KENNESAW STATE HITS THE ROAD TO DUKE IT OUT WITH DUQUESNE

Kennesaw State hits the road for a date with the Dukes of Duquesne on Saturday on ESPN3 in Pittsburgh. The Owls are fresh off their open week, and last played Sept. 10 - a 49-3 rout of Point University. The game kicks off at 1 p.m. and can be heard in Atlanta on ESPN Radio 1230 The Fan 2.



QB Chandler Burks collected a career-high 138 rushing yards on nine carries and completed 9-of-13 for 82 yards in the air, totaling 220 total yards of offense vs. Point on Sept. 10.

FIRST & 10

- Saturday's game at Duquesne is the first road test of the 2016 slate for Kennesaw State.
- The matchup between the Owls and the Dukes is the first in series history. Duquesne's football program has been in existence since 1969, while Kennesaw State is in its second season.
- The Owls announced their eight-straight sellout crowd at Fifth Third Bank Stadium on Sept. 10 when Kennesaw State hosted non-conference foe Point to campus. KSU has sold out all eight games at The Nest in program history.
- Kennesaw State will appear on ESPN3 for the first time this season at Rooney Field, and can also be heard on ESPN Radio The Fan 2 as Brian Giffin, Tutan Reyes and Art Eckman will have the call.
- Of the 50 Owls on the two-deep, 33 are redshirt-sophomores or younger. The depth also includes just seven seniors and 10 are juniors for head coach Brian Bohannon's team, which is the youngest team in the Big South Conference.
- Sophomore Chandler Burks made his first collegiate start at QB versus Point, totaling 220 yards of offense including a career-high 138 rushing yards on just nine carries – an average of 15.3 yards per rush.
- Senior RB Micah Reed, sophomore Jonah Huff and redshirt-freshman Daniel David all scored their first touchdowns wearing the Black and Gold on Sept. 10 versus Point.
- Dustin Clabough (six tackles) and Bronson Rechsteiner (two) each recorded career-highs in tackles versus Point.
- The Owls held Point to 94 rushing yards on 36 carries, who became the third victim in program history to fall short of 100 rushing yards in a single game.
- The Owls have held their opponents to 23 points through two home games, an average of 11.5 points per game.

FIFTH THIRD BANK STADIUM

Fifth Third Bank Stadium is located at 3200 George Busbee Pkwy NW, Kennesaw, GA 30144. The media entrance is located on the west side of the stadium near Gate B and the box office. The media entrance will open three hours prior to kickoff.

KSU head coach Brian Bohannon and requested players will be available in the post-game interview approximately 10 minutes after the team enters the locker room. Kennesaw State's locker room is closed. The SID of the visiting school will establish admittance policies to the visiting locker room.

A WIN VERSUS DUQUESNE WOULD

- Give Kennesaw State its second win of the 2016 season.
- Improve its record to 7-5 in first-time meetings in program history.
- Give the Owls their first road victory since Sept. 3, 2015 at ETSU, snapping a four-game losing skid.

TAKING A LOOK AT THE DUKES

- Duquesne is the reigning Northeast Conference Champions and were picked to repeat as conference champs in 2016. The Dukes fell in the 2015 NCAA FCS Playoffs to William & Mary, 52-49.
- The Dukes entered the season with seven offensive starting returning and six defensive players returning from an 8-4 overall campaign in 2015.
- Head Coach Jerry Schmitt is in his 12th season at the helm of the Dukes and 17th overall. He currently owns a 69-52 overall record at Duquesne and a 97-73 overall coaching record.
- Duquesne is coming off a season in which lost to William & Mary, 52-49, in the NCAA FCS Playoffs.
- RB Rafiq Douglas returns after rushing for 977 yards and 11 touchdowns in 2015.

LOOKING BACK AT POINT

- Kennesaw State rolled up 555 yards of total offense and sophomore QB Chandler Burks accounted for three touchdowns as the Owls took down Point University, 49-3, at Fifth Third Bank Stadium on Sept. 10.
- The Owls announced their eight-straight sellout crowd at Fifth Third Bank Stadium on Sept. 10 when Kennesaw State hosted non-conference foe Point to campus. KSU has sold out all eight games at The Nest in program history.
- Sophomore Chandler Burks made his first collegiate start at QB versus Point, totaling 220 yards of offense including a career-high 138 rushing yards on just nine carries – an average of 15.3 yards per rush.
- Kennesaw State totaled 201 rushing yards in the first half on just 19 carries. The team's first-half rushing average of 10.57 yards per carry set a school record, surpassing the 7.4 yards in the first half versus Point last season.
- It is the fourth time in school history the Owls have surpassed 200 yards rushing in the first half (254 at Dayton in 2015, 221 vs. Point in 2015 and 207 vs. Edward Waters in 2015).
- The Owls' 49 points are the most points scored in a single game since Point was welcomed to The Nest in 2015, when KSU racked up a school-record 56 points on the day.

