» Head coach Al Skinner enters his 24th season as a head coach and second at Kennesaw State. Coach Skinner won his 400th career game against the N.C. A&T Aggies on December 22.

» The Owls secured their first ASUN Quarterfinal victory since the 2010 season and second victory in the ASUN Tournament ever topping Upstate 80-78. The other victory was in 2010 as KSU beat Lipscomb in the guarterfinals.

» Kennesaw State had three players honored by the ASUN as Kendrick Ray, Aubrey Williams and James Scott all landed on All-Conference teams. Ray became the first KSU player to be named ASUN First Team All-Conference.

» Kendrick Ray has elevated his game to another level in his senior season. He is averaging 21.0 points per game scoring over 30 points in four games this season. Against Lipscomb, he surpassed the 600 point mark becoming only the third player in Kennesaw State history with 600 points in a single season.

» Aubrey Williams is currently first in the ASUN and sixth in the country averaging 11.0 rebounds per game. He is averaging a double-double scoring 13.3 per game. » Nick Masterson has been highly efficient from the floor this season hitting 48.5 percent of his shots and 53.5 percent of his shots from behind the arc. The 53.5 percent clip is second in the nation. In true shooting percentage that combined field goal attempts, three-point field goal attempts and free throws, Masterson leads the team shooting 65.5 percent.



THE ALL-TIME SERIES VERSUS FGCU

Gulf Coast has won 13 straight games against Kennesaw State as the Owls are 6-15 against the Eagles.

Earlier this season, FGCU won by three in the KSU Convocation Center and then won by 12 down in Fort Myers.

This is the second season in a row the two teams have faced off in the ASUN Tournament.

SCOUTING FGCU

The Eagles racked up the post-season awards as Demetris Morant won ASUN Defensive Player of the Year, Brandon Goodwin won Newcomer of the Year and Joe Dooley won Coach of the year.

Goodwin has led the team averaging 17.9 points per game. He averaged 22.0 points per game in the two games against the Owls earlier this season.

ASUN TOURNAMENT HISTORY

Kennesaw State got their second win in ASUN Championship history over USC Upstate on Monday night with an 80-78 victory.

Their first victory came in 2010, when KSU topped the top seed Lipscomb.

With a win on Thursday against FGCU, the Owls would reach their first ASUN Championship game in program history.

ALL-CONFERENCE MEMBERS

The Owls had three student-athletes honored by the ASUN.

Kendrick Ray became the first player in Kennesaw State history to make First Team All-Conference after he averaged 20.9 points per game through the regular season.

Aubrey Williams was named Second Team All-Conference after being the only player in the ASUN to average a double-double with 13.3 points per game and 11.0 rebounds per game.

James Scott was voted onto the ASUN All-Freshmen Team after averaging 9.2 points per game in 16 minutes of action. He is the fifth Owl all time to make the All-Freshmen team and first since 2010.

Nation Leaders

Nick Masterson and Aubrey Williams hard work in the offseason is showing up on the court as the three of them are among the nation leaders in a couple of statistical categories.

Nick Masterson has been deadly from long range as he has made 81 of 153 for a 52.9 percent clip. That mark is second in the nation. He is the one of two players in the nation shooting over 50 percent from three-point range in the country.

Aubrey Williams has pulled down 19 double-doubles and is averaging 11.0 rebounds per game. The 19 double-doubles is fifth in the country. For the season, he has 330 rebounds, which is fifth in the country.

NCAA rankings do not include post-season games.

Super Senior

Ray is currently second in the ASUN averaging 21.0 ppg. He has scored at least 20 points in 18 of the 31 games this season and has four 30-point performances. Last season, he had two 30-point games giving him six for his career.

Ray became the first KSU player in history to be named ASUN First Team All-Conference.

Against USC Upstate in the ASUN Quarterfinals, Ray scored 18 points in the second half to help guide the Owls to a two-point victory over the Spartans.

