### NEWS & NOTES

- La Salle has won two of its last three games after defeating Saint Joseph's in a Big 5/A-10 showdown at Tom Gola Arena this past Sunday, 67-59.
- In the win over the Hawks, sophomore **Kayla Spruill** scored a career high 24 points and 12 boards for her second double-double of the season. Freshman **Claire Jacobs** added 21 points to become the first duo to score 20+ points in a game the first round of the A-10 Championship Tournament in 2014.
- Sophomore **Kayla Spruill** put together back-to-back performances against Richmond and Saint Joseph's to earn the nod as Big 5 Player of the Week. Spruill averaged 21 ppg and 10.5 rpg, while shooting 64.7% from the floor, 66.7% from long range, and a perfect 14-of-14 from the line.
- Senior **Shalina Miller** broke the all-time blocks record against Richmond and followed that up with a six-block performance against the Hawks to tie her career best. Miller leads the Explorers with 46 blocks, 2.3 bpg, and 7.3 rpg. She ranks second in the Atlantic 10 in both categories and 20th in blocks and 26th in blocks per game nationally.
- Freshman **Claire Jacobs** is La Salle's leading scorer with 12.5 points per game. Jacobs hits 35.6% of her shots, including 33.0% from three-point land.
- Sophomore **Kayla Spruill** is second on the team with 10.7 ppg and 5.8 rpg. Big Smooth converts 37.1% of her shots. The Baltimore, Md. native has dropped 10+ points in eight straight games, including 15+ in the last three.
- Freshmen **Jordon Lewis** (7.7 ppg) and Amy Jacobs (7.1 ppg) round out the top four scorers. The quartet is accounting for 60.3% of the Explorers points this season.
- Junior **Kate Hill** is the team's leader in assists with 88 on the season and 4.4 per game. Not only does she pace the team, but the entire conference in assist to turnover ratio at 2.7 and assists.
- La Salle is scoring 61.9 ppg and allowing opponents 67.8.

The correct spelling of our University is “La Salle”, with a space in the middle. Please do not use “LaSalle.”

**ONE OF A KIND**

With over 1,100 schools across three divisions in the NCAA, the La Salle Explorers are the only institution with the nickname ‘Explorers.’

**FAKE NEWS?**

La Salle University’s nickname – the Explorers – was announced by The Collegian in March 1932 as the winning entry to a student contest. However, in the fall of 1931, a Baltimore sports-writer covering the La Salle/St. John’s (Md.) football game erroneously alluded to La Salle as being named for the French explorer La Salle, not St. John Baptist de La Salle. Were the two events related? We’ll never know for sure.

**SERIES HISTORY - GEORGE MASON**

La Salle holds the all-time record 6-5 after splitting the season series last year. The Explorers are 4-2 inside Tom Gola Arena against the Patriots. La Salle concluded the 2018-29 regular season with a 77-71 overtime victory over Mason.

**SHALINA'S FAVORITE FOE?**

Senior **Shalina Miller** has been very successful against George Mason. Last meeting, Miller set her career marks at the time of 17 points, 15 rebounds, and six blocks. The last two meetings average out to 12.5 ppg, 10.0 rpg, and 4.5 bpg with her all-time numbers at 8.6 ppg, 6.0 rpg, and 2.0 bpg.

**BIG SMOOTH - BIG 5 PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

After back-to-back impressive performances, sophomore **Kayla Spruill** was dubbed the Big 5 Player of the Week on Jan. 27. Big Smooth averaged 21.0 ppg, 10.5 rpg, and shot 64.7% from the floor, 66.7% from long range, and a perfect 14-of-14 from the line. Spruill started the week with 18 points and nine rebounds in a narrow loss at Richmond. In Sunday’s Big 5 finale against the Hawks, she scored a career best 24 points and added her career mark 12 boards.

