### TIPOFF

- NSU finishes the 2019 portion of the schedule on the road at Lamar and at Texas on Dec. 29. The Lady Demons open 2020 with three straight home contests and four of the first five games scheduled to be played in Prather Coliseum.
- The Lady Demons had their second best shooting performance of the season against Sam Houston going .397 from the field, despite a 1-for-9 performance over the final five minutes of the game.
- NSU used the same starting lineup in consecutive games for the first time since the beginning of the season. The Lady Demons have seen six different lineups take the floor through the first nine games of the year.

### SCOUTING THE OPPONENT

- Lamar won its conference opener on Wednesday 65-57 at Southeastern La. The Cardinals top scorer on the season **Amber Vidal** put 21 points, her second 20-point performance of the season. She scored a season-high 26 points in the season opening loss at Oklahoma State.
- The Cardinals are averaging 60.9 points per game and shooting .345 from the field on the season, one of three teams, including the Lady Demons, shooting below .350 for the year.
- Senior forward Briana Laidler ranks fifth in the Southland Conference in rebounds per game at 7.4 a night.

## THE SERIES WITH LAMAR

• Lamar has won the last three games in the series, including the two most recent games in Beaumont.  
 • Northwestern State is 13-11 overall in road games at Lamar, but have lost 10 of its last 11 games there. The Cardinals won eight straight home games against the Lady Demons between 2005 and the most recent NSU win in Beaumont in 2016.

• In the 94-70 Cardinal win a year ago in Natchitoches, Lamar's Moe Kinard scored 31 points on 10-of-17 shooting with six made 3-pointers. Three Lady Demons reached double figures in that game (RaVon Nero, Libba Gilliam, Nautica Grant). None of the four players mentioned will play in Saturday's game.

## THE STRUGGLE IS REAL

• One of if not the biggest early-season struggles for the Lady Demons has been their field goal shooting.  
 • Following a 55 percent performance in the 91-61 win against LeTourneau to start the season, NSU shot at or below 30 percent from the field during its four game losing streak, going 70-for-269 during that time, and a season low 19 percent at Arkansas.  
 • Not surprisingly, their second best shooting performance of the season against Grambling, shooting almost 40 percent, resulted in a 65-61 win.  
 • One of the by products of the missed shots is the chance for offensive rebounds and the Lady Demons have taken advantage of that. NSU is 11th in the country and first in the Southland in offensive rebounds per game at 16.8 per contest.  
 • NSU is only averaging 11.9 second-chance points per game however, scoring just 107 of those points this season.  
 • Dupuy has said on multiple occasions that the team is not taking bad shots, they just aren't going in, and that it comes down to getting over the mental block, which can come with one game, one quarter, or one shot for any player.

## GRAND LARCENY

• Forcing turnover is a major part of the Northwestern State defensive game plan, however they may come. Through the first nine games of the season a large majority of those turnovers have been the good old-fashioned steal.  
 • With a total of 120 on the year, led by Jasmyn Johnson and her 28, NSU ranks 20th in the country in steals. The Lady Demons average 13.3 steals per game, ranking them eighth in the NCAA.  
 • NSU had its performance of the season in that category with a 25 steal night against LSU-Shreveport, 11 more than the previous two games combined.  
 • In their five home games this season, the Lady Demons are averaging 18.8 steals and 33.0 forced turnovers per game.

## WHAT'S FOR DESSERT?...TURNOVERS

• Through the first eight games of this year NSU has forced 238 turnovers, including an impressive average of 32.3 through the first three contests. They currently rank third in the NCAA in forced turnovers per game at 26.44, only behind Alcorn's 29.82 and East Carolina's 26.70 averages.

• One of major focuses for Northwestern State this season is creating chaos on the floor, something that is hard to scout and hard to play against.

• One of the by products of that chaos, Jordan Dupuy believes, will be turnovers, or better still takeaways for his team, leading to more scoring opportunities and utilizing the athleticism and depth that the Lady Demons have on the roster.

