## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

### LAST TIME OUT

Although pushing the pace of play in the second half, the Lander men's soccer team was unable to overcome two first-half goals as it fell to No. 16 Clayton State 2-1 on Saturday.

Lander drops to 2-4-2 overall and 1-1-0 in the PBC while Clayton State moves to 7-1-0 overall and 3-0-0 in the PBC.

The Lakers were first to strike, as the home side tucked away goals in the 13th and 23rd minute of play to take a 2-0 lead into the half.

Lander put 4-of-5 shots on goal in the first half to test the Clayton State keeper.

Juan Rodriguez came up with five saves in the first half as the Lakers put 7-of-11 shots on goal in the first frame.

The Bearcats would cut the deficit in half in the 53rd minute on a Penalty Kick converted by Christian Hatley.

Lander would attempt seven shots in the second half with four more going on goal.

### KNOW THY FOE

USC Aiken is coming off a 2-1 PBC victory over GSW on Saturday. The Pacers picked up their first win of the season after getting shutout the past four games where they allowed 13 goals. Aiken is 1-4-1 overall with a season-opening tie against Belmont Abbey.

### INSIDE THE SERIES

Lander holds a 42-3-1 overall record against the Pacers with the series stretching back to 1985. The Bearcats have won the past 10 meetings with the last Pacer win coming on the road in 2014 when USC Aiken won 3-2.

### A TEAM OF TWO HALFS

The Bearcats have seen better results in the second half.

Lander has eight of its 11 goals this season in the second half along with attempting 56 total shots this season compared to the 33 in the first half. Lander has also put 23 shots on goal in the second half this season compared to 10 in the first half.

### A NEW CAREER HIGH

With his game-winning goal at Flagler, Christian Hatley set a new career-high for goals scored in a single season. He scored three his freshman season at Lincoln Memorial and currently has five this season.

### SHOT STOPPER

Juan Rodriguez set a new career-high for saves in a game with seven against Clayton State.

### THE OPENING ACT

Lander is 9-0-1 in the past 10 PBC openers and is 15-0-2 since losing to USC Upstate in 2006. The Bearcats also hold a 27-4-2 record all-time in their opening conference game with USC Upstate holding three of those four wins over Lander

### AGAINST THE TOP-25

Lander is 0-2-1 against top-25 teams this season after the 2-1 loss to Clayton State

### DEFENSIVE IMPROVEMENTS

After allowing five goals in the season opener against Florida Tech, Lander has allowed two or fewer goals in the past seven games.

### TO THE FIRST OF MANY

Head coach Dale Parker collected his first win leading the Bearcats in the 3-0 win against the Falcons

### SO FRESH AND SO CLEAN

Juan Rodriguez posted the first clean sheet of the year in the 3-0 win against Montevallo. He also collected his first win as a Bearcat

### THE FIRST SINCE 2013

With the 3-0 victory over Montevallo, Lander collected its first home win over the Falcons since October 5, 2013

### NIFTY 50

Both Jonah Miller and Dymond made their 50th career appearance on September 16. Making 26 appearances at Duquesne, Dymond has now played in 24 matches as a Bearcat while Miller has played all 50 as a Bearcat

### WHEN SCORING AND ALLOWING 2

Lander has both scored and allowed two goals in its two ties this season

### KC AND THE SUNSHINE STATE

The Bearcats' first five games of the season were against opponents from the Sunshine State Conference. After tying Tampa 2-2 on September 13, the Bearcats went 0-3-2 against teams from the SSC.

### THE ONE AND ONLY

### TOUGH TEST TO BEGIN

The Bearcats will start the season against the preseason No. 11 and No. 7 teams. Florida Tech was ranked No. 11 in the USC preseason poll while Rollins was ranked No. 7. Lander will battle Rollins in the second game of the season, which will also be in Wingate, N.C.

### PEACH BELT PRESEASON

The PBC Preseason Poll was released on August 24 with just three points separating first place from third place. Clayton State was picked first with 22 points and 2 first-place votes. Flagler was picked second with 21 points and 2 first-place votes. Lander was picked third with 19 points and the remaining 2 first-place votes

Lander also saw four players individually named to the PBC Preseason all-conference squad. Rob Dymond, Lorenzo Ferrari, Jed Smith, and Charlie Bushby represented the Blue and Gold

### HE'S BACK

The fifth coach in program history is former Bearcat assistant Dale Parker. Parker was the head coach at Lincoln Memorial last season where he led the Railsplitters to a 10-8-1 record

and an appearance in the SAC Championship game

### A BRICK WALL

In 14 starts last season, Lorenzo Ferrari allowed just nine goals, made 36 saves, and posted a GAA of 0.63. Ferrari's 0.63 GAA was the 8th best in the NCAA

### WHO'S GOING TO STEP UP

The Bearcats will be without four of their top-five point producers from last season