**BIG 5 WIN OVER THE HAWKS**

La Salle’s win over Saint Joseph’s marked a plethora of milestones for the program. The victory was head coach **Mountain MacGillivray**’s first Big 5 win and the programs largest over SJU since 2006. Sophomore **Kayla Spruill** (24 pts) and freshman **Claire Jacobs** (21 pts) is the first performance of two 20+ point scorers since **Micahya Owens** (23 pts) and **Alicia Cropper** (20 pts) did against Saint Louis in the first round of the Atlantic 10 Tournament in 2014.

**BLOCK MONSTER**

Senior **Shalina Miller** broke the all-time program record for blocks with her first deflection against Richmond. Miller leads the Explorers with 46 blocks and 2.3 bpg. She’s second in the Atlantic 10 in both categories. Nationally, Miller checks in at 20th in deflections and 26th in bpg. Miller has 2+ blocks in 15 games, 3+ in eight games and 4+ in three games. The Philadelphia, Pa. native tied her career best of six against Saint Joseph’s.

**CALL HER ROW**

After back-to-back career games, rookie **Claire Jacobs** was named the Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Week. Against UMass, Jacobs dropped a freshman record 29 points. She followed that up with a 16-point performance, adding a career best eight rebounds in the Explorers win. On the week, she shot 53.1% from the floor, 42.9% from long range, and 83.3% from the line.

**SMOOTH SO STRONG**

Sophomore **Kayla Spruill** aka, Big Smooth, has been arguably the most consistent played for the Explorers this season. The Baltimore, Md. native is averaging 10.7 ppg this season and has registered 10+ points in 12 games, including eight straight, and three straight of 15+.

**DISHIN' OUT DIMES**

Junior **Kate Hill** has established herself as one of the best ball handlers in the nation. Hill leads the Atlantic 10 in assist to turn-over ratio at 2.67 and ranks 13th in the country. She's first in the league in assists (88) and second in assists per game (4.4). The Toronto, Ontario native has the most games in the A-10 of seven or more assists at seven, with the next highest being four.

**FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH**

This season, La Salle's freshmen and sophomores are accounting for 68.1% of the Explorers' points. Of the 68.1%, 60.3% come from the team's top four scorers - freshman **Claire Jacobs**, sophomore **Kayla Spruill**, freshman **Jordon Lewis**, and freshman **Amy Jacobs**.

**MAGIC NUMBER: 70**

Under head coach **Mountain MacGillivray**, La Salle is a perfect 7-0 when scoring 70 or more points in a game.

**ROOKIE RECORD BREAKER**

Against UMass, freshman **Claire Jacobs** scored a career best 29 points on 12-of-18 shooting and 5-of-8 from long range. Her 29 points is the most by a freshman in program history, passing **Suzi McCaffrey's** 28 points over Towson State in 1983.

VAST IMPROVEMENTS AGAINST TEMPLE

La Salle saw four players score in double figures against the Owls for the first time this season. Freshman **Claire Jacobs** led the way with 19 points, followed by rookie **Amy Jacobs** (15), sophomore **Kayla Spruill** (12), and senior **Shalina Miller** (10). The squad outshot Temple from the field (44.6%) and three-point range (39.3%). Collectively, the team dished out 20 assists, which is the most in almost three years when the Explorers had 22 assists against Rhode Island on Jan. 9, 2017. Last season, Temple stumped La Salle, 75-47.

C. JACOBS, K. HILL RECORD CAREER HIGHS VS. NOVA

Rookie **Claire Jacobs** and junior **Kate Hill** had career games in the Explorers' loss to Villanova. Jacobs scored a career high 25 points and became the first Explorer to hit the mark since **Amy Griffin '18** did to conclude the regular season in 2017-18. Hill dished out a career best 11 assists. She's the first to do so in a La Salle uniform since **Shaquana Edwards** handed out 10 against UMass on Feb. 4, 2018.

500-500-100 CLUB

Senior **Shalina Miller** recorded her 500th rebound against Villanova earlier this season. She became the third player in program history to register 500 points, 500 rebounds, and 100 blocks. Miller joined **Amy Griffin '18** and **Suzi McCaffrey '86**.

