COACHES:



STEVE CAMPBELL went 6-6 in his first season at the helm of the UCA football program, then went 7-4 with a 7-2 mark (tied for 2nd place) in the Southland Conference last season.

Campbell is **132-41** overall record as a head coach, including an NCAA Division II national championship at Delta State in 2000.

Campbell, a Pensacola, Fla., native, came to UCA from a highly successful 10-year stint at Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College where he led the Bulldogs to a national championship in 2007. His overall record at MGCCC was 87-

22 and his teams finished ranked in the NJCAA Top 10 eight consecutive seasons. Under Campbell, the program produced 28 NJCAA All-Americans and 17 Academic All-Americans. Fifteen Bulldogs signed with four-year colleges after the 2013 season, including the No. 1 ranked junior college player in the nation. There are currently six Bulldogs who played for Campbell on NFL rosters.

At Delta State, Campbell went 27-8, with a 14-1 record and the national title in 2000. From there, he was the offensive coordinator and offensive line coach at Middle Tennessee State in 2002, and offensive line coach under Jackie Sherrill at Mississippi State in 2003.

Campbell was a graduate assistant under Pat Dye at Auburn and coached at Delta State, Nicholls State and Southwest Mississippi CC prior to returning to Delta State in 1999. He played at Southeastern Louisiana and Troy, and received his degrees from Troy and Auburn.

RAY WOODARD is in his seventh season as head coach at Lamar and has an overall record of 34-41, including 3-3 this season.

Woodard, who played at Corrigan-Camden HS in Texas, was a two-time All-American as a defensive tackle at the University of Texas in 1980-81. He went on to play five years in the NFL with the San Diego Chargers, Denver Broncos and San Diego Chiefs. He received his degree from Sam Houston State in 1988, his master's from the University of Texas-Tyler in

1991 and his doctorate in educational leadership in 2014.

Woodard came to Lamar from Navarro College. He coached previously with the Scottish Claymores and Frankfurt Galaxy of NFL Europe, with the Texas Terror in the AFL, at Louisiana-Lafayette and at Kilgore College.

THE SERIES:

The Bears lead the overall series 5-0 since Lamar brought football back in 2010. UCA is 2-0 in games played in Conway.

LAST MEETING:

The last meeting was a showcase for running backs Blake Veasley (UCA) and Kade Harrington (LU) as UCA beat Lamar 35-17 at Provost Umphrey Stadium.

Veasley, a senior from Cherry Valley, Ark., set school records with 49 carries for 292 yards and four touchdowns. Harrington, the league's leading rusher, topped the Cardinals with 243 yards on 24 carries, with two touchdowns. Veasley had touchdown runs of 1, 14, 56 and 19 yards. Jace Denker added a pair of 21-yard field goals for the Bears.

Veasley's career highs prior to the game were 19 carries (Lamar 2013) and 85 yards (UIW 2013).

UCA ran for 313 yards and had 467 yards of total offense. UCA controlled the clock with 36:37 time of possession compared to 23:23 for Lamar. The second half difference was even more pronounced as UCA led 22:03 to 7:57.

The Bears' defense intercepted a season-high five passes, four in the second half (Tyler Williams 2, Tremon Smith, Bobby Watkins, Devin Spurlock).

LAST GAME:

The Bears did something last week that few teams have done, shutting out the McNeese State Cowboys 35-0 at Cowboy Stadium. Their last shutout at home was 1987 and their last shutout by an Southland team was 1988.

UCA rolled up 483 yards of offense while holding McNeese to just 309. The Bears rushed for 231 yards, led by senior Antwon Wells with 16 carries for 105 yards and two touchdowns. Junior Hayden Hildebrand completed 12 of 21 passes for 252 yards and a pair of second-half touchdowns, a 33-yarder to Jatavious Wilson and an 83-yarder to Roman Gordon.

UCA's defense, which held McNeese to 4 of 16 on third downs, had six tackles for loss, two sacks and two interceptions (Jaylon Lofton, Raphael Garner). In all, the Bears forced five turnovers (2 INT, 3 FBL).

McNeese's leading rusher was Ryan Ross with 46 yards, while QB James Tabary was 17 of 35 for 151 yards and 2 interceptions.