CB3 AWAKENED

- Sophomore Chandler Burks made his first collegiate start at QB versus Point, completing a career-high nine passes – which also tied the school mark for most completions in a game – for 82 yards in the air.
- Burks not only did damage through the air, but a career-high 138 rushing yards on just nine carries – an average of 15.3 yards per rush – also provided a dual threat under center.
- Burks' 220 total yards of offense was the fifth time in school history a QB has totaled over 200 yards of offense, as senior QB Trey White owns the other four: Monmouth, Shorter, Point, GWU.
- The sophomore, with a 14-0 lead capped off a 98-yard drive with a career-best 51-yard touchdown run in the second quarter versus Point to give the Owls a three-score lead at the time. Burks accounted for 82 of the 98 yards on the drive including the TD rush and a 31-yard run earlier in the drive.

CB3'S CONNECTION WITH SUMPTER

- QB Chandler Burks entered the game late in the Owls' season opener on Sept. 3 versus East Tennessee State and completed four passes, including a 22-yd TD catch in OT, to wide out Justin Sumpter.
- The connection carried over to KSU's game versus Point, as the two hooked up for a 4-yard TD catch and a 3-yard touchdown grab on back-to-back possessions in the first quarter.
- Burks found Sumpter for five catches in the game for 59 yards and two scores.

SURE HANDS SUMPTER

- Sophomore WR Justin Sumpter hauled in a career-high two TD passes versus Point -- both coming in the first quarter. It marked his sixth career game with at least one TD catch.
- The Point game marked the third time in his career that he's totaled at least five catches. His career-high of six catches game in Week 1 vs. East Tennessee State.
- Through two games in 2016, the wide out is averaging 67.0 yards per game, totaling 134 yards on 11 receptions - a 12.2 average per catch.

THE STREAK

- The Owls announced their eight-straight sellout crowd at Fifth Third Bank Stadium on Sept. 10 when Kennesaw State hosted non-conference foe Point to campus. KSU has sold out all eight games at The Nest in program history.
- The Owls, who went 5-1 at Fifth Third Bank Stadium in 2015, responded from a season-opening loss a week ago to enter their bye week 1-1 with an impressive 49-3 victory in The Nest in front of the Owl faithful.
- Kennesaw State is 6-2 overall at The Bank in program history, outgaining opponents 223-85 in eight games and scored 50 or more three times and 40 or more once in an offensive juggernaut showcase on their home grass.
- The Owls are holding their opponents to an incredible 10.6 points per game at Fifth Third Bank Stadium and 261.8 yards per game, including holding teams to 100 rushing yards per game in two home games in 2016.

RUNNING THE 'O'

- The Owls totaled over 500 yards of total offense for the third time in program history versus Point.
- In fact, KSU's 412 rushing yards fell just five yards shy of a new school record on the ground, as the Owls' 416 versus Edward Waters set the mark in the home inaugural game.
- Kennesaw State totaled 26 first downs, 143 yards through the air and averaged 8.5 yards per rush versus Point in an offensive showcase for all 60 minutes.
- Kennesaw State totaled 201 rushing yards in the first half on just 19 carries. The team's first-half rushing average of 10.57 yards per carry set a school record, surpassing the 7.4 yards in the first half versus Point last season.
- It is the fourth time in school history the Owls have surpassed 200 yards rushing in the first half (254 at Dayton in 2015, 221 vs. Point in 2015 and 207 vs. Edward Waters in 2015).
- The Owls rushed for four touchdowns versus Point, marking the fifth time in program history Kennesaw State rushed for four or more TDs in a single game: ETSU (6 -- record), Edward Waters (5), at Dayton (4), Point (5) all in 2015.
- Interestingly, the Owls outgained the Skyhawks in total yards (555-236) and rushing yards (412-94) but Point won the time of possession battle (32:06-27:54).
- The Owls scored 14 points in each of the first three quarters of the game versus Point and seven more in the fourth. Kennesaw State owns a 6-1 mark when lead after the first, 6-2 mark when leading after the second and a perfect 6-0 record when leading after the third quarter under head coach Brian Bohannon in 13 games.