LA SALLE LOVES KIDS GAMES

This season, the Explorers are set to play in two more Kids/School games - at Richmond (1/23) and vs. Davidson (2/26). Since the 2011-12 season, La Salle is 9-2 in such games, including 7-1 at home, 2-1 on the road, and 7-1 in its last eight.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 2006!

Through its first seven games, La Salle sat 6-1 on the year which marked the program's best start since the 2006-07 season when the Explorers started 7-0.

LEWIS, MILLER HAVE CAREER DAYS IN MILESTONE WIN

In La Salle's win at Norfolk State, freshman **Jordon Lewis** and senior **Shalina Miller** led La Salle with career days. The rookie registered a career high 18 points on 50% (4-of-8) shooting, including 2-of-3 from long range and a perfect 8-of-8 from the line. Miller grabbed a career best 16 rebounds. The victory was the program's 700th.



**COMEBACK KIDS**

In back-to-back upset wins, the Explorers have registered 16+ point comebacks over Harvard and Penn State. La Salle claimed a win over the Crimson with a 16-point comeback and overcame a 21-point deficit in Happy Valley. In the following game against Norfolk State the Explorers also overcame an 8-point deficit.

**HISTORY MAKERS**

La Salle's come-from-behind win over Penn St. was the first ever victory over the Lady Lions in program history. The win also signified the first over a Power 5 team since Nov. 29, 2015 when the Explorers topped Miami, 71-68, and the first over a Big Ten team since Dec. 22, 1988 when the Blue & Gold downed Northwestern, 69-67. In the win, La Salle outscored the Lady Lions, 33-11, in the final 8:23 led by the freshman trio of **Amy Jacobs**, **Claire Jacobs**, and **Jordon Lewis** who combined for 39 points, including 21 of the team's final 33.

**NEW SEASON, NEW TEAM?**

During head coach **Mountain MacGillivray's** first season, the Blue & Gold opened play with the same three opponents it did this season - Howard, Robert Morris, and Harvard. In 2018-19, the Explorers were 0-3, shot 22.9% (42-of-183) from the floor, and lost by a combined 74 points. It has been the opposite in 2019-20 with La Salle holding a 2-1 record, shooting 39.6% (72-of-182) from the floor, and outscoring opponents by 19 points.

**REVENGE AGAINST HARVARD**

After last year's loss to Robert Morris by 28 points, the Explorers nearly topped the Colonials at Tom Gola Arena on Saturday. RMU took the overtime-thriller, 71-68. Sophomore **Kayla Spruill** led La Salle with a career high 19 points, while senior **Sofilia Ngwafang** registered a double-double with 14 points and a career best 12 boards.

# Mountain MacGILLIVRAY

HEAD COACH | SECOND SEASON | TEMPLE '96

Mountain MacGillivray, a Philadelphia native who helped lead Quinnipiac to seven straight 20-win seasons and a trip to the Sweet 16 in 2017, was appointed the ninth head coach in La Salle University women's basketball history, in April of 2018. He begins his second year at the helm of the program in 2019-20.

MacGillivray spent the previous nine seasons at Quinnipiac, including the last three as the associate head coach. The Bobcats had tremendous success during MacGillivray's tenure, qualifying for the NCAA Tournament in four of his last five seasons, including three wins in NCAA play over the final two.

MacGillivray's role with the Bobcats evolved through the years and one of his greatest responsibilities is within the recruiting of prospective student-athletes. His success in the recruiting landscape has only improved through the years as his last two incoming classes featured the four highest-ranked recruits in program history. In his eight years with the Bobcats, MacGillivray helped guide 18 All-Conference players, including 10 in his final three seasons, as well as three Defensive Player of the Year award winners and three Tournament MVPs.

Quinnipiac went undefeated in the MAAC in 2017-18 for the third time in six years, winning the conference regular season title

for the fifth time in six seasons. After earning the league's automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament with a victory over Marist in the MAAC title game, the Bobcats earned a No. 9 seed and defeated Miami (Fla.) in the opening round.

