STORYLINES

FRESH PANTHER FACES: The Kentucky Wesleyan women's basketball program has just three players returning from last season's 21-7 team: Shiya Hoosier, Sydnee Richetto, and Myah Montgomery. The new faces include five freshman (Asia Sawyers, Lena Stinebrickner, Emma Bruwer, Carson Sisk, and Laura Hruby) and four transfers (Arielle Dabu, Riley Neal, Vilborg Jonsdottir, and Ilani Williams-Harris).

NEW STRUCTURE AT THE TOP: After 14 seasons as co-head coaches of the Kentucky Wesleyan women's basketball program, Nicole Nieman is now the head coach while Caleb Nieman has been titled the associate head coach. Although different in structure, the operation is set to remain the same as the Niemans look to build on their incredible run thus far.

SUCCESSFUL CAMPAIGNS: Both programs are coming off successful campaigns last season as both finished with a 21-7 record. The Panthers appeared in the Division II Tournament, ultimately falling in the first round to Northern Michigan, while the Thorobreds made it to the championship of the SIAC Tournament before narrowly being defeated by Miles.

YOUTH AT THE HELM: Amani Williams, a Kentucky State women's basketball alum from just four years ago, was named the Thorobreds head coach before last season. In her first year, she was named the SIAC Coach of the Year and led Kentucky State to the 2023-24 SIAC Regular Season West Division Title. Williams and the Thorobreds will look to build on that campaign this season.

SERIES HISTORY: This will be just the fourth matchup among the two programs all-time, with Kentucky State currently leading 2-1. The programs faced off twice in the 2015-16 season, with the Thorobreds taking the first 79-59 in Frankfort and the second 72-64 in Owensboro. The Panthers' lone win came last season, an impressive 95-51 triumph in Frankfort.

THE COACHES

The Niemans

15th season

The team of Nicole and Caleb Nieman enter their 15th season together at Kentucky Wesleyan College, this time with a new structure at the top. Nicole is now the sole head coach, while Caleb's official title is associate head coach of the Panthers. The Niemans have recorded a 279-120 overall record at the helm of the program.

The Niemans' historic success as a duo continued last season, as the Panthers compiled a 21-7 record and another NCAA Tournament appearance, ultimately falling to Northern Michigan in the first round. Jordyn Barga (11.1 PPG), Emmy Ralph (11.0 PPG), and Corina Conley (10.8 PPG) led the way during another winning campaign.

In 2023, the Panthers qualified for yet another NCAA tournament. Led by first team all-conference members Cali Nolot and Tahlia Walton, the Panthers finished their season with a record of 23-7, and fell to #5 Grand Valley State in overtime in the NCAA Regional.

Caleb and Nicole led Wesleyan to another strong season in 2021-22, finishing the year with a 19-10 (15-6 G-MAC) record. They concluded the season ranked ninth in the region and made the semi-finals of the G-MAC tournament.

In 2021, the Panthers had yet another successful season, going 18-6 with a 16-4 mark in the G-MAC. This season included a nine game winning streak and a birth in both the G-MAC title game as well as the NCAA Midwest Regional as the #3 seed.

The Niemans guided the Panthers to a 24-8 record in 2019 with a 18-4 mark in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. Wesleyan won the regular season Great Midwest Title while earning an at large bid into the NCAA Tournament, marking the third time in their tenure. The Panthers post-season run ended with a loss to the nation's top team in Drury University. Wesleyan also produced a perfect 16-0 mark at the Sportscenter, the longest home winning streak in school history.

The Panthers finished 2018 with a 15-12 record and an even 11-11 mark in Great Midwest action. Wesleyan qualified again for the Great Midwest Tournament, falling in the opening round to Walsh, 75-67.

More success continued for the Panthers in 2017 as the Nieman's guided Wesleyan to a 19-8 overall record with an 8-6 mark in the Great Midwest Athletic Conference. The season featured an 11 game winning-streak that ran into the New Year.

In 2016, the Nieman's won their 100th game after defeating Lane College 69-45. It is the fastest to 100 wins by any women's basketball coaches in Kentucky Wesleyan history.

For the third consecutive season, the Niemans produced 20-wins as they finished the 2014-15 year with a 20-9 record, place third in the G-MAC regular season while reaching the G-MAC Championship game for the third time in four seasons..

The 2013-14 season marked a banner year as they won the Great Midwest Athletic Conference Tournament Championship after tying for third in the regular season as they compiled their second straight 20-win season with a 21-8 record plus 12-4 in the G-MAC.

The Nieman's also saw Karly Rhodes become their first All-American that season. She became the third Panther in history to receive this honor.

Kentucky Wesleyan captured a share of their first-ever Great Lakes Valley Conference East Division Championship with a 14-4 slate and earning a trip to the NCAA Midwest Region Quarterfinals by finishing with a 20-9 record during the 2012-13 season. The 20 wins and the NCAA tournament appearance marked only the second time in Panther history, while the 14

GLVC wins set a new KWC single season record. The Niemans guided the squad to 10 victories in their last 12 games.

The Panthers also climbed to their highest spot in the NCAA Midwest Region rankings at No. 5 in the final poll. They also produced their second biggest upset in history by defeating the nation's No. 5 team, Indianapolis, 67-61, on Jan. 17. KWC led the GLVC in three-pointers, second in forcing turnovers and third in scoring offense. This marked the third straight season KWC finished in the Top Three in the league. The five graduating seniors ended their career as the winningest senior class in history with a four-year record 65 wins.

The 2011-12 Panthers compiled their second straight 17-win season with a 17-13 mark as they pulled off two one-point upsets including over No. 16-ranked Wisconsin-Parkside in the Great Lakes Valley Conference Tournament to reach the championship game for the first time in program history.

The Niemans' guided KWC to a 17-10 record in 2010-11 and the first-ever trip to the NCAA tournament in their 36-year history. The 17-wins tied for the third-most in history as they earned KWC's highest finish in the GLVC East Division with a second place tie.

They used 17 different starting lineups where 11 of 12 saw action in 20-plus games with all averaging 13 minutes or more per contest in their first season leading the Panthers.

The couple came to KWC as assistants to then head coach Ron Williams in the summer of 2009 from Michigan where they combined for six years serving as co-head coaches in high school and two years of college coaching experience at a Division III powerhouse.

Prior to moving to Owensboro, Nicole spent two seasons as an assistant and head junior varsity coach at the legendary Calvin College in Grand Rapids, Mich. She helped lead the Knights to 35 wins in two years including a 19-8 record in 2009 where they set the NCAA Division III single game attendance record 4,395.

At the prep level the Nieman's inherited a 2-19 team at Greenville High School in Greenville, Mich., and proceeded to take the Yellow Jackets to back-to-back Class A district playoff wins for the first time since the 1998 season. For their accomplishments, they were named the Area's Coach of the Year.

Caleb, a certified strength and conditioning specialist, worked for the Grand Rapids MVP Sportsplex supervising over 700 athletes including collegiate and professional teams and athletes plus the Michigan State University's Athletic Strength and Conditioning program.

Caleb graduated from Grand Valley State University in 2001 with a bachelor's degree in physical education and a master's in kinesiology from Michigan State University in 2009.

Nicole, a native of Marlette, Mich. graduated from Aquinas College in 2002 with a bachelor's degree in learning disabilities and a master's in kinesiology from Michigan State University in 2009. They have one daughter, Lilly.
