will air nationally on Westwood One radio.

This agreement marks the second consecutive year that an A-Sun Championship game is available across the country via terrestrial and satellite radio.
