Big 5 History

The head baseball coaches at five Division I universities in Philadelphia gathered in February, 2006 to announce the formation of Philadelphia Big Five Baseball. The group encompasses the five Division I schools in Philadelphia that sponsor baseball—La Salle, Penn, Saint Joseph's, Temple and Villanova. Formed with the mission of increasing the exposure of college baseball in the area, the Big Five named its first-ever all-star team at the conclusion of the 2006 season. Liberty Bell Classic

The Liberty Bell Classic was conceived in 1992 as a way for local Division I colleges to compete against each other in a tournament as well as an opportunity for the schools to play on the big league field of Veterans Stadium.

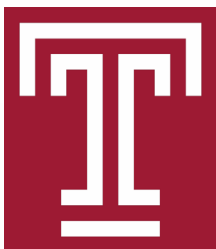
The original eight schools were the University of Pennsylvania, University of Delaware, Saint Joseph's, Drexel, Villanova, Temple, West Chester, and La Salle Universities. In the first championship game, the University of Delaware defeated Villanova University 6-2.

When West Chester University was reclassified as Division II, it was replaced by Rider University and Rider was then in turn replaced by Lehigh University. When Drexel's baseball program was dissolved after the 2003 season, Lafayette University joined the Liberty Bell Classic.

Originally all games were played at Veterans Stadium, but in 2004 games were played at local venues with the championship game being held at Citizens Bank Park. The first championship at Citizens Bank Park was claimed by Lehigh University as they defeated Villanova University 11-3.
