KENNESAW STATE FOOTBALL SETS FOR SECOND SEASON

TEN THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Kennesaw State University returns 19 starters and 50 letterwinners from 2015, when the Owls were one of two FCS programs nationally to debut.
- KSU finished last season with a 6-5 record, including a 5-1 mark at home, and picked up conference wins over Gardner-Webb and Monmouth.
- The Owls' 6-5 mark in 2015 tied Georgia State for the third-best inaugural season ever by an FCS team. It was bested only by Mercer (10-2 in 2013) and Old Dominion (9-3 in 2008).
- The returnees are headlined by reigning first-team All-Big South sophomore DB **Taylor Henkle**, who led the Owls in tackles (65) and tied for the conference lead in interceptions (four).
- Also back in The Nest are second-team All-Big South senior DB **Derrick Farrow** and second-team All-Conference senior **C Malik Letatau**.
- Orchestrating KSU's explosive spread option offense is senior QB **Trey White**, who rushed for 964 yards, passed for 1,059 and totaled 17 touchdowns.
- KSU led the Big South in rushing by rolling up 293.0 yards per game -- the second-best single-season average in conference history (VMI, 357.5 in 2008).
- Big play sophomore WR **Justin Sumpter** averaged 20.2 yards per game, which ranked sixth nationally last season. He reeled in 26 catches for 525 yards and three scores.
- The Owls sold out each of their six home games in 2015, averaging an over-capacity 8,820 at Fifth Third Bank Stadium. With another off-season of brisk ticket sales, KSU looks to extend that sellout streak in 2016.
- In 2016, KSU will play at home at night for the first time ever. The 7 p.m. kickoffs at Fifth Third Bank Stadium are vs. ETSU (Sept. 3), vs. Point (Sept. 10) vs. Liberty (Oct. 15).



Sophomore DB **Taylor Henkle** will return to anchor the secondary that held opponents to 13.7 points per game at home. He was a first-team All-Big South pick in 2015.

OWLS AT BIG SOUTH MEDIA DAY

- **Head Coach Brian Bohannon:** Enters his second year as KSU's head coach, but has been in The Nest since being hired on March 24, 2013 as the program's inaugural coach... Has averaged 8.6 wins per season in his 18-year college coaching career as both assistant and head coach.
- **Sophomore DB Taylor Henkle** (5-11, 184, Marietta, Ga./Kell HS): a first-team All-Conference pick in 2015... Was the first-ever local commit to the KSU program.
- **Sophomore WR Justin Sumpter** (6-3, 216, Tyrone, Ga./Sandy Creek HS): KSU's first offensive play at home in program history was a 55-yard TD pass from Trey White to Sumpter.

Credentials for Kennesaw State home games are issued for working media only. Because of space limitations, seating will be based on a priority system. Individual game credentials must be requested two (2) weeks prior to the date of the game.

MEDIA PARKING

Media parking will be located in the Pink Lot (465 Big Shanty Rd. Marietta, GA 30066). All media requesting season parking should make their request in writing. Parking passes along with season credentials will be mailed out in advance. All media must have a parking pass prior to game day to park in the Pink Lot.

FIFTH THIRD BANK STADIUM

Fifth Third Bank Stadium is located at 3200 George Busbee Pkwy NW, Kennesaw, GA 30144. The media entrance is located on the west side of the stadium near Gate B and the box office. The media entrance will open three hours prior to kickoff.

PRESS BOX SERVICES

The press box at Fifth Third Bank Stadium has limited seating and is available to media on a priority basis. High speed internet is available to transmit stories.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

The Kennesaw State locker room is located below the East stands near the North end zone. The interview room is located under the stage at the northwest end zone. The visitor's locker room is located below the East stands near the South end zone.

KSU head coach Brian Bohannon and requested players will be available in the post-game interview approximately 10 minutes after the team enters the locker room. Kennesaw State's locker room is closed. The SID of the visiting school will establish admittance policies to the visiting locker room.