### AGE BEFORE BEAUTY

Of the 29 players on the Bearcats roster, 20 are juniors, seniors, and grad students (9 juniors, 6 grad students, 4 seniors)

### SOME SMART CATS

For the second straight year, Lander saw two members of the men's soccer team named to the College Sports Communicators Academic All-American Team. Marco Gueli and Alistair Danjon took home those honors

### JUMPING OUT IN FRONT

When scoring first last season, Lander went 10-0-3 overall and was 7-0-0 in the PBC while being the first to score

## LAST TIME AGAINST USC AIKEN (10/5/22)

**GREENWOOD** -After a slow start at Van Taylor Stadium, the Lander men's soccer team scored three unanswered second-half goals to defeat USC Aiken 3-0 Wednesday evening.

Lander improves to 6-2-4 overall and 5-0-2 in the PBC while Aiken drops to 1-8 overall and 1-6 in the PBC.

Since taking over the program in 2015, head coach Lee Squires has gone 49-9-4 in home contests with the Bearcats.

The Bearcats are now 10-0 in the past 10 meetings against USC Aiken, with the last defeat coming on Oct. 1, 2014, at USC Aiken.

Although unable to score against the Pacers in the first half, the Bearcats were firing on all cylinders. Lander attempted 10 shots with six on target compared to zero attempted shots from Aiken in the first frame.

Lander finally got on the scoreboard in the 53rd minute after a lobbed pass from Rob Dymond was headed by Alistair Danjon to put Lander up 1-0. Dymond recorded his team-leading fifth assist of the season while Danjon has recorded a goal in back-to-back games.

Lander is now 6-0-2 on the season when scoring first.

Max McNulty would be next to score for the Bearcats. After a penalty kick was awarded to Lander, McNulty would strike home his fourth goal of the season in the 55th minute of play.

The third and final goal would be delivered by Kevin Rubaszewski in the 83rd minute. After Jonah Miller battled for a ball on the right side of the box, he would send a pass to a wide-open Rubaszewski who bounced a shot past the Aiken keeper to wrap up the Lander scoring.

Lorenzo Ferrari needed to make just one save as he picked up his third win as a Bearcat and fourth shutout. Ferrari is 3-0-2 so far this season.

The Bearcats close out the week with a trip to Young Harris on Saturday, October 8.

## HEAD COACH: DALE PARKER



Dale Parker enters his first season as the Lander men's soccer coach. Parker returns to Greenwood as the Head Coach in January 2023 after serving as the lead assistant from 2019 through 2021.

Parker served under former head coach Lee Squires for three seasons before being named the head men's soccer coach at Lincoln Memorial in 2022.

After going 2-13-2 in 2021, Parker led the Railsplitters to a 10-8-1 record in 2022 that saw his squad advance to the South Atlantic Conference Championship game.

Under Parker, LMU saw Harry Cooke named to the D2CCA All-America team along with earning SAC Offensive Player of The Year honors while also being named the SAC Freshman of The Year. Three other Railsplitters were also named to the SAC All-Conference team last season.

While at Lander, Parker helped the Bearcats to a Peach Belt Regular Season Title (2021) and coached 10 Lander athletes to Peach Belt All-Conference honors including two PBC Freshman of the Year and one PBC Player of the Year honor. Parker was also part of the staff awarded United Soccer Coaches Regional Staff of the Year (2021).

Parker also serves as the head coach of the Appalachian Football Club in the National Premier Soccer League. In their inaugural season, he led the program to a third-place finish in the NPSL Southeast Conference, making it to the conference semi-finals in year one. In his second season (2022), Parker led his team to the Southeast Conference Regular Season title, Southeast Conference Tournament title and went on a run that ended in the National Quarter Final (Regional Final). Parker was awarded the Southeast Conference Coach of the Year, East Region Coach of the Year and NPSL National Coach of the Year honors.

A two-time All-American and three-year captain at Lees-McRae College, Parker helped the Bobcats capture three regular-season titles and advance to the quarterfinals of the NCAA Tournament in 2007, last 16 in 2008 and the National Championship Game in 2009. Parker played 80 matches at Lees-McRae, including a stretch of 72 consecutive starts. In his final season as a Bobcat, Parker led his team to an appearance in the NCAA National Championship match in 2009. In 2022, Parker was inducted into the Lees-McRae College Athletics Hall of Fame for his contributions to the program as part of the 2009 team, and their NCAA Championship run.

Prior to arriving in Greenwood in 2019, Parker served as the Director of Coaching for Virginia Soccer Association and as a head coach for the Virginia Development Academy Program. He also worked as the Director of Coaching for Chesterfield United FC and as head coach for the club's women's pre-WPSL team.

Parker currently holds an A-License from the United States Soccer Federation, which is the highest level of coaching license one can receive in the U.S. The Worksop, England native also holds qualifications from the World Football Academy and The Football Association (England).
