

The 2021-22 year provided highlights both on the fields of play and in the classroom. Men’s cross country won its 11th Atlantic 10 title, dominating the field by nearly 40 points. Four student-athletes earned All-A-10 honors by placing in the Top 15. On the water, men’s rowing had a banner season, earning a pair of gold medals at the famed Dad Vail Regatta and earning eighth place nationally at the IRA National Championships.

The classroom accolades were just as impressive. In December, the NCAA announced that La Salle University, along with seven other prestigious academic institutions, ranked first among all Division I members for Graduation Success Rate - alongside Columbia, Dartmouth, Duke, Harvard, Holy Cross, Lafayette, and Yale. All told, our student-athletes boast an impressive 3.45 cumulative GPA and all 19 teams have over a 3.0 GPA.

We are devoted to giving each student-athlete the tools necessary to excel in all aspects of their college lives, and fostering a positive environment for all.