Owning the Boards

Through 31 games, Aubrey Williams is averaging 13.1 points and 11.0 rebounds with 19 double-doubles. Williams had a double-double in 10 of the 14 conference games through the regular season.

Earlier in the season against FGCU, Williams set the single-season rebounding record at Kennesaw State.

Williams is the first ASUN player to average a double-double since Daniel Emerson did it back in 2009-10.

Smart Outside Shooting

Kennesaw State doesn't shoot a lot of threes, but when they do it's usually a good shot leading to a high shooting percentage from behind the arc. The Owls are second in the nation shooting 41.7 percent from three-point range.

Two players have carried the load as Masterson and Ray have made 166 of the 200 three pointers by the team including the ASUN Quarterfinal game against Lipscomb.

Double Digit Wins

The victory against USC Upstate set a new record for wins in Division I with 14 in the regular season.

This is the third season in a row that Kennesaw State has notched double-digit victories.

Hot at the Right Time

Heading down the stretch of conference season, a team always wants to be hitting its stride and the past two seasons Coach Skinner has done just that. In his two seasons as head coach of Kennesaw State, the Owls are 9-5 in February. The team has outscored its opponents 1,128-1,034 in those 14 games.

Success on the Road

The Owls have six wins on the road this season, which is the most since the team joined Division I. In ASUN action, the team is 5-4 winning three of their last four games on the road.

Setting Up Their Teammates

Against USC Upstate, the Owls had 19 assists to only eight turnovers.

The Owls are second in the ASUN in assists per game averaging 15.9 through the 32 games.

In conference play, Kennesaw State leads the ASUN in assist to turnover ratio at 1.3 as they average the 16.1 assists per game and 12.3 turnovers per game.

Masterson of the Three

Nick Masterson is averaging 12.8 points per game with a 48.9 percentage from the floor and 53.5 percent from behind the arc, which is second in the nation.

Overall, Masterson has made 84 three pointers this season compared to last year where he only made 31.

Against Jacksonville, he went 5-6 from three-point range. That is the fifth time this season that he has had at least five three pointers in a game.

Dynamic Offensive Duo

Williams and Ray have stepped up time and again this season as senior captains. The two are combining to score 34.1 points per game together.

In the 31 games this season, the two have combined to lead the team in scoring in 23 of them.

Great Scott

James Scott got his first career start against Stetson and came up big for Kennesaw State scoring a career high 33 points for the Owls. It is the fifth 30-point performance for Kennesaw State this season, and he is the second freshman in the ASUN to score over 30 points in a game this season.

For the season overall, he's averaging 8.9 points per game in 15.8 minutes per game. Per 40 minutes, the freshman is second on the team averaging 22.3 points per game.

He became the first KSU player to be named to the All-Freshmen Team since Delbert Love in 2010.

Freshmen Five

In the games against USC Upstate at home and Stetson on the road, five freshmen were on the floor at the same time and in both games they extended the team's lead. Over a span of 7:17 on the game clock, Tyler Hooker, James Scott, Anthony Wilson, Johannes Nielsen and Zach Cameron are +9 on the floor.

Against Stetson, the group was +8 pushing the Owls out to a double-digit lead.

400 Career Victories

Head Coach Al Skinner got win number 400 against North Carolina A&T as the Owls defeated the Aggies 68-60. He's currently in his 24th season as a head coach.

Coaching Tree

Coach Skinner is one of the very few Coaches in Division 1 Basketball, to have 4 of his former assistants, currently serving as Head Coaches-Tim O'Shea at Bryant University, Ed Cooley at Providence College, Bill Coen at Northeastern & Pat Duquette at U Mass-Lowell.

1,000 Career Points

After setting a single-season record with 579 points in his first season at Kennesaw State, Ray needed 11 points against North Georgia and got just that surpassing the 1,000 career points mark.