UCA senior CB Tyler Williams was ejected for targeting in the first half, but will be eligible to return for the start of Saturday's Lamar game.

BEAR TRACKS...

- The Bears are 4-0 in the SLC for the first time since joining the league in 2006.
- The 83-yard touchdown pass from Hayden Hildebrand to Roman Gordon vs. MCN was the longest of the season.
- UCA's turnover margin in the past three games is +11. The Bears lead the SLC at +8 for the season, one of only four teams with a positive margin.
- Patrick Ponder averaged 41.6 yards per punt vs. MCN and is now second in the SLC with a 42.1 average.
- Senior RB Antwon Wells had his second 100-yard rushing effort of the season against McNeese. He also had 129 vs. Northwestern State.
- Senior LB Garrett Sharp returned to the field against McNeese following a three-week absence due to a concussion. He had 3 tackles.
- UCA forced four McNeese State turnovers in the first half.
- The Bears rushed for a season-high 329 yards against ACU and averaged 6.2 yards per carry.
- UCA held Abilene Christian to 55 rushing yards (30 attempts) and Arkansas State to 45 (34 attempts).
- UCA has now beaten ACU by a combined score of 100-41 over the past two seasons.
- UCA is leading the SLC in time of possession (34:09) and opponents third-down conversion rate (24.7%). The Bears are also No. 1 in net punting (39.1) and opponent first downs (16.3).
- QB Hayden Hildebrand had two quick kick punts against ASU, going for 52 and 42 yards. They were downed at the ASU 3 and 2 yard lines.
- Tremon Smith's 47-yard punt return for a TD was the first since Brandon Cox had a 93-yarder against Houston Baptist in 2015. Dwayne Smith's 93-yard KO return was the first since Jatavious Wilson had a 91-yarder against Lamar in 2014.
- LB James Graves had a career-high 12 tackles against ASU.
- UCA had 62 running plays (of 82) in the win over Northwestern State.
- It was Bears' third straight win over the Demons.
- UCA junior punter Patrick Ponder averaged 53.0 yards on four punts against NSU and 49.7 on three punts against ACU.
- UCA's 148 first downs is No. 3 in the SLC. UCA has allowed just 98 first downs to lead the SLC.
- Senior WR Jatavious Wilson leads the SLC in receiving yards per game (92.0) and is second in receptions per game (5.8). He is also No. 1 in all-purpose yards (134.2).
- Sophomore PK Matt Cummins is 27 of 28 on PATs this season.
- UCA ran a school-record 115 offensive plays (577 yards) against Samford, with 36 first downs to Samford's 11. The Bears had the ball for 36:46 compared to 23:14 for the Bulldogs.
- UCA was 11 of 25 on third-down conversions and 3 of 4 on fourth down while Samford was 3 of 16 and 1 of 2.
- UCA had two receivers with more than 100 yards in receptions against Samford (Jatavious Wilson 9-134; Desmond Smith 6-133), the first time that happened since Chase Dixon (9-149) and Courtney Whitehead (8-108) against McNeese State on Oct. 5, 2013.

STINGY DEFENSE:

UCA's defense is ranked No. 2 in the FCS against the run (behind Wofford), allowing just 65.8 rushing yards per game, including 45 on 34 attempts by FBS Arkansas State and 55 yards on 30 attempts by ACU.

HBU netted just 30 yards on the ground, and Samford was even worse with -25 net rushing yards. Northwestern State managed 169 rushing yards, with 93 of those coming on three plays.

UCA recorded 15 negative-yardage plays against HBU for -69 yards. UCA had five sacks (-34 yards), forced two fumbles and blocked a field goal. The Huskies averaged 3.0 yards per play (80 plays, 242 yards).

In the previous matchup in 2015, UCA held HBU to -9 rushing yards on 25 attempts.

Against Samford, UCA's defense had 11 negative plays, including six sacks (-38 yards). The Demons had five lost-yardage plays (-15). Against ASU, UCA had 10 tackles for loss, its third double-figure game out of four.