OWLS' SPREAD OPTION OFFENSE ROLLS UP BIG YARDS

- Kennesaw State led the Big South with 293.0 rushing yards per game, a per-game average that ranked second in league history (VMI, 357.5 yards in 2008).
KSU totaled 3,398 rushing yards in 2015. The mark ranks as the fifth-highest single-season total in Big South history.
The Owls rushed for more than 300 yards in a game five times, three shy of the Big South Conference record of eight set by VMI in 2008.
KSU returns its entire starting backfield, along with senior QB Trey White.

PRIME TIME FOOTBALL COMING TO THE BANK

- Announced late June, the Owls will take the field under the lights at home for the first time in program history when East Tennessee State visits to open the season at 7 p.m.
The Owls will host Point the following week at 7 p.m. before welcoming Big South foe Liberty in a 7 p.m. gridiron showdown to open conference play on Oct. 15.

PROTECTING THE NEST

- The Owls went 5-1 at Fifth Third Bank Stadium with their lone setback coming to No. 13/15 Charleston Southern, 28-14, on Nov. 7.
Kennesaw State averaged 30.2 points per game and 437.3 total yards of offense at Fifth Third Bank Stadium, while holding opponents to 13.7 points per game and 256.3 yards.
KSU outscored opponents 181-82 in six home games, a margin of 99 points at home.
The Owls averaged 273.8 yards on the ground in front of the Owl faithful, while the defense held opponents to 134.8 rushing yards per game.

GAMEDAY ATMOSPHERE

- Kennesaw State sold out every home game in 2015 and was listed as No. 10 on StadiumJourney.com's Top 25 ranking of FCS gameday atmospheres.
Fifth Third Bank Stadium capacity of 8,300 ranks second-most among Big South stadiums. Liberty (19,200) holds the most at Williams Stadium.
The Owls announced a record-breaking 9,506 fans in the home inaugural football game on Sept. 12, 2015 against Edward Waters.

OWLS STRIKE LOCAL RADIO, TV DEALS FOR FOOTBALL

- This past off-season, Kennesaw State inked a multi-year partnership with Dickey Broadcasting Company in Atlanta to make ESPN Radio 1230 The Fan 2 (WFOM-AM) the exclusive radio home of KSU Football.
Dickey Broadcasting, which owns 680 The Fan, 1230 The Fan 2 and 1340 The Fan 3, just celebrated its 22nd anniversary as Atlanta's first and biggest sports talk radio station. Kennesaw State joins Georgia Tech, Georgia, Georgia State and the Atlanta Braves as part of the Dickey Broadcasting Family.
ESPN Radio 1230 The Fan 2 will carry all 11 games this season with Brian Giffin (play-by-play), Tutan Reyes (analyst) and Art Eckman (sideline) calling the action.
On the television side, Kennesaw State and Peachtree TV (WPCH) unveiled a football broadcast agreement to air a selection of KSU home games this season.
Kennesaw State is now the only FCS program in the nation to boast a local TV agreement in a Top 10 media market. Peachtree TV reaches nearly 6.2 million people (2.38 million households) in the greater Atlanta area -- the nation's No. 9 media market.
KSU's TV broadcast crew includes Brian Katrek (play-by-play), former Atlanta Falcons QB D.J. Shockley (analyst) and Nathan McCreary (sidelines).
KSU's radio and TV deals marked the final pieces of the newly-created Owl Network, which will serve as the primary media hub for live event video and audio, along with on-demand programming, highlights and feature videos.
Also back in 2016 are weekly podcasts, which will begin during Training Camp. "The Final Word on Owl Network" will air Fridays on KSUOwls.com beginning in early August.

