POW: Thomas Gordon received Great Lakes Football Conference Offensive Player of the Week honors for his 103-yard rushing performance at Indianapolis.

Indianapolis: Richard Fangman recorded his longest career field goal (41)...Thomas Gordon produced his first 100-yard rushing game (103) on a career high 19 carries...Steven Smith collected his first career interception for a 25-yard return in his hometown.