UCA is No. 1 in the Southland Conference in total defense, allowing 305.7 yards per game, and No. 1 in scoring defense, allowing 18.0 points a game. The Bears No. 2 in the SLC in red-zone defense (69.2%), allowing opponents just 5 field goals and 4 TDs in 13 trips into the red zone.

UCA's opponents are converting just 24.7% of their third downs (23 of 93). The Bears are tied for second in the league in sacks (16).

MUSICAL CHAIRS:

The Bears lost their top three rushers from 2015 but have found several solid weapons in the offensive backfield so far this season. Two different backs have rushed for 100+ yards in UCA's six games this season. True freshman running back Carlos Blackman (Gosnell, Ark.) exploded for 123 rushing yards on 28 carries against Samford, helping the Bears put up 231 yards on the ground. He also had 98 yards in the season opener against Houston Baptist.

Against Northwestern State, senior Antwon Wells had 129 yards on 25 carries (both career highs) in the win over the Demons. Wells entered the game with 12 carries for 45 yards this season, and had 1 carry for 2 yards in 2015. Wells then got 105 yards against McNeese State.

Against Abilene Christian, QB Hayden Hildebrand and RB Keshawn Ledet both had 80 yards on the ground.

UCA has used six different running backs so far this season, including senior Kelton Warren, juniors Darrien Daniels and Jarvis Cooper and freshman Keshawn Ledet. The Bears are second in the SLC in rushing offense (235.5 per game), second in scoring offense (38.3) and second in total offense (476.8).

RECORD BOOKS:

Senior receiver/kick returner Jatavious Wilson has broken two school career records this season. He is now the career leader in all-purpose yards (4,857), surpassing former RB Hosea Knowlton (4,793, 1990-93). He also broke the school record for kickoff return yards earlier this season and now has 2,483, surpassing Isaiah Jackson (2008-11). He is second behind Jackson (106) with 103 career returns.

Wilson already held the single-season school record for kickoff return yards (1,140, 2014) and the KO returns for touchdowns career mark (3).

Senior WR Desmond Smith is fourth in career receptions at UCA with 184, trailing No. 1 Michael Norvell (213). He is just two catches behind No. 3 Aaron Fairouz (2003-06). Smith, from Bentonville, Ark., is also sixth in career receiving yards (2,329). Smith's 67 receptions in 2015 was tied for the third-best in school history (tied with Carl Thomas in 2000).

Smith broke the school record for receptions in a game with 14 against SFA last season. The old mark was 13 held by Fairouz (UT Martin 2005) and Jesse Grandy (Nicholls 2012).

THE POLLS:

The Bears moved up to a tie for 18th in the FCS Coaches Poll and up to No. 20 in the STATS FCS Top 25 on Monday. Sam Houston State took over the top spot after North Dakota State's loss.

UCA and Sam Houston meet in the regular-season finale on Nov. 19 in Huntsville, Texas.

LONE STAR BEARS:

UCA's roster features 25 Bears from the state of Texas. That includes 13 listed on the two-deep depth chart. That total number is second only to players from the state of Arkansas (30).

HOME SWEET HOME:

The Bears, who did not play a home game in 2015 until October, did not leave the state of Arkansas this season until October 1.

The Bears have three consecutive home games to start the season, then traveled two hours to Jonesboro, Ark., to take on the Arkansas State

Red Wolves on Sept. 24. However, they have not been at home since.

The Bears are in their sixth season on "The Stripes" at First Security Field at Estes Stadium and have a 25-6 record since the installation of their unique purple and gray striped playing surface.

Through two+ seasons on the turf, the Bears were a perfect 12-0 on "The Stripes." Losses to McNeese State and Southeastern Louisiana in 2013 were the first two since the turf went down in 2011. The Bears did close out that season at home with a rousing 49-31 victory over No. 9 Sam Houston.

Over the past 10 seasons since moving to Division I, UCA's home record is 47-12, including 7-0 in 2008, 5-0 in 2011 and 6-0 in 2012. The 46 home victories is the most of any SLC team over that time period.

The turf is GeoSurface, the same that was put down on UCA's baseball field (Bear Stadium) and softball field (Farris Field) over the past five years. The unique field features alternating purple and gray panels every five yards, with a large midfield logo and two large logos behind both end zones. UCA was the last team in the Southland Conference to change from natural grass to artificial turf in 2011.