• NSU led the country in forced turnovers per game for the majority of the 2018-19 season and finished the year ranked third nationally in that category. They forced 685 turnovers a year ago, a 23.62 turnover per game average, only fellow SLC member Lamar (25.61) and America East's Hartford (24.47) averaged more forced turnovers per game.

## NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?

• The Lady Demons return just a handful of players from last year's squad and feature seven newcomers. NSU has four first-year freshmen - Anessa Dussette (Houston), Tristen Washington (Gonzales, La.), Juila Sion (Port Arthur, Texas), and Karyn Ford (Pearland, Texas), to go along with their three junior college transfers – Kalen Green (Forney, Texas), Leilani Moncrease (Oakland, Calif.), and Nakaylis Washington (Magnolia, Miss.).

• Despite the learning curve that newcomers must face with a new program, they have the benefit of multiple four-year Dupuy disciples at their disposal. Gabby Bell, Jasmyn Johnson, Victoria Miller, and Jocelyn Scott have all been there done that time and time again and have taken a big leadership role in ushering the new faces along.

## COACH 'EM UP

• The Northwestern State coaching staff remained in tact for the most part from the 2018-19 season.

• The departure of Deneen Parker allowed new associate head coach **Aaron A. Swinson** to move down the bench, so to speak, as well as take on a role in practice he is a little more familiar with, working with the post players.

• Swinson helped guide RaVon Nero to one of the best freshmen seasons for a Lady Demon this past year working with the backcourt. As he moves to the frontcourt players, his knowledge and work ethic will benefit the Lady Demons around the glass on both ends of the floor.

• Swinson also has previous head coaching experience as he served as the interim head coach at Prairie View A&M for the second half of the 2017-18 season, his most recent stop before arriving at NSU.

• **Nicole Mitchell** also got a promotion within the staff, taking over the role of recruiting coordinator for the team and will take over for Swinson working with the backcourt.

• New to the staff this year is West Virginia standout **Sarah Miles**, who makes her way to Natchitoches after two seasons as an assistant at Colorado State-Pueblo.

• Miles was the 2009-10 Big East Defensive Player of the Year and averaged a career-best 12.2 points and 5.3 rebound during her sophomore campaign.

## Last Time Out...

NATCHITOCHES — A late dip in offensive production cost Northwestern State its Southland Conference opener on Wednesday afternoon, falling 79-69 to Sam Houston.

After taking the lead into the fourth quarter, the Lady Demons (3-6, 0-1 SLC) tied the game at 64 with just over five minutes remaining. An 0-for-7 slump from the field over the next four minutes of play allowed Sam Houston (5-4, 1-0 SLC) to build a 10-point lead that carried it to the first win in 10 tries at Prather Coliseum.

"We did a lot of good things and were tough for the most part, but towards the end when it counts the most, we didn't finish," fourth-year head coach Jordan Dupuy said. "You've got to finish plays."

"In conference all the games come down to the simple things because everybody knows what everybody's running. It's finishing layups, which we missed 12 of tonight. That's 24 points off the board. It's the little things like that that stick to you and hurt."

Tied at eight after a Nakaylis Washington 3-pointer with 3:34 left in the first quarter, NSU saw Sam Houston score the next 11 points in a row, despite missing the SLC's top scorer Amber Leggett who was sidelined with foul trouble. Victoria Miller ended the 11-0 Kat run with a jumper near the buzzer to make it a 19-10 affair after the first 10 minutes.

Leggett picked up her third foul of the game early in the second quarter, and the Lady Demons took advantage of her absence from the floor.

NSU closed a nine-point gap with a 10-2 run that ended with six straight points from Jasmyn Johnson making it a 23-22 game with 6:25 left in the half. A pair of Sam Houston 3-pointers, combined with some critical misses by the Lady Demons, made it an eight-point game less than two minutes later.

