Lady Senators drop to 6-8

GREENWOOD----After defeating Erskine College, 53-38, in a non-conference game on Jan. 22, the Lander women's basketball team lost a pair of Peach Belt Athletic Conference (PBAC) games and dropped to 6-8 overall and 2-8 in the PBAC.

Faye Wright, a 5-11, junior center from Abbeville, scored 15 points and grabbed 20 rebounds against Erskine. It was the second time this season Rosalind Jennings, Lander's first-year coach who was at Erskine the previous four years, has defeated her former team.

Wright scored a season-high 24 points and grabbed eight rebounds to lead the Lady Senators in a 63-46 PBAC loss at Kennesaw State on Jan. 24.

Wright, who made the all-PBAC team last year, scored 12 points and had 12 rebounds in a 66-55 loss to Armstrong State on Jan. 27.

Lander will host USC-Spartanburg at 5:30 p.m., Wednesday, Jan. 31, in the Finis Horne Arena, and will enterain Augusta College at 2 p.m., Saturday, Feb. 3, in Lander's homecoming.

In the weekly PBAC statistics, Lander is second in points allowed per game (61.4), and fourth in field goal percentage defense (.395) and rebound margin (+3.7).

In individual PBAC statistics, Faye Wright is second in rebounds per game (11.5), fourth in points per game (15.5) and ninth in field goal percentage (.482); Charlonda Robinson is second in assists per game (5.8) and fifth in steals per game (2.7); and Maggie McDermott is ninth in free throw percentage (.702).
