## » THE OPENING DRAW

» Kennesaw State takes on the Butler Bulldogs at Fifth-Third Bank Stadium on March 12 at 12 p.m. to close out a two-game homestand.

» This is the first meeting in program history between the Owls and the Bulldogs.

» **Siena Gore** is the driving force behind the Owls' scoring production. The midfielder was fourth in the nation in 2021 in goals per game and eighth in total goals, while also ranking first in free position goals per game at 2.36. This season, she's currently third in the NCAA in total goals (29), 11th in goals per game (4.14), and 13th in draw controls per game (7.57).

» Graduate transfer **McKenzie Jackson** has accumulated 11 goals and 17 draw controls so far this season. The attacker was a two-time First-Team All-Sunshine State Conference selection for Embry-Riddle.

» One advantage for Kennesaw State heading into the schedule, the Owls return nine of 11 starters from last year's squad, and a total of 20 overall players. Sixth-year head coach **Laura Maness** is hopeful that experience will be an advantage for KSU this season.

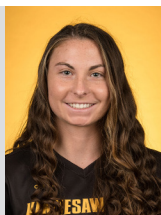

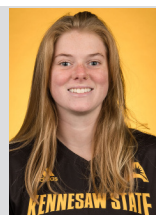

### KENNESAW STATE HISTORY

» Siena Gore has re-written the Kennesaw State record book, holding all-time career records for total goals, shots on goal, draw controls, free-position goals and points. She ranked among the top-10 in the NCAA in 2021 for assists, ground balls and caused turnovers. She currently holds the top two spots for single-season records in points, goals, shots on goal and draw controls.

### THE GORE EFFECT

• Senior **Siena Gore** has dominated the attack for KSU throughout her career, becoming the only Owl in history to score over 50 goals in a season, netting 70 in 2018, 68 in 2019 and 67 in 2021.

• Gore has scored four or more goals in 31 games, averaging 4.08 goals per game for her career. She has scored three or more goals in all but 10 games throughout her career and has only been held to less than two goals once.

• KSU's first-ever ASUN Player of the Year, Gore led the team in 2019 with 68 goals, 78 points, 36 ground balls and 98 draw controls while second with 21 caused turnovers.

• Gore is just the third player in ASUN history to record over 200 career draw controls. After picking up five draw controls against Florida in 2020, she became the all-time **ASUN record holder** with 339 and counting.

• After scoring six goals in 2020's tilt against Presbyterian, Gore became the first Owl in program history to reach 150 career

goals scored. She is the only player in the conference to record over 200 career goals, setting the **ASUN record** for goals after recording four in KSU's 2021 tilt against Stetson.

• Deadly from the eight-meter arc, Gore has netted 99 free position goals in her career with a 56.4 shooting percentage. She finished the 2019 season ranked third in the NCAA averaging 1.56 free position goals per game, and led the NCAA in 2021 averaging 2.31 per game.

• As the leader of the offense, Gore has accounted for nearly 30 percent of the Owls' goals scored and 40 percent of their draw controls since joining KSU.

• With her hat trick against Florida in 2021, she reached 191 career points to surpass Sydney Farwick (2014-17) for the KSU all-time career points record.

• Gore has won nearly every accolade the league has to offer, earning Freshman of the Year honors in 2018 and a spot on the all-academic team in 2019. She is the only Owls to be named a three-time First Team All-ASUN selection.

## NOTES

### SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

Junior Campbell Connors is the leading scorer for the Bulldogs with 12 goals on the season. Fellow Junior Greer Bireley is the team's leader in assists with a total of 10 to date. Securing possession for the Bulldogs is midfielder Leah Rubino, who has 23 draw controls this season. Protecting the net is Aleigh Monroe, who has 32 saves and a save percentage of .416.

### OWLS ROUT WOFFORD

Kennesaw State cruised in its game against Wofford, scoring the first six goals on the way to a 22-9 win on March 5. The game marked the largest win margin (13 goals) since a 25-3 win at Howard in 2019, and was a season-high in goals for KSU as well.

### No. 11 FOR GORE!!

Thanks to a week in which she averaged five goals a game, senior Siena Gore picked up her second ASUN Player of the Week honor, and the 11th overall in her career, the league announced on March 8.

### FIRST-EVER POWER FIVE VICTORY

Kennesaw State claimed its first-ever victory over a Power Five school on Feb. 20 when it held off the Oregon Ducks for 14-13 victory. That was also the first-ever victory for KSU against the Pac-12 Conference, after dropping a pair of games to Arizona State.

### BRING OUT THE BROOMS

The Owls swept the ASUN Player of the Week awards in week two of competition. Siena Gore brought home Offensive Player of the Week after accumulating five goals, two assists and five draw controls. Errin Crowe earned the first Defensive Player of the Week of her career with a career high eight saves and save percentage of .533.

### PRESEASON ACCOLADES

The Owls placed two on the preseason All-ASUN team. Both were repeat selections, beginning with to no one's surprise, star senior Siena Gore as a midfielder. She was joined by senior defender Payton Gregory.

### NEXT TIME OUT

The Owls hit the road for a two-game road trip to Washington D.C., leading off with a match against Howard University on Tuesday, March 15 at Greene Stadium at 3:30 p.m.