In 2016-17, MacGillivray helped Quinnipiac to a pair of upset wins in NCAA Tournament action, defeating Marquette and Miami (Fla.) en route to the Sweet 16. The Bobcats won four conference championships and averaged 26 wins over that seven year span, and head coach Tricia Fabbri won MAAC Coach of the Year four times with the contributions of MacGillivray.

Prior to Quinnipiac, MacGillivray served as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of New Hampshire for two seasons from 2007-09, helping the Wildcats improve their finish in the conference in both seasons.

He got his start in collegiate coaching as an assistant at the University of Vermont in 1999-00, guiding the Catamounts to the NCAA Tournament that year after winning the America East regular season and tournament championships.

MacGillivray has 13 years of experience coaching at the high



school and AAU levels, helping turn Archbishop Carroll High School in Radnor, Pennsylvania into one of the most successful prep programs in the country. He also guided the Philadelphia AAU Lady Running Rebels from 2000-02 and Delaware Valley Comets AAU team in 2006.

A 1996 graduate of Temple with a degree in Journalism, MacGillivray and his wife Grace have eight children: Chiara, Mary, Brigid, Sean, Catherine, Joseph, Theresa, and Emily.

## DAY, MACGILLIVRAY REUNITE, TRY TO TURN AROUND LA SALLE

**PHILADELPHIA** – La Salle head women's basketball coach Mountain MacGillivray and his associate head coach, Chris Day, laughed and joked like the old friends they are as they spoke Monday about the paths that led them both to 20th & Olney.

This pairing did not happen by chance.

The seeds were sown 30 years ago when they served as managers in the girls basketball program at Archbishop Carroll High School. MacGillivray, a 1991 grad, was a sophomore at the time. Day, who graduated a year later, was a freshman.

Day would videotape the games and MacGillivray did the play-by-play, among many other tasks. Those humble beginnings grew into separate coaching careers. Day quickly became one of the best high school athletes in Delaware County of the early 1990s, and went on to become the head women's basketball coach at Widener and the University of Vermont, along with assistant coaching gigs for the girls team at Carroll and the women's programs for Widener, Duquesne, La Salle, Saint Joseph's, Indiana and Penn.

He also spent time as an assistant football coach at Widener and was the track coach for a year at West Chester East. MacGillivray served as an assistant at Carroll for 13 seasons before moving to assistant women's coaching positions at Vermont, New Hampshire and Quinnipiac universities.

Regardless of where they were, however, MacGillivray and Day always stayed close.

"We prepared for a lot of teams over the phone together," said MacGillivray, who played baseball for the Patriots.

"Yes we did," added Day, an All-Delco standout in football and track during his scholastic career at Carroll. "We shared tons of ideas, how to guard people, what they had, recruiting, all that."

Now they're sharing those ideas together as part of the same staff. Although La Salle is off to a rocky start (0-5), it was a pairing that was meant to be.

It was Day who heard through the coaching grapevine that there was going to be an opening at La Salle last spring and the man who encouraged his best friend to go for the job. MacGillivray had just completed his ninth season as an assistant at Quinnipiac University in Hamden, Conn. and his third as the associate head coach.

The Bobcats were coming off their third MAAC title in four years and fourth trip to the NCAA Division I women's tournament in six seasons, including a Sweet 16 run in 2017. MacGillivray had a great situation. He was comfortable, happy, coaching at a winning program and able to provide for his large family, which includes his wife Grace and their seven children.

"I had no interest in leaving a great program as an assistant just to be the head coach, so my name was on the marquee," MacGillivray said.

He threw his hat into the ring, anyway.