ASUN Championship Final on ESPN & Westwood One

For the first time since 2002, the ASUN Championship Final will be seen on ESPN after spending the past few seasons on ESPN2. The 2017 ASUN Final is set for Sunday, Mar. 5th at 3 PM. To go along with the ESPN coverage, Westwood One will air the conference final for the second-straight season on national radio.

Al Skinner, a former Division I national coach of the year and two-time BIG EAST Conference Coach of the Year, was named the head coach of the Kennesaw State men's basketball program on April 26, 2015.

In his first season at Kennesaw State and 23rd season as a head coach, Skinner had a big impact on the Owls team guiding them to a .500 record in the Atlantic Sun Conference for the first time since the 2006-07 season. The team won four of its final five regular season games, including beating the back-to-back A-Sun Champions, North Florida.

A big part of the success came from the guard play as Kendrick Ray and Yonel Brown both thrived under Coach Skinner as each of them set a new Division I single-season Kennesaw State points record with 579 and 578 points respectively. The leading duo in the A-Sun finished as one of three pairs in the country to average over 18 points per game with Ray averaging 18.7 ppg and Brown averaging 18.6 ppg.

Both student-athletes were honored at the end of the season as they were named A-Sun Second Team All-Conference, and Ray was unanimously voted as the Newcomer of the Year

A current member of the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Ethics Coalition, Skinner guided his teams to nine NCAA Tournament appearances and four conference titles during tenures at the University of Rhode Island and Boston College. His teams posted ten 20-plus win seasons.

The winningest coach in BC history, Skinner spent 13 seasons at The Heights, compiling a 247-165 (.560) record from 1997-2010. He took Boston College to six NCAA Tournaments in a seven-year stretch, leading his 2005-06 team to the Sweet 16. Four of his teams finished the year ranked in the final Associated Press Top 25 Poll, including the 2001 and 2007 clubs that concluded those seasons at No. 7.

After guiding the Eagles to a 27-5 overall record and the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Skinner was named 2001 National Coach of the Year by Chevrolet/CBS, ESPN,Sports Illustrated, The Sporting News and the United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA). He also earned BIG EAST Conference Coach of the Year honors.

Skinner earned BIG EAST Conference Coach of the Year again in 2005 after leading Boston College to a 25-5 mark and the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Prior to his time at BC, Skinner spent nine seasons as head coach at Rhode Island, leading the Rams to a 138-126 (.523) mark. Skinner took over as head coach at URI in 1988 after serving as an assistant on the Rams' bench from 1984-88.

During his tenure in Kingston, he led Rhode Island to a pair of NCAA Tournament berths (1993 and 1997) and two more National Invitational Tournament (NIT) appearances (1992 and 1996), as well as three 20+ win seasons. He was named the Atlantic-10 Coach of the Year in 1991-92 and was inducted into the University of Rhode Island Athletics Hall of Fame in 2000.

Skinner came to Kennesaw State after serving two seasons as associate head coach under longtime friend Tim O'Shea at Bryant University where the Bulldogs compiled a 34-29 (.540) overall record, including a 22-12 (.647) mark in the Northeast Conference.

Skinner first broke into coaching as an assistant at Marist College in 1982 following successful stints in the ABA and NBA from 1974-80 (Nets, Pistons, 76ers). Drafted by the ABA's New York Nets in the eighth round of the 1974 draft, Skinner was named to the 1974-75 ABA All-Rookie Team and led the Nets to an ABA Championship a year later.

Prior to his professional playing career, Skinner spent three years on the court at the University of Massachusetts from 1971-74, becoming the only player in Minuteman history to be named a three-time All-Yankee Conference selection.

A team captain and All-America Honorable Mention in 1973-74, Skinner remains one of the most decorated players in UMass basketball history, concluding his career with 1,235 points, 749 rebounds and 320 assists in 79 games. Skinner was inducted into the UMass Athletics Hall of Fame in 1982, and his No. 30 jersey was retired by the Minutemen on Feb. 18, 2004.

Skinner and his wife, Donna, have two grown children, Vaniecia and Andre.