UCA will play five home games in 2016, including the first three of the season and then one each in October (22nd) and November (12th).

AWARDS SHOW:

Junior safety Jaylon Lofton was the latest and sixth UCA player to secure SLC weekly honors when he was named the Defensive Player of the Week on Monday. Lofton had four tackles, a forced fumble and an interception in UCA's 35-0 win over McNeese State.

Junior Dwayne Smith earned SLC Special Teams Player of the Week after the Abilene Christian game in which he returned a kickoff 93 yards for a touchdown, just his second KO return of the year.

Two more Bears won SLC Player of the Week awards after the victory over Arkansas State. Junior cornerback/punt returner Tremon Smith (Aniston, Ala.) was named the SLC Special Teams Player of the Week after his 47-yard punt return for a touchdown. Junior rover George Odum (Millington, Tenn.) earned Defensive Player of the Week honors after getting 11 tackles, 2 sacks, another tackle for loss and forcing 2 fumbles.

UCA also nabbed two of the three SLC Player of the Week awards in Week 1. Junior QB Hayden Hildebrand was named the SLC Offensive Player of the Week and junior R George Odum received the Defensive Player of the Week.

Hildebrand, from Bossier City, La., completed 81 percent (17 of 21) of his passes for 2338 yards and two touchdowns, and ran for 52 yards and another touchdown. Odum, from Millington, Tenn., had 6 tackles, including half a sack, and blocked a field goal that Tyler Williams returned 54 yards for a touchdown.

Freshman RB Carlos Blackman from Gosnell, Ark., was named an honorable mention FCS Freshman of the Week after rushing for 98 yards on 15 carries in limited second-half action.

Also, the blocked field goal and return was named the national NCAA FCS Play of the Week for Week 1.

TV GAMES:

UCA has had four televised games already this season, with at least three more upcoming.

Saturday's matchup with Lamar be an ESPN3 broadcast, as will the UCA-Southeastern Louisiana game on Oct. 29 in Hammond, La.

UCA's season opener against Houston Baptist on Sept. 1 at First Security Field at Estes Stadium on American Sports Network. The Arkansas State game was on ESPN3, while the UCA-ACU game was an ASN broadcast and UCA-McNeese was on ESPN3. UCA @ Stephen F. Austin on Nov. 5 and the regular-season finale at Sam Houston State are also set for ESPN3.

LAST SEASON:

The Bears were a handful of plays from possibly making their third NCAA Playoff appearance in the past five years, ultimately finishing 7-4 overall and 7-2 and tied for second place in the Southland Conference.

UCA's postseason awards included first-team All-Southland Confer-

ence players WR Desmond Smith, OL Kyle Stouffer, DE Jonathan Woodard and CB Tremon Smith. Second-team selections included RB Blake Veasley, PK Jace Denker, DE Derek Floyd and LB Ricky Wyatt.

Six more Bears were named honorable mention, including OL Stockton Mallett, WR Jatavious Wilson, OL Alec Willis, DB Bobby Watkins, DB Devin Spurlock and PR Brandon Cox.

Woodard, who won the Dan Hampton Award as the top defensive lineman in Arkansas, was drafted in the seventh round (226th overall pick) by the Jacksonville Jaguars.

Veasley, Cox and Denker all earned SLC Player of Week honors during the 2015 season.

SENIOR CLASS:

The Bears feature a season class of 18, following last year's group of 25, the largest class in Division I school history.

This year's seniors include: WRs Desmond Smith, Jatavious Wilson and Jacquez McMillian; TEs Cody Dauksch, Scott Matiaha and Zach Gouglar; LBs James Pope, Garrett Sharp and Kamane Thomas; DBs Devin Spurlock, Brandon Porter, Tyler Williams and Prince Ene; DLs Dawson Hadnot, Terrence Partee and Jordan Toliver, and RBs Kelton Warren and Antwon Wells.