"Coaching in the Big 5, bringing my family back to Philadelphia

and being at a Catholic university, that was too much to pass up," MacGillivray said. "It takes a lot just to put yourself out there to do it, just to go for the job. You have to stress out your head coach. You have to stress out your family and then you don't get it, so I didn't even know if I wanted to get involved. But the more I thought about those three things: Being in the Big 5, being back home and being at a Catholic university, I was like, 'I have to do it.'"

MacGillivray applied for the job, with one condition.

"I said if I get it I want you," MacGillivray said of Day. "Would you do it? How much would it take? We were negotiating the whole time."

The offer came at an interesting time for Day. He had just finished his second season as the head coach at Vermont, albeit under a cloud.

In early April, Vermont athletic director Jeff Schulman confirmed television and published reports that the university was "Investigating certain aspects of the women's basketball program." Specifically the school was looking into Day's 'verbal interaction' with the players, according to an unnamed source in the television report.

The investigation caught Day by surprise, but came to an end without a report when he tendered his resignation on April 26. Less than two weeks later Day joined MacGillivray as his associate head coach.

Day said the investigation was not the reason for his resignation. It was the opportunity to bring his family home and coach

with his best friend.

"I can't speak on everything," said Day, who went 17-42 in his two seasons in Burlington. "The best way to phrase it is that there were a couple of curveballs that were thrown at me that were unexpected. It made me think, when Mountain got the job, is this meant to be? Is this going to be our final chance to ever come back home?"

Day had left Philly twice before only to return to his roots. He left Duquesne after a year to take an assistant coaching job at La Salle, which led to a seven-year stint at Saint Joseph's. He then went to Indiana only to return for a post at Penn, which led to the job at Vermont.

No matter where he was, though, his hometown area was always on his mind.

"I told many people that the only reason I would leave Vermont was to come back to Philly," Day said.

And so, when the opportunity presented itself to return home for a third time, Day jumped at it.

"The biggest thing for me, at this point in my career, if I'm going to make a move to be a head coach or go somewhere else, coming home and working with someone who understands family is important," Day said. "I have five kids. I have one in college and four younger. As you get older, it's important to work with someone you know understands about family and (MacGillivray), with seven (children), understands that."

MacGillivray and Day understand one another other and work well together. It dates to their days at Carroll when they served as managers, first under Linus McGinty and later Barry Kirsch.

"The behind-the-scenes meetings with Linus and Barry, oh my goodness," Day said. "We learned so much from them ... A lot of our base is what we learned at Carroll, running the Loyola Marymount transition, that type of stuff."

"They treated us more like assistant coaches than managers," MacGillivray said. "We talked about basketball nonstop. They taught us the way they did things. They encouraged us to get in there and work with the players and help them out, so I can't say enough about the opportunity that Linus gave us and that Barry gave me, specifically. That was huge."

Now MacGillivray and Day are trying to use those lessons learned at Carroll, and many other stops along the way, to turn around an Explorers program that has had just one winning season (17-13 in 2016-17) in the last 11 years.

They know what it's going to take to achieve that goal.

"Patience," they responded in unison.

Three decades ago they talked about coaching together on the collegiate level and now it's a reality. It's only fitting that it comes at La Salle, where both

reached the pinnacle of their high school athletic careers.

As a senior, MacGillivray helped Carroll win the Catholic League baseball title at La Salle's DeVincent Field. A year later, Day won the 100- and 200-meter dashes at the Catholic League championships at McCarthy Stadium.

Talk about karma.

"It was just a sign," Day said. "Whatever was going on up there at Vermont and Mountain getting the job here, it was just crazy. The Lord spoke again. He keeps calling me home and we listened again. It was nothing that went down. It was just me saying, 'OK, what's happening is unfortunate. I could easily fight it and be fine.' Nothing happened. There was no report. But it was like, 'Why do all this and have this hanging over me? Are people going to be side-eyeing me? It was like I was being told to go home and coach with my best friend. The Lord spoke. I listened and here we are.'"



