KWC is 0-24 against 12 different universities. ►The last I-AA contest — Sept. 15, 2007 at Southeastern Louisiana — L, 79-7. ►Top five crowds to watch KWC vs. I-AA: 49,212 at South Florida, Sept. 6, 1997; 12,125 at Southern Illinois, Aug. 29, 2002; 9,600 at Western Kentucky, Aug. 29, 1996; 6,269 at Liberty, Sept. 20, 2003; and 5,137 at Tennessee Tech, Sept. 3, 1998.

Texas homecoming: The Panthers Cliff Thomas, a 5-foot-8, 135-pound redshirt-freshman defensive back from Houston (North Shore High School), returns to his home state.

Next week: KWC opens Great Lakes Football Conference play at Missouri S&T.

NCAA Division II statistics: Senior wide receiver Josh Smith is tied for seventh in the nation in receptions (7.6 rpg) and 19th in receiving yards (92.2 ypg). Junior cornerback Robert Glover is tied for 19th in interceptions (0.6 ipg). Senior wide receiver David Smith is tied for 29th in receptions (6.2 rpg). Sophomore Sean Maguire is 42nd in punting (30.0 ypg). The Panthers are ranked 12th in passing offense (301.0 ypg) and 25th in net punting (35.3 ypg).

Almost: The Panthers came close to breaking the single game record for most total offensive yards with 596 at Grand View. The record is 623 set at North Greenville on Oct. 26, 2002.

50-plus: Sophomore Sean Maguire tied for the ninth longest punt with 57 yards against Southwest Baptist.

Clean sweep: Sophomore quarterback Chris Owen and senior linebacker Chad Smith swept Great Lakes Football Conference Players of the Week honors in offense and defense respectfully for their performances in the Panthers 31-28 win at Kentucky Christian on Sept. 6. Owen threw for 262 passing yards on 20-for-30 attempts for three touchdowns including the game-winning 27-yard touchdown pass. Smith collected a team-high 10 tackles including seven solos and a fumble recovery.

GLFC POW: Josh Smith, a senior wide receiver from O'Fallin, Ill., caught a game high and KWC single game record 13 passes for 124 yards including a 51-yard reception in the Panthers 40-14 loss to visiting Indianapolis to be named the GLFC Offensive Player of the Week.

Top 10 performances: Josh Smith set a new single game record for receptions with 13 versus Indianapolis surpassing 11 caught by Corey Jordan (2000), Jason Simpson (2004) and DaMarcus Ganaway (2007). Chris Owen's 27 pass completions against the Greyhounds tied for the sixth best single game performance in history.

26th season: 2008 marks the 26th season of modern football at KWC. The sport was renewed on Sept. 3, 1983, after a 53-year absence. The Panthers played when the college was located in Winchester, 15 miles east of Lexington, from 1907 to 1930. The sport was dropped due to the depression.

Preseason All-America: Greg Embers, a senior strong safety from Louisville, received preseason All-American honorable mention recognition by the Consensus Draft Services. He finished second in tackles with 73.5 and tackles for loss with 12 in 2007.

Fab five: Five Kentucky Wesleyan Panthers were named to the D2Football.com All-Independent team. First team selection Greg Embers (ss), Perry Freeze (og), Brandon Hodnett (k), Ron Rapiere (fs) and second team honoree Josh Smith (wr).

From where: The 2008 squad hales from 13 states: Kentucky 55; Florida 8; Indiana 6; Mississippi 6; Illinois 5; Ohio 5; Alabama 1; California 1; Georgia 1; Maryland 1; Michigan 1; New Jersey 1; and Texas 1.

Strength in numbers: The Panthers have 11 seniors, 20 juniors, 18 sophomores and 41 freshmen. KWC has eight three-year letterwinners, 11 two-year letterwinners, 21 one-year letterwinners, 12 redshirts and three transfers.

Coaches choice: The Panthers were picked No. 4 in the Great Lakes Football Conference coaches preseason poll. Missouri S&T was chosen as the favorite to win the title followed by 2. Saint Joseph's, 3. Central State, 4. Kentucky Wesleyan and 5. Lincoln.