GETTING DEE-FENSIVE

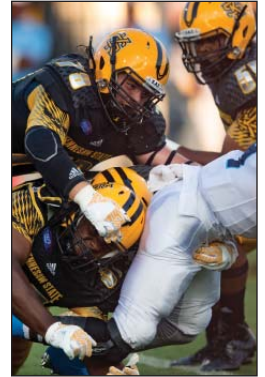
- Kennesaw State's defense has been nothing short of spectacular throughout the first two home games, allowing just 11.5 points per game and 278 yards per game.
- The Owls held Point to 94 yards rushing on 36 carries as the Skyhawks became the third foe in the last two seasons to fall short of 100 yards rushing versus KSU.
- The Owls held Point to 94 rushing yards on 36 carries, who became the third victim in program history to fall short of 100 rushing yards in a single game.
- Kennesaw State, in fact, has now held its opponents scoreless in the first quarter in seven of the 13 games in program history.
- Point went scoreless in the second half versus KSU, becoming the first opponent to be shutout in the second half in program history.

NOTES TO REMEMBER IN 2016

- Tonarius Portress tied the Big South single-game record for tackles-for-loss as he registered 5.0 stops behind the line of scrimmage vs. East Tennessee State.
- Portress is now the seventh player in Big South history with 5.0TFL in a game, but just the second to achieve the feat in a season opener (ETSU, Sept. 3, 2016).
- Rewarding his performance in Week 1 was the Big South Conference, naming Portress Defensive Player of the Week for his performance versus ETSU.
- Senior WB Trey White became the ninth QB in Big South history to surpass 1,000 career rushing yards, as he eclipsed this milestone in the season opener versus ETSU.
- White needs 151 rushing yards to move into eighth all-time in Big South history QB history.
- White also became the 13th Big South signal-caller with 10 career rushing touchdowns.
- Taylor Henkle's 22-yard punt return versus Point marked the longest in Kennesaw State history.
- The Owls totaled over 500 yards of total offense for the third time in program history versus Point on Sept. 10, 2016.
- Kennesaw State is 6-2 overall at The Bank in program history, outscoring opponents 223-85 in eight games.
- The Owls shutout Point in the second half on Sept. 3, 2015, marking the first time in history KSU shut out an opponent over the final 30 minutes.
- Kennesaw State's defense gave up three points to the Skyhawks, the lowest total in a single game in program history.

KENNESAW STATE, SAMFORD AGREE TO FOUR-GAME SERIES

- Kennesaw State and Samford have announced a four-game series that begins in the 2017 season.
- The first and fourth games of the series will be Thursday night season-openers at Samford's Seibert Stadium in Birmingham in 2017 and 2022, while the middle two games are set for KSU's Fifth Third Bank Stadium in 2018 and 2020.
- A member of the Southern Conference, Samford is entering its second season under head coach Chris Hatcher. The Bulldogs went 6-5 last season and made a 2013 appearance in the Division-I FCS Playoffs. Samford is the third Southern Conference member to appear on KSU's football slate, joining Furman (2016, 2019) and Wofford (2020).
- Kennesaw State is set to battle Georgia State in 2018, the Owls' first scheduled game versus a Football Bowl Subdivision program.
- A scheduled game at Georgia Tech in 2021 would be KSU's first against a Power-5 program.

HEAD COACH BRIAN BOHANNON

Brian Bohannon made history on March 24, 2013 when he was named the first football coach in the history of Kennesaw State University.

As the program enters its second season in 2016, Bohannon looks to continue the momentum from a dazzling debut in 2015 that saw the Owls finish 6-5, roll up eye-popping numbers out of the spread option offense and sellout every home game at Fifth Third Bank while going 5-1 in front of raucous crowds.

In 18 years as either a college assistant or head coach, Bohannon has been part of teams that averaged 8.6 wins per season, reached the postseason 15 times and won a pair of national championships while at Georgia Southern.

A Griffin, Ga., native and former wide receiver at the University of Georgia, Bohannon joined the Owls after spending the previous five seasons as quarterbacks/B-backs coach at Georgia Tech where he helped engineer one of the country's most prolific spread option offenses.