## 75 PAIRS OF SNEAKERS? LA SALLE'S KATE HILL HEADS INTO JUNIOR SEASON ON SOLID FOOTING

**PHILADELPHIA** - In Kate Hill's own words, sitting out, not being able to play college basketball games last season, was the worst thing ever. Hill had transferred from Rutgers to La Salle in search of playing time. By all accounts, she'll find it this season.

Hill just had to survive the year sitting out.

Passing the time, favorite thing to do?

"Go to the mall," Hill said. "King of Prussia."

Favorite store?

"House of Hoops."

Favorite thing to buy?

"I'm a sneaker head."

How many sneakers are we talking about here?

"Over 75 sets of shoes," Hill said. "I've got all the boxes, a shoe rack on display."

La Salle teammate Deja King suggests 75 could be a conservative estimate.

"Between 75 and 100," King said of Hill's collection. (King is the other acknowledged sneaker head on the team, figuring she has between 30 and 45.)

Hill's favorite? She'll go with the Georgetown Air Jordan 11.

"Honestly, they just look the best – go with most of my outfits," Hill said. "White and blue ... I feel bad when I don't wear them, so I try to keep them in rotation."

Teammates will walk in her room, she said, and the response is typically the same.

"Dang, girl – why do you have so many?"

A lot of Jordans, Vans, Air Max.

"I try to stick to those four," Hill said. "I have a couple of random ones."

Most random?

"A couple of KDs I liked," Hill said, referring to shoes endorsed by Kevin Durant.

"Any shoe you can think of, and she has it in multiple colors," King said of the Hill collection.

For the record, Hill isn't going to be wearing any of those during a La Salle game. The Explorers are an Under Armour program. Hill said she is more than all right with that.

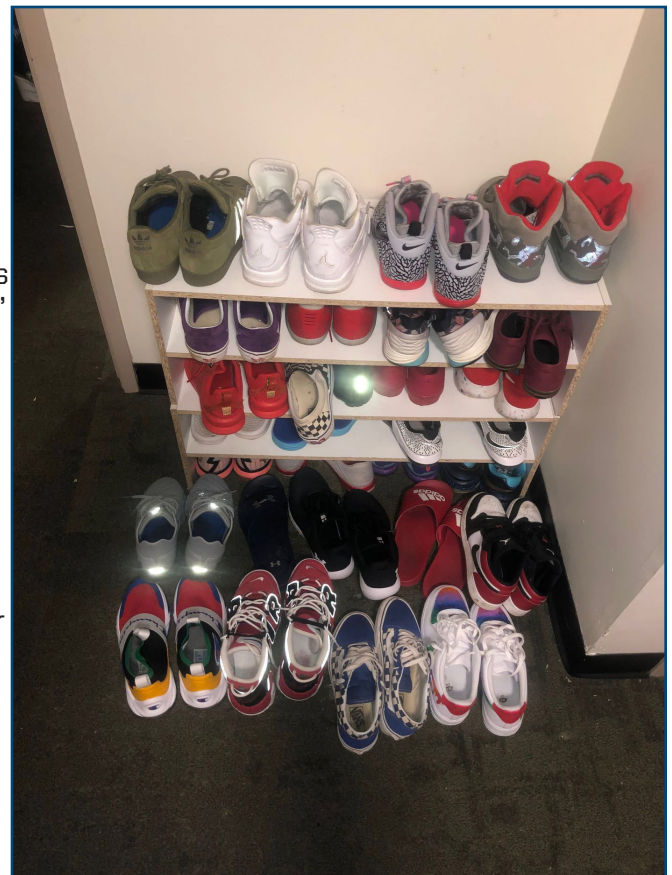
"Yeah, I like my Currys," Hill said.

Sitting out last season, she became close friends with King, although maybe at first King didn't know all that such a friendship would entail.

"Deja definitely has a lot," Hill said, talking sneakers. "We're the same size. I have a couple of her shoes in my room."

"Whenever she tries to put an outfit together and tries to get the right shoe, I say, 'I think I have the right one for you,' " King said.

For example ... black shirt, some writing on it. Light blue jeans. King's thought: Space Jams 11, from her own Jordan collection.