WHITE UNDER CENTER AGAIN

- QB Trey White passed for 1,059 yards and rushed for 964 yards in 10 games, falling 36 rushing yards shy of becoming the Big South Conference's first 1,000-yard passer and 1,000 rusher in a single season.
- White became the first QB in Big South Conference history to rush for three touchdowns in a game twice in the same season (Week 2 vs. Edwards Waters and Week 8 at Liberty). His nine rushing scores tied for second-most in a season by a Big South QB and three shy of the league's single-season mark of 12 (VMI's Tim Maypray in 2008).
- White is just the second quarterback in Big South history to record a games in which he rushed for three touchdowns and passed for three touchdowns in the same season, joining Coastal Carolina's Tyler Thigpen, who achieved the feat in 2005.
- White was the Big South's top rushing quarterback last season with 964 yards (third overall).

SUMPTER OUT WIDE

- Big-play sophomore WR Justin Sumpter averaged 20.2 yards a reception last season, which ranked sixth-best in the nation.
- Sumpter headlines a group of wide receivers for KSU that totaled 79 catches, 1,505 yards and 10 touchdowns a year ago.
- Sumpter led all KSU receivers with 26 catches for 525 yards and four TDs.
- The sophomore had three catches of 46 or more yards, including a 69-yard TD grab in the inaugural game at East Tennessee State.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- The Owls' defense forced at least one turnover in nine of 11 games in 2015.
- Kennesaw State scored four defensive touchdowns, and added a special teams touchdown.
- The Owls' D was dominant in the first and third quarters of games, allowing a total of just 44 points (4.0) in the first quarter and 28 points (2.5) in the third quarter through the season's first nine games.
- KSU held its opponents scoreless in the first quarter in five of 10 games. Even better, the Owls blanked their opponent in eight of 11 games in the third quarter.
- Kennesaw State held 10 of its 11 opponents to under 200 rushing yards, and two teams failed to gain 100 yards rushing.
- KSU's pass defense was just as stout, allowing opponents to average just 153.5 yards through the air -- the league's second-best total.

REVIEWING THE INAUGURAL SEASON

- Kennesaw State was one of two Football Championship Subdivision Division (FCS) programs that made its debut in 2015.
- In fact, KSU was one of four institutions who made their debut in football in 2015 which also included ETSU (FCS), Finlandia (D-III) and Lyon College (NAIA).
- KSU faced another start-up program in East Tennessee State in their inaugural football game in program history.
- The Owls were the only FCS program since 2008 to score 50-plus points in each of its first two games (56 at East Tennessee State, 58 versus Edward Waters.)
- The 56 points scored by the Owls in their 2015 opener at East Tennessee State are the most scored by a debuting Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) program dating back to 2008, and the 40-point margin of victory is the second largest during that time.
- Kennesaw State is the sixth different program to win its first game as a member of the Big South Conference
- With the exception of the first season of Big South football in 2002, Kennesaw State's six wins tied for the most by a program in its first season in the Big South.

**STRONG IN THE CLASSROOM,
STRONG IN THE GAME**

- Former WR P.J. Stone, who hauled in nine receptions for 116 yards in his only season as an Owl in 2015, became the first KSU football player to graduate as the Marietta native accepted his bachelor's degree in exercise science this past May.
- Stone finished his undergraduate academic career with an impressive 3.70 GPA, graduating magna cum laude from KSU and earning Academic All-Big South honors.
- In July, he was named one of five national recipients of the John McLendon Minority Postgraduate Scholarship. The \$10,000 scholarship, funded in part by Capital One, will be used as Stone enrolls in KSU's special education graduate program
- He also plans to begin teaching and serving as an assistant football coach at nearby Campbell High School.



Former WR **P.J. Stone** graduated magna cum laude this past May from KSU, becoming the Owls' first-ever football graduate.

