Today's Contest

Lamar and Rice will be meeting for the sixth straight season this afternoon. The game will be broadcast in Beaumont on KLVI Radio 560 AM. It will also be broadcast in Houston on ESPN Radio 97.5 FM.

Series History

This will be the 26th meeting between Lamar and Rice with the series dating back to a 69-65 Rice win on Feb. 17, 1954. The Owls lead the all-time series by a 16-9 margin.

The Owls won the first six meetings in the series before Lamar won 65-53 in Beaumont on Dec. 1, 1960. Rice leads 11-3 all-time in Houston.

More recent history has seen Lamar and Rice meet in each of the last six seasons, including today's game. Lamar has won the last three matchups in the series, including 77-61 last year in Beaumont. The last meeting in Houston was two years ago when Lamar won 61-53.

Last Time They Met

Lamar and Rice last met on Dec. 23, 2009, with the Cardinals winning 77-61 in the Montagne Center.

Lamar shot 50.0 percent from the field in the first half en route to a 38-26 advantage after the first 20 minutes. The Cardinals continued their efficiency in the second half as they pulled away for the 16-point victory.

Lamar enjoyed a 10-rebound advantage on the Owls, and held Rice to 37.7 percent shooting from the floor. The Cards also shot nine more free throws than Rice and made 10 more.

Current junior Anthony Miles may have had his best game as a Cardinal, finishing with a career-high 28 points, 10 rebounds and five assists. Charlie Harper chipped in with 14 points and eight rebounds as all five LU starters scored in double-figures.

Rice got 15 points from Tamir Jackson and 13 points and nine rebounds from Arsalan Kazemi.

Scouting the Owls

Rice enters today's game with a 3-4 overall record and carrying a three-game losing streak after falling to Arizona by an 84-57 score on Wednesday.

The Owls are scoring 67.1 points per game as a team and are allowing 63.7 to their opponents. Rice is shooting 41.3 percent from the field, 29.5 percent from 3-point range and 76.9 percent from the free throw line. The Owls are tied with North Dakota for the 18th best free throw percentage in the nation.

Rice is averaging 36.7 rebounds per game, led by forward Arsalan Kazemi at 10.6 per contest to rank 21st in the country. The Owls are out-rebounding their opponents by just over four boards per game.

Kazemi, a 6-foot-7 sophomore, leads the team in scoring at 14.6 points per game. Fellow sophomore Tamir Jackson, a 6-foot-2 guard, is the other double-figure scorer for Rice at 13.0 ppg. Jackson also leads the team in assists at 2.1 per game.

Lamar last time out

Lamar played on Wednesday night at No. 20 Texas and fell by a 76-55 score. The Cardinals led 11-5 early on, but scored just two points over the next 12 minutes as Texas built a 34-25 lead.

UT opened the second half with 14-2 run to go up by 21 points with 17

minutes to play. The Cardinals battled back, twice cutting the Longhorns' lead to 12, but could get no closer as Texas picked up the victory.

Lamar held its own on the boards, grabbing 42 rebounds and 19 off the offensive glass. However, the Cardinals could not overcome their 18-of-70 shooting from the floor in falling to 0-5 all-time against Texas.

Senior guard Kendrick Harris led Lamar with 13 points, while Anthony Miles finished with 11. Orlando Brazier, making his first start as a Cardinal, added six points and a career-high nine rebounds.

UT got 16 points from leading scorer Jordan Hamilton, but he shot just 5-of-15 from the floor. Freshman post Tristan Thompson added a double-double with 11 points and 13 rebounds.

Common Opponents

Lamar and Rice have played two common opponents thus far, and have the same record against the two. The Cardinals and Owls both picked up home wins over St. Gregory’s, and both lost at Texas.

Lamar knocked off St. Gregory’s by a 118-69 score on Nov. 27, while the Owls defeated the Cavaliers 75-58 on Nov. 21.

The two teams played Texas just four days apart with Rice falling 62-59 on Nov. 27, and Lamar losing 76-55 on Dec. 1.

Lighting up the Scoreboard

The Southland Conference currently boasts three of the top nine scoring teams in the nation with Lamar leading the way. The Cardinals are currently fourth in scoring a 90.1 points per game, just behind Duke at 90.3. Texas State is sixth in the country in scoring at 87.0 points per game, while Southeastern Louisiana ranks ninth at 86.2.

With Northwestern State (82.0) at 21 and UT Arlington (78.9) sitting at 45th, the SLC has five of the top 50 scoring teams in the land.

Men of Steal

Lamar has been helping itself to extra possessions by picking up 10.3 steals per game to rank 18th in the country. Lamar opened the season with 20 in its win over Lyon College, and then established a new Montagne Center record with 22 against St. Gregory’s on Saturday. The previous record of 21 came against Central Florida on Jan. 10, 1991.

The Cardinals continued their thievery on Wednesday with 12 steals against No. 20 Texas.

Kendrick Harris Scores Career-High

Senior guard Kendrick Harris had his best scoring day as a Cardinal in Lamar’s 102-98 loss to Portland State last Saturday. Harris connected on 7-of-17 shots from the floor, 3-of-4 from 3-point range and all eight free throw attempts to lead Lamar with 25 points. His previous high of 24 points came against tonight’s opponent Texas-Pan American on Nov. 16, 2009.