King's personal favorite?

"Just any pair of Jordan 11," King said.

La Salle coach Mountain MacGillivray said that when Hill first got to La Salle, she asked if she could store some stuff in the locker room.

"That does not constitute some stuff," MacGillivray remembers telling Hill.

What does the coach make of it all?

"I have no comment," MacGillivray said. "Kate has lots of style, and she needs lots of sneakers to go with all of them. As long as she plays hard on the court, I don't care what she does with her sneakers."

From Toronto, Hill first got into sneakers when she moved to New Jersey, boarding at the Peddie School, after her family decided this was the best path to college basketball. Her older sister Sami had done a year at Blair Academy before playing at Virginia Tech.

The family has mixed up its sports. Her father played basketball at the University of Toronto, while mom was a long and triple jumper at the same school. Two brothers played college baseball.

"Two things she's brought to our program – a work ethic, and she's in great shape," MacGillivray said. "She has a competitiveness to her. She's not losing sprints. She's going to win every conditioning drill. She's in the gym extra without being asked and people are following that lead. Every dog track needs a

rabbit. She's been the rabbit for us."

As it happens, Hill and King will split time at point guard, and no doubt share time on the court as well. Their coach thinks that is kind of special, seeing them compete for time while forging a close friendship.

Sharing playing time, sharing sneakers? What's the difference?

"My parents tell me I need to stop buying shoes," Hill said, adding, "I haven't."

She collects other kinds of shoes, too?

"No, just sneakers," Hill said. "I think I own one pair of heels that I'm required to wear when we dress up."

Her teammate King said newcomers to La Salle's team don't "know the full extent" of Hill's collection.

When will she stop?

"Never," Hill said. "I don't think I

will ever grow out of it."



## LA SALLE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL COACH MOUNTAIN MACGILLIVRAY CHARTED A UNIQUE PATH TO 20TH AND OLNEY

**PHILADELPHIA** - It's his given name, not a nickname. Mountain MacGillivray knows how many conversations will start there.

"You can imagine, every time I say my name," La Salle's first-year women's basketball coach said.

He's making a hotel reservation. It's Mountain. M-O-U ....

"Milton? Malcolm?"

You expect maybe a guy wearing overalls – not someone who grew up in Overbrook, Columbia by 64th, "right behind the 7-Eleven."

Back to the name. We're not done there.

"He'll tell you: He's got his repertoire of stories of where he got the name," said Mountain's former boss, Tricia Fabbri, the head women's coach at Quinnipiac. "Feel out the person, tell the story."

"I have like five go-to stories," Mountain said. "You call them stories. But they're lies."

Some more plausible than others.

"I've never walked away with someone believing my mother was the second woman to climb Mount Everest," he said.

But second woman is a nice touch.

"First would never work, and it's more verifiable," Mountain said.

He'll also say his mom went into labor while flying over the Rocky Mountains.

"That's not true," Mountain added.

Or he might say his father was a big baseball fan and he is named for Kenesaw Mountain Landis, the first commissioner of baseball.

"I would like that one to be true," Mountain said, since he played baseball at Archbishop Carroll High and for a time at Temple.

The real story? His old boss knows it.

"His mom and dad were hippies," Fabbri said.

"It was 1973," Mountain said. "My dad was 20; my mom, 19. They wanted to name me something different. If I was a girl, it would have been Sunshine."

"It fits him," Fabbri said. "There's only one Mountain."

Which gets to his path to being a Big 5 head coach. Which also sounds fictional. Not how he got this La Salle job. Quinnipiac's big-time success made this move make sense. You don't get to the NCAA Sweet 16 out of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference without all sorts of things hitting on all cylinders.

It was the path to Quinnipiac, to coaching at all, that is, well ... Mountainous.

"I know a ton of women's basketball coaches," said Bobbi Morgan, head coach at Haverford College. "He's probably had the most interesting path."