**THE OWLS FUND NEARS RECORD \$1 MILLION
IN DONATIONS**

- Thanks in large part to the momentum and excitement regarding the launch of football, Kennesaw State's The Owls Fund recently set a record with just shy of \$1 million in donations to the annual fund.
- The Owls Fund raises money to offset the costs of student-athlete scholarships, a financial burden of \$3.86 million to the department.
- Total donations to The Owls Fund for 2015-16 were \$839,682, which surpassed The Fund's goal of \$750,000 – an increase of nearly 20 percent from last year's total.
- The Owls Fund has a total of 1,488 donors that contributed to the KSUAA in 2015-16 -- also a record. There were just 23 donors that contributed \$15,000 when The Owls Fund was established in 2011-12.

**KENNESAW STATE, SAMFORD AGREE TO
FOUR-GAME SERIES**

- Kennesaw State and Samford have announced a four-game series that begins in the 2017 season.
- The first and fourth games of the series will be Thursday night season-openers at Samford's Seibert Stadium in Birmingham in 2017 and 2022, while the middle two games are set for KSU's Fifth Third Bank Stadium in 2018 and 2020.
- A member of the Southern Conference, Samford is entering its second season under head coach Chris Hatcher. The Bulldogs went 6-5 last season and made a 2013 appearance in the Division-I FCS Playoffs. Samford is the third Southern Conference member to appear on KSU's football slate, joining Furman (2016, 2019) and Wofford (2020).
- Kennesaw State is set to battle Georgia State in 2018, the Owls' first scheduled game versus a Football Bowl Subdivision program.
- A scheduled game at Georgia Tech in 2021 would be KSU's first against a Power-5 program.

OFFENSE WINS 2016 SPRING GAME, 59-51

- In front of a crowd of 1,916 at Fifth Third Bank Stadium, the Owls' Offense pulled out a 59-51 victory over the Defense in the second annual Black & Gold spring game.
- Redshirt freshman QB Daniel David, who transferred from Appalachian State, finished 6-of-14 passing for 128 yards and a touchdown. David also rushed for 96 yards on nine carries and two more scores.
- The game was scored using a modified point system that awarded points to both the offense (for touchdowns, field goals and explosive plays) and the defense (for turnovers, three-and-outs, Red Zone stops and third and fourth-down stops).
- Senior RB Micah Reed led the ground attack for the Offense, rushing 24 times for 113 yards, while sophomore RB Jake McKenzie carried 16 times for 98 yards.
- On the defensive side, sophomore DB Taylor Henkle forced a fumble and was one of three Owls with a game-high seven tackles. Redshirt freshman DB Raekwon Chatman and senior DB Derrick Farrow were also each in on seven stops. Senior DL Nick Perrotta made three tackles, recovered a fumble and broke up a pass.

HEAD COACH BRIAN BOHANNON



Brian Bohannon made history on March 24, 2013 when he was named the first football coach in the history of Kennesaw State University.

As the program enters its second season in 2016, Bohannon looks to continue

the momentum from a dazzling debut in 2015 that saw the Owls finish 6-5, roll up eye-popping numbers out of the spread option offense and sellout every home game at Fifth Third Bank while going 5-1 in front of raucous crowds.

In 18 years as either a college assistant or head coach, Bohannon has been part of teams that averaged 8.6 wins per season, reached the postseason 15 times and won a pair of national championships while at Georgia Southern.

A Griffin, Ga., native and former wide receiver at the University of Georgia, Bohannon joined the Owls after spending the previous five seasons as quarterback/B-backs coach at Georgia Tech where he helped engineer one of the country's most prolific spread option offenses.

His first team at Kennesaw State rushed for 293.0 yards per game, which led the Big South Conference and ranked sixth nationally. It was the second-best single-season rushing effort by a Big South team since VMI's 357.5 yards in 2008. The Owls lit up the scoreboard with 41 touchdowns and 429.8 yards of total offense.

It didn't take the nation long to realize Kennesaw State's explosiveness. KSU blitzed East Tennessee State, 56-16, on the road in a match-up of two programs playing their first-ever games. The next week, the Owls were welcomed home for the first time and pounded Edward Waters, 58-7, in front of 9,506 at Fifth Third Bank Stadium.