NEW FACES:

UCA's coaching staff has six new faces for the 2016 season. Former UCA All-America defensive end Larry Hart is coaching the defensive line, replacing Dan Augustine. Larry Warner is coaching running backs, replacing Mike McCarty. Tony Davis is the new assistant defensive line coach, while Josh Jones is coaching cornerbacks. Ryan Howard moved into a full-time roll of coaching tight ends after serving as a graduate assistant in 2015. Gunner Boykin is the new assistant OL coach and football operations after

a year as offensive quality control coach in 2015. Matt Kitchens moved to safeties and will also coordinate UCA's special teams.

Three of UCA's coaches played for the Bears in Hart (2008-09), Howard (2012-14) and offensive coordinator Nathan Brown (2005-09).

PAYTON AWARD CIRCA 2008:

Two coaches on the UCA staff were finalists for the Walter Payton Award in 2008. Offensive coordinator Nathan Brown, a former UCA quarterback, and running backs coach Larry Warner, a former running back at Southern Illinois, were among the 18 finalists for the annual award, given to the outstanding player at the FCS level.

HOLES TO FILL:

The Bears lost five senior offensive linemen and its top three running back from 2015. Running backs Blake Veasley, Dominique Thomas and Jeff Anderson all are gone. The leading returning running back is senior Kelton Warren, who rushed for 29 times for 223 yards and one touchdown (5.7 yards per carry).

UCA's senior offensive lineman from a year ago included Kyle Stouffer, Alec Willis, Jordan Kersh, Lance Kloker and D.J. Appe. The lone returning starter is junior Stockton Mallett, a preseason All-SLC selection.

ISN'T THAT SPECIAL:

UCA returns two of the top return men in the Southland Conference in senior kick returner Jatavious Wilson and junior punt returner Brandon Cox.

Wilson, who made the preseason All-SLC list at three positions (wide receiver, all-purpose back, kick returner), was No. 5 in the conference last season in kick returns at 19.5 yards per return. He was second in the SLC in 2014 at 24.8 yards.

Wilson holds the school career record with three kick returns for touchdowns.

Cox, No. 2 in the SLC in punt returns last season at 12.3 yards per return, had the second-longest punt return in school history last season against Houston Baptist, a 93-yarder for a touchdown.

Also returning is sophomore placekicker Matt Cummins, who booted a 50-yard field goal in his first career attempt last season at Samford.

SPORTS HALL OF FAME:

UCA inducted former wide receiver Michael Norvell into the UCA Sports Hall of Fame during a special ceremony in August. Norvell, the new head football coach at the University of Memphis, is the school's career leader in receptions (213) and is fourth in career receiving yards (2,611). He played for the Bears from 2001-05.

His quarterback in 2005 was freshman Nathan Brown, currently the Bears' offensive coordinator. Brown, the leading passer in UCA history, was inducted in this year's HOF class on Sept. 17. Brown threw for a then-state record of 10,558 yards and 100 touchdowns from 2005-09. His 495 yards (6 TDs) in an NCAA D-II playoff win over Presbyterian in 2005 is No. 2 on the UCA list of single-game passing yards.

NFL DRAFTEES:

Defensive end Jonathan Woodard was UCA's fifth NFL draftee in the past nine seasons, and the fourth defensive end. Woodard, who went in the seventh round to the Jacksonville Jaguars, suffered an achilles injury in the first OTA of the season and is out for the 2016 season.

The other defensive ends drafted out of UCA were Markell Carter (2011, New England), current UCA defensive line coach Larry Hart (2009, Jacksonville) and Jacob Ford (2007, Tennessee). Hart, currently UCA's defensive line coach, is the school's highest draftee in school history, taken in the fifth round with the 143rd pick.

WINNING SEASONS:

UCA has recorded 35 winning seasons in the past 39 years, dating back to 1976. UCA tied the school record with 11 victories in 2005, and have won nine games in both 2011 and 2012. The Bears are a combined

86-43 over the past 11 seasons, with 10 of those at the Division I level.

The Bears are 68-40 since moving to the FSC level in 2006.