She's had an interesting one herself, since it was always a dual one: sports journalism and coaching. Morgan used to be sports editor of the Main Line Times.

"Mountain was an Archbishop Carroll student when he started writing for me," said Morgan, whose own Haverford team just won the Centennial Conference to qualify for the NCAA Division III tournament. "Then he went to Temple. I think he majored in journalism."

Mountain was a baseball player at Carroll, an optimistic one. There was a conversation with his coach when he was a junior, how he was going to be all-Catholic the next year.

"Mountain, you have to play to be all-Catholic," the coach told him. (Postscript: He played, was all-Catholic.)

While Mountain was at Carroll, he got cut from the hoops team, and



ended up being a manager for the girls' team. (Not unique; his assistant coach, Chris Day, was a two-sport athlete at Carroll, but also managed the girls' hoops team, their friendship cemented.)

That began when his old CYO coach saw Mountain at the 7-11 near his house. Mountain didn't know this coach was also the junior varsity girls' coach at Carroll, and was surprised when the coach asked him if he wanted to help out.

"I didn't even know girls played basketball," Mountain said.

It turned out his cousin Nancy ["like third cousin, once removed"] was one of the better players at Carroll. And the head varsity coach at the time, Linus McGinty, asked Mountain to do play-by-play for the game film, since McGinty was practically falling asleep watching it. So that was fun right off the bat.

"They were a really good team," Mountain said. "Like top 15 in the country. They played Dawn Staley and Dobbins Tech at St. Joe's. I started to see I could pick up 'Hey, when you missed a shot, you did this. When you made a shot, you did this.' I wasn't very good as a player. I had a decent eye for mechanics."

Mountain also helped Morgan coach a Narberth League team. He stopped baseball while at Temple,

as McGinty asked him to go on Carroll's staff.

"I was really excited," Mountain said. "Then he takes the job at O'Hara. I was crushed. I was so upset. I wouldn't have gone to O'Hara for a million dollars – maybe a million dollars."

He hadn't really overlapped with the new Carroll coach, Barry Kirsch, an assistant, but Kirsch kept the offer out there, and Mountain ended up being on his staff for 13 years.

"He really taught me everything I know," Mountain said. "I learned the game at his hand."

He also began coaching with the Comets AAU program. The Gallagher family, who had started that Delaware County-based program – "they had a full half-court in the backyard, with a light. Every night in the summer, there would be three-on-three games, for five, six hours." A who's who's of Delaware County hoops rolled through. (John Gallagher left those games in his backyard to become Hartford's head men's coach.)

Joan Gallagher knew Mountain's cousin, and her college assistant coach became the head coach at Vermont and offered Mountain a part-time, \$5,000-a-year job. He took it, working breakfast at the Sheraton in the mornings.

The money just wasn't survivable, though, since he was planning to get married. When Cathy Rush offered him a job running her camp, he grabbed it. "Working for Cathy Rush gives you an air of legitimacy," Mountain said of the former Immaculata coaching legend.

At Carroll, he remembers not getting a guard the staff had wanted, losing her to O'Hara, but that same player, Kara Cassidy, ended up going to Quinnipiac as an assistant years later, then left for Penn and recommended that Mountain replace her. It didn't hurt that she knew his third cousin once removed.

"It's so amazing how intertwined Philadelphia basketball is," Mountain said.

He knows La Salle doesn't have the same facilities as Quinnipiac had. He had expected to be there, he said, as long as Fabbri was there. But being a Big 5 head coach? He had to go for that opening.

He was talking on the phone, on a recruiting trip in Florida, just beating last week's snow out of town, explaining how he could sell La Salle's tradition and the opportunity for playing time and specific majors.

"It's a big deal to young women to have a degree that fits what they're looking for," he said.

Most of all, he can sell himself.

"They're Philly people," Morgan said of his whole family. "I forget what parish."

And if he tells you it's easier to climb Mount Everest than to take his particular path to a head-coaching job, you might have to believe Mountain on that.