Scoring in bunches

Lamar’s 115-point outburst against Lyon College was just one point away from tying the school’s all-time mark for points in a season opener. Lamar also scored 115 against Jarvis Christian to open the 2004-05 season and set the mark of 116 against Samford to begin the 1990-91 campaign.

In addition to the scoring, Lamar established the fifth-widest winning margin in school history of 58 points. The all-time record is a 75 point win over Mary Hardin-Baylor on Dec. 18, 1996. LU also has winning margins of 69 points vs. Sam Houston State (12/30/91), 62 points vs. Concordia (11/25/88) and 61 points vs. Prairie View A&M (12/28/92).

Giving up 100 Back-to-Back

Lamar allowed 102 points on Nov. 20 to Portland State, the first time the Cardinals had given up 100 points since a 112-105 double overtime loss to Sam Houston State on Jan. 28, 2009. The following night, Lamar allowed 102 points again in its loss to SMU.

That was the first time that Lamar had give up 100 points in back-to-back games since the first game of the 1989-90 season and the last game of the 1988-89 season. The Cards fell 103-80 to Louisiana Tech in the American South Conference Tournament to close out the 1988-89 season, and then opened the following season with a 104-67 loss at Cal State-Fullerton.

The last time it happened in the same season goes all the way back to the 1974-75 season under head coach Jack Martin. Lamar fell at Centenary 105-83 on Jan. 13 of that season before losing 104-95 at Houston Baptist on Jan. 16.

Cardinals sign 6-9 forward

Lamar has added to its talent-laden roster with the signing of 6-foot-9 forward Mike Kyser to a national letter of intent. Kyser prepped at Lancaster High School and is currently enrolled at Christian Life Center Academy in Humble, TX.

Kyser helped Lancaster to a 36-3 record and a spot in the Texas Class 4A State Championship Game. Kyser scored 15 points and grabbed six rebounds in the title game, a loss to Houston Yates.

As a senior, Kyser averaged 12 points, 10 rebounds and six blocks en route to being named All-District 15-4A. Lancaster won three straight district titles and finished 29-0 during that time.

60th Season of Basketball

Lamar University is beginning its 60th season of basketball as a four-year institution. The Cardinals became a four-year college prior to the 1951-52 season and since that time have compiled an 883-738 (.545) record.

Lamar comes into the 2010-11 season with 246 Southland Conference victories, trailing only McNeese State (277) and UT Arlington (258) for most in league history.

Highly Rated Recruiting Class

Head coach Steve Roccaforte and the Cardinal coaching staff had a successful offseason, signing the ninth-best recruiting class in the country according to hoopscooponline.com. Kentucky led the 2010 signing class, followed by Memphis, Ohio State, Missouri, Hawaii, Wake Forest, Virginia and Connecticut. Lamar finished just ahead of North Carolina as the Tar Heels rounded out the top 10.

Where Roc Ranks

Now in his fifth season at the helm of the Lamar University men’s basketball program, head coach Steve Roccaforte stands in fifth place on the LU career wins list with 67 victories. Roccaforte needs 14 victories to

move ahead of Grey Giovanine (1993-99) into fourth place.

The top three on the list are an impressive trio of college coaches. Jack Martin, who was the first four-year coach for Lamar, spent 25 seasons on the Cardinals' sideline and compiled 334 wins. Pat Foster stands at second on the all-time wins list with 134, and his .732 winning percentage is the best in school history. Third place belongs to none other than Billy Tubbs, winner of 121 games over two different stints as head coach. The aforementioned trio led LU to 11 of its 12 regular season conference title. The other title belongs to Roccaforte.

Home Sweet Home

Lamar finished the 2009-10 season with a solid 13-5 record in the Montagne Center. However, that .722 winning percentage is slightly below Lamar's all-time home winning percentage of .733.

The Cardinals are 261-115 in 26 seasons of play at the Montagne Center, were 40-2 in four seasons at the Beaumont Civic Center and were 220-65 in 23 seasons at McDonald Gym. Lamar played its first seven seasons at the four-year level in three different gyms and compiled a 52-27 record.

Lamar's home court advantage was never more prevalent than during a six season stretch from 1978-84. The Cardinals won 80 straight games, the seventh-best home court winning streak in NCAA history.

Lamar is 2-0 at home this season.

Custer Moving Up the Block Charts

With his one block against Texas-Pan American on Tuesday, fifth-year senior Coy Custer moved into a tie with Lewis Arline for sixth place on Lamar's all-time blocked shots list with 79. With his 10th blocked shot this season, Custer would move all the way up to the fifth spot with 86, one ahead of Marlene Jackson.

Custer led Lamar with 47 blocks last season and ranked fourth in the Southland Conference at 1.5 per game. Should he reach that total this season, he would have 123 and stand alone in fourth place. The school record is 196 by Jason Grant (2002-06).

Up Next for the Cards

Lamar will have one full week off before playing its third home game of the season against Huston-Tillotson next Saturday at 7:05.