NSU finished the half on a flurry, converting on five consecutive possessions to cut the 36-26 Sam Houston lead down to just a pair with two long balls from Kalen Green bookending the stretch. Her second dagger from beyond the arc made it 40-38 Bearkats heading into the break.

An early 3-ball from Tristen Washington, followed by a layup from Lacee Savage, gave the Lady Demons a 43-42 lead early in the third quarter. Six lead changes later, and nine straight points from Leggett, Sam Houston had a 53-51 advantage. Another jumper put them up four with 3:12 to go.

Three free throws and a jumper from Johnson in the final minute however created the final two of 10 total lead changes in the third quarter. Nakaylis Washington dropped in a jumper at the buzzer to put NSU up 58-57 going to the fourth.

The teams played even through the first four and a half minutes of the final period. Both made runs of 6-0 or better, leaving the game knotted at 64 with 5:38 left.

The 0-for-7 slump for the Lady Demons over the next four minutes was exacerbated by the 3-for-7 from the field and 5-for-8 effort from the free throw line by Sam Houston, creating the 10-point lead that carried them to victory.

"Sam Houston is going to be right there at the end of the season," Dupuy said. "To me they're one of the toughest and most physical team that I think we'll play. They guard you hard on the ball and they did it for 94 feet for all 40 minutes. You've got to take what you can, accentuate the positive, correct the negative and then go try and steal one at Lamar."

## Two Games Ago...

FAYETTEVILLE, Arkansas — A hot start faded quickly for Northwestern State as No. 21 Arkansas ran away with Sunday afternoon's game 99-39 at Bud Walton Arena.

In a blistering opening to the ball game, where the Razorbacks (10-1) jumped out to an 8-0 lead through the first two minutes of play, the Lady Demons (3-5) responded quickly.

NSU came right back with an 8-0 run of its own on back-to-back 3-balls from Kira Bonner and Jasmyn Johnson, knotting the game at 8 just a minute later.

The teams traded 3's on their next possessions, with Bonner drilling another, and after a pair of free throws put the Hogs back up, Bonner tied the game at 13 on a layup with 5:05 left in the first.

The game changed after the ensuing media timeout.

The Razorbacks began a 24-0 run that would ultimately put the game away before the end of the first half. One of the best scoring and 3-point shooting teams in the country, Arkansas sprinted to the big lead on the heels of a massive Lady Demons offensive drought.

NSU went more than 10 minutes of game time between Bonner's layup in the first and a Victoria Miller jumper at the 4:48 mark of the second. During that stretch the Hogs went 10-of-17 from the floor including starting the second quarter making their first five shots.

Arkansas came back to Earth the rest of the quarter, going 3-for-6 the rest of the half, but an 18 percent shooting effort for the Lady Demons could not cut into the 49-22 halftime lead.

"I can live with defeat if you fight and compete and are doing everything that you can possibly do," fourth-year head coach Jordan Dupuy said. "We didn't do that today and that's what is really frustrating, especially a couple days away from conference play."

Arkansas picked up where it left off in the third quarter with an absurd 76 percent shooting effort to start the second half.

They scored 35 points and extended the lead to 84-30 by the end of the period. The 10-for-11 start to the third quarter all but secured the win for the Razorbacks by the end of the frame.

Kalen Green provided a pair of mild sparks in the period with a 3-pointer at the midway point and a fast break layup with 3:08 remaining, the only two field goals for the Lady Demons in the quarter.

Green reached double figures for the third time this season, matching Bonner's 10 points as NSU's top scorers.

With a quick turnaround before the beginning of Southland Conference action, the Lady Demons look to move past a tough loss to a quality opponent quickly.

"If you have anything about you as a competitor, then this should fuel you to hurry up and get the taste out of your mouth and start preparing for the next one," Dupuy said. "We'll address what we need to on the ride back and start looking at Sam Houston right away. We have to understand that there is so much that we have to get ready for and it starts with our heart and effort."
