No. 14 Senators down Carson-Newman, 5-1

GREENWOOD----The No. 14-ranked Lander men's soccer team won its sixth straight game Saturday night when it defeated Carson-Newman College, 5-1, in a non-conference game.

The Senators improve to 11-1 overall, while Carson-Newman drops to 5-4-1.

Jamie Creaghan scored two goals to lead the Senator attack, while goalkeeper Matthew Shirley collected five saves.

Lander took a 1-0 lead when Mikko Kotilainen scored a goal on an assist from Seven Sprinkle at 12:08. Carson-Newman retaliated on a Josh Schiding goal at 35:28, assisted by John Powell.

Sprinkle gave Lander a 2-1 lead with 19 seconds remaining in the first half on an assist from Peter Martisek.

Creaghan scored his first goal at 52:16, assisted by Scott Montgomery. Montgomery then gave the Senators a 4-0 advantage on a penalty kick at 57:13. Creaghan gave Lander its final goal at 84:27 on an assist from Raurie Robinson.

Lander outshot Carson-Newman, 15-10, and led in corner kicks, 6-2.

Stian Alnes, Carson-Newman's goalkeeper, had five saves.

Lander will travel to USC Spartanburg for a Peach Belt Conference game at 7 p.m., Saturday, Oct. 13.