Bohannon's Owls began their debut season 4-1 in non-conference action and made history again with a 12-7 win over Gardner-Webb on October 17 as Kennesaw State became the first Big South member to win its first conference game in its initial year as a member.

The early-season success gave Bohannon's team national recognition in the Top 25 polls for the first time in program history, as KSU spent three consecutive weeks among teams receiving votes in the FCS Stats Top 25 beginning October 19.

Another Big South win over Monmouth, 23-13, allowed the Owls to clinch a winning record and the team would finish 6-5 to tie Georgia State for the third-best record by an FCS program in its inaugural season.

Four Owls received Big South honors as DB Taylor Henkle was named to the first team, while DB Derrick Farrow and OL Malik Letatau earned second-team nods. Senior WR Prentice Stone was named to the All-Academic Team and would become the program's first graduate this past May.

Bohannon himself earned praise as well as he was inducted to the Griffin-Spalding Hall of Fame and was named the state of Georgia's 2016 Most Positive College Head Coach by Positive Athlete Georgia – a program spearheaded by Hines Ward.

Bohannon was formally introduced as head coach at a press conference inside the locker room at Fifth Third Bank Stadium before a standing-room only audience that included media, family, friends, KSU Athletics administration and coaches, members of the University community and invited guests on March 26, 2013.

Since his arrival at Kennesaw State, Bohannon and his staff have been tireless in their efforts to attract high-quality student-athletes to The Nest. He signed his first recruiting class of 29 players on Feb. 5, 2014, added 16 future Owls on Feb. 4, 2015, and inked 18 more on the most recent National Signing Day.

Bohannon brought 17 seasons of coaching experience at the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) and Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) levels to Kennesaw State, all of which came under spread option mastermind Paul Johnson at Georgia Tech, Navy and Georgia Southern.

During Bohannon's time at Georgia Tech, the Yellow Jackets finished in the top four nationally in rushing offense every season and led the nation in rushing in 2010. No team in college football rushed for more yards than Georgia Tech, which accumulated more than 20,000 yards during his last five seasons.

Under Bohannon's direction, former Georgia Tech quarterbacks Tevin Washington and Joshua Nesbitt emerged as two of the most prolific signal callers in Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) history. Nesbitt and Washington combined to rush for more than 5,000 yards and rank first and third, respectively, in ACC history for career rushing yards by a quarterback.

Under Bohannon, four players rushed for more than 1,000 yards in a season -- B-back Jonathan Dwyer in 2008, Dwyer and Nesbitt in 2009, and B-back Anthony Allen in 2010. Dwyer was a first-team All-ACC selection in 2008 and 2009. Nesbitt was the first-team All-ACC quarterback in 2009, and Allen was first-team All-ACC in 2010. Dwyer and Allen went on to NFL careers.

Before arriving at Georgia Tech, Bohannon spent six years as wide receivers coach at Navy. He was part of a staff that returned the Midshipmen to the national spotlight. Navy won 35 games over four years, earning a school-record four consecutive bowl berths and a school-best four straight Commander-In-Chief's Trophies.

Prior to his appointment on Johnson's staff at Navy, Bohannon coached the wide receivers for three seasons at Georgia Southern before taking over the defensive backs his last two years.

In each of those five seasons in Statesboro, the Eagles advanced to the NCAA Division I-AA playoffs, finished as national runner-up in 1998 and claimed back-to-back national championships in 1999 and 2000.

A four-year letterwinner and standout wide receiver at Georgia, Bohannon started his coaching career at West Georgia before earning his first full-time position at Gardner-Webb (N.C.) as wide receivers coach in 1996.

Bohannon earned his bachelor's degree in general business from Georgia in 1993 and a master's in business education from West Georgia in 1996.

He is married to the former Melanie Cobb and the couple has three children, sons Blake Patrick and Braden Thomas, and daughter Brooke Anna. The family resides in Woodstock, Ga.
