KEY STORYLINES

NEW FACES ALL AROUND

- **KEY DEPARTURES:** With the departure of last season's headcoach, two assistant coaches, the women's basketball director of operations, the women's basketball trainer, and 70 percent of the team's scoring, Lamar University women's basketball looks considerably different this season.
- **FRANKLIN ERA:** Head coach Aqua Franklin brings in assistant coach/recruiting coordinator Rodney Hill from Texas State and TCU, assistant coach Charinee Mitchell from Garden City Community College, and Hannah Gentry from Texas A&M. Empress Davenport, an University of Texas alum, remained at Lamar from the previous staff.
- **NEW FACES:** Joining the team this year are Kayla Mitchell, and Malay Mitchell, who just returned from a hand injury against Louisiana-Lafayette. Micaela Wilson, a transfer from Kansas, will have to miss this season due to NCAA transfer rules. Amber Vidal, who transferred to Lamar last season from Nebraska-Omaha, leads LU in scoring.

THINGS CHANGE, SOME DON'T

- **ORANGE AT HOME:** Despite all the changes that occurred in the 2019 off-season, over half of the team returned from last year's Southland Conference Championship team.
- **HONORING THE PAST:** Among the familiar faces are 2017-18 SLC Freshman of the Year Jadyn Pimentel, Ashlan Miles, Briana Laidler, Shedricka Pierson, Rikiah Cowart, Umaja Collins, and Angel Hastings.



DID YOU KNOW?

- **DEFENDING CHAMPS:** The Cardinals have been picked fifth according to the poll – which is voted on by the league's head coaches and media relations directors.
- **FIRST PLACE VOTES:** The Cardinals are one of five schools to receive a first-place vote along with Abilene Christian, Stephen F. Austin, Sam Houston State and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Big Red received 195 total votes along with one first-place nod to be picked fifth.
- **COACH THOUGHTS:** "I was surprised about the first-place vote," said LU first-year head coach Aqua Franklin. "When you consider we lost several players from last year – 70 percent of our scoring from that team is gone, a brand new coach and the kids having to learn a new system, but in the same breath I would say that my predecessor did an unbelievable job recruiting."

Lamar Head Coach Aqua Franklin

Aqua Franklin was named the 14th women's basketball head coach at Lamar University on May 1, 2019.

Prior to being named the head coach at Lamar, Franklin was on the sidelines of Allen Fieldhouse as the associate head coach at Kansas. In her second stint with the Jayhawks, Franklin spent four seasons as the Jayhawks' associate head coach and five overall in Lawrence. During her time at Kansas, Franklin has worked to help rebuild the KU program.

During her career, Franklin has recruited and coached eight all-conference players and three all-freshman team selections. Franklin guided yet another KU guard to All-Big 12 honors during the 2017-18 season after junior Christalah Lyons earned an honorable mention nod for her work on the hardwood. Lyons repeated honorable mention honors following the 2018-19 season as well.

During the 2016-17 season, Franklin mentored Jessica Washington to new heights in the red and blue. Under Franklin's guidance, Washington became the first Jayhawk to garner Big 12 Newcomer of the Year honors after averaging a league-best 19.3 points per game in conference play.

Prior to returning to KU, Franklin spent the last three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Mississippi State, where she helped the Bulldogs to a historic season in 2014-15. That year Mississippi State set a school record for overall (27) and conference (11) wins and advanced to the second round of the tournament. In

addition to the Bulldogs work on the court, Franklin was also instrumental in helping Mississippi State bring in one of the top recruiting classes in program history with a top 20 national ranking.

During her first stint with the Jayhawks in 2011-12, Franklin helped Kansas to one of its best seasons in recent history, highlighted by the Jayhawks' trip to the NCAA Sweet 16. Franklin coached Angel Goodrich to a banner season after she paced KU with 23.3 points per game and shattered the single-season school record with 250 assists. Goodrich was named Honorable Mention All-America by both the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and the Associated Press, and was one of the four finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, given annually to the top point guard in the nation.

Franklin spent the 2010-11 season at Stephen F. Austin under current Kansas head coach, Brandon Schneider. With the Ladyjacks, she tutored Tammara Marion to All-Southland Conference accolades after Marion became the 25th SFA player to score 1,000 points and set a school mark for three-pointers made in a season.

Franklin's coaching career got started at her alma mater serving as a graduate assistant for Texas A&M during the 2009-10 season. Her collegiate and professional experiences were a valuable asset to the Aggies as she helped guide the team to the Big 12 Championship and the No. 2 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Franklin was selected with the 38th pick in the 2008 WNBA Draft by the Sacramento Monarchs. As a rookie, Franklin helped lead the Monarchs to the opening round of the 2008 WNBA playoffs. The following season she signed with the Seattle Storm before going on to begin her coaching career at her alma mater.

She concluded her four-year playing career at Texas A&M as one of the most-decorated guards in program history, ranking in the top three in assists with 627. Her final season with the Aggies was a memorable one for the program, as the team made its first run to the NCAA's Elite Eight. Franklin capped her career by claiming honorable mention All-America accolades from the Associated Press to go along with second-team All-Big 12 honors. During her collegiate career, Franklin led the Aggies to three NCAA appearances and was twice named Honorable Mention All-America.

A 2018 Texas A&M Hall of Fame inductee, Franklin graduated from A&M with a degree in recreation park and tourism science in 2009. She was also a member of the second Tyler ISD Hall of Fame class – one that also included NFL legend Earl Campbell.