WINNING WAYS:

UCA enters the 2015 season as the winningest college football team in the state of Arkansas since 2001. Their best outing was an 11-3 record back in 2005 when they reached the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Division II Playoffs and tied the school record for victories. Since 2001:

CONFERENCE AFFILIATION:

The Bears have been members of the Southland Conference since they moved to Division I FCS in 2006. UCA's record in SLC games is officially 45-22. That includes 6-1 records in 2008, 2011 and 2012 and 7-2 in 2015. The Bears also beat two SLC teams (Sam Houston & S.F. Austin) in their first year in the league when they did not play a full league schedule. UCA won the "unofficial" SLC title in 2008 and was co-champion in 2012.

SCORING STREAK:

The Bears have scored in 237 straight games, dating back to the 1995 season. UCA lost 19-0 at Delta State for their last shutout loss. The Bears have scored in 344 of their last 345 games, dating back to 1986.

BEING OFFENSIVE:

The Bears' offense has been consistently prolific during their time in the Southland, averaging 4,816 yards per season since joining the league in 2006. UCA has averaged 3,100 passing yards per season, with 24.8 passing TDs per season. The Bears have topped the 3,000-yard passing mark six times, including four of the past five seasons, and topped 5,000 yards of total offense four times, including two of the past three years.

OVER THE AIRWAVES:

The UCA Radio Network returns for the 10th year in the capable hands of Justin Acri and Monty Rowell, with newcomer Chris Kane.

Acri, the program director and midday talk show host at KABZ 103.7 The Buzz, will move over to the play-by-play chair this season after nine years of color commentary. Kane, the morning co-host of KATV's Daybreak, will assume the color commentary role. Rowell will once again serve as the engineer and do the sideline reporting for the UCA broadcasts.

The UCA games will be carried live on The Point 94.1, a 100,000-watt classic rock station based out of Little Rock, and KUCA 91.3 The Bear on the UCA campus. They will also be streamed on www.ucasports.com/watch.

STEVE CAMPBELL SHOW:

The Steve Campbell Show returns this fall on Monday night at 7 p.m. live from The Draft on Dave Ward Dr. The show will be once again be hosted by Justin Acri and will feature Coach Campbell and his players, along with other special guests throughout the year. Tune in on The Point 94.1.

FAMOUS ALUMS:

UCA's most famous football alumnus is Monte Coleman, who played 16 seasons (1979-94) with the Washington Redskins and won three Super Bowl titles. Coleman, from Pine Bluff, Ark., was a linebacker and safety at UCA from 1975-78 and is currently the head football coach at Arkansas-Pine Bluff. UCA's most famous non-football alum is Scottie Pippen, a six-time NBA champion and two-time Olympic Dream Teamer. Pippen grew up in Hamburg, Ark., in the southern part of the state and played at UCA from 1983-87.

POSTSEASON HISTORY:

UCA made its second straight NCAA Division I FCS Playoff appearance in 2012, in just its third year of postseason eligibility, reaching the second round before falling at perennial power Georgia Southern.

ACADEMIC PROGRESS RATE (APR)

CONWAY, Ark. _ The University of Central Arkansas football program earned the award for the top Academic Progress Rate (APR) score in the Southland Conference for the fifth consecutive year, it was announced by the Football Championship Subdivision Athletic Directors Association (FCS ADA).

UCA's football program had a four-year average of 949 and a yearly score of 963 for the 2015-16 school year. It was the sixth straight year that UCA topped the SLC.

"Our football program has set the benchmark in our conference for six consecutive years," said Dr. Brad Teague, UCA's director of athletics. "Having the top four-year average in the conference for six consecutive years is a tribute to our student-athletes and coaches."

"We have now had two consecutive 963 scores, which is excellent. I am very pleased with the type of young men our coaches are bringing to UCA and the emphasis which is placed on academics here."

The APR Award recognizes one institution at each of the 13 FCS conferences that has the highest APR score. In addition, the Association also recognizes one institution from each conference that has improved the most from the previous year. In all, 25 awards will be given this year.

"Our Association is pleased to present these awards to spotlight one true mission of all FCS programs, embracing the academic progress of their student-athletes, who will become leaders off the field," said FCS ADA President Brian Hutchinson, director of athletics at Morehead State University. "We are happy to continue to recognize the FCS institutions and their football programs for continuing to reach exemplary APR scores."