His first team at Kennesaw State rushed for 293.0 yards per game, which led the Big South Conference and ranked sixth nationally. It was the second-best single-season rushing effort by a Big South team since VMI's 357.5 yards in 2008. The Owls lit up the scoreboard with 41 touchdowns and 429.8 yards per game.

It didn't take the nation long to realize Kennesaw State's explosiveness. KSU blitzed East Tennessee State, 56-16, on the road in a matchup of two programs playing their first-ever games. The next week, the Owls were welcomed home for the first time and pounded Edward Waters, 58-7, in front of 9,506 at Fifth Third Bank Stadium.

Bohannon's Owls began their debut season 4-1 in non-conference action and made history again with a 12-7 win over Gardner-Webb on October 17 as Kennesaw State became the first Big South member to win its first conference game in its initial year as a member.

The early-season success gave Bohannon's team national recognition in the Top 25 polls for the first time in program history, as KSU spent three consecutive weeks among teams receiving votes in the FCS Stats Top 25 beginning October 19.

Another Big South win over Monmouth, 23-13, allowed the Owls to clinch a winning record and the team would finish 6-5 to tie Georgia State for the third-best record by an FCS program in its inaugural season.

Four Owls received Big South honors as DB Taylor Henkle was named to the first team, while DB Derrick Farrow and OL Malik Letatau earned second-team nods. Senior WR Prentice Stone was named to the All-Academic Team and would become the program's first graduate this past May.

Bohannon himself earned praise as well as he was inducted to the Griffin-Spalding Hall of Fame and was named the state of Georgia's 2016 Most Positive College Head Coach by Positive Athlete Georgia – a program spearheaded by Hines Ward.

Bohannon was formally introduced as head coach at a press conference inside the locker room at Fifth Third Bank Stadium before a standing-room only audience that included media, family, friends, KSU Athletics administration and coaches, members of the University community and invited guests on March 26, 2013.

Since his arrival at Kennesaw State, Bohannon and his staff have been tireless in their efforts to attract high-quality student-athletes to The Nest. He signed his first recruiting class of 29 players on Feb. 5, 2014, added 16 future Owls on Feb. 4, 2015, and inked 18 more on the most recent National Signing Day.

Bohannon brought 17 seasons of coaching experience at the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) and Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) levels to Kennesaw State, all of which came under spread option mastermind Paul Johnson at Georgia Tech, Navy and Georgia Southern.

During Bohannon's time at Georgia Tech, the Yellow Jackets finished in the top four nationally in rushing offense every season and led the nation in rushing in 2010. No team in college football rushed for more yards than Georgia Tech, which accumulated more than 20,000 yards during his last five seasons.

Under Bohannon's direction, former Georgia Tech quarterbacks Tevin Washington and Joshua Nesbitt emerged as two of the most prolific signal callers in Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) history. Nesbitt and Washington combined to rush for more than 5,000 yards and rank first and third, respectively, in ACC history for career rushing yards by a quarterback.

Under Bohannon, four players rushed for more than 1,000 yards in a season -- B-back Jonathan Dwyer in 2008, Dwyer and Nesbitt in 2009, and B-back Anthony Allen in 2010. Dwyer was a first-team All-ACC selection in 2008 and 2009. Nesbitt was the first-team All-ACC quarterback in 2009, and Allen was first-team All-ACC in 2010. Dwyer and Allen went on to NFL careers.

Before arriving at Georgia Tech, Bohannon spent six years as wide receivers coach at Navy. He was part of a staff that returned the Midshipmen to the national spotlight. Navy won 35 games over four years, earning a school-record four consecutive bowl berths and a school-best four straight Commander-In-Chief's Trophies.

Prior to his appointment on Johnson's staff at Navy, Bohannon coached the wide receivers for three seasons at Georgia Southern before taking over the defensive backs his last two years.

In each of those five seasons in Statesboro, the Eagles advanced to the NCAA Division I-AA playoffs, finished as national runner-up in 1998 and claimed back-to-back national championships in 1999 and 2000.

A four-year letterwinner and standout wide receiver at Georgia, Bohannon started his coaching career at West Georgia before earning his first full-time position at Gardner-Webb (N.C.) as wide receivers coach in 1996.

Bohannon earned his bachelor's degree in general business from Georgia in 1993 and a master's in business education from West Georgia in 1996.

He is married to the former Melanie Cobb and the couple has three children, sons Blake Patrick and Braden Thomas, and daughter Brooke Anna. The family resides in Woodstock, Ga.
